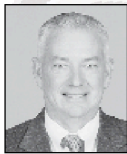

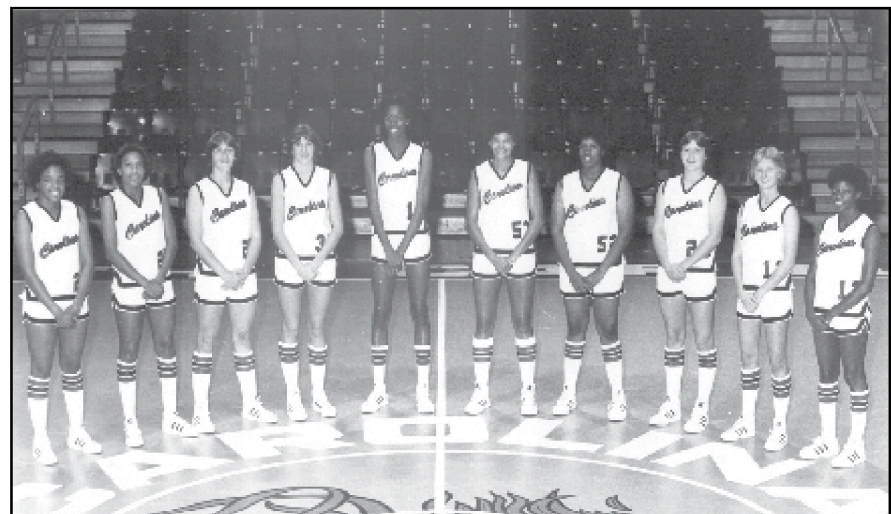

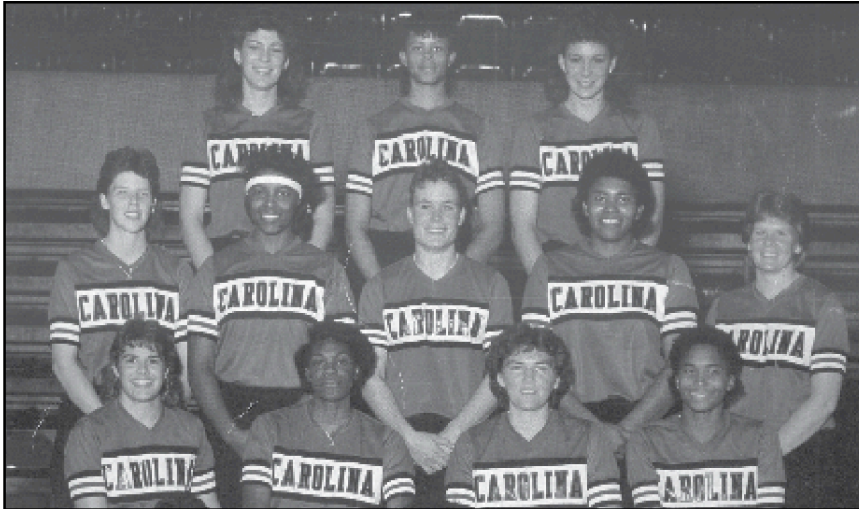

**SEC By The Numbers**

\* The SEC has posted impressive non-conference records in the last decade. The SEC compiled a 137-48 (.741) non-conference record during the 2004-05 season. Since the 1990 season, the SEC has compiled a 2,162-585 (.787) record against other conferences. The league has recorded 150+ wins during seven seasons and had never recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .746.

\* SEC teams have earned appearances in 22 of 24 NCAA Final Fours, an accomplishment unmatched by any other league. Overall, SEC squads have filled 29 of the 96 Final Four berths, including having two Final Four teams in 1988 (Auburn, Tennessee), 1989 (Auburn, Tennessee), 1995 (Georgia, Tennessee), 1996 (Georgia, Tennessee), 1998 (Arkansas, Tennessee), 2004 (LSU, Tennessee) and 2005 (LSU, Tennessee).

\* SEC teams have made 16 appearances in a nation-high 14 NCAA Championship games, winning six national championships (Tennessee: 1987, 1989, 1991, 1996, 1997 and 1998). The league had the distinction of providing both national finalists twice in its history in 1996 (Tennessee 83, Georgia 65) and in 1989 (Tennessee 76, Auburn 60).

\* SEC teams have won 272 NCAA Tournament games against 141 losses (.659) for an average of 11.3 NCAA wins per year. In addition, all 12 current members have appeared in the NCAA Tournament.

\* The SEC has paced the pack in NCAA tournament bids 21 times in its 24-year history. The SEC was the first league to ever have eight teams invited to the NCAA Tournament, doing it in 1999 and 2002.

\* The SEC was also the first league to ever have seven teams invited to the NCAA Tournament and earned this honor a leading seven times (1986, 1991, 1995, 1996, 1997, 2003, 2004).

\* In 2003, Auburn won the WNIT title with wins over South Alabama, Florida State, Richmond, Creighton and Baylor. It was the second WNIT Championship for the SEC. In 1999, the Arkansas Lady Razorbacks defeated Wisconsin 76-64 to claim the SEC's first Women's NIT championship.

**NCAA Numbers Do The Talking**

In the 24-year history of the NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament (since 1982), no league has posted more appearances, wins or titles than the SEC.

**Individual Honors**

\*The SEC has had 49 student-athletes named as a First-Team All-America selection. Those 49 have been named a total of 113 times since 1977.

\*The league has had three Honda-Broderick Cup Award winners (1988-Katrina McClain, Georgia; 1990-Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee; 1998-Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee).

\*Five Naismith Player of the Year winners have come from the SEC. In 1996 Georgia's Saudia Roundtree was given the honor. Chamique Holdsclaw of Tennessee won the honor in 1998 and 1999 while teammate Tamika Catchings was named in 2000. Last season, LSU's Seimone Augustus won the award.

\*SEC teams have provided 115 All-Region performers, including 23 Most Outstanding Players.

\*Over the past 24-years, 31 Final Four All-Tournament Team members have come from SEC schools. In 1996, the entire all-tournament team was made up of SEC players.

\*Six NCAA Post-Graduate Scholarship winners and 18 Academic All-Americans hail from the SEC.

**Pros**

\* SEC schools had 33 former players on opening day rosters in the WNBA.

\* In this year's WNBA draft, a total of eight SEC women's basketball players were taken.

\* Since women's basketball was added as an Olympic sport in 1976, the SEC has produced 30 Olympians. A complete listing follows:

**Dominance In the Polls**

\* Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1983, it has never failed to place at least four members in each of the final polls (The USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).

\* In terms of rankings, the SEC has the richest history of any conference in the nation, boasting more poll appearances than any other. Since the 1981-82 season, SEC teams have been ranked 405 consecutive weeks in the AP Poll.

\* League teams have been ranked 2,209 times, including 1,105 Top 10 appearances and 636 Top 5 appearances.

\* SEC teams can also boast of 120 # 1 rankings in the AP Poll.

\* The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three last season and in week eight in 1989.

\* A nation-leading eight SEC teams were ranked at one point in the AP and CNN/USA Today Top 25 polls during the 1995-96 season. The league mirrored that feat during the 1996-97 season.
