An outstanding hitter, will get some DH opportunities and some time in left field ... Pitched for Chatham A's in Cape Cod Baseball League over the summer.

2009 – Selected by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 46th round of the 2009 MLB Draft ... 3-for-4 with two runs scored, two RBI and homer in win over George Mason (5/29) ... Pinch-hit RBI double in 5-4 loss to Vanderbilt at SEC Tournament (5/21) ... Hurlled 2.2 scoreless innings of relief and struck out six batters while allowing just one hit in 9-5 win over Alabama at SEC Tournament (5/20) ... 2-for-3 with a run scored in 7-4 win vs. Georgia (5/15) ... 

OUTLOOK – Got a lot of innings as a true freshman ... Tremendous competitor ... Looking to cut down on his walks from a year ago ... May possibly be used out of bullpen but may be back in rotation like last year.

2009 – Named to SEC All-Freshman team ... Quality start in loss vs. LSU at SEC Tournament, allowed just two runs on five hits in six innings of work (5/22) ... Earned win vs. Georgia hurling 6.1 innings and allowing one run, unearned, on three hits with a career-high 11 strikeouts in 7-4 victory (5/15) ... Picked up win vs. Vanderbilt, allowed five runs on six hits in 7.1 innings of work with five strikeouts and three walks (5/2) ... Hurled first career complete game in 8-1 win at Ole Miss, allowed just one run on eight hits, struck out eight batters (4/11) ... Hurled 8.1 innings, allowed just one run on four hits in 9-1 victory over Arkansas (4/4), struck out career-high 9 batters ... Had 5.2 innings of work at Kentucky (3/28), limited Wildcats to one run on four hits ... 5.2 innings of relief allowing four runs on seven hits with six strikeouts in 10-3 loss to Mississippi State (3/14) ... Started against Duquesne (2/22) and went four-plus innings allowing one run on two hits with four strikeouts and four walks in 8-4 victory ... Named to 2009 SEC Freshmen Academic Honor Roll.

HIGH SCHOOL – Compiled a career record of 47-2 with 516 strikeouts in 282 innings in high school ... Finished his senior season with a 12-1 record, a 0.89 ERA and 142 strikeouts in 78 innings ... Also played in the outfield and batted .527 with nine doubles ... As a junior went 10-1 on the mound ... 
