The only Gamecock to play in all 47 games, Payne started 46 of those and led the

team in batting average (.348), runs scored (23), hits (55), doubles (7), triples (6) and total bases (74)...Ranked second on the team in on-base percentage (.372), slugging percentage (.468) and stolen bases (3)...Had 16 multi-hit games, most on the squad...Hit a team-best .360 with the bases empty...Also led the squad with a .318 average during SEC play, scoring 10 runs while hitting three doubles and four triples...Versatile player drew starts at second and in both corner outfield positions...Compiled an 18-game hitting streak that started with a pinch-hitting appearance against Western Carolina and ended during a perfect game in game two at No. 22/20 Georgia (2/13-3/15)...Had three hits twice during that stretch, against Cal Poly (2/15) and Wright State (2/24)...Scored runs in six straight from the Wright State game through the first game against Arkansas (2/24-3-8)...Went 2-for-3 against Florida ace Stacey Nelson in the first game in Gainesville (3/26), starting a seven-game hitting skein...Had two hits on four occasions and three hits once during that streak...Went 5-for-12 with three runs, an RBI and a triple in the series sweep at Kentucky (3/29-30)...Tripled in a 2-for-4 game while scoring two runs at Winthrop (4/2)...Ended the season on a four-game hitting streak, which included a 3-for-4 game against LSU...Picked to the SEC Softball Community Service Team...Earned a spot on the *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-District III first team and on the National Fastpitch Coaches Association All-South Region second team...Also voted onto the *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-America second team.
