2006-07 Season Review

South Carolina Finishes In The Top 25

After bouncing in and out of the Top 25 throughout the season, South Carolina concluded the 2006-07 campaign ranked No. 25 in both the *GolfWeek* and the NGCA Coaches Polls. Carolina's appearance in the final Coaches Poll was only its second appearance of the season, the first coming the week of March 7 when the Gamecocks were ranked No. 24.

South Carolina last finished a season ranked in the Top 25 when the 1994-95 team finished No. 6 in the final rankings. That team, headlined by current LPGA pro Siew Ai Lim, placed second at the SEC Championships and placed fourth at the NCAA East Regional and ninth at the NCAA Championships, both school-best finishes. Lim won the individual title at the 1995 NCAA East Regional with a 214 (-2) at the par-72 Quail Ridge Country Club in Memphis, Tenn.

NCAA Regional Recap

Despite turning in the second-best 54-hole team score in school history and having two of its players post career-best 54-hole scores, South Carolina saw its 2006-07 season come to an end at the NCAA East Regional Championship played at the par-72 LSU University Club. The Gamecocks finished tied for ninth with a 290-289-295=874 (+10), four strokes shy of finishing among the top eight and earning a berth into the NCAA Championship.

Gamecocks Continue NCAA Regional Streak

South Carolina advanced to its ninth-consecutive NCAA Regional in 2007, the fourth-longest active postseason streak in the Southeastern Conference. During that span, the Gamecocks finished in the top 10 five times and advanced to the championship round four times, most recently in 2003. Here's a closer look at the SEC's current NCAA Regional streaks:

Gamecocks Fourth At SEC Championship

Senior Jenna Pearson and junior Blythe Worley both posted top-10 finishes for South Carolina at the Southeastern Conference Championships in leading the Gamecocks to a fourth-place finish at the par-72 Old Waverly Golf Club. Pearson finished the tournament tied for fifth on the individual leader board with a 217 (+1), with Worley claiming 10th with a 220 (+4). Shooting a season-best 887 (+23) at the SEC Championship, the Gamecocks' fourth-place finish put them ahead of four of the nation's top-25 teams.

Pearson provided South Carolina's first top-five finish at the SEC Championship since two-time SEC Champion and current LPGA player Kristy McPherson finished third in 2003.

The Gamecocks' performance marked Carolina's fourth top-four finish at the SEC Championship in the last seven years. Four Gamecocks – Pearson, Worley, Camila Mori, and Bénédicte Toumpsin – finished in the top 25 on the individual leader board. The weekend score ties for the fifth-lowest 54-hole team score in school history.

Pearson Named Second Team All-SEC

Jenna Pearson earned a spot on the All-Southeastern Conference second team, becoming the first Gamecock since Adrienne Gautreaux in 2004 to make the all-conference team. It was the first time in her career that Pearson received all-conference honors, with the recognition coming on the heels of being named the South Carolina Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year and team MVP at the Gamecocks' All-Sports Banquet earlier in the week.

Pearson finished the season with a 74.79 stroke average, a mark that ranks as the sixth-lowest single-season stroke average in school history. Her 76.52 career stroke average ranks fourth in school history.

Team Sets School Record

The 2006-07 squad set a new school record with a team stroke average of 302.59, breaking the existing record of 302.71 set by the Gamecocks of 2002-03.

Toumpsin Sets USC Freshman Record

Bénédicte Toumpsin enjoyed the best freshman campaign in school history, setting the freshman record for best stroke average in a season. Toumpsin finished the season with 2,167 strokes in 28 rounds to post an average of 75.61. Her average shattered the existing freshman record of 77.07 set by current LPGA pro Kristy McPherson in 1999-2000.

Toumpsin Tears Up The Course

Freshman Bénédicte Toumpsin turned in the fourth-lowest postseason 54-hole score in school history with a 72-73-72=217 (+1) at the NCAA East Regional. Toumpsin's score placed her behind only current LPGA players Kristy McPherson (209 at the 2002 East Regional and a 214 at the 2001 East Regional) and Siew Ai Lim (214 at the 1995 East Regional) in the annals of Gamecock postseason performances.

Pearson Sets New School Record

Senior Jenna Pearson set a school record for lowest single round when she carded a 66 in the second round at the SEC Championships. Pearson carded six birdies on the day to sit at six-under on the par-72, 6,242-yard Old Waverly Golf Club course in West Point, Miss.

Her school-record round bested the previous mark of 67, set by current LPGA pro Kristy McPherson in 2001 and matched by Pearson in the 2006-07 season opener. McPherson fired the 67 in the first round at the 2001 SEC Championship, played on the par-72 University of Florida Golf Course, while Pearson hit the mark in the second round at the Branch Law Firm/Dick McGuire Invitational.

Gamecocks Lead NCAA Division I With Five All-American Scholar Honorees

With five Gamecocks on the National Golf Coaches Association's All-American Scholar Team, South Carolina matched Appalachian State, Ball State, Indiana State, Santa Clara, South Alabama and Tennessee for the highest figure in Division I women's golf.

The criteria for selection to the All-American Scholar Team are some of the most stringent of all college athletics. The minimum cumulative GPA is 3.50, and student-athletes must have competed in at least 50 percent of the college's regularly scheduled competitive rounds during the year.

Pearson earned a spot on the All-American Scholar Team for the fourth consecutive year, with Worley and Simons both securing the third such honor of their respective careers. Simons, the 2006 SEC Women's Golf Scholar Athlete of the Year, joined two-time NGCA All-America Scholar Laura Raffo as international business

majors to make the All-American Scholar team. A native of York, S.C., Barrett earned All-American Scholar recognition in her first year at the collegiate level.

Under head coach Kristi Coggins, South Carolina has led the nation by placing 23 student-athletes on the NGCA All-American Scholar Team in the last four years, averaging 5.8 scholars per year. The Gamecocks were recognized as the NGCA All-Scholar Team of the Year in 2005 and 2006.

Gamecocks in Top 100

Senior Jenna Pearson concluded the season in the Top 100 for the seventh-consecutive week. Pearson finished the year ranked No. 54 in the final *GolfWeek* poll. She peaked at No. 36 earlier in the season, prior the Lady Puerto Rico Classic the week of Oct. 6.

Pearson, Toumpsin Set A New First

Both Jenna Pearson and Bénédicte Toumpsin posted rounds in the 60s at the season-opening Dick McGuire Invitational, with Pearson firing a second-round 67 and Toumpsin posting a second-round 69. In doing so, Pearson and Toumpsin became the first pair of Gamecock teammates to both shoot a round in the 60s in the same tournament, much less in the same round.

Pearson Joins FUTURES Tour

Jenna Pearson earned exempt status to the Duramed FUTURES Tour on January 11, 2007, and joined the tour after the season. The FUTURES Tour has been designated as the official developmental tour of the LPGA. Former Gamecock Kristy McPherson graduated from the tour in 2006 and began her first LPGA season in February. Three other former Gamecocks currently compete on the FUTURES Tour.

An LPGA Indicator?

Throughout South Carolina's women's golf history, only 10 players have ever shot a round in the 60s, including 2006-07 standouts Jenna Pearson and Bénédicte Toumpsin. Of the eight remaining players on that list, five have gone on to play professionally. Kristy McPherson, Siew Ai Lim, Marianne Morris and Debbie Eckroth are either currently on the LPGA Tour or were at one time, with Adrienne Gautreaux currently on the Duramed FUTURES Tour.
