

2008 Season In Review

After a stunning run to the program's first NCAA Super Regional appearance in 2007, the 2008 Gamecocks came into the season with high expectations. Head coach Joyce Compton scheduled according to that thought, playing one of the 10 toughest schedules in the country, that ranking coming even with four games against eventual NCAA Tournament participants being washed out during the season. A rough start for Carolina was followed by a nice rebound, but all dreams came to a crashing halt towards the end of the campaign.

The Garnet and Black started the season for the second-consecutive year in a tournament at Florida Atlantic, but the results were not the same from 2007. The team captured the first game against North Florida, thanks to a bases-clearing double from senior Lisa Longo. But the squad then fell to the host Owls in the second game of opening day. Heartache continued after a 2-0 defeat against UMass and a lost opportunity when

No. 12 Michigan came from behind with three runs in the seventh to defeat the Gamecocks, 3-2, on Saturday. Sunday's rematch against the Ospreys proved to be a roller coaster for emotions. After being no-hit for six innings, the squad broke through to tie the game at 2-2 on Jacqueline Wetherbee's pinch-hit single. But UNF scored in its half of the eighth while Carolina could not.

The squad returned to Columbia and took out its frustrations on Western Carolina, taking a 3-0 victory over the Cata-mounts in the home opener. The group then traveled to Sin City to take part in the UNLV Louisville

Sluggo Desert Classic. A 6-2 loss to No. 10 UCLA opened the tournament, but the Gamecocks rebounded with an 8-3 beating of Cal Poly. Saturday's action was rough on South Carolina, as it fell to ninth-ranked Oklahoma and to Oregon in a rematch of the championship games from the Columbia Regional a year before. The trip ended on a positive note when freshman Laura Mendes hit her first career home run against Cal State Northridge, driving in all three runs in the 3-2 win.

The USF Louisville Sluggo Tournament was next, and the Gamecocks got two 1-0 victories on opening day over Georgia Tech and Wisconsin. A rainstorm washed out a scheduled contest against the host Bulls, and the weather played a part in the team's 7-4 loss to Hofstra. A 6-0 thumping of Wright State brought Carolina to just one game under .500 before its final non-conference weekend of the season.

The Carolina Classic pitted the Gamecocks against Bucknell and Gardner-Webb, and the pitching staff starred throughout the weekend. The Bison scored the only run off the hosts of the tournament to force extra innings in the first game, but Wetherbee came through again off the bench to give Carolina the 2-1 win. The Gamecocks then followed with three consecutive shutouts from senior Melissa Hendon, redshirt-freshman Krystle Robinson and senior Kate Pouliot, with Pouliot capping the weekend with a five-inning no-hitter in the rematch against Bucknell.

Riding the momentum into the opening weekend of Southeastern Conference play, the Gamecocks took on a surprising Arkansas club that

took then-No. 1 Arizona State to its limit the previous weekend. South Carolina got a 5-4, come-from-behind victory in game one against the Lady'Backs, as Mendes and senior Jessica Josker got RBI hits in the seventh for the victory. Arkansas came back to take game two, 3-2, before Melissa Hendon shut the Western Division foes down for a 4-0 win.

After a good start to the conference slate, Carolina looked to continue that with a trip to No. 22/20 Georgia. But the Bulldogs had other plans, as they swept the Gamecocks out of Athens. The Garnet and Black scored the first run of the series before Georgia shut down their bats. Kate Gaskill tossed a perfect game in the second game, while four Carolina errors in the final contest ended that one early in an 8-0 UGA win.

Next on the schedule were the two mid-week SEC doubleheaders, both coming against top-10 teams in Tennessee and Florida. The first scheduled contest against the Lady Vols turned into one that needed nine innings for Tennessee to take a 2-0 win while the second ended an inning short of the five required to be considered official thanks to heavy rain in the Columbia area. The double-dip in Gainesville saw the Gators take a 6-0 win in game one and a 1-0 victory in the second. Hendon pitched brilliantly in the loss to Tennessee and the second game against Florida, allowing just two earned runs in the defeats.

A trip to the Bluegrass State came next for the Gamecocks, and it was just what the doctor ordered for a club on a six-game losing streak. Becky Martinez cleared the bases with a double to lead Carolina to a 5-3 victory in game one over Kentucky, while Mendes capped a four-run seventh to hand the Garnet and Black a 4-3 victory in game two. The final game saw the Gamecocks get on top and not look back, taking an 8-1 win.

The momentum continued with a 6-3, mid-week victory at Winthrop that saw Cagney Davis and Laura Mendes hit home runs in the contest. Rain cost Carolina a chance at a three-game sweep of Auburn; however, the Gamecocks took care of business in a doubleheader against the Tigers with 2-0 and 3-2 victories on Sunday, running the season-best winning streak to six games in front of a regional television audience on FOX Sports Net.

Jill Semento's grand slam at Coastal Carolina pushed the skein to seven in a 6-2 win. The Gamecocks then concentrated on SEC play the rest of the way, starting the final stretch of the season with a 7-7 SEC record against Mississippi State. The Bulldogs halted Carolina's winning streak with a 1-0 win in game one and came back with a 3-1 victory in game two. Looking to salvage the third game of the series, the Gamecocks instead fell, 9-1, against the Dogs.

The road got tougher immediately, as the schedule-makers sent the Gamecocks to Tuscaloosa for a date against No. 1 Alabama. The Crimson Tide won the first two games via the run rule, 8-0, before taking Sunday's game, 6-0.

Despite the six-game losing streak, the Gamecocks were still in position to make the SEC Tournament. A win at Mississippi would eliminate the Rebels from tournament consideration, while Carolina needed a combination of wins and Arkansas losses that totaled six to secure their berth. But the Rebels had other plans, taking a 2-1 win in nine innings in game

one of the series before a 3-0 triumph in game two. Weather did not make Sunday's game look very promising, but the Rebels, needing that victory to make their chances better to go to Baton Rouge, moved the start time up before it was pushed back by the first batch of storms. The game started, and the Red and Blue got a run in the first on a passed ball. In the top of the sixth, sophomore Lindsay Walker led off with a single. The rain, falling since the start of the game, picked up just a bit, and the umpiring crew halted the contest immediately. A four-hour wait did not bring any relief from the skies or from the Ole Miss field crew, as the Rebels got the rain-shortened victory.

Carolina still had its chance to advance into the post-season, but it would need two wins over No. 15/16 LSU at home to do so. After a 5-3 loss in the first game, the Garnet and Black got a 4-3 win in the second game to make Senior Day count. However, LSU would come out firing, getting three runs in the first before finishing off the contest in six innings with a 9-0 triumph. The loss kept South Carolina home for the post-season for just the second time in the 12-year history of SEC softball.

Redshirt senior Chrissy Schoonmaker, who came back after a broken neck cost her the 2007 season, picked up a spot on the first SEC All-Defensive Team at second base. Mendes garnered selection on the SEC All-Freshman Team, while junior Ashton Payne collected three postseason honors. Payne was the South Carolina representative on the SEC Softball Community Service Team and a second-team National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) All-South Region member. Hendon joined Payne on the *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-District squads, with Payne gaining access to the national ballot via her first-team selection. Hendon made the second team in the district, behind first-team selections Stacey Nelson of Florida and Angela Tincher of Virginia Tech. Payne went on to reap *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-America accolades, garnering a spot on the second team.

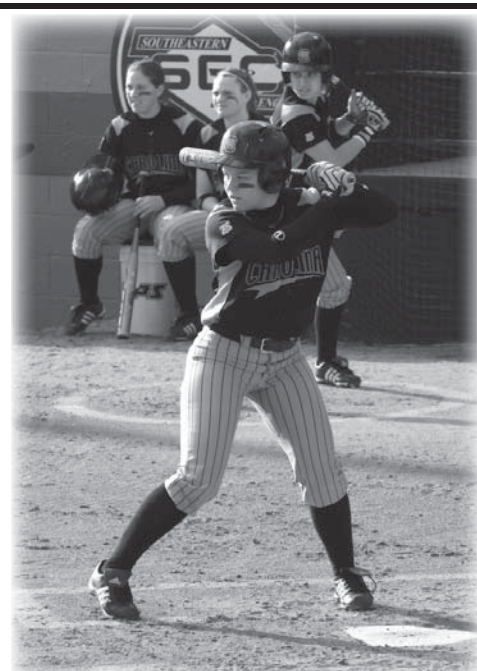
