#### **South Carolina Notables**

- · Tonight marks the Gamecocks' third-straight home game, matching their longest homestand of the season. Going forward into SEC play, South Carolina plays back-to-back home games just once.
- · Facing a top-10 team for the third time this season, the Gamecocks are hosting that level of opponent for the first time. In fact, of South Carolina's six non-conference games against teams in this week's AP Top 25, this is the only one to be played at Colonial Life Arena.
- Senior center Alaina Coates blocked a seasonhigh four shots against Clemson Thursday night, inching closer to the program's career blocked shots record currently held by teammate A'ja Wilson, who stayed one ahead of Coates by blocking two of her own against the Tigers.
- The Gamecocks' frontcourt of Coates and Wilson accounts for 31.2 points per game on 62.1 percent field goal shooting. The twin towers' offense is complemented nicely this season by transfer guards Kaela Davis and Allisha Gray, who combine to post 29.7 points per game, including 38.5 percent shooting from 3-point range.
- Four Gamecocks earned spots on the Naismith Trophy Preseason Watch List - Alaina Coates, Kaela Davis, Allisha Gray, A'ja Wilson - with Coates and Wilson also on the Wade Watch List.

#### **UCLA Series Notes**

The Gamecocks and Bruins have split their alltime series 1-1, but just one of those games had taken place during the lifetime of any player on either team.

South Carolina claimed last season's meeting (Nov. 22, 2015) at Pauley Pavilion 68-65 after the Gamecocks locked down defensively in the final four minutes.

The inaugural meeting between the two teams was a Jan. 5, 1981, game that was later forfeited by South Carolina, along with seven others, due to the participation of an ineligible player. Ranked No. 10 in the nation at the time, the Gamecocks defeated the Bruins 86-81 in Columbia.

#### **Ranked Readings**

Under head coach Dawn Staley, South Carolina is 42-44 against nationally ranked opponents. That record is skewed by the early seasons of her tenure as the Gamecocks are 27-5 versus ranked foes since the start of the 2014-15 campaign. South Carolina is 11-3 against top-10 opponents during that time, and 14-20 against them in Staley's tenure.

#### Holding Home Court

The Gamecocks are 412-154 all-time on their home court, including a 170-59 mark in Colonial Life Arena. South Carolina is 105-26 at home during the Dawn Staley era and has lost just once in its last 55 home games, including undefeated home seasons in 2013-14 and 2014-15.

#### **Rankings Review**

Ranked sixth in this week's AP Poll, the Gamecocks are in the midst of the nation's thirdlongest active top-10 ranking streak (56), trailing just UConn (219) and Notre Dame (112) and well ahead of fourth-place Baylor (41).

#### **Tough Tasks**

Head coach Dawn Staley did not shy away from a challenging schedule this season, despite having to replace five seniors from last season's squad. The Gamecocks' overall schedule is ranked the sixth-toughest in the nation based on opponent winning percentage (.744).

South Carolina's schedule features nine games against teams ranked in either the AP or USA Today Coaches Top 25 this week, including four against this week's top-10 teams. Just three of those nine games are home games for the Gamecocks.

The Gamecocks are currently 3-0 against ranked opponents.

#### League Legends

The Gamecocks are the only team in the nation to boast two former WNBA All-Stars on their coaching staff in head coach Dawn Staley and assistant coach Nikki McCray-Penson. Five other programs tout multiple WNBA alums – Miami, Notre Dame, Penn State, Texas and Vanderbilt – but only Beth Cunningham at Notre Dame and Tina Thompson at Texas earned All-Star status at least once in their time in the league.

South Carolina has the added bonus of its other two coaches – associate head coach Lisa Boyer and assistant coach Fred Chmiel – having experience coaching in the WNBA as well.

#### Location, Location, Location

South Carolina averages 43.3 points in the paint this season, making up 51.4 percent of the Gamecocks' offense. Just one opponent has outscored South Carolina in the paint this season – Duke (42-32, 12/3/16), and the Gamecocks have out-paced their opponents in that space by 20.4 points per game. Their interior advantage has been at least 20 points five times, including a season-high 44 points against Maine (Nov. 21). In three games against ranked opponents, South Carolina has out-scored its opponent 118-84 in the paint.

#### **Blocking Scheme**

South Carolina leads the SEC and ranks 13th in the nation with 6.4 blocked shots per game. The two driving forces of that defensive movement at also the program's all-time career blocked shot leaders – A'ja Wilson (190) and Alaina Coates (189). Wilson broke the school record earlier this season (vs. Saint Peter's, Nov. 22) but can hardly celebrate with Coates nipping at her heels. The duo may trade the record several times this season as Wilson leads the SEC with 2.4 blocks per game, and Coates is closing in at 2.0 per game for fourth in the league.

#### **Helping Hands**

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley likes to say that with good movement, the ball will find who is supposed to shoot it on any given possession. With four 1,000-point scorers on this season's team, many observers wondered how the quartet would abide that philosophy.

Early returns are good as the Gamecocks rank 27th in the nation in assists per game at 17.9. That number would be the program's highest since the 2002-03 squad finished its season at 18.6.

The quartet of 1,000-point scorers account for 10.0 assists per game of that average with Allisha Gray leading the way at 3.2 and Kaela Davis just behind at 3.1.

#### Alai-ja Awaits

Opponents may be inclined to think of the paint as the Gamecock-owned continent of Alai-ja as senior center Alaina Coates and junior forward A'ja Wilson have firmly planted the flag in the lane on both ends of the court. Both were on numerous preseason All-America lists this season with Wilson grabbing 32 of a possible 33 first-team votes from the Associated Press. ESPN tapped Wilson as the top player in the nation this season as well, naming Coates the No. 9 player.

This season, the pair combine to average 31.2 points and 17.1 rebounds while shooting a combined 62.1 percent from the field. The duo also averages 3.7 assists this season. Defensively, they combine for 4.4 blocked shots per game.

Earning All-America and First-Team All-SEC status last season, the duo averaged a combined 27.3 points, 18.5 rebounds and 4.2 blocks. In the Gamecocks' 15 games against ranked opponents,

the pair was even more dominant with 29.7 points per game, 20.3 rebounds per contest and 4.9 blocks per outing.

#### Quarter Breakdown

Through nine games this season, South Carolina has out-scored its opponent in all but six quarters. The Gamecocks have out-paced their opponent by double digits 12 times in the 36 quarters, including a season-high differential of 25 points (37-12) in the first quarter against Saint Peter's (Nov. 22).

South Carolina has shot at least 50.0 percent from the field 14 times in its 36 quarters of action, led by a its 71.4 percent accuracy in the first quarter against Saint Peter's (Nov. 22). The Gamecocks' 37 points in that quarter are the most for the program since the NCAA went to the format for the 2015-16 season.

Individually, junior guard Kaela Davis leads the Gamecocks with five double-digit scoring quarters and has the highest-scoring quarter this season with 14 points in the second against Minnesota (Dec. 11).

#### This is 30

With 30-point games already this season by juniors Kaela Davis (37 at #7/6 Ohio State, 11/14) and A'ja Wilson (31 at #14/15 Texas, 12/1), the Gamecocks have more 30-point games in a season since the 2002-03 season when Jocelyn Penn recorded three such outings, none of which were against a ranked opponent.

The program record for 30-point games in a season is six with the most recent coming in 1994-95. In each of the three seasons with six 30-point games, every game was recorded by the same Gamecock. Shannon Johnson posted six in 1994-95 to duplicate her effort in 1993-94. Beth Hunt originally set the record with her six 30-point games in the 1989-90 campaign. The only 30-point outing against a ranked opponent in those three seasons was Beth Hunt's 34-point showing in a losing effort at then-No. 18 Southern Miss.

Individually, only eight 30-point games by a Gamecock have come against ranked opponents, including this season's showings from Davis and Wilson. Davis' 37 points is the most in a game against a ranked opponent and was the first since Johnson netted 35 against then-#5 Tennessee on Feb. 15, 1996, which until Davis' 37 was the highest-scoring came against a ranked opponent in program history.

player. Coates' 189 career blocks are just behind league leader Wilson's 190, more than 60 ahead of third place. Coates is fourth in scoring at 1,373 and in field goals made (510).

In addition to leading the blocks list, Wilson is third in double-doubles with 21 and sixth in scoring with 1,165 career points. She is fourth in rebounding (587).

#### Fourth Follow-Up?

The Gamecocks enter the 2016-17 season as the three-time reigning SEC regular-season champions, becoming just the third program to win three straight titles, joining Tennessee (2000-04 and 1993-95) and Auburn (1987-89).

SEC coaches and the media picked the Gamecocks to claim the conference title again this season. The league has had the same champion four straight seasons just once before when Tennessee claimed its fourth straight in 2003 en route to the league-record five consecutive titles (2000-04).

#### Four x 1,000

conference selections last season as well.

#### Back in (Garnet and) Black

The Gamecocks return four letterwinners from last season with a fifth, Tiffany Davis, returning after missing 2015-16 due to injury. Five of those six letterwinners are junior and seniors.

#### **New Faces**

Five new Gamecocks join the fold this season with the four freshmen taking the court right away. Junior forward Alexis Jennings will sit out this season due to NCAA transfer rules.

Guard Tyasha Harris (Noblesville, Ind.) headlines the freshman class, coming off a summer spent helping the U.S. to its seventh-straight gold medal in the FIBA U18 Americas Championship. Araion Bradshaw (Hyde Park, Mass.) and Victoria Patrick (Orlando, Fla.) join her in the guard spot. Bradshaw is point guard with good court vision, and Patrick comes in as a scorer to help stretch the floor. Forward Mikiah Herbert Harrigan rounds out the class, bringing athleticism, speed and perimeter shooting to the team.

The quartet combines to play 50.4 minutes per game, while contributing 13.1 points per game. Harris leads the group in minutes at 20.0 per game and was the first of the group to earn a starting spot (Dec. 11 vs. Minnesota). Herbert Harrigan is on top of the scoring average at 6.7.

#### The Amazing Technicolor Dream Coates

Senior center Alaina Coates has started the 2016-17 season on a mission and with a passion that is on display every minute she is on the court. The result has her averaging a double-double (14.7 ppg/10.8 rpg) and ranked among the nation's top 15 in field goal percentage (2nd, .707), rebounding (15th) and double-doubles (5th, 6).

In the midst of one of the most productive careers for a post player in South Carolina history, Coates became the third Gamecock all-time to reach the 1,000-rebound plateau, hitting the mark in a strong second-half effort at #14/15 Texas (Dec. 1). And now sits in second place in the program's all-time standings with 1,027,

trailing the Sheila Foster's record of 1,427

Coates' 48 career double-doubles are second in program history, trailing only Foster's schoolrecord 72. The Irmo, S.C., native is also a defensive force, ranking second in career blocked shots at 189, just behind teammate A'ja Wilson's 190.

#### AW = All-World

In her third season at South Carolina, junior forward A'ja Wilson is already one of the most decorated Gamecocks in program history as a three-time All-American, the reigning SEC Player and Defensive Player of the Year and a finalist for all three national player of the year awards last season.

This season, Wilson is back atop the Gamecocks' scoring list with 16.6 points per game to rank fifth in the SEC. She has three 20-point games to her credit already, including a career-best 31 points at #14/15 Texas (Dec. 1). Shooting 55.6 percent from the field, she is fourth in the SEC and 42nd in the nation.

Defensively, Wilson is just as strong as last season when she set the school record for blocked shots in a season with 103. This season, her 2.4 blocks per game lead the SEC and rank 28th in the nation. She broke the school record for career blocks (previously 177) with two against Saint Peter's (Nov. 22) and now sits at 189 in just 79 career games played.

#### KD for 3

Junior transfer Kaela Davis wasted little time making her mark on the Gamecock program, opening her South Carolina career with a 37-point, 10-rebound, five-assist effort at No. 7/6 Ohio State (Nov. 14). A recent 22-point outing against Minnesota (Dec. 11) further solidified her outside shooting prowess, as she hit 6-of-10 from beyond the arc.

Davis leads the SEC in both 3s made per game (2.8) and 3-point field goal percentage (.446), ranking 48th and 49th in the nation, respectively With 15.8 points per game, she ranks 10th in the league in scoring.

Davis established herself as an elite scorer in two seasons at Georgia Tech, where she became

#### **Gray Area**

Junior transfer Allisha Gray may be the Gamecocks' most quiet and consistent offensive powerhouse, scoring in double figures in seven of nine games this season, including opening her inaugural Gamecock season with five straight double-digit scoring outings.

The unassuming six-foot guard amassed 1,000 points in her first two seasons at North Carolina and kicked off her South Carolina career with a 24-point outing at No. 7/6 Ohio State that included 10-of-18 shooting and some of the most momentum-killing baskets of the game. With sniper-like accuracy, she scores 13.9 points per game (21st in the SEC) on 48.9 percent shooting, which is good for 10th in the SEC and 97th in the nation.

Gray's contributions go beyond the scoring column, though. She leads the team with 29 assists (3.2 apg), including six games of at least three, and is second in the SEC in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.2), which ranks 16th in the country. Gray also adds 4.3 rebounds per game with four games of five or more boards. In fact, she led the team in rebounding against Saint Peter's (Nov. 22) with eight.

#### DC Insider

Sophomore guard Doniyah Cliney is enjoying her first full season with the Gamecocks after missing the start of her redshirt freshman campaign due to a preseason injury. The setback limited her minutes and impact during SEC play in 2015-16, but she has clearly benefitted from the full preseason preparation this season. Especially locked in defensively, the 6-foot guard has used her size and athleticism to shut down opponents and crash the boards.

In the last two games, Cliney averaged 6.5 points, 8.5 rebounds and 24.5 minutes. The extended minutes have helped dial in her shot as well as she has hit 5-of-9 from the field (.556) over that time after entering the stretch 3-of-9.

#### Talking Ty

Freshman point guard Tyasha Harris arrived in Columbia with lofty expectations and the ambition needed to play the position under Hall of Famer Dawn Staley. Rated the No. 8 point guard in the 2016 recruiting class, Harris has a winning pedigree with three straight state championships at Heritage Christian (Noblesville, Ind.) and a gold medal in the 2016 FIBA U18 Americas Championship.

Averaging 20.0 minutes so far this season, Harris is showing the poise and command of the position that originally caught Staley's eye. Things seemed to click for the young guard against #4/4 Louisville (Nov. 27) when she drew the secondhalf start and handed out five of her career-high six assists in the final two periods. Her solid play continued at #14/15 Texas (Dec. 1) where she earned a career-best 30 minutes on the court with great effort that included three steals and no turnovers.

Harris drew her first career start against Minnesota (Dec. 11) and delivered nine points on 3-for-4 shooting from 3-point range and matched her career high with six assists in just 21 minutes of action.

#### Bronx Bandit

Earning a steady starting role for the first time in her career, point guard Bianca Cuevas-Moore is directing the team on both sides of the ball with the maturity typical of a junior playing the position under Staley. The transition has Cuevas-Moore balancing her blazing speed and instinct to attack with abandon against her improved communication and ability to set up her teammates. She has multiple assists in all but two games this season and has committed multiple turnovers just twice through eight games.

What hasn't changed in Cuevas-Moore's game is her lightning quick hands on defense. She ranks ninth in the SEC with 2.2 steals per game. She has multiple steals in seven of eight games this season, including matching her career high with five against Saint Peter's (Nov. 22).

#### **USA Basketball Connection**

At least one Gamecock has donned the red, white and blue for USA Basketball in each of the last three summers, and the group has helped six U.S. teams to five gold medals and one bronze in that time. Former Gamecock Tiffany Mitchell got the streak started with her FIBA 3x3 World Championship gold in 2014, which A'ja Wilson

## Dawn Staley Head Coach 9th Season at South Carolina Virginia, 1992

When three-time Olympic gold medalist Dawn Staley took the reins of the University of South Carolina women's basketball program on May 10, 2008, the Gamecocks' stature immediately rose not just in the Southeastern Conference but on the national stage as well. Building on a foundation of hard work, defensive effort and a "team first" mentality, South Carolina began to realize those expectations in 2011-12, and the program has continued to thrive as one of seven in the nation to be ranked in every Associated Press Top 25 poll since the start of the 2013-14 season. The Gamecocks boast five straight 25-win seasons, which include three SEC regular-season championships (2014, 2015, 2016), two SEC Tournament titles (2015, 2016), an NCAA Final Four appearance (2015) and three other Sweet 16 seasons (2012, 2014, 2016), the program's first ever No. 1 national ranking and a school-record 34 wins in 2014-15. Staley's success has united every demographic in the state of South Carolina as the Gamecocks' fan base tripled over a span of three seasons, and twice led the nation in home attendance (2014-15, 2015-16).

While her coaching career is blossoming, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified her legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012 and was one of the final nominees for induction to the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame the same year. In the summer of 2011, the WNBA recognized her as one of the league's "Top 15," honoring the most influential players in the league's history.

Now in her 17th season as a head coach, Staley has amassed a 368-157 (.701) record, including her 196-77 (.718) slate in her ninth season at South Carolina. She has led her teams to seven 25-win seasons, a total of 13 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 56 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 12 in the No. 1 spot. Also a force in USA Basketball, she has been the head coach of three gold medal teams – 2015 FIBA U19 World Championships, 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship, 2007 Pan Am Games – and served as an assistant on the Senior National Team 2006-08 and again from 2014 to present, helping the team to gold medals in the 2014 FIBA World Championship and the 2008 and 2016 Olympic Games.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last eight seasons, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year (2014, Basketball Times), a Naismith National Coach of the Year Finalist (2014, 2015, 2016), SEC Coach of the Year (2014, Coaches and AP; 2015, Coaches; 2016, Coaches and AP) and BCA Female Coach of the Year (2012). Under Staley's leadership, four Gamecocks have collected eight All-America selections, two have picked up three SEC Player of the Year honors, two have earned SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognition, one has been the SEC 6th Player of the Year and three were named SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 10 Gamecocks who earned All-SEC honors a combined 19 times, including nine first-team selections, and two Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last two seasons, including 2016 selection Tiffany Mitchell who became the third first-round selection for South Carolina.


