A LOOK BACK AT THE 2007 SEASON IN THE SEC

The Southeastern Conference, with its storied 74-year history of athletic achievements and academic excellence, has built perhaps the greatest tradition of intercollegiate competition in baseball of any league in the country since its inception in 1933.

The SEC posted another tremendous season in 2007 as the conference had five teams earn selection to NCAA postseason play and Mississippi State advanced to the College World Series. A SEC squad has now appeared in the College World Series 22 of the last 23 years. Four SEC teams were selected as NCAA opening-round host sites, while Mississippi State shattered Super Regional attendance records a week later. Vanderbilt won the SEC tournament title over Arkansas. Vanderbilt won the SEC regular- season title with a 22-8 conference record.

The Southeastern Conference boasts 11 former National Players of the Year (Vanderbilt's David Price won in 2007), nine Baseball America Coach of the Year and seven Collegiate Baseball Coach of the Year honors. 133 student-athletes have been named first-team All-American, seven of which came in 2007.

In 2007, 42 former SEC players were listed on MLB opening day 25-man rosters. Ten SEC players were taken in the first round of the 2007 Major League Baseball Amateur Draft, including the first pick overall. Vanderbilt's David Price was the first overall pick of the draft by the Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Florida's Matt LaPorta was seventh by Milwaukee, Casey Weathers of Vanderbilt was eighth by Colorado, J.P. Arencibia of Tennessee was 21st by Toronto and Arkansas' Nick Schmidt was 23rd by

San Diego. Tennessee's Julio Bourbon and James Adkins, Josh Donaldson of Auburn, Tommy Hunter of Alabama and Mississippi State's Edward Easley were all taken in the supplemental first round of the 2007 Major League Baseball Draft. With those ten selections, the SEC has now had a first round selection in each year since 1991 and 68 total in the first round during that time.

The SEC drew a record-high 1,686,932 fans to its on-campus ballparks in 2007, double that of the next closest conference.

Seven SEC teams drew in excess of 100,000 fans to their parks in 2007. The SEC averaged a new league-high 4,134 fans per game in 2007. In addition, for the first time in league history, all 12 SEC schools averaged more than 1,500 fans per game.

NOTES

The SEC has sent 34 teams to the College World Series since 1990. That was accomplished despite no SEC teams making the field in 1992. LSU has been to Omaha 10 times and Florida, Georgia and Mississippi State four times, while Alabama, South Carolina and Tennessee have been three times each. Auburn has been once, while Arkansas advanced in 2004.

SEC teams have won six of the last 18 national championships, with LSU winning five (1991, 1993, 1996, 1997, 2000) and Georgia claiming the 1990 title. The SEC has finished runner-up three times in that time, 1997, 2002 and 2005.

SEC teams are 61-59 since 1990 in Omaha, a 50.8 winning percentage. Not counting games against each other, the SEC has a 46-45 record in the CWS since 1990, a 50.5 winning percentage.

The SEC has played 25 games in the "Final Four" of the College World Series since 1990, an average of 1.4 per year. Only five times, 1992, 1994, 2003, 2006 and 2007 has the SEC failed to get a team to the "Final Four" of the CWS

The SEC has averaged nearly eight games played per year in the College World Series since 1990. In 2004, 12 of the 15 games played in Omaha involved a SEC team. In 1997, the SEC had a team in 13 of the 14 games played in the CWS. Since 1990, an SEC team played in 105 of the 254 games played in the College World Series, an amazing 41 percent of games.

The SEC has sent nine of its 12 schools to the College World Series since 1990 - Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, LSU, Mississippi State, South Carolina and Tennessee.

Since 1990, 113 SEC squads have been invited to the NCAA Tournament, an average over six per season. The SEC set yet another NCAA record in both 2004 and 2005 with nine teams earning postseason berths. The SEC also had a NCAA-record five teams earn regional host sites in 2004 and 2006.

The SEC has had an NCAA-high 10 different teams compete in the 56-year history of the College World Series. In those appearances, the conference has registered an 83-100 record, a 45.4 winning percentage.

Since 1990, 23 SEC squads have posted 50-plus win seasons, while 86 have won 40-plus games in a season, including four teams in 2006.

The SEC posted a 233-90 record against non-conference foes in 2007, a 72.1 winning percentage. Since 1990, the SEC has accumulated a 4298-1626-4 record against non-conference teams, a 72.5 winning percentage.

SEC teams have also been strong in the polls. Since 1990, 85 conference teams have appeared in the final *Baseball America* poll, 90 in the final *Collegiate Baeball* poll and, since 1992, 82 in the final *ESPN* coaches poll.
