The SC State Series

The Gamecocks and Lady Bulldogs have met 32 times prior to today's matchup. South Carolina has a 23-9 edge and has won the last 19 meetings, including the most recent – a 66-21 decision on Dec. 14, 2011 at Colonial Life Arena. In fact, the Gamecocks have a 17-2 record against the Lady Bulldogs in games played in Columbia.

Scouting the Lady Bulldogs

South Carolina State brings an 8-2 record and a veteran squad to Columbia with four returning starters among the team's six returning letterwinners. The Lady Bulldogs are off to a hot start, already amassing more non-conference wins than last year, and are riding a four-game win streak into today's game. Their two losses came to teams the Gamecocks are familiar with – Georgia and Hampton, which South Carolina defeated earlier this season at the Paradise Jam.

Senior Tiara Knotts leads the offense with 15.2 points per game behind 39.1 percent 3-point shooting. Also a threat on the defensive end, the 5-foot-4 guard ranks among the nation's top 50 with 3.0 steals per game so far this season. Junior center Paris Alston comes off the bench, but joins Knotts in double-figure points with 10.0 per game. She is hitting 48.8 percent from the field and paves the way on the glass with 8.3 rebounds per outing.

Another defensive stalwart for the Lady Bulldogs is senior center Fannie Goodwin who is 34th in the

nation with 2.2 blocked shots per game. She also snags 6.5 rebounds per contest and scores 6.3 points per game. Senior Cabriel Duren sets the table for SC State, handing out 4.2 assists per game in addition to her scoring average of 7.3 points. The 5-foot-6 guard will challenge the steal-happy Gamecock guards as she turns the ball over just 2.4 times per game.

As a team, SC State scores 67.1 points per game on 40.7 percent shooting, including 33.6 percent from 3-point range. The Lady Bulldogs have been outrebounded by 2.8 boards per game but have a +6.9 turnover margin, which ranks among the top 20 in the nation. Opponents have scored 53.5 points per game on 34.5 percent shooting, including just 29.8 percent from 3-point range.

SC State head coach Doug Robertson, Jr. is in his fifth season, leading the Lady Bulldogs to a 53-77 record, pushing his career mark to 106-109 in his eighth season.

Gamecocks' Five-Second Count

With a complementary blend of youth and experience, South Carolina has opened the season 10-0 for the first time since the 1981-82 team also won its first 10 contests. The Gamecocks have shown they have diverse offensive options and are dominant on the glass this season while the defense has dropped off very little from last season's NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 effort. Three Gamecocks average double-figure points with two other netting six or more points per game. South Carolina ranks among the nation's best with a +13.9 rebounding margin and has three players ranked among the SEC's top 20 rebounders. Defensively, the Gamecocks have held eight of their 11 opponents this season under 50 points and limited five of the 11 to under 30 percent field goal shooting, including Hampton which hit just 19.3 percent (11-57) from the field for the second-lowest opponent field goal percentage of the Staley era.

Read with the Gamecocks

The women's basketball team is celebrating the winners of the first segment of this season's Read with the Gamecocks program today. The statewide initiative aims to encourage reading and promote literacy among elementary students in kindergarten through fifth grade. In this segment, 34 schools around the state participated. The combined 2,321 students read a total of 754,450 pages over the 12-day segment.

South Carolina will recognize the winners of the next two segments during its game against Auburn on Feb. 3 and its contest with Florida on March 3. Home Sweet Home

South Carolina is in its 11th season at Colonial Life Arena and enjoys a 110-56 (.663) record in that time. Overall, the Gamecocks are 354-153 all-time in home games. Since South Carolina first entered a conference in the 1983-84 season, the Gamecocks are 286-132 in non-conference home games. Head coach Dawn Staley has amassed a 44-23 home record in her fifth season at the helm, including a 27-6 mark in non-conference action.

Deciding in December

South Carolina has a 153-78 (.662) record all-time in the month of December, including a 21-8 (.724) record under fifth-year head coach Dawn Staley. In fact, December is the lone month during which Staley has had a winning record each of her first four seasons. The Gamecocks are 91-23 (.798) at home in the final month of the calendar year with a 51-18 (.739) mark at Colonial Life Arena. South Carolina is 33-30 in road games in December and 24-23 at neutral-site contests during the month.

Reading the Rankings

South Carolina is ranked in both national polls for the second-straight week. The Gamecocks climbed to No. 21 in the Associated Press Poll this week after finally cracking into that ranking at No. 24 the week of Dec. 10. The USA Today Coaches' Poll has not been released yet this week, but the Gamecocks came in at No. 18 last week.

The Gamecocks were receiving votes in both polls right out of the gate, finally breaking into the coaches poll at No. 24 on Nov. 26 behind a 7-0 record. South Carolina moved up to No. 21 the following week before climbing to No. 18. The AP voters added the Gamecocks to their top 25 at No. 24 the week of Dec. 10 before lifting them to No. 21 this week. It is the program's highest ranking in the poll since finishing the 2002-03 season at No. 16.

Rendering the RPI

With a 10-1 record, including five wins away from home, the Gamecocks are among the nation's top 20 in RPI (varies depending on the organization). In the SEC, only Tennessee and Georgia have higher RPIs than South Carolina.

The Gamecocks' strength of schedule ranks in the top 100 but will continue to build over the course of the season. The Gamecocks are slated to play five teams currently ranked in the top 25 as well as two others that are in the next five vote getters in the AP Poll. That stretch of games begins tonight against No. 1 Stanford and includes a road game at Georgia (6), home and road games against Kentucky (7), and home games against Tennessee (10) and Texas A&M (22). Arkansas and Vanderbilt are just outside the top 25, and South Carolina will take those teams on in road and home games, respectively.

Gamecocks' bailiwick, but South Carolina has out-rebounded all but one of its 11 opponents this season (Stanford), including four by more 20 or more. The team effort has the Gamecocks ranked second in the nation in rebound margin at +16.4. In comparison, last season's squad out-rebounded its 13 non-conference opponents by just 7.2 boards per game.

While rebounding is a team focus, this season has seen a surge in individual performances. In 2011-12, a Gamecock posted double-figure rebounds just seven times over 35 games. Through just 11 games this season, South Carolina has amassed 12 double-digit rebound efforts, including six from sophomore forward Aleighsa Welch, who is tied for the SEC led in the category.

Twice as Nice

South Carolina forward Aleighsa Welch earned a spot on the 2012 SEC All-Freshman Team despite lacking a key resume bullet for forwards – a double-double. The sophomore has made up for last season's missing ingredient by amassing five through the team's first 11 games this season. She leads the SEC in the category and is 17th nationally. After narrowly missing the mark in the season opener, Welch picked up her first career double-double two games laster with a 13-point, 12-rebound effort against Savannah State (Nov. 15). She added two more at the Paradise Jam against Hampton (Nov. 22) and Florida Gulf

Coast (Nov. 24) and tacked on her fourth against Drexel (Nov. 28). She made it four in five games with a 14-point/10-rebound effort at Seton Hall (Dec. 2). Welch leads the team and the SEC with six double-digit rebound games this season and also paces the Gamecocks in double-figure scoring outings with nine.

Posts Up – Spurs Up

For the first time in the Dawn Staley era, neither of the team's top two scorers is a guard. Forwards Aleighsa Welch and Ashley Bruner have been an integral part in the team's 10-1 start this season, averaging 12.4 and 10.4 points, respectively. Welch is shooting a team-best 66.7 percent from the field, although she is five field goals shy of the minimum required to be ranked in the SEC.

The duo are among the league's top 10 rebounders with Welch ranking second at 9.1 per game and Bruner coming in at 7.4. Both are especially proficient on the offensive glass, ranking first and eighth, respectively, in the league. More than half of Welch's 100 total rebounds have come on the offensive end (51), while 46.9 percent of Bruner's have come on a Gamecock miss. Welch has the second-highest single-game rebound total in the SEC this season with her career-high 15 against Drexel.

Working Overtime

After Wednesday's 58-55 win over Drexel, South Carolina is 16-14 all-time in overtime games, including a 1-3 mark in double-overtime contests. Since taking the reins for the 2008-09 season, Gamecock head coach Dawn Staley has amassed a 5-3 record in extended games. South Carolina played a school-record four overtime games in 2010-11, going 2-2, and in 1995-96, going 1-3.

Preseason Predictions

South Carolina was picked by both the media and league's coaches to finish in the middle of the 14-team pack in the Southeastern Conference. The media predicted the Gamecocks would take seventh place, while the coaches slotted South Carolina into sixth.

Senior guard Ieasia Walker drew preseason second-team all-conference honors from both groups. She is the team's lone returning starter and the highest returning scorer from last year's squad. Her 7.9 points per game came with 3.2 assists per outing, which combined to earn her Second-Team All-SEC honors for the second-straight year.

Quick Re-Take

South Carolina put together its best season in a decade last season, reaching the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 for the first time since 2001-02 and making the program's first ever appearance in the SEC Tournament semifinals. The team's 25 victories tied for the most during the program's time in the SEC, matching that of the 2001-02 team, which advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.

The Gamecocks found success behind a steady dose of stifling defense, ranked fourth in the nation, and a diversified offense. South Carolina allowed more than 55 points just 12 times in 25 games and held five nationally ranked opponents to that mark or lower. Seven different Gamecocks led the team in scoring, and eight scored in double figures at least once. South Carolina's 14-2 start earned the program's first national ranking since the end of the 2002-03 season, and the Gamecocks finished the season ranked No. 25 by the Associated Press. The team posted the most SEC wins since the 2001-02 squad also had 10. Signature league wins included the program's first sweeps of Vanderbilt and Florida and its first win over Tennessee in Knoxville.




