

NCAA WOMEN'S SOCCER SECOND ROUND POSTGAME NOTES

South Carolina vs. Rutgers - November 15, 2009

South Carolina

Sunday afternoon's win marked head coach Shelley Smith's 100^{th} victory as head coach at South Carolina. Her all-time record is 141-100-26 in 13 seasons as a head coach (Rhode Island and South Carolina).

The attendance of 2,724 for Sunday's game was third highest in school history. South Carolina set an attendance record on Friday vs. Davidson with 3,813 fans at Stone Stadium in the opening round.

With her goal in the first half, Brooke Jacobs has now scored in three consecutive NCAA matches. Jacobs had a goal vs. William & Mary in 2008 and scored last Friday evening in the victory over Davidson. All three of those goals also came in the first half.

Junior goalkeeper Mollie Patton tallied her 15th shutout of the year and her 22nd of her career.

South Carolina has advanced to the Round of 16 for the first time in school history.

South Carolina is the only SEC team remaining in the NCAA Tournament.

The Gamecocks are now 11-0-0 on the year in home games at Stone Stadium. The Gamecocks are 8-2 on the year in one-game matches.
