## Game Notables

- Today marks the Gamecocks' 13th game in Myrtle Beach all-time and their ninth as part of the Beach Ball Classic/Carolinas Challenge at the Convention Center. South Carolina is 6-6 in Myrtle Beach, including a 2-6 mark at the Convention Center, where it previously has faced only North Carolina. The Gamecocks' other games in Myrtle Beach were part of the 1991 and 1993 Coastal Carolina Invitationals.
- Plagued by trouble at the foul line this season, the Gamecocks have hit 76.7 percent (33-of-43) over the last two games.
- Junior center Alaina Coates has been on a tear since South Carolina returned from Hawaii, averaging 22.3 points and 11.7 rebounds over the last three games. The stretch includes her first career triple-double (vs. Winthrop, 12/13), which she followed up with a double-double (vs. Hampton, 12/16) three days later.
- Senior guard Khadijah Sessions has been showing off her more efficient offense lately, shooting 68.4 percent from the field (13-of-19) over the last five games to average 6.6 points.
- Senior guard Tiffany Mitchell continues to rediscover her form after a long layoff following August foot surgery, and she is showing more frequent signs of her two-time All-America self. Scoring in double figures in all but one game this season, she shot 50.0 from 3-point range ( 6 -of-12) over the last two games while also averaging 5.5 rebounds during the stretch.

## Gamecocks' Five-Second Count

South Carolina is enjoying its most successful period in program history. The 2015 Senior Class set a four-year record with 113 wins and a .813 winning percentage. The 2016 Senior Class has a chance top that number, currently holding a of $98-16$, winning 86.0 percent of its contests. Winning consecutive SEC regular-season titles in the last two seasons, South Carolina has not finished outside the SEC's top four in four campaigns.

In the last two seasons, three Gamecocks have earned All-America honors - prior to the 2013-14 season just 12 Gamecocks had captured the title. Seven Gamecocks have earned All-SEC selection in the last two seasons, including three members of the 2015-16 squad.

## East Carolina Series Notes

The Gamecocks are 14-1 all-time against the Pirates with the lone loss coming in the inaugural meeting between the teams on Feb. 15, 1975. The two programs have not met since a 67-60 South Carolina win on Jan. 19, 1998, in Columbia. The Gamecocks have been nationally ranked in four of the games against the Pirates, winning by an average of 24.5 points in those outings.

## Neutral Corners

South Carolina is 106-82 (.564) all-time playing on a neutral court, including a $28-16$ record (.636) under head coach Dawn Staley. In regular-season action, the overall neutral-site record improves to 60-40 (.600) with a 14-5 mark (.739) under Staley.

## Fast Start

South Carolina is looking to start a season 11-0 for just the second time in program history but the second time in as many seasons. The Gamecocks rocketed through the 2014-15 season with 22 straight victories. Prior to that, a

10-0 start was the program's best and was accomplished by the 1981-82, 2012-13 and 2013-14 teams.

## Getting Back Where We Belong

The Gamecocks have steadily marched up the national standings in field goal percentage and field goal percentage defense, ranking among the country's top 20 in both. South Carolina has long been among the nation's best defensive teams, adding offensive efficiency in recent seasons. The Gamecocks finished last season ranked fourth in the nation in field goal percentage (.484) and 10th in field goal percentage defense (.349). South Carolina is currently shooting 46.5 percent from the field (18th) and holding opponents to 33.2 percent (19th).

## Identity Search

While South Carolina returns 11 letterwinners from last season's NCAA Final Four team, Gamecock head coach Dawn Staley knows her squad continues

to search for its 2015-16 identity. The names may not have changed, but the roles for many key Gamecocks certainly have. Senior Tina Roy, junior Alaina Coates and sophomore A'ja Wilson are all adjusting to regular calls to the starting lineup after coming off the bench for the first years of their careers. Senior guard/forward Asia Dozier is acclimating to her role off the bench after starting the last two seasons and is spending more time in the frontcourt. The Gamecocks are counting on sophomore forward Jatarie White to provide more off the bench. Even senior guard Tiffany Mitchell is still feeling her way into the offense after a long layoff due to August foot surgery as well as embracing her more active leadership role.

## Constantly Climbing

A pair of Gamecocks are moving rapidly up South Carolina's career charts, closing in on milestones.

Senior guard Tiffany Mitchell needs just two points to reach 1,500 for her career, which only 10 other Gamecocks have achieved. With 288 career assists and 186 career steals to go along with her scoring, only two former Gamecocks have surpassed that collection of numbers - Shannon Johnson ( 2,230 pts, 467 assts, 260 stls) and Martha Parker ( $1,728 \mathrm{pts}, 542$ assts, 284 stls ).

Junior center Alaina Coates has launched an assault on the Gamecocks' blocked shots record book since swatting away 73 her freshman year. She needs just one more to break into the program's all-time top three in career blocks. Coates broke the 38 -year old singlegame blocks record when she swatted away 10 against Winthrop on Dec. 13, 2015.

## Poll Position

South Carolina remains at No. 2 in the nation in both polls this week, marking the 25th-straight time the Gamecocks have been ranked among the nation's top three teams. South Carolina has held a top-10 position in the Associated Press poll for 36 straight weeks and been ranked in the AP top 25 for 60 consecutive weeks (beginning Dec. 10, 2012). The longest ranked streak in school history is 62 weeks - Feb. 27, 1979 through Jan. 9, 1983.

## Ranked Readings

South Carolina's 10 wins against ranked foes last season set a program record, topping the eight wins of the 1979-80 squad. Of those wins, five came against a top-10 foe.

This season, the Gamecocks have 11 games on the schedule against teams currently ranked in the top 25 , including five vs. top-10 entries. South Carolina opened the season with a win over No. 6/10 Ohio State (Nov. 13, 88-80), following that with victories over No. 16/18 Arizona State (Nov. 27, 60-58) and No. 14/13 Duke (Dec. 6, 66-55).

After posting a 17-8 record against ranked opponents since the start of the 2013-14 season, head coach Dawn Staley has a 28-42 mark vs. the nation's best teams during her South Carolina tenure, highlighted by a 16-8 mark when the Gamecocks carry a better ranking than their opponent into the contest.

## Strength in Numbers

Based on cumulative opponent winning percentage, South Carolina currently has the 29th toughest schedule in the nation. The 26 teams the Gamecocks will face this season have a current winning percentage of .669 .

With just four home games so far this season, the Gamecocks are 14 th in the RPI, the third-highest in the SEC, trailing only Georgia in fifth and Kentucky in ninth. Missouri (20) and Tennessee (24) are the other SEC schools among the top 25 . Two others - Florida (35) and Texas A\&M (42) - are in the top 50.

## Quarter Breakdown

Through 40 quarters so far this season, South Carolina has out-scored its opponent 28 times with the Gamecocks topping their foe by double digits 10 times, including twice posting a season-high differential of $19-27-8$ in the third quarter at Clemson (Nov. 18) and 26-7 in the first quarter against Winthrop (Dec. 6). This season's best second-quarter advantage is 17 (269) against UNCG (Nov. 15) and fourth-quarter edge is 17 (27-10) vs. Hampton (Dec. 16). South Carolina has shot at least 50.0 percent in 19 quarters this season with a high of 80.0 percent ( 8 -of-10) in the third quarter against Hampton.

Defensively, of the 10 lowest shooting percentage quarters for opposing teams seven have been in the second half, including three of the four lowest.

A more detailed look at the quarter-by-quarter production for the Gamecocks and their opponents.

Individually, sophomore forward A'ja Wilson has turned in four of the top five scoring quarters for South Carolina, netting double digits in all four led by her 12 in the fourth quarter against \#6/10 Ohio State (Nov. 13) and in the third quarter against \#14/13 Duke (Dec. 6). Senior guard Tiffany Mitchell has the highest firstquarter scoring total with nine against both CSUB (Nov. 28) and Winthrop (Dec. 13). Wilson's 11 against UNCG (Nov. 15) are the team's best second-quarter production.

## Free Throw Follies

South Carolina's emphasis on interior play has the Gamecocks ranked 12th in the nation in free throw attempts (239) and 22nd in free throws made (155). After hitting a rough stretch from a percentage standpoint, South Carolina has shot 76.7 percent (33-of43) from the line over the last two games. Individually, three Gamecocks rank among the SEC's best in free throw percentage, led by senior guard Tiffany Mitchell's 81.0 percent in fourth. Sophomores Bianca Cuevas (.714) and A'ja Wilson (.711) come in 11th and 12th, respectively.

## Block Party

The Gamecocks blocked a Dawn Staley-era high 16 shots against Winthrop (Dec. 13), led by junior Alaina Coates' single-game school-record 10. In completing the program's first triple-double since Dec. 2006, Coates broke the 38 -year-old record of eight set by Jean Walling against SC State on Dec. 7, 1977, and doubled her previous career high of five. Sophomore forward Jatarie White also updated her career high for blocks with four against the Eagles.

## Legacy of Leadership

South Carolina has thrived under excellent leadership from its team-selected captains the last few seasons. While some thought that area would be a question mark heading into this season, the Gamecocks selected their four returning seniors - Asia Dozier, Tiffany Mitchell, Tina Roy and Khadijah Sessions - as their captains. All but Roy have served in that capacity at least once prior to this season.

## Highest Honors

Experts have their eye on three Gamecocks in the running for national player of the year honors - senior guard Tiffany Mitchell, junior center Alaina Coates and sophomore forward $A^{\prime} j$ a Wilson. South Carolina is in elite company with that many players in the running.

Most recently, the trio appeared on the Naismith Early Season Watch List, which included the 50 best players in the nation. South Carolina was one of three teams with three entries.

The USBWA announced its 20 -member watch list for the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award, which included Mitchell and Wilson, putting South Carolina among just three programs with multiple players recognized.
The Wooden Award got the streak going, announcing it's 30 -player watch list, which featured all the Gamecocks. South Carolina joined UConn as the only schools with three players selected.

## Great Gamecock Fans

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers. Average attendance has grown steadily over the last three seasons, culminating in this season's sellout of the season-ticket allotment - over 11,000 . Only single-game, general admission tickets remain available for purchase. And fans are doing that, too.

South Carolina leads the nation in average attendance at 14,475 , topping second-place Iowa State by more than 3,940 . Only three programs average at least 10,000 fans this season - South Carolina, Iowa State and Louisville $(10,364)$.

Delving more deeply into the numbers, South Carolina's Colonial Life Arena's capacity of 18,000 makes it the seventh-largest women's basketball venue in the nation. South Carolina is the only one of those
selling over 50 percent of their capacity as Gamecocks fans are filling Colonial Life Arena at 80.42 percent capacity, the highest of any facility seating at least 10,000 and seventh overall.
Prior to 2015-16, the Gamecocks led the nation in average attendance increase in each of the previous two seasons and paced the country in average attendance in 2014-15 at 12,293. South Carolina played in front of over 10,000 fans 15 times that season with 13 of those coming at Colonial Life Arena. The 17,156 fans that turned out for the Jan. 11 game against Kentucky were just shy of the women's basketball record of 17,712 (vs. Clemson, $11 / 22 / 02$ ) at the facility.

## SEC Active Leaders

The SEC compiled its active leaders in seven statistical categories this week, and five different Gamecocks are among the top 10 in at least one category. Senior Tiffany Mitchell's league-high six entries is not a surprise given the breadth of her resume, but the appearance of sophomore A'ja Wilson at No. 4 on the active blocked shots list, which junior Alaina Coates leads, may catch some observers off guard.
Mitchell headlines the South Carolina entries ranking second in scoring ( 1,498 ); third in steals (186), field goals made (502) and 3-pointers made (137); fourth in assists (288) and seventh in rebounding (508). She is the highest-ranking guard on the rebounding list, which includes just two other true perimeter players.

Senior Khadijah Sessions holds seventh in steals (137) and eighth in assists (245). Senior Tina Roy is on the 3 -pointers made list, coming in at sixth (112).
Junior Alaina Coates is the league's active leader in blocks (147), sits third in rebounds (655) and ninth in scoring (949).

## Preseason Poll Pop

For the second-straight season, South Carolina was ranked No. 2 in both the AP and USA Today Coaches Preseason Poll, which is the best preseason rank in program history. The Gamecocks spent the entire 2014-15 season ranked in the top three in the nation, including 12 weeks at No. 1 - the first-ever No. 1 ranking for the program.

## Mitchell's March

Senior guard Tiffany Mitchell has worked her way into the annual national player of the year conversations over the last two seasons, and expectations are the same this season for the two-time All-American and reigning back-to-back SEC Player of the Year. Ranking among the SEC's best in numerous categories over the last three seasons, Mitchell is steadily moving up various Gamecocks' career charts as well.

this season, she is among the SEC top 20 in both scoring and rebounding. Her 679 field goal percentage leads the league and ranks fourth in the nation. Coates is sixth in the SEC in rebounding at 8.5 per game and 17 th in scoring average at 13.3. Her 2.1 blocks per game are second-best in the league as well.

With 25 career double-doubles she is tied for eighth in program history in that category, just seven shy of reaching the all-time top five. Ten of her double-doubles have come in SEC play, which rank her second in program history in that category, just one behind the school-record 11 by Marsha Williams (1992-93).

The SEC's active leader with 147 career blocks, Coates holds fourth place in South Carolina history in the category. She is just 30 shy of Lakesha Tolliver's (2004-07) career record of 177.

## Hometown Hero

Sophomore forward A'ja Wilson has lived up to her billing, both this season being selected to the watch lists for the Wooden, Naismith and the USBWA Ann Meyers Drysdale Awards and last season as the SEC Freshman of the Year, First-Team All-SEC selection and the first Gamecock freshman to earn All-America honors.


This season, Wilson has been the Gamecocks' top scorer six times and top rebounder in five games. She leads the SEC in blocks per game (3.1) and doubledoubles (5), categories in which she ranks eighth and 17 th in the nation, respectively. Wilson is also among the SEC's top five in scoring ( $4 \mathrm{th}, 18.3$ ), rebounding ( 2 nd , 9.3 ) and field goal percentage (5th, .545). Named SEC Player of the Week three times in the first four weeks of the season, Wilson has routinely delivered at crunch time - 12 of her 20 points against \#6/10 Ohio State (Nov. 13) came in the fourth quarter, including six of the team's 10 in the final 2:35; scoring and rebounding

late at UCLA (Nov. 22) put Gamecocks on top in final 3:00 of tight game; three rebounds in final 18 seconds of tie game vs. \#16/18 Arizona State (Nov. 27) led to game-winning free throws with 0.6 seconds to play; 10 points in fourth quarter vs. CSU Bakersfield (Nov. 28) broke open seven-point game heading into the period; and 20 second-half points against Duke included 12 of the team's 16 in the third quarter and six in the final $1: 45$ of the game.

## So Sarah

Senior forward Sarah Imovbioh joined the Gamecocks this season after three campaigns at Virginia, during which she annually ranked among the ACC's top 15 rebounders and top 10 field goal percentage shooters.

After starting this season off with a bang - adding six points and four rebounds early in the fourth quarter against \#6/10 Ohio State (Nov. 13) to help the Gamecocks hold off then storm past the Buckeyes and posting a double-double in the second game of the season - Imovbioh struggled to find her rhythm playing fewer minutes than she was accustomed to with the Cavaliers. Starting the last two outings, she has rediscovered her scoring efficiency, shooting 81.8 percent (9-of-11) from the field and averaging 13.0 points.

## Dawn Staley

# Head Coach 8th Season at South Carolina Virginia, 1992 



When three-time Olympic gold medalist Dawn Staley took the reins of the University of South Carolina women's basketball program on May 10, 2008, the Gamecocks' stature immediately rose not just in the Southeastern Conference but on the national stage as well. Building on a foundation of hard work, defensive effort and a "team first" mentality, South Carolina began to realize those expectations in 2011-12, and the program has continued to thrive. The Gamecocks boast four straight 25 -win seasons, which include two SEC regular-season championships (2014, 2015), an SEC Tournament title (2015), an NCAA Final Four appearance (2015) and two other Sweet 16 seasons (2012, 2014), the program's first ever No. 1 national ranking and a school-record 34 wins in 2014-15. Staley's success has united every demographic in the state of South Carolina as the Gamecocks' fan based has tripled over the last three seasons, leading the nation in home attendance in 2014-15 at 12,293 fans per game and pacing the country in attendance increase in 2013-14 and 2014-15.

While her coaching career is blossoming, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified her legacy with her enshrinement into the Hall as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012 and was one of the final nominees for induction to the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame the same year. In the summer of 2011, the WNBA recognized her as one of the league's "Top 15," honoring the most influential players in the league's history.

In her 16th season as a head coach, Staley has led her teams to six 25 -win seasons, a total of 12 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 34 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 12 in the No. 1 spot.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last seven seasons, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year (2014, Basketball Times), a Naismith National Coach of the Year Finalist (2014, 2015), SEC Coach of the Year (2014, Coaches and AP; 2015, Coaches) and BCA Female Coach of the Year (2012). She has coached two All-Americans, 16 All-SEC selections, six SEC All-Freshman team selections, two SEC Player of the Year choices, an SEC Sixth Player of the Year, an SEC Defensive Player of the Year and three SEC Freshman of the Year winners. South Carolina has turned in historic seasons each of the last four, especially standing out among the program's 24 seasons in the SEC, posting 25 wins in 2011-12 and 2012-13, 29 wins in 2013-14 and a school-record 34 victories in 2014-15. The Gamecocks have won more SEC games than the season before in each of Staley's last six seasons, and her 67 SEC victories are more than any other Gamecock coach, accounting for 51.1 percent of the program's total 131 league wins. She has helped the Gamecocks to four of the program's five top-four finishes in the SEC, including the first regular-season championship in 2013-14 and a share of the same title in 2014-15. Her 113 overall wins in the last four seasons mark the most successful four-year stretch in program history. Off the court, Staley's Gamecocks have been active in the community and thriving in the classroom. Every student-athlete who completed her eligibility under Staley at South Carolina has graduated or is on track to graduate, and the team GPA has been over 3.0 for the last six semesters. During the historic 2014-15 season, eight Gamecocks posted at least a 3.0 GPA for the year.
