

South Carolina 71 East Tenn. State 66

Nov. 24, 2002 Columbia, S.C. The Carolina Center (14,922)

Carlos Powell and Chuck Eidson hit back-to-back three pointers to give Carolina the lead for good and the Gamecocks survived an East Tennessee State surge for a 71-66 victory to open the season and a new era of USC basketball at The Carolina Center. A crowd of 14,922 instantly became the largest to see a Gamecock men's home game in the 18,000-seat, state-of-the-art Carolina Center.

Carolina started the game on a dunk by Kerbrell Brown, but ETSU responded with 11-straight points and had a 16-3 lead after a Tim Smith layup with six minutes gone. USC scored seven points in a row and eventually tied the game at 19-19 before the Bucs raced back out to a five-point advantage (26-21) with 7:44 left. The Gamecocks, however, finished the half strong and capped a 20-8 run to take a 41-34 lead into the lockerroom.

ETSU again fought back and went on a 12-0 run to take a 51-45 lead on a pair of Ryan Lawson free throws with 14:52 to play in the game. The Bucs kept the lead for most of the second half until Carolina took a brief lead on a pair of Chuck Eidson free throws (5:51), then with the game tied, Powell and Eidson nailed back-to-back treys to give USC a 67-63 lead with 3:31 to go. The Buccaneers would come no closer down the stretch.

Eidson came within one assist of the first triple-double in USC history, leading Carolina with 19 points, 10 rebounds, nine assists and five steals. Powell had 15 points and 10 rebounds, while Rolando Howell had 12 points and Brown 11. Tony Kitchings led the Gamecocks with 11 rebounds.

South Carolina 82 S.C. State 65

Nov. 29, 2002 Columbia, S.C. The Carolina Center (13,505)

Chuck Eidson tied his career high with 25 points and recorded the first triple-double in South Carolina history as the Gamecocks pulled away in the second half for an 82-65 victory over South Carolina State before 13.505 at The Carolina Center.

Eidson had 10 assists and 10 rebounds — three in the final three minutes — along with five steals to post his best day in the Carolina uniform.

South Carolina started the game on fire, with an Eidson slam dunk capping a 16-0 run highlighted by back-to-back three pointers. Eidson's slam came just 3:30 into the contest, with the Gamecocks going up 21-4 at the 9:37 mark on an Eidson three pointer. The Gamecocks recorded their largest margin of the game, 34-12, after a pair of Marcus Morrison free throws with 4:23 left. But South Carolina State ended the first half on a 20-6 run with a Dustin Braddick bank three pointer ending the first 20 minutes with the Gamecocks ahead 40-32.

The Bulldogs cut the lead to five points three minutes into the second half, but the Gamecocks quickly went back up by 13 after a Marius Petravicius jumper at the 15:29 mark. SCSU, however, went on a 14-4 run and cut the lead to 56-53 on a Braddick three pointer three minutes later. USC upped the lead to 10 points, but again the Bulldogs cut it to four points on a Dakin Braddick jumper at the 4:53 mark of the half (65-61). USC responded with a 17-4 run to end the game going away.

Carlos Powell had a career-high 20 points while Petravicius came off the bench for 15 points.

South Carolina 71 Appalachian St. 56

Nov. 30, 2002 Columbia, S.C. The Carolina Center (9,109)

Four South Carolina players scored in double figures and Chuck Eidson set the Gamecock all-time steals record as Carolina downed a pesky Appalachian State team, 71-56, before 9,109 at The Carolina Center.

Eidson's back-to-back steals in the second half gave him 224, breaking the USC record of 223 set by Barry Manning in 123 career games. Eidson broke the mark in his 87th career game (36 fewer contests).

The opening stages of the game featured three ties and a trio of lead changes with the Mountaineers' Johnathan Mitchell giving ASU a 9-7 advantage on a slam dunk at the 15:03 mark. Carolina responded with a 17-4 run and took a 24-13 lead after a Carlos Powell three pointer at the 8:24 point of the game. App. State go the margin to seven, but USC went on a 13-4 run for its largest first half lead (37-21) and had a 37-23 advantage after the first 20 minutes.

Playing without Tony Kitchings, who broke his hand early in the previous game, Carolina rotated its post players and never led by less than 11 points in the second half. The Gamecocks put together a modest 7-0 run and had their largest lead of the game at 51-33 after back-to-back jumpers by Mike Boynton and Rolando Howell, the last at the 9:56 mark of the second half.

Eidson led the Gamecocks in scoring for the third-straight game with 16 points, while Powell had 15 points and nine rebounds. Howell chipped in 11 points and eight boards while Chris Warren had 13 points. Boynton led the Gamecocks with a career-best eight assists.

South Carolina 66 Temple 47

Dec. 2, 2002 Columbia, S.C. The Carolina Center (14,573)

Carlos Powell tied his career high with 20 points and South Carolina used a suffocating defense to limit Temple to 5-of-26 from the three-point line as the Gamecocks cruised to a 66-47 victory before 14,573 at The Carolina Center. The victory ended a fourgame streak of wins to open the new building.

Coming off allowing Appalachian State to make just 2-of-23 three pointers, the Gamecocks broke a close game open with a run at the end of the first half and an offensive explosion in the second stanza.

Carolina started off the game on fire, pushing out to a 9-2 lead after a Chuck Eidson three pointer with 14:30 left. But Temple scored the game's next 14 points and led 16-9 after a Nile Murry jumper midway through the period. In fact, Carolina would make just two field goals in a 12-minute span, but stayed within striking distance. Then down five with 2:39 left, Carolina scored the half's final nine points and took a 23-19 lead into intermission.

Temple quickly re-took the lead in the second half and the teams traded leads six times in the first eight minutes of the period. Then with USC down by one, the Gamecocks went on a 15-2 run and took its largest lead of the game at the time at 48-36 after a Rolando Howell three-point play. Carolina would lead by double digits the rest of the way with the final score being the Gamecocks' largest lead the entire game. Carolina put the game away with a strong second half of shooting, making 16-of-24 shots (66.7%) while limiting Temple to just five points in an eight-minute span of the period.

Howell had 12 points and eight rebounds for Carolina while Chuck Eidson had 12 points.

Georgetown 67 South Carolina 59

Dec. 5, 2002 Washington, D.C. MCI Center (5,469)

Georgetown's Mike Sweetney scored 27 points and pulled down 11 rebounds and Carolina could not overcome an 11:40 stretch without a field goal in the second half as the Hoyas handed the Gamecocks their first loss of the season, 67-59, before 5,469 fans at MCI Center. The game was Carolina's first on the road on the 2002-03 season.

The game started out slowly, with the teams trading leads a pair of times with Carlos Powell tying the contest at 5-5 on a jumper four minutes in. But Georgetown went on an 11-0 run over a 3:30 span to take its largest lead of the game at 16-5 after a dunk by Sweetney. Carolina then clamped down defensively and held the Hoyas to just one field goal over the next six minutes and 10 points overall the rest of the half as the Gamecocks worked their way back into the contest. Carolina used an 18-8 run over the last 10 minutes of the first half, tying the game at 29-29 on a Marcus Morrison free throw at 1:16. A pair of Tony Bethel free throws 12 seconds later gave Georgetown a 31-29 halftime lead.

The Gamecocks raced to their first lead of the game early in the second half and opened up a 45-42 advantage after a Rolando Howell jumper at the 12:40 mark. But Carolina would not knock down another field goal until there were 50 seconds to play; however, five-straight free throws pulled USC to within 53-50 with 5:38 left. But the Gamecocks could not convert on two opportunities to pull closer or tie the game and Georgetown pulled away for the victory, the Bulldogs' fourth in as many tries over South Carolina.

Carlos Powell led the Gamecocks with 18 points while Kerbrell Brown had 17.

NC State 76 South Carolina 64

Dec. 8, 2002 Raleigh, N.C. RBC Center (12,069)

Julius Hodge sparked a 17-3 run with threestraight three-point possessions as NC State came back from six points down to race past South Carolina, 76-64, before 12,069 fans at RBC Center. The loss was Carolina's second in a row on the road as the Gamecocks played their first regular-season game in Raleigh since the 1971 season.

Carolina got things rolling early, erasing a 2-0 Wolfpack lead with an 11-3 run, highlighted by a Rolando Howell dunk, giving USC an 11-5 lead with 16:02 to play. NC State got to within one point, but Carolina scored seven-straight points and took its largest lead of the game at 18-10 after a Howell layup at 9:24. USC led by as many as seven points with just more than two minutes remaining, but the Wolfpack scored the half's final six points and pulled to within 32-31 after the game's first 20 minutes. Carolina made most of its headway from the line, going 11-of-13 from 15 feet out in the first half.

The Gamecocks again got out to a quick start, upping the lead to six points (41-35) after another Howell dunk, and after NC State tied the game, raced back out to another six point advantage (51-45) after a Kerbrell Brown layup. But the Wolfpack started their surge, going on an 8-0 run to take a 53-51 lead on a Hodge three pointer at 8:29. Brown responded with a trey, but Hodge gave NC State the lead for good on a layup on the next possession, and the Wolfpack increased the lead from there on spectacular shooting. NCSU made 13-of-22 field goals in the final 20 minutes (59.1%), 7-of-13 three pointers (53.8%) and 12-of-15 free throws (80%).

Carlos Powell again led USC in scoring with 19 points, while Brown added 15.

A game removed from one of its finest performances of the year in a 75-77 loss to then-No. 6 Florida, USC didn't travel as well to Mississippi State, dropping a 48-64 game to the Bulldogs in front of 7,035 fans at Humphrey Coliseum.

USC shot a season-low 27.5% from the field. The Gamecocks also collected season low's, as a team, in the following categories: points (48), field goal made (14) and field goal attempts (44).

One bright spot: Chuck Eidson went 10-11 from the free throw line, including hitting nine straight to begin the game.
