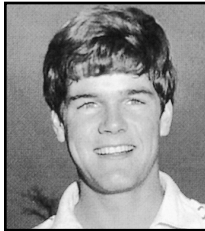


**Bobby Heald**

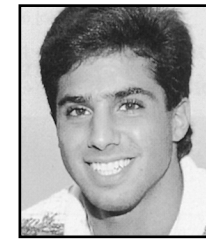

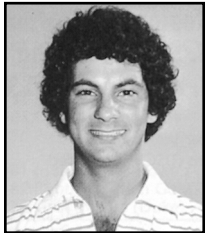
**Lou Gloria**
