NOTEWORTHY

SCOUTING ALABAMA

Alabama split last weekend, losing Sunday at No. 6 Florida but winning a thrilling five-set match against arch-rival Auburn in Tuscaloosa. The Tide do have wins in two of their last three outings, but are just 2-5 since Oct. 23 and 2-6 overall on the road this season. With outside hitter Kat Hutson out with an injury since Sept. 10, Bama has run senior Krystal Rivers early and often for offensive production, and she has produced eye-popping numbers that puts her second in the nation in kills (5.75/set) and total points (6.53/set). For the season, Rivers has 1,445 attacks to her name, just 95 fewer than Alabama's second-, third- and fourth-leading attackers combined. Despite the heavy reliance on Rivers, Alabama does have a number of other threats on both sides of the net. Leah Lawrence leads the team with 104 total blocks and pitches in 1.62 kills per set, Brittany Thomas averages 2.91 digs and 1.89 kills per set, and freshman Hayley McSparin ranks second on the team with 1.94 kills per set.

SCOUTING AUBURN

The Tigers tout one of the most well-rounded offenses in the SEC, with four different hitters averaging over two kills per set joining in with perhaps the most dangerous setter in the conference. Alexa Filley ranks fifth overall on the team in kills as a six-rotation setter, but also averages almost 10 assists per set and has dig averages (3.31/set) that rival most team's liberos. Auburn leads the conference in digs per set, popping up 15.55 as a team, and wears down the opposition with an offense that doesn't lean on any one player in particular. For 2016, Auburn has played in 27 matches, and nine of those have gone five sets with another nine going four. On defense, the Tigers don't have a particularly imposing block (averaging just 1.71/set), but keep the ball alive thanks to libero Jesse Earl (5.14 digs/set). On offense, sophomore Breanna McIlroy averages 3.09 kills per set, and thanks to the strong passers for Auburn, middle blockers Gwyn Jones and Breanna Barksdale are second and third on the team in kills, combining to average 4.77 per set through the middle.

PREVIOUS WEEKEND (FLORIDA/MISSOURI) NOTABLES

- Despite giving up more kills to Missouri on Sunday, the Gamecocks committed 11 fewer attack errors to take
 a match that was decided by a combined 11 points. 12 blocks for South Carolina are the most in a single
 match since Oct. 2 against Kentucky. All told, the Tigers committed 30 unforced errors (17 attack, eight on
 service, two on serve receive and three on blocking errors).
- The last win over a ranked opponent came on Sept. 17, 2006, when current assistant coach Shonda Cole talled 35 kills over four sets to beat #6 Florida. This is South Carolina's second win ever against Missouri, the last coming at home in 2014.
- Koko Atoa-Williams recorded her third double-double of the season on Sunday, giving her 16 for her career.
 She now ranks 21st in school history for double-doubles, and her 18 digs Sunday night are the most since her career high of 27 against Tennessee in 2014.
- Mikayla Shields has flourished in the team's 5-1 offense against Missouri. The freshman put together her third
 double-double over the last five matches and had a season-best 14 digs.
- Missouri hit .367 as a team in the first meeting between the two this season, but the Tigers were limited to
 just .178 on Sunday. South Carolina was able to slow down a deep Mizzou offense thanks to 12 blocks. Four
 different players had three or more blocks, led by Claire Edwards' four.
- The team's 18 wins are now tied for the most under Scott Swanson, and tied for the most since 2008.
- Megan Kirkland's 13 digs against Florida are tied for the most in a three-set match for Carolina this season.
- Koko Atoa-Williams was second on the team with 11 digs Friday night in Gainesville. It was her ninth match
 of the season with double digit digs. She had seven for the entire 2015 season.
- The Gators out-aced the Gamecocks 8-0 for the night, and were able to keep South Carolina out of system
 on offense throughout the match. The last time the Gamecocks went a whole match without an ace was Oct.
 15, 2014, coincidentally against Florida.

NOTEWORTHY

SENIOR SALUTE

The Gamecocks will bid farewell to five seniors, honoring them on Nov. 18 against Alabama. Jacqy Angermiller, Koko Atoa-Williams, Megan Kirkland and Dessaa Legros are all four-year members of the program who have combined to play in over 400 matches, and Joely Cabrera came to Columbia from junior college in 2015. The group is leaving Carolina on high notes, as Kirkland is averaging new career highs in assists and digs, Atoa-Williams in digs per set and aces, Angermiller and Legros are each hitting well above their career averages, and Cabrera is averaging 1.68 digs per set as a defensive sub.

HOLDING ALL THE ACES

The Gamecocks' 12 aces against Georgia on Nov. 6 were a season high, surpassing the 11 they had against Buffalo on Sept. 9. The team's best performance in SEC play coming in was just five, and it had not recorded 12 aces combined over the previous four matches. The last time South Carolina had 12 aces in a three set match was on Sept. 8, 2007 against Appalachian State. The total is the best in any three set match in the SEC so far this season. Mikayla Shield's six aces are tied for the second-most in a three set match in program history. Megan Hosp holds the record with eight, and eight other Gamecocks have had six - including Aubrey Ezell earlier this year against Buffalo.

TO BE THE BEST, YOU HAVE TO BEAT THE BEST

The Gamecocks face one of the toughest conference schedules of any team in the SEC, with an 18-game slate that features two matches apiece against the top four teams in the conference - Florida, Kentucky, Missouri and Texas A&M. Seven of South Carolina's eight conference losses to date have come to those four teams, who currently have a combined conference record of 51-7 (.879). No other team in the conference plays each of the aforementioned top four twice this year.

COMFORTABLE BEING UNCOMFORTABLE

Early season tests on the road at Georgia Southern and Wake Forest have helped the Gamecocks be, as senior Dessaa Legros put it, "comfortable being uncomfortable". The team is 5-2 in four-set matches and 4-0 in five-set matches so far this season, highlighted by the comeback at Mississippi State on Nov. 4. Carolina trailed 2-0 in the match, but battled back to win despite trailing 20-16 late in the third set and 13-12 in the fifth. Over their four five-set matches, the Gamecocks are out-hitting opponents .271 to .196 in those fourth and fifth sets.

A 'FRESH' PERSPECTIVE

The team has received a big lift from a trio of freshman at key positions this season:

- Mikayla Shields leads the team with 3.08 kills per set, and his hitting an impressive .312 for the season despite hitting from the outside. So far this season, she has 15 matches with double-digit kills (highlighted by a season-high 23 at Mississippi State) and has hit over .500 seven times.
- Courtney Koehler has stepped in as a setter in the team's 6-2 offense and is
 averaging 4.28 assists and 1.16 digs per set. On top of her setting skills, she has
 been a clutch server, with 11 aces and the team's best serve percentage (eight
 errors in 281 attempts).
- Alicia Starr had to earn her spot in the starting lineup mid-season, after being trained at an entirely different position than she played in club and high school. She is averaging 1.18 kills and 1.13 blocks per set and hitting .322 in conference play this season. She has already made her mark on the program record books as well, as her four solo blocks vs. Davidson are the second-most in the program's rally-scoring era (since 2001) and her 11 blocks vs. Kentucky are tied for the second-most in a four set match since 2001.

WHEN THE GAMECOCKS WIN...

- The team is out-hitting the opposition .299 to .183, and have yet to lose this season when out-hitting opponents in a match (17-0).
- The opposition averages 1.10 aces per set, compared to 1.39 for Carolina. The Gamecocks are 10-0 when finishing a match with more aces.
- The Gamecocks average 2.43 blocks per set, compared to 1.57 for opponents.
- Freshman Mikayla Shields hits .354 in wins, compared to .189 in losses. Her kills per set dips from 3.44 in wins to 2.15 in losses.
- The offense features the middle attackers much more in wins, as the trio of Jacqy Angermiller, Alicia Starr and Claire Edwards combine for 4.44 kills per set in wins and 3.21 in losses.

WHEN THE GAMECOCKS LOSE...

- The offense is hitting just .160 in losses with two fewer kills per set than the season average, and the defense is allowing opponents to hit .307. None of Carolina's top four hitters are above .200 through the team's seven losses.
- The Gamecocks are allowing 1.96 aces per set to opponents in the four matches, but only average 0.69 aces while holding serve.
- Opponent's passing success weight heavily in matches lost by Carolina. In the five losses, Gamecocks opponents are averaging three digs more per set (15.62 to 12.62) and has a serve-reception percentage advantage of .960 to .914.
- Seven of South Carolina's eight losses have come after dropping the first set.

KIRKLAND NAMED ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT

Senior libero Megan Kirkland (Lugoff, S.C.) was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District team on Thursday, Nov. 3. She has carried a perfect 4.0 grade point average throughout her college career, despite carrying an exercise science major. Kirkland is due to graduate in December, and has already been accepted into Carolina's prestigious Physician Assistant Program. On the court, Megan is having a career year, already with a new season best of 79 assists and an average of 3.36 digs per set while appearing in every match for the Gamecocks.

COLE NAMED TO GAMECOCKS HOF

Current South Carolina assistant head coach Shonda Cole was inducted into the South Carolina Athletics Hall of Fame class of 2016 on Thursday, Oct. 20. She is the third woman from the program to make the Hall of Fame, joining Ashley Edlund-Heidtke (inducted in 2010) and Heather Larkin (inducted in 2012). Cole was the first Gamecock volleyball player to earn All-America honors, and was also a three-time All-SEC honoree. Cole still holds the program's career record for points per set, kills per set, and attacks.

STANDING ROOM ONLY

Of the top 10 crowds on record at the Carolina Volleyball Center, three have come this season alone. Currently, the Gamecocks rank 41st nationally in average attendance this season (1,135), despite the fact that two matches were rescheduled due to weather and four other matches went directly against either home football or basketball games.

ALABAMA WINS IN VOLLEYBALL'S HOME FINALE

COLUMBIA, S.C. - The South Carolina volleyball team ended its 2015 home schedule Sunday afternoon, hosting Alabama (16-14, 10-6 SEC). The Gamecocks (12-17, 5-11 SEC) were led by Sarah Blomgren's 14 kills and seven blocks from Jacqy Angermiller, but could not slow down `Bama's dynamic duo in a 3-1 loss (27-25, 25-20, 17-25, 25-20).

1st Set: The Crimson Tide controlled the tempo early on in the opening set, building a 13-8 early on and forcing a Carolina timeout. The Gamecocks would chip away slowly but surely, eventually tying the game up at 17-all behind the serve of Joely Cabrera. The junior had a pair of aces that helped turn a 17-14 deficit into the team's first lead of the day at 18-17. The Gamecocks would lead 21-20 later in the set, but Alabama's Krystal Rivers took control all by herself to put the visitor's back up 23-21. A kill from Blomgren tied things up at 25, but a kill and a block from Kat Hutson in quick succession closed out the scoring.

2nd Set: Alabama would take a 2-0 halftime lead thanks to another solid set from Rivers. The redshirt junior totaled seven kills and five digs in the set, hitting .500. The Gamecocks led big early on, earning a 10-4 lead behind a pair of aces from Aubrey Ezell. Behind the serve of Kryssi Daniels, Alabama clawed its way back to 16-all, and would take a 19-16 lead after her third ace of the game. Carolina would struggle in the serve game, committing three errors on serve and allowing Daniels' three aces. The Tide out-hit the Gamecocks .310 to .129 to take the 2-0 lead to intermission.

3rd Set: The Gamecocks would lock in on offense to earn a big win in the third set, with a diverse attack that would feature four different players with three or more kills. Carolina hit .464 in the set, and on top of that it held Alabama to just .107 thanks in large part to six blocks. The team would hold a comfortable lead for most of the final half of the set, taking a 15-10 lead at the media timeout and extending it out to 20-14 before the Crimson Tide would burn their final team timeout. Angermiller helped close out the set and extend the match, recording a pair of blocks in the final four total points.

4th Set: Needing to win again to extend the match, Carolina battled early on, but the service of Kat Hutson would provide a key run at the mid-point of the set that made all the difference for Alabama. Hutson took over serve with the Tide ahead 12-9, and her tough topspin jump serve would be good for a 4-0 burst that allowed the visitors to hold Carolina at an arm's length down the stretch. Blomgren was 4-for-4 on her attacks in the set, but Rivers and Hutson combined for 10 to counter her

AUBURN HOLDS OFF SOUTH CAROLINA, 3-1

AUBURN, ALA.- Despite season-best performances from their middle hitters, the Gamecocks were unable to rally back from an early deficit in a 3-1 loss at Auburn (25-16, 25-23, 21-25, 25-23). Darian Dozier recorded her first career double-double with 16 kills and 11 blocks

1st Set: The Tigers pounced from the first serve, taking a commanding 7-3 lead after an early 3-all tie. Breanna McIlroy would go for six kills in the set and Auburn as a team would hit .300. Carolina would struggle to stay in system offensively due to the Auburn attack and when the home side was on serve. The Gamecocks hit .108 as a team, with four different attackers recording two kills.

2nd Set: With some tweaks to its defense in place, the Gamecocks rallied back for a stronger second set, but could not close it out and went into the half down 2-0. Both defenses would toughen up on the net, with each recording three blocks in the first 20 combined points. Darian Dozier would be a calming presence both on offense and defense, recording five kills and four blocks in the second set alone. Carolina held an early 12-10 lead, but the Tigers pulled ahead before the media timeout, 15-14, and would not allow the Gamecocks to retake the lead the rest of the way. Along with Dozier, Elizabeth Johnbull would produce for Carolina, chipping in three kills on four attacks.

3rd Set: The defense would again be a big contributor for the Gamecocks in the third set, and Dozier and Johnbull remained productive on the attack. Carolina would stake itself to a big lead early and held on for the win. Auburn erased an early lead but still trailed 9-8, the Gamecocks hit the gas again with an 8-2 run from there to force the Tigers into their final timeout. The home side came out of the break rein-vigorated, though, and chipped away until it was just a one-point game again, 22-21. A kill from Dozier provided a major swing point and a 23-21 lead and the Gamecocks closed out the final two points to extend the match. Johnbull and Dozier led the offense with four kills apiece.

4th Set: The momentum carried over early for the Gamecocks, who took the lead early in the fourth. This time, however, Auburn was able to close out the comeback it was short on the set before. After burning its final timeout, trailing 17-11, Auburn would rally to tie the set up at 20-20. Carolina was unable to stem the comeback, and despite five more kills from Dozier the team would drop a 25-23 decision to end the match. The Tigers, after committing 19 hitting errors in the second and third sets, had just five in the fourth. Three of those errors came on blocks.

STAT OF THE MATCH

For as strong as Carolina was up the middle, the Tigers were able to counteract that with a strong night from their outside hitters. Courtney Crable and Breanna McIlroy each went for 16 kills. Auburn finished with a plus-18 margin in kills for the match.

SCOTT SWANSON

Head Coach | Sixth Year at South Carolina

- Third in program history for career wins
- Coached seven NCAA tournament teams (Arizona State 1999, 2000, Minnesota 2006-10)
- Part of staff that coached eight All-Americans
- Recruited three top-10 classes to Minnesota

The 11th head coach in Gamecock Volleyball history, Scott Swanson has his sights set on a successful 2016 season as he enters year six in Columbia. The Gamecocks will bring an exciting balance of veterans and talented youngsters into the season, with the aim of building off 2015's 13-18 campaign.

The Gamecocks faced a season of different adversities in 2015, coming from untimely injuries and a roster featuring six freshmen who all were asked to fill important roles. The team bonded through the rigors of the season, and picked up impressive wins over Tennessee, Ole Miss, and a season sweep of Arkansas. Swanson moved into third in program history for wins in a career after winning his 72nd game at South Carolina on Oct. 25.

Individually, freshman Aubrey Ezell finished with perhaps one of the best debut seasons ever by a Gamecock, finishing the season with the second-most assists ever in the program's rally-scoring era and a spot on the SEC All-Freshman Team.

It would not just be the freshmen who would surprise, the team also saw breakout seasons from Dessaa Legros and Sarah Blomgren. Senior Darian Dozier capped her career in style, moving up to third in program history for career blocks and entered the top ten in hitting percentage as well. Off the court, the team volunteered over 1100 for community service, the most of any team at South Carolina.

In 2014, the Gamecocks posted a 17-14 record, which included seven SEC wins, the program's most since 2008. Libero Mikaela Christiaansen set the program record for most digs in a single season with 535, while middle blocker Darian Dozier set single-season rally scoring era school records for total blocks (141) and block assists (127). The Gamecocks also turned in another strong year in the classroom, as a league-best 12 players made the SEC Fall Academic Honor Roll.

During the 2013 season, outside hitter Juliette Thévenin became just the second Gamecock in school history to earn AVCA All-America honors as she was named honorable mention All-American. Thévenin was also a first-team AVCA All-Southeast Region and All-SEC selection as she left the program ranked in the top 10 in six career categories.

Swanson guided the Gamecocks to an 18-14 record in 2012, the program's second winning season in the last decade. South Carolina got off to a program-best 13-0 start and improved its hitting percentage for a second straight season, ranking second in the SEC with a percentage of .255, an improvement of 29 points from the previous year. Outside hitter Juliette Thévenin garnered second-team All-SEC honors after she ranked second in SEC play with 4.40 kills per set and 4.81 points per set, becoming the first Gamecock since 2008 to receive an All-SEC award.

In Swanson's first season, the Gamecocks went 14-16 and improved its offensive efficiency and its backline defense under his guidance. The team led the SEC with a 16.78 digs average, the best mark in four years for the Gamecocks, and hit .226, a 45-point improvement from the 2011 season.

Swanson's teams have also proved themselves in the classroom, earning the Team Academic Award from the American Volleyball Coaches Association in 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14. In his first five seasons, 49 student-athletes have earned a spot on the SEC Academic honor roll, including eight of the nine eligible players from 2015. The team also claimed the department's Life Skills Team of the Year award in 2011-12, honoring the group for its academic achievements, personal development and work in the community.

Prior to his current head coaching job, Swanson spent five years on the sidelines for the Golden Gophers, helping the team to five-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and a 125-46 record. Three times, Minnesota finished second in the Big Ten behind perennial power Penn State. The 2009 team advanced to the national semifinals in the NCAA Tournament.

During his tenure in Minneapolis, five Golden Gophers earned All-America accolades, including 2009 first-team middle blocker and 2012 US National Team pool member Lauren Gibbemeyer. Swanson also led the Gophers' recruiting efforts, posting three top-10 recruiting classes according to PrepVolleyball.com. The 2009 group earned top honors from the outlet.

In the summer of 2009, Swanson spent time with USA Volleyball's A-2 Junior National Team, and he coached the USA Red team to a second-place showing in the 2008 USA Adult Open Championships.

Swanson brings in four years of head coaching experience to Columbia after his tenure at the University of Texas-El Paso. With a 50-61 career record, Swanson had the team on the brink of the NCAA Tournament in 2005, when the Miners went 21-10. Three player earned all-conference honors under Swanson's tutelage, including honorable mention All-American Kari Stacy. He also inked a high school All-American and saw his team improve in the classroom to a department-best 3.2 GPA in 2005.

Prior to UTEP, Swanson spent six years at his alma mater, Arizona State. He helped the team to two NCAA Tournament appearances during his time in Tempe and coached one second-team All-American and two Pac-10 All-Freshman Team players. Two of his Sun Devil players garnered Academic All-America certificates as well.

Swanson started his coaching career at Mountain View (Ariz.) High School, working as an assistant with the varsity team and leading his junior varsity group to a 17-1 record. As a head coach with the Arizona East Valley Juniors club, he led a 16-1s team to a national runner-up finish and earned Cactus Region Coach of the Year honors. He also served as head coach at Camelback High School before landing the job with Arizona State, where he also played club volleyball.

A graduate of ASU, Swanson is married to the former Erin Meier. The couple has two daughters, Rylee Sue and Haylen Rae.
