



Season in Review

Led by All-SEC players Kelley, Wallace and Archie, Gamecocks defeat 2 NCAA Sweet 16 teams

Following the recent success of back-to-back NIT titles, the Gamecocks went into the 2006-2007 season feeling good. Despite losing Renaldo Balkman in the June, 2006 NBA Draft as a first round draft pick prior to his senior year, and Tarence Kinsey and Rocky Trice graduating, the Gamecock staff believed in seniors Tre' Kelley, Brandon Wallace and Bryce Sheldon.

The season started out well with a surprisingly hard fought victory over in-state S.C. State Bulldogs. The Gamecocks then headed out west for two games at UC Irvine and Southern California. Carolina split the two contests, first losing to UC Irvine 67-52, but quickly rebounding to spoil the opening of the Trojans' new arena beating them 80-74 in overtime. USC was paced by Kelley's 26 points against the Trojans (who reached the NCAA Sweet 16). Sheldon also scored 22 points in the win against the Trojans.

South Carolina quickly followed up with two easy wins over Lipscomb and The Citadel. The Gamecocks lost a tough one against archrival Clemson and then quickly rebounded with a win over a Bobby Cremins-led College of Charleston.

South Carolina then quickly put together five wins in a row. Most importantly, winning a hard fought game against Baylor in Waco, Texas. At Baylor the Gamecocks had to rally from seven points down to win with Kelley pouring in 26 points. Then USC went on with its winning ways beating Princeton, UNC Asheville, Jacksonville and Western Carolina all at home. The Jacksonville win proved costly as Kelley sprained his right knee, was unable to play against Western Carolina and then battled problems the rest of the year.

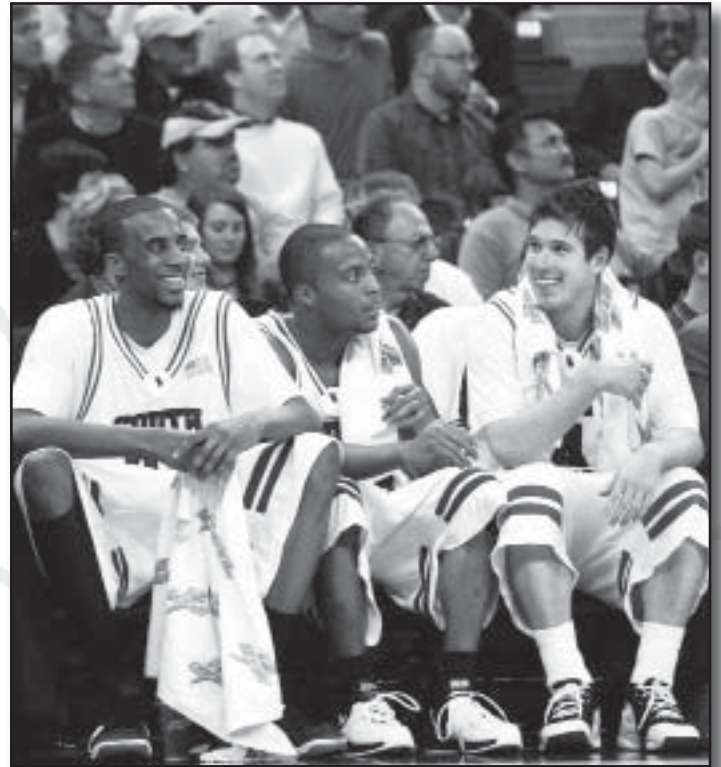
The Gamecocks were riding a high going into the New Year with a game with the No. 9 Kansas Jayhawks looming on the horizon. The nationally televised game on CBS ended with a disappointing showing from USC as the Gamecocks fell 70-54. The woes continued, as the Gamecocks would lose the next four games to Georgia, Florida, Kentucky and Tennessee.

USC landed on its feet with a win over Arkansas in Columbia. Kelley scored 22 points in the win, and surprising freshman Dominique Archie added 13 in the 66-60 win. The Gamecocks continued that success with a win over Mississippi State in Starkville a few days later. Again Kelley paced South Carolina with 23 points with another 15 points from junior Dwayne Day, and a double-double from center Brandon Wallace.

Hitting a rough patch, South Carolina fell to Auburn, at Alabama, at Kentucky, Georgia and at Vanderbilt in succession. But in the loss to Kentucky, Kelley put on his gutsiest performance of all scoring 36 points in the loss. Then-Kentucky coach, Tubby Smith, gave high praise to Kelley saying that he should win the SEC's MVP award.

The Gamecocks rebounded again, upsetting the Tennessee Volunteers, an NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 participant, in Columbia. USC hit a season high 13 three-pointers, and again Kelley led the way with 25 points. The game featured three other Gamecocks scoring in double digits, including Bryce Sheldon with 16, Brandis Raley-Ross chipping in 12 and Archie giving 11 points.

After dropping a contest to the eventual back-to-back NCAA Champion Florida Gators, South Carolina won the next game beating Ole

Miss 76-63. An important story-line in the game would be Wallace blocking seven shots to put him in the lead for most blocked shots in the program's history. Kelley led the Gamecocks by putting in another 28 point night.

The Vanderbilt Commodores, an NCAA Sweet 16 finalist later, came to town for the final home game of the year and both teams put on a thriller of a game. The Gamecocks put up an epic rally, coming back from 17 points down to tie the game and send it into overtime. Yet once more Kelley was the star of the game scoring 32 points, and at times looked dominate, willing the Gamecocks back into the game. Kelley shot an amazing 9-18 from the field, 3-4 from the three-point line, and 11-13 from the free throw line, but Carolina fell in overtime 99-90. Archie also chipped in 21 points in the loss. USC finished the regular season in Baton Rouge, falling to LSU 61-52.

Losing in the first round of the SEC Tournament to SEC Tournament finalist Arkansas, USC players garnered post season awards with Kelley earning first team AP SEC honors, unanimous first team Coaches All-SEC honors and the Frances Pomeroy Naismith Award (given to the best player 6'0 or under). He was also one of four finalists nationally for the Chip Hilton Character Award.

Wallace received SEC Honorable mention, and also left as the career leader in blocks (249) - shattering Danny Traylor's record set in 1973 (235) as well as playing the most games in school history (135). Archie was honored as part of the SEC All-Freshmen team.

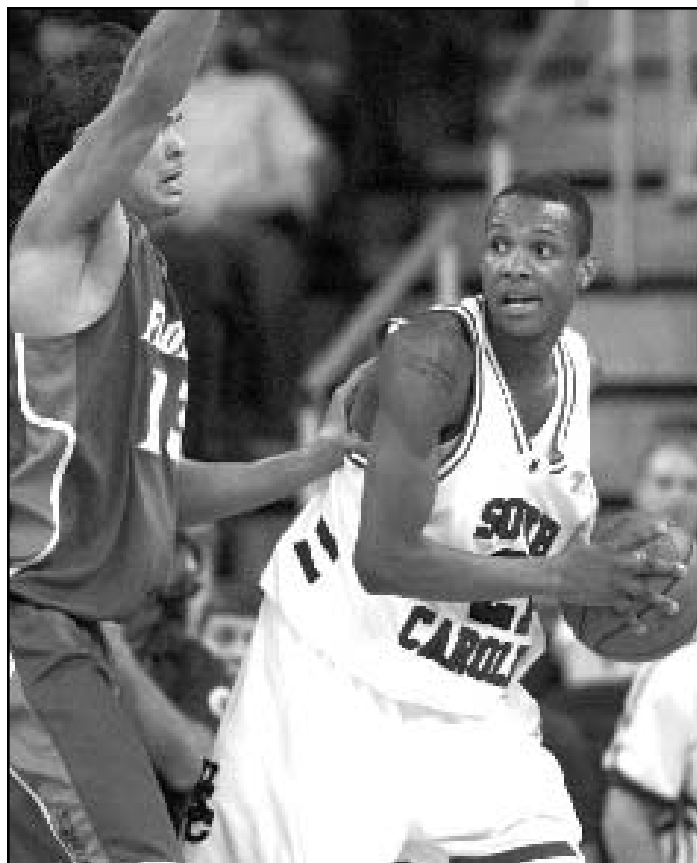
