South Carolina Track and Field Teams Head to NCAA Track and Field Championships

Hot off its outstanding finishes at the NCAA East Region Track and Field Championship, South Carolina's women jumped up to No. 5 nationally and the men leaped **Date** into the top 25 at a season-high No. 12 after spending a March 17-18 week out of the rankings. The women won the region March 24-25 title for the second straight year and the men finished a April 1 Florida Quad Meet program-high third.

With the NCAA Championships in Sacramento June 7-10, the women have qualified nine individuals in eight events and both its 4x100m relay and its 4x400m relay. The men qualified four individuals in five events in addition to its 4x400m relay.

"The women are ranked about right. I am also pleased to see them move from ninth to fifth. It's a tribute to their May 12-14 finish last weekend at the regional. We have got a short May 26-27 at being fourth, but it will be tough," said USC Head June 7-10 Coach Curtis Frye. "We are elated about the men being June 23-25 ranked 12th. We are excited Trackwire sees what we have

accomplished with our fifth place finish at the SEC meet and the third place finish at the regionals. We are shooting to be top 10 and we have a shot, but I'd be happy with a top 20 finish as well."

The women finished as the runner-up to Texas last year, while the men finished 26th. The USC women join only the Texas women, Arkansas men and the UCLA women as the only four programs nationally to finish in the top 10 at the NCAA Outdoor Championships the past 10 years, beginning with its ninth place finish in 1996. USC's women won the school's first NCAA title in any sport in 2002. The women have finished in the top five of the last six years with the men Women - 1st place finishing in the top 11 five times in the last 10 years.

The SEC rules again

The Texas women hold down the No. 1 spot nationally with the Florida State men edging out UTEP for the No. 1 spot on the men's spot.

Known traditionally as the toughest track and field conference in the country, the SEC Men's 4x400m relay represents again this season. The women have four teams in the top nine (Auburn, 4, Carolina 5, LSU 6, Georgia, 9) and six teams in the top 16 (Alabama, 13; Tennessee, 16). On the men's side, the SEC has five teams in the top 13 including LSU (4), Arkansas (5), Carolina (12).

The Best 'Round Here

With both capturing individual regional titles and leading their team to victories in their respective relays as the anchor leg, South Carolina sophomores Jason Richardson Women's Discus and Shalonda Solomon have been named the U.S. Track and Field and Cross Country Coaches (USTFCCCA) Southeast District Athlete of the Year.

In addition to their work on the track, Solomon and Richardson are also Dean's List students. Both were also named to the CoSIDA Academic District All-American list on May 31.

USC won region titles in the women's 100m, 200m, 4x100m relay and discus. The USC men won region titles in the 110m hurdles and the 4x400m relay.

USC's 4x100m relay repeated as the NCAA East region champion behind the running of Natasha Hastings, Amberly Nesbitt, Faraign Giles and Shalonda Solomon. USC ran a 43.85 to runner-up Miami's 43.86. The women's 4x400m relay qualified for nationals by running a season-best 3:31.81 and finishing fourth. The women's 4x4 were paced by Chiquita Martin, Giles, Stephanie Smith and Hastings.

Paced by 110m hurdle champion Jason Richardson, USC's 4x400m relay won the region title. Richardson ran a 45.6 split on the anchor leg and paced the Gamecocks' to a 3:04.62 – a season best. Also running on the 4x4 region champion 4x4 were Keith Hinnant, Thomas Hilliard and Jamil James.

Charleston's Precious Akins won the women's discus with a mark of 173' 2. It is South Carolina's first region title in the throws with Akins finishing as the runner-up two years ago.

Shalonda Solomon ran a blistering 11.07 to win the 100m with a new school record. Greenville's Amberly Nesbitt was close behind as the runner-up running her own personal best at 11.18. With the wind at 3.0+, Solomon's time of 11.15 stands as the East Region record from

Solomon came back to win the 200m at 22.30, breaking her own school record. Nesbitt finished fifth with a personal best 23.26 and also qualified for nationals.

Jason Richardson ran a 13.36 – a personal best – to win the 110m hurdles and advance to nationals. His tie would be No. 2 on the NCAA list and running with a 3.4+ wind it is allowed (for NCAA timing qualifying purposes the wind must be under 4.0+). Richardson finished third in last year's NCAA Championship.

Later Richardson took the track to run the 400m hurdles and finished as the runner-up with a personal best time of 49.90 - his first race under 50 seconds as a collegiate. Thomas Hilliard was fifth in the 400m hurdles with a personal best of 50.62 and also qualified for NCAAs.

team to a high standard. My teammates all know each others majors and class-work load. Because we travel quite a bit, we try to look out for each other," said Richardson.

The district winners will be honored on Monday, June 5 in Sacramento with the National Athlete of the Year (track athlete and field athlete) to be named on Tuesday, June 13 after the NCAA Championships June 7-10.

Richardson finished second in the 110-meter high hurdles and 400 hurdles at the SEC meet and won the highs at the East Regional meet. His best times this season are 13.36 and 49.90. He also ran the anchor leg (45.6) of USC's region-winning 4x400m

Solomon shares the top collegiate time in the 200m (22.30) and has the second-fastest mark in the 100 (11.07). The NCAA indoor champion in the 200, Solomon won both sprints at the East Regionals and anchors South Carolina's fourth-seeded 4x100 relay team. She is also expected to run a leg of USC's 4x400m relay.

Carolina at the NCAA East Region

The USC women repeated as the NCAA East Region champions with 79.5 points. USC's women, who were ranked No. 9 nationally, outdistanced ACC champion Miami (2nd place, 71 points) and SEC champion Georgia (3rd place, 50.5 points) who are both ranked No. 5. The South Carolina men finished a program-high third with 51 points, one spot ahead of Clemson (42 ½ points) and one spot better than its fourth place finish last year. Florida State won the men's title with 97 points, while Florida finished as the runner-up with 64 points.

"This is a fantastic day for the Gamecocks. We had some ex-

traordinary finishes and performances today," said USC Head Coach Curtis Frye, in his 10th

Natahsa Hastings was the runner-up in the 400m with a season-best time of 51.56. She qualifies for NCAAs, but Stephanie Smith finished ninth

Ronnetta Alexander won the bronze medal with a personal best 13.08 in the SEC Outdoor Track and Field Championship (2 100m hurdles to qualify for nationals. Alexander made the semi-finals of last year's NCAAs. Chiquita Martin ran a personal best 13.39 to scratch a point in eighth place. Martin was sixth in the 59.21 in the 400m hurdles.

Leroy Dixon was fourth in the 100m, moving up a place from last year, finishing at 10.24 – a season best. Dixon followed up with a personal best in Men's Medalists the 200m, finishing third with a time of 20.70. He was eighth at the nationals in the 100m last year.

Cheryl Terrio was sixth in the pole vault, hitting 12' 6.

USC's SEC. NCAA Titles

Outdoors, the men have won 16 SEC individual titles and one relay since first competing in the SEC meet in 1992. On the track (indoors and outdoors), Trammell won eight SEC titles and Otukile Lekote won seven SEC titles. In field events, two-time Olympian Brad Snyder won seven SEC titles. Ron Willis won USC's first SEC outdoor title in 1993 (discus) and followed up that performance by winning the 35lb. weight at the NCAA Championships in 1994, helping the men to a 19th place finish.

Trammell (six), Lekote (four) and Snyder (three) won 13 of USC's 16 110M HURDLES NCAA titles.

Outdoors, the women have won 35 SEC individual titles and nine relays since first competing in the SEC Championship in 1993. Leslie Coons won USC's first SEC outdoor title on the women's side in 1994 (javelin). She followed up her SEC title by becoming USC's first All-American in 1995 (javelin).

On the track, Miki Barber won a school-high SEC eight titles, while in field events Dawn Ellerbe and Crystal Brownlee each won five SEC titles. All told, Demetria Washington (five in track) and Ellerbe (four in field) won the most NCAA titles of any Gamecock.

Elite of Elite

The USC women join just the Texas women, Arkansas men and the UCLA women as the only four programs nationally to finish in the top 10 at the NCAA Outdoor Championships the past 10 years, beginning with its ninth place finish in 1996. USC won the NCAA title in 2002 and finished as the runner-up in 2005.

The SEC Championships have provided the Gamecocks an excellent 200M springboard for the NCAAs. SC's women have won three SEC titles in the last eight years and have finished as the runner-up three times since 1996 as well. In addition, the USC women have finished in the top three every year 400Msince 1996, with the exception of 2003 and '04 when the Gamecock women were fourth. USC finishes the last 10 years at the SEC Outdoor Championships: 1996 (2nd), 1997 (3rd), 1998 (2nd), 1999 (1st), 2000 (2nd), 2001 (3rd), 100M HURDLES 2002 (1st), 2003 (4th), 2004 (4th), 2005 (1st) and 2006 (3rd).

Adding women's track and field in 1991, USC scored in its first SEC Outdoor Championship in 1993 when it finished 10th, followed up by a fifth place 400m HURDLES finish in 1995 and an eighth place finish in 1996.

The Men

The Carolina men have also used the SEC Championships as an outstanding tune-up for the NCAA Championships - finishing in the top 31 nationally eight straight years - including three top-10 finishes and a program-high sixth twice outdoors (1999, 2002; 10th, 2003).

Finishing ninth last season at the SEC Championship, the men have fin- SR - School Record ished in the top six seven times since 1994 (1994, 4th; 1996, 5th; 1997, 5th; RQ - NCAA Regional Qualifier 1998, 5th; 1999, 5th; 2003, 6th; 2006: 5th).

Leading all schools in the SEC and ACC with a combined five CoSIDA Track and Field Academic All-American District winners, USC put all five on Men's Results the second team. The five is the highest number of Carolina track and field athletes on the Academic All-District teams in the school's history in a single year.

On the men's second team were Dan McKenzie and Jason Richardson. On the women's second were Natasha Hastings, Amberly Nesbitt and Shalonda Long Jump Finals Solomon. Four of the five are sophomores with McKenzie being the lone junior.

South Carolina has broken or tied four school records this spring -- all on the women's side.

Precious Akins (185' 9) broke former four-time NCAA champion Dawn Ellerbe's nine-year old school record in the discus (1997, 183'8) in April.

Shalonda Solomon broke the 100m and 200m records twice outdoors. She broke both at the NCAA region for the third time this season. She ran an 11.07 in the 100m and 22.30 in the 200m to win both region titles. She also owns the record indoors in the 200m.

Cheryl Terrio hit 13' 5 3/4 to tie the school record in the pole vault.

Solomon Named SEC Indoor Runner of the Year

USC's Shalonda Solomon and LSU's Xavier Carter claimed SEC Women's and Men's Runner of the Year awards for the 2005-06 indoor season.

Solomon grabbed a national champion title in the 200-meter dash with a blazing time of 22.57. The time was two-tenths of a second faster than next competitor. Solomon tied teammate Amberly Nesbitt with a team-leading time of 7.21 in the 60-meter dash, which was the fourth fastest time for an SEC runner in the Championships.

Akins Named SECThrower of the Week

Fresh off her school record discus toss of 185' 9, Charleston native and South Carolina junior Precious Akins was been named the SEC Field Athlete of the Week.

Akins won the discus at the Spec Town Relays (Athens, Ga.) with a regional PR – Personal Best qualifying toss of 185' 9 on April 8. She also finished as the runner-up in the shot put, bettering her regional qualifier at 48' 10. Akins mark in the discus

Gamecocks Walk the Walk

USC, which posted one of its most successful seasons in the classroom during the Fall, 2005 semester, congratulated eight student-athletes as they walked across the stage to receive their diploma's in mid-May. In addition, USC will look forward to five more graduating in August.

The May graduates include former NCAA champion Aleen Bailey, former All-American Alexis Joyce, Brook Antonio, Greg Royster, All-American Tawana Watkins, Steve Mance, Thomas Hilliard and manager Gershwyn Caruth. The August graduates include All-American Greig Cryer (Psychology), Monica Bozenski (Criminal Justice), Shay Shelton (Sports Management), All-American Cheryl Terrio (Sports Management) and four-time All-American Tony Allmond (Sociology).

In addition, Keri Groover graduated in May, 2005 and has been working on graduate work. She received her degree in Sports and Entertainment Management.

Bailey, a two-time NCAA champion in the 100m and 200m who also won a gold medal with Jamaica's 4x100m relay at the 2004 Athens Olympics, will graduate with a degree in Sociology. Joyce, who finished her eligibility last season, will graduate with a degree in Hotel, Restaurant and Tourism Management.

USC's manager, Gershwyn Caruth, will leave with USC with a degree in Mathematics, compiling 3.81 GPA (prior to the spring). Caruth has been a member of the President's list three times (Fall, 2003 and '05, Spring 2004) and the Dean's List once (Fall, 2004). He has received the following awards this year: US Air Force Reserve OTC Award; Distinguished graduate: ROTC Air Force; Lt. Swanger Leadership award; Fleet Foot Wasserman award (fastest mile and half in ROTC class); ROTC Cadet of Senior Class; and the highest GPA of his ROTC class.

Antonio, a Criminal Justice major who also played football for the Gamecocks, has been a member of the Dean's List five times including the Fall of 2002, '03 and '04 semesters and the Spring of 2004 and 05.

Royster was a member of the Dean's list the Fall of 2002 and is a double major (Management and Marketing) with a minor in Economics.

A two-time All-American, Watkins will finish with a degree in African-American Studies.

Mance, who had a 3.8 GPA prior to the Spring semester, will graduate with a double degree in Economics and Political Science. He has been a member of the President's List (4.0 GPA) twice (Fall 2004 and Fall 2002) and the Dean's List five times (Fall 2003, 05 and Spring 2003, 04 and 05). Mance is a member of Omicron Delta Epsilon.

The USC track and field teamsgot it done in the classroom as well. During the Fall, 2005 semester, the two teams combined to put eight men and women on the President's List (4.0 GPA) and 31 men and women on the Dean's List (3.5 GPA or better).

The women posted a 3.2 GPA and the men were close behind at 3.15 GPA. The women's team had 39 of its 52 student-athletes post a 3.0 GPA or better in the Fall of 2005, while on the men's side 23 of the 39 student-athletes posted a 3.0 GPA or better.

Gamecocks at NCAA Indoor Championships

The South Carolina women earned its seventh straight top-10 finish at the 2006 NCAA Indoor Track & Field Championships. The USC women collected 20 points to tie Northern Arizona for 10th place in the final team standings. Texas won the women's team title with 51 points. Shalonda Solomon won the school's lone NCAA title with her victory in the 200m.

The South Carolina men finished in 33rd place in a tie with Notre Dame, Villanova and Akron, getting six points from Greig Cryer in the long jump competition on the first day. Arkansas claimed the men's team title.

Former Gamecocks Succeed at World Indoor Championships

Gamecock graduate Lisa Barber won a gold medal in the 60 meters, running a blistering 7.01 on the opening day of the 2006 World Indoor Track & Field Championships at the Olimpiyskiy Sport Palace Complex in Moscow. With her victory, Barber joins Gail Devers as the only American woman ever to win world indoor 60m gold. Devers captured world indoor 60m titles in 1993, 1997 and 2004.

2006 men's Visa Championship Series winner and USC graduate Terrence Trammell overcame a stomach ailment to grab the bronze medal in 6.54 in the 60m. Two days later Trammell won his second world 60m hurdles indoor crown. The South Carolina alum, who won his first World Indoor hurdles crown in 2001 and entered this year's Championships as the world leader, ran the fastest time in the world this year of 7.43 seconds to win the gold medal. Dayron Robles of Cuba finished in second place and 2006 USA Indoor runner-up Dominique Arnold won the bronze medal with his clocking of 7.52 seconds.

Both train out of Columbia.
