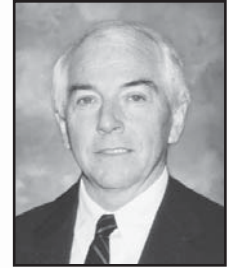

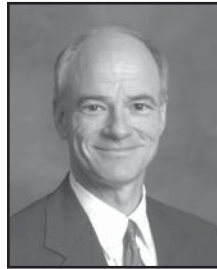

Winning championships is about attracting the best student-athletes and providing them with the resources and coaching they need to meet their potential. Each year, nearly five hundred student-athletes from the University of South Carolina are provided these resources through the generosity of the loyal fans and alumni that make up Gamecock Nation.

The mission of the University of South Carolina's Athletic Development Program is to provide the resources these student-athletes need to succeed. The Development Program is divided into three main areas:

The Office of Capital Support is responsible for generating major gifts to the athletics program.

The Office of Revenue Development handles priority seating for all Gamecock Athletic programs. Projects like The Zone and the Champions Club have contributed greatly to the Athletic Department's ability to build the facilities we need to consistently battle for championships in every sport.

The Gamecock Club is the most recognized part of the South Carolina Athletic Development Program. It began in 1942 and was one of the nation's first athletic booster and fund-raising organizations to surpass \$1 million in annual contributions. The Gamecock Club is recognized by State and Federal Government as an eleemosynary and tax exempt entity, making all individual contributions tax deductible.

The charter of the Gamecock Club is approved by the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA), the Southeastern Conference (SEC), the University of South Carolina and the Athletic Director of the University of South Carolina, main campus. Its sole purpose is to provide financial support to student-athletes in 20 sports. This aid is in the form of recruitment, tuition fees and charges, meal cost, housing cost, medical cost, injury assistance and rehabilitation expense, as well as special education needs and tutorial sessions. Gamecock Club membership is open to any alumnus or friend of the University.

## Gameweek Media Availability

**Sunday:**  
Coach Spurrier holds a teleconference from his office at 2 p.m. (No in-person availability). No player availability.

**Monday:**  
Coach Spurrier, players and assistant coaches are available coming off the practice field. All media requests for players must be in to the SID office by 11 a.m.

**Tuesday:**  
Coach Spurrier's weekly press conference in the team meeting room on the second floor of the Crews Building at noon. In addition, selected players will be brought to the lobby area before and/or after Coach Spurrier's press conference. There is no availability after practice.

**Wednesday:**  
Coach Spurrier, players and assistant coaches are available coming off the practice field. All media requests for players must be in to the SID office by 11 a.m. Coach Spurrier is available on the SEC conference call at 11:07 a.m. ET.

**Thursday:**  
Coach Spurrier and assistant coaches are available coming off the practice field. There is no player availability after practice. Coach Spurrier's radio show is at 7 p.m.

**Friday:**  
Coach Spurrier and Defensive Coordinator Ellis Johnson are available for network TV. No player availability.

**Saturday:**  
Coach Spurrier, Coach Johnson and requested players will be available in the team meeting room and/or the lobby area on the second floor of the Crews Building following the game. The locker room is closed to the media.

## Carolina Student-Athlete Media Interview Policy

All interviews are to be coordinated through the media relations office. This allows us to arrange the interview when it best suits the student-athlete's and the reporter's schedules. Please contact the media relations office in advance to make your interview requests. **Media are not permitted to contact student-athletes on their own at any time.**

All interviews will take place at the practice fields, in the lobby outside the team meeting room on the second floor of the Crews Building or at the media relations office. No interviews will take place prior to practice on the practice fields.

Dormitory, apartment and cell phone numbers for student-athletes will not be provided to the media. Should you need to conduct a telephone interview with a student-athlete, a call will be placed to you from the student-athlete at a mutually agreeable time.



## Preseason Media and Photo Day

The annual Media Day will be held on Sunday, August 3. Photos will be taken on the field beginning at 3 p.m. No interviews will be allowed on the field. Coach Spurrier will hold a press conference beginning at approximately 3:40 p.m. in the Team Meeting room, located on the second floor of the Crews Building in the south end zone. Requested players and assistant coaches will be available following Coach Spurrier's press conference in the lobby area outside the team room.

## Press Credentials

Working press credentials for the 2008 South Carolina home football games must be submitted online through [www.gamecocksonline.com](http://www.gamecocksonline.com).

To submit a credential request: 1) Select Athletics Department (located near the top on the right hand side of the main page); 2) Use the dropdown menu to select Media Relations; 3) Select 2008 Football Credential Request (located near the bottom of the page in the middle section); 4) Follow the step-by-step instructions.

Requests for season passes should be submitted no later than Aug. 14. Requests for single games should be made as far in advance as possible and no later than seven (7) days prior to game day. Once approved, credentials may be picked up at media will-call, located at the press gate on the west side of the stadium by the press elevators. Credentials can also be picked up at the Carolina Media Relations Office by making arrangements with Diana Koval. Special arrangements for credentials to be mailed must be made and approved through Diana Koval. Media will-call will open three (3) hours prior to kick-off. The sports editors of daily newspapers and sports directors of television stations should submit the requests. Requests will be honored from sports directors and full-time hosts of radio stations that have local daily sports broadcasts originating from that station. All other requests will be considered on a space-available basis.

**Please note:** Due to the high number of applications, it is not possible to accommodate all requests. Accredited working media will have first priority and all others will be on a space-available basis. No one under 18 years of age will be issued a credential or armband without prior approval of the SID.

## Internet Sites

The University of South Carolina adheres to the SEC policies regarding representatives of websites. The official website of the home and visiting schools will be credentialed. Also, the official online service of the national over-the-air or cable television network that owns broadcast rights to the game will receive credentials. Other websites will not be credentialed unless they meet specifications outlined below:

1. Must be a legal corporate entity that has been in business for at least one full calendar year and has provided coverage of South Carolina or the visiting team for at least one year.
2. Must provide daily coverage of ALL athletic teams of South Carolina or the visiting team with its own staff of reporters, photographers and equipment.
3. Must travel to and cover all football away games and all major post-season events.
4. Must provide coverage of all press conferences of all athletic teams at South Carolina or the visiting team.

Websites will be credentialed one writer and one photographer pass.

## SEC Internet Real Time Policy

By acceptance and use of an SEC media credential, the holder agrees to the following conditions for any and all athletic events hosted by the SEC and its member institutions:

The SEC and its member institutions grant a media organization a limited license to use certain gathered information on the media organization's own Internet or online site beginning

at the start of an athletic event and up to the conclusion of such event, all subject to the following limitations and conditions:

(a) No more than 10 still photographs may be used for news coverage of the game and other editorial purposes. Such still photographs must be used on a time-delayed basis, that is at least five (5) minutes after the happening of the event depicted by the still photograph.

(b) It is agreed that video tape is NOT to be used on an Internet or online site (except that video tape may be shown as part of a single, non-archived, online "simulcast" of a television station's regularly-scheduled news program).

(c) While a game is in progress, the use of textual statistical information is time-delayed and limited in amount (e.g., updates pertaining to score, injuries and national, conference or institutional record-breaking performances, a condensed half-time story) so that an organization's Internet or online game coverage does not undercut the authorized and rights-paying fee organization's rights to play-by-play accounts of the game and/or exclusivity as to such rights.

This policy is in effect for all SEC sporting events including championships. The limitations for football is three per quarter; one at halftime.

## Press Box

South Carolina features a state-of-the-art press box. This press facility has seats for 143 members of the media, along with television and radio booths, coaches booths and public address and stadium operations/security booths. Located just above the press level is the photo deck. All members of the media covering the game are invited to a catered meal which is served starting two hours prior to kickoff.

The Carolina press box is for the working media only. In accordance with the Football Writers Association of America, no cheering will be allowed.

## Satellite Truck Parking

Limited parking is available for TV station live/satellite trucks and those vehicles will need a specific pass. Please contact Diana Koval no later than Noon on Wednesday prior to Saturday games for help in securing a parking pass.

## Press Box Services

The Press Box is equipped with 14 outside telephone lines and all data jacks for electronic photo transmissions. These services are available to media members on a first-come, first served basis. In addition, the press box has wireless internet capabilities. Electrical outlets are available at each seat. Any newspaper that wishes to install its own telephone should contact South Carolina Telephone Communications at (803) 777-1800. The Media Relations Department supplies quarterly play-by-plays and quickie stats, halftime statistics, final team and individual statistics and coaches and players quotes. An inside public address announcer also keeps the media informed of play-by-play, records and game notes.

## Visiting Radio

The visitor's radio network must be designated by the opponent's athletic director. Booth space will be assigned and telephone lines must be ordered by the originating station through Bell South (803) 780-2800. The non-designated stations will be admitted on a space-available basis. The Gamecock Sports Network will be handled by Gamecock Sports Properties, a joint venture of Learfield Communications and International Sports Properties. Stations requesting information regarding the network should contact: Liz McMillan, Gamecock Sports Properties, (803) 777-8254.

## Spotters and Statisticians

The Media Relations Department can supply radio and television broadcasters with spotters and stat personnel if notified of their needs in advance.

## South Carolina Sideline Policy

The University of South Carolina adheres to the NCAA and SEC guidelines regarding media representatives on the sidelines.

1. Photo credentials will be issued only to accredited media outlets – daily newspapers, specialized publications and television stations – prior to the game and photo identification must be provided. Photo credentials will not be mailed. No freelance photographers will be issued credentials.
2. Photographers must check in at the Press Will Call Booth on the west side of the stadium adjacent to the press elevator to acquire sideline photo credentials.
3. Each photographer who will work on the sidelines will be issued a photo armband. This armband must be worn on the arm at all times to gain access to the game and to the sidelines. No other type of photo or media credentials will allow an individual access to the sidelines.
4. Photographers and videographers are not permitted to shoot between the 25-yard lines and they must wear a photo armband at all times. Working photographers/videographers with armbands and cameras are permitted to shoot in the designated area (between the two marked dotted lines outside the 25-yard lines). All other media representatives on the field (announcers, reporters, etc.) must stand behind the designated area. This will ensure that photographers/videographers have the appropriate space to do their work.
5. Each student publication will be limited to one sideline photographer's credential.

## Postgame Interviews

The press box elevator will be held at press level with six minutes remaining in the game for anyone wanting postgame interviews. The Gamecock postgame interview room is located in the Team Meeting room, located on the second floor of the Crews Building in the south end zone. The visitors' locker room and postgame interview room are located under the West stands at the North end. The Gamecock locker room will be closed following the game. Coach Steve Spurrier will be available in the postgame interview room approximately 10 minutes after the game. Players who have been requested to be interviewed by the media will also be brought to the interview room following the cool-down period. Admittance to postgame interviews is by credential only. The Carolina press conference will be televised live back to the press level.

The Southeastern Conference will again host a weekly press teleconference each Wednesday from August 27 through November 26. The teleconference, open to the media, will feature the head coach from each team every week. Gamecock Sports Properties, a partnership between the University of South Carolina Athletics Department and two of the country's leaders in the collegiate sports marketing industry, ISP Sports and Learfield Communications, Inc., is the originating medium for radio coverage of the South Carolina Gamecocks.

This is the first year of a nine-year, \$50 million contract between the University and ISP Sports and Learfield Communications, Inc. that runs through 2017. 2008 also marks the first year of a five-year agreement with Citadel Broadcasting that makes WNKT-FM (107.5) the official flagship station of Gamecock Athletics.

All Gamecock Football broadcasts are also available on XM.

Gamecock Sports Properties is responsible for the overall management of the athletics program's corporate partnership effort, which includes producing, selling and distributing the Gamecock Radio Network (live play-by-play and call-in shows) and television programming (pay per view opportunities and coaches shows), print advertising in various athletics department publications, and selected signage in university athletic facilities.

**Todd Ellis**, the all-time leading passer in Gamecock history and the school's winningest quarterback, begins his 16th season with the network and his sixth as the play-by-play voice of Carolina football. Ellis has served as sideline reporter for the radio network and also worked as color analyst and play-by-play announcer for Comcast Sports Southeast for Gamecock telecasts. Ellis has also hosted the coaches television show in the past and served on CBS's bowl game radio coverage. He will also host the Steve Spurrier Television Show and the Steve Spurrier Radio Call-In Show. Ellis re-wrote the school's passing records during his career (1986-89). He set more than 20 school passing marks, while throwing for 9,953 yards.

**Tommy Suggs**, a former standout Gamecock quarterback, is back for his 35th year as color analyst for the radio network. Suggs played for Carolina from 1968-70 and is regarded as one of the school's all-time premier signal-callers. He led the Gamecocks to the 1969 ACC championship and Peach Bowl berth and was named MVP of the 1970 Blue-Gray All-Star Classic. Suggs was inducted into the University's Athletic Hall of Fame in 1989.

Former Gamecock and NFL standout **Duce Staley** is in his second season working as the sideline reporter.

**Mike Morgan**, who handles play-by-play duties for Carolina's men's basketball and for Gamecock baseball, will handle play-by-play responsibilities on the Comcast Sports Southeast football tape delay, which airs each Sunday.

**Liz McMillan** serves as the General Manager of Gamecock Sports Properties in Columbia.

**Carroll Senn** is the broadcast engineer, **David Spence** is the spotter and **Doug Adams** is the statistician. **Rachel Wilson** assists with production.

South Carolina football has appeared on television numerous times, dating back to a local telecast of a game against Marquette University in Milwaukee, Wis., Nov. 5, 1949. The first Gamecock home game to be televised was against the University of North Carolina in Carolina (now Williams-Brice) Stadium, Nov. 7, 1953.

That first home telecast was the first program aired by WIS-TV (Channel 10) when the Columbia NBC affiliate went on the air. The NBC network originally planned a "panorama" of four games nationwide on that date, showing one quarter of each game. When plans for that production did not materialize, NBC agreed to honor a commitment to WIS-TV, which had scheduled the football telecast as its inaugural program.

NBC sent a remote unit from Washington, D.C., and play-by-play was handled by WIS-TV Sports Director Ray Stanfield. South Carolina beat North Carolina 18-0 in the game, which was sponsored by General Motors. The teams split the \$50,000 rights fee for the one station network broadcast.
