# The SEC: Setting The Standard For Intercollegiate Athletics In Tennis

The Southeastern Conference men's and women's tennis programs continue to be the nation's leader on the collegiate hardcourt and in 2005 the trend continued.

The conference made another strong national showing on the men's side in 2005, as Florida and Ole Miss advanced to the semifinals at the Division I Men's Tennis Championships in College Station, Texas.

Georgia sophomore John Isner and junior Antonio Ruiz claimed the NCAA Men's Doubles National Championship with a 7-6 (4), 7-5 win over Mark Growcott and Ken Skupski of LSU. The No. 1 seeded Bulldog duo broke Skupski's serve twice in the second set to earn the victory. The win marks the third NCAA doubles crown for the University of Georgia.

In the singles tournament, three SEC players made it to the quarterfinals. Florida's Greg Oulette, Kentucky's Jesse Witten and Ole Miss' Catalin Gard all lost in the quarters.

Overall the SEC has 16 NCAA singles champions in men's tennis dating back to 1930. Eight of those singles titles have come since 1984.

Six of the ten doubles titles have come since 1993, with five different SEC schools being represented. Florida won in 1993 with the doubles tandem of David Blair and partner, singles champion Merklein. Mississippi State followed in 1994 with Laurent Miquelard and Joc Simmons, while Ole Miss duo Mahesh Bhupathi and Ali Hamadeh captured the doubles title in 1995. In 2001, Matias Boeker and Travis Parrott of Georgia took home the title.

The national team titles for the league have all been captured by Georgia as it boasts the SEC's only four men's NCAA championship teams. (1985, 87, 99, 2001).

**CAROLINA MAKES SIXTH NCAA "SWEET SIXTEEN";  
DEMARS BECOMES USC'S ALL-TIME WINNINGEST COACH**

The 2005 season may have been a turning point for the South Carolina men's tennis program. The program has a long history of success, but last season could just have been the one that finally gets USC and head coach Kent DeMars over the top and into the national spotlight on a regular basis. Not only did South Carolina make their 12th straight NCAA Tournament, a streak that ties DeMars for the fifth-longest active streak among the nation's head coaches, it was the year USC seemed to put everything together.

The 2005 Carolina squad had one of the best years in school history last season, setting or tying four school records, including seven wins over Top 25 squads and earning six wins in Southeastern Conference play to finish fourth in what is, without question, the nation's toughest men's tennis conference. In addition, junior Tom Eklund became the first Gamecock to earn SEC Player of the Week honors twice and the third Carolina player to be named first-team all-SEC after picking up the award in 2005.

The Gamecocks opened up their season on the right note, winning nine of their first 10 matches against non-conference opponents. After dropping their next two matches, Carolina stepped into SEC play for the first time as they hosted Arkansas and LSU. With their 5-2 upset of No. 38 Arkansas, USC Head Coach Kent DeMars earned his 320th win at Carolina, surpassing Ron Smarr atop the all-time win list as a Gamecock coach. Two days later USC would pick up the first of its seven upsets of the Top 25, defeating No. 9 LSU 4-3 in Columbia. In the win, Eklund knocked off No. 5 Ken Skupski at No. 1 singles, and

freshman Jaime Cuellar would provide a glimpse into his first year success with the match-clinching win at No. 4 singles over LSU senior Peter Richman.

Following that successful weekend, Carolina would make the highest single-week jump in the ITA polls of any team all season, rocketing up 25 spots to No. 30. The rest of the season would be one of the best stretch runs in recent history for the Gamecocks, who picked up wins over No. 25 Wake Forest, No. 17 Tennessee, No. 8 Georgia and No. 15 Mississippi State before falling to No. 6 Florida to end the season.

South Carolina's No. 18 national ranking and 18-8 regular season record was enough to extend their school-record of consecutive NCAA appearances to 12. In the NCAA Tournament, USC was sent to Stillwater, Okla. to face No. 51 Oklahoma in the first round. Junior Geraldo Knorr clinched the 4-3 victory with his win at No. 5 singles, advancing the Gamecocks to the regional final where they would face the host and 13th-seeded Oklahoma State. In one of the most dramatic matches in recent memory, Carolina overcame a 3-0 deficit following doubles and Nos. 1 and 5 singles, and senior Ben Atkinson clinched the upset in a third-set tiebreaker to send USC to its first Sweet 16 since 1998. In addition, Eklund advanced to the NCAA Singles Championships and the duo of Knorr and sophomore Pedro Rodrigues advanced to the Doubles Championships.

The team's No. 16 final ranking was the highest for Carolina since the 1998 season when the Gamecocks finished 15th. Eklund's final singles ranking of No. 38 was the best for a USC individual since Guillaume Legat

finished fourth in 2001 and Knorr/Rodrigues' ranking of 29th was the best since Jerome Jourdon and Vladimir Pavicevic were 16th in 1998.

"Last year was great for our program and the school," said USC Head Coach Kent DeMars. "We had an excellent team that had a legitimate shot at hosting an NCAA Regional last year, and I think that the guys would have been disappointed if they hadn't made the last 16. We came up with two tough wins in Oklahoma to get to the Championship site, and faced a Final Four team in Florida. I think with five of the six back from last year we have a great shot at another excellent year in the best tennis conference in the country."
