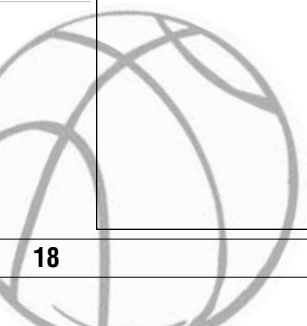

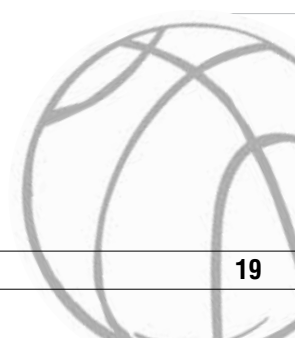

Junior Year (2011-12)

Played in every game, including three starts ... ranked 19th in the SEC, second on the team, in rebounding average and 11th in league in offensive rebounds per game (2.7) ... had two double-doubles ... was team's top rebounder seven times (at Illinois, Penn State, CofC, Presbyterian, at NC State, at Arkansas, at Kentucky, vs. Eastern Michigan) and top scorer three times (at Illinois, Alabama A&M, vs. Georgia) ... scored in double figures nine times and had two double-figure rebound games ... averaged 9.3 points and 5.7 rebounds in NCAA Tournament games ... snagged three of her five rebounds in the NCAA Sweet 16 vs. #2/2 Stanford on the offensive end ... scored seven of her 10 points in second half to hold off #13/15 Purdue in NCAA second round ... reeled in five offensive boards among her seven against Eastern Michigan in the NCAA first round ... led offense with 12 points in SEC Tournament second-round win over Georgia ... put back a missed free throw to help spark a 14-4 run in the second half that put the Gamecocks on top of Arkansas for good ... scored 10 of her 13 points and grabbed eight of her 11 rebounds in the second half at #13/10 Kentucky, including a put-back to bring Gamecocks within two with 42 seconds left ... sparked game-winning 9-0 run in the final 3:18 at #8/8 Tennessee with a basket and a steal on the Lady Vols' next possession ... scored three of her four points at #25/22 Vanderbilt on back-to-back possessions early in the second half to stop the Commodores' 10-2 run and preserve the team's lead ... netted all eight of her points and pulled down five of her six boards at Auburn in the second half as Gamecocks tried to rally back from a nine-point halftime deficit ... drew her first start of the season against #9/8 Kentucky (Jan. 15) ... pulled down 18 rebounds against #11/12 Penn State (Nov. 20), tying for third-most in Colonial Life Arena history and the third-most by an SEC player on the season... posted double-figure points in four of season's first six games.

Sophomore Year (2010-11)

Ranked sixth in the SEC in offensive rebounding (3.0 per game) ... in SEC play, ranked 29th in scoring ... led the team in rebounding 13 times and was the leading scorer three times ... reached double-figure points in seven SEC games ... grabbed three of her five rebounds against Charlotte on the offensive end to go with eight points in the second round of the WNIT ... turned in her second perfect shooting game of the season (6-of-6) against Appalachian State in the first round of the WNIT ... pulled down five rebounds in just nine minutes against Georgia in second round of SEC Tournament ... scored three tough baskets and handed out two assists in SEC Tournament game against Ole Miss ... posted second-straight 14-point game and led the way with seven rebounds at LSU ... paced the team with six boards against Auburn, including five offensive, to finish with 14 points ... netted both her shot attempts, including a layup in the last 20 seconds of the overtime win

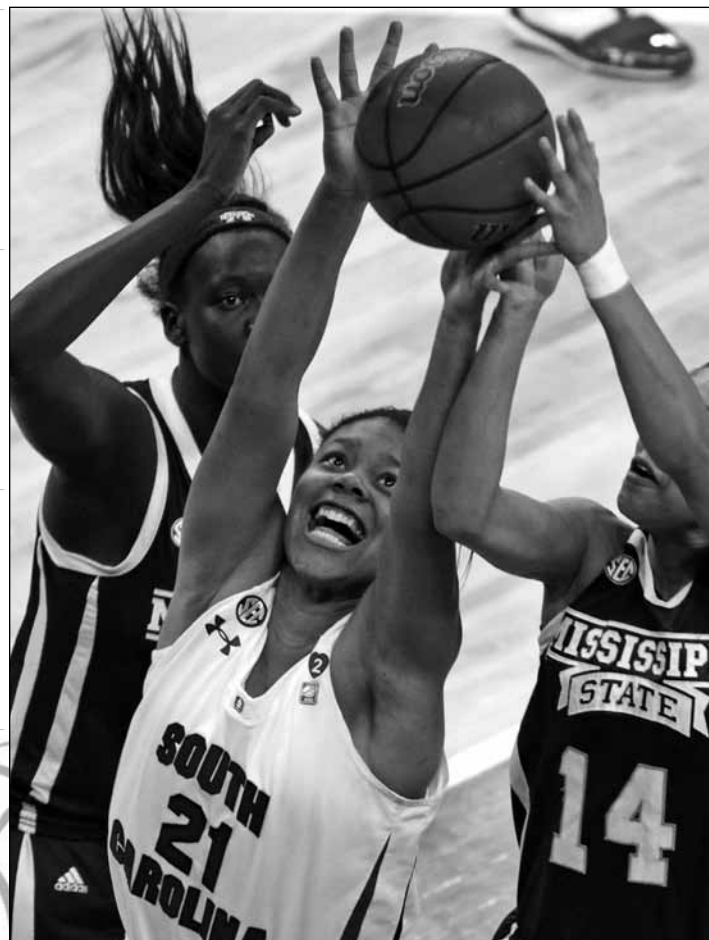

Freshman Year (2011-12)

Come off the bench in 25 games, including 10 SEC contests and five postseason games ... was the team's top rebounder one time (Miss. State) ... tied South Carolina freshman record with five blocks in first-round win over Eastern Michigan, the most blocks by any Gamecock in program's history in the NCAA Tournament ... was perfect from the floor in SEC Tournament semifinal against #13/10 Tennessee ... played a season-high 16 minutes in first round SEC Tournament game vs. Alabama ... was solid presence in middle of zone that held Alabama to just 27.7 percent shooting at Colonial Life Arena, the lowest by an SEC opponent this season ... posted six points and team-high six rebounds against Mississippi State, all during her 10 minutes of second-half play ... was solid at Auburn, adding a basket and two rebounds in just three minutes of action late in the first half ... pulled down season-high seven rebounds against SC State in 15 minutes of action ... netted season-best seven points against Furman on 3-of-6 shooting ... swatted away three shots at Xavier ... made her Gamecock debut in season opener at Illinois.

Earned four letters for Coach John Strickland's Tigers ... rated among the top 15 post players in the 2011 class by ESPN HoopGurlz and the overall No. 57 recruit in the class, according to *Blue Star Basketball* ... earned a spot on the Atlanta Tip-Off Club All-Metro team and was a 4A second-team selection as a senior after helping her team to a 28-5 record and region and state titles ... was named to the All-Metro Southside Second Team by the *Atlanta Journal Constitution* and first-team All-Fayette County by the *Fayette County News* as a junior

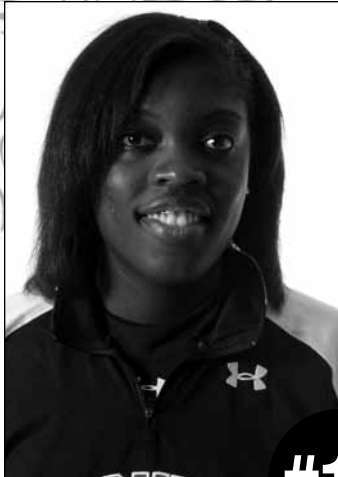
