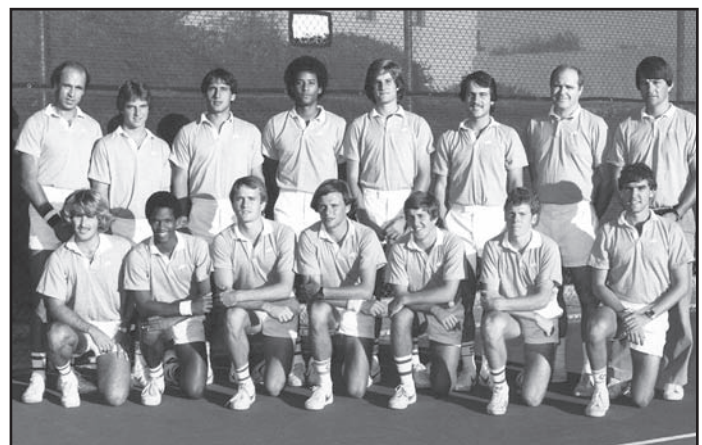

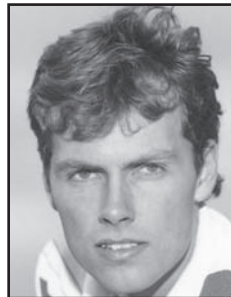
# GAMECOCK ALL-AMERICANS

## BOBBY HEALD ▶ 1968



Bobby Heald became the first ever Gamecock All-American in 1968 after compiling a 26-1 singles record. Heald was 67-6 for his career. He led the 1968 team to an ACC Championship and a 22-0 season record. During Heald's career, the Gamecocks compiled a 57-6 dual match record. Currently, Heald is the Manager of Tennis Operations at MacGregor Downs Country Club in Cary, N.C.

## JAN SANDBERG ▶ 1985



Jan Sandberg became the first Gamecock to earn All-America honors under head coach Kent DeMars as a freshman in 1985. Sandberg reached the NCAA singles round of 32 and helped South Carolina to its first NCAA berth under DeMars that season. He was ranked as high as No. 3 in the ITA tennis poll during his three-year career and earned All-Metro Conference honors in 1987.

## CHRIS MAYOTTE ▶ 1977-78



Chris Mayotte was a two-time All-American in singles and doubles at South Carolina. Mayotte also received the 1979 Rafael Osuna Award, signifying outstanding sportsmanship, character, scholastic achievement and tennis playing accomplishments. He advanced to the quarterfinals of the NCAA Doubles Championships with teammate Arthur Anastopoulo in 1978 and also helped USC make its first appearance in the NCAA team tournament.

## KEN DILLER ▶ 1987, 1989



Ken Diller was a two-time All-American at South Carolina, accomplishing the feat in both 1987 and 1989. Diller compiled a 33-16 singles record and a 26-12 mark in doubles during his junior season in 1987. As a senior, Diller led USC to a win over No. 1 UCLA and a berth in the NCAA Semifinals. He also advanced to the NCAA singles semifinal and quarterfinal rounds during two seasons at UCLA.

## ARTHUR ANASTOPOULO ▶ 1978



Arthur Anastopoulo earned All-America honors in doubles in 1978 after reaching the NCAA quarterfinals. He also led South Carolina to its first ever NCAA team tournament appearance that season. He compiled a 93-25 singles mark, which ranks him 13th on USC's career singles list. In doubles, he posted a 69-29 record, which ranks him 10th among USC's career doubles leaders. Anastopoulo played in the Davis Cup for Greece after graduating from USC in 1980.

## STEPHANE SIMIAN ▶ 1989-90



Stephanie Simian was a two-time singles All-American (1989, 1990) and 1989 doubles All-American. Simian ranked as high as No. 5 in the ITA Tennis Rankings during his career. He led the Gamecocks to the 1989 NCAA Semifinals. Simian also captured the Metro singles title at the No. 2 position as a junior and at No. 1 as a senior. As a senior, Simian reached the semifinals of the ITA All-America Championships and won 12 consecutive matches while posting 49 total singles victories and reaching the NCAA Tournament Round of 32 in 1989. Simian qualified for the 1991 U.S. Open and reached the third round before falling to defending champion Pete Sampras in four sets in his rookie season on the tour. He also reached the third round of the 1992 Australian Open before falling to Sweden's Christian Bergstrom.

## LOU GLORIA ▶ 1991



Lou Gloria earned All-America honors in 1991 with a 27-7 singles mark, despite missing all but two dual matches due to a stress fracture. He was the Champion of Milwaukee Classic, Rolex South Atlantic Regional, and USC Region II Fall Invitational during the 1990-91 season. Gloria advanced to the round of 32 at the 1990 NAAs before losing to Stanford's Jonathan Stark. He also participated in the 1990 NCAA doubles tournament. As a sophomore, he won the Metro Conference singles championship at the No. 5 position. Gloria posted a career record of 100-49, a mark that ranks him sixth on USC's all-time singles victory list. He is also eighth on the career doubles victory list with a 64-25 record. Gloria was ranked as high as No. 177 in the world.

## GUILAME LEGAT ▶ 2001



Guillame Legat capped his senior season with ITA No. 4 final ranking, the highest in school history, on his way to earning All-America honors. Legat also advanced to the semifinals at the NCAA Championship that season, further than anyone in school history. He capped his senior season a 26-7 record that included 17 wins over ranked opponents. A four-time All-SEC selection (first team in 1999 & 2001; second team in 1998 & 2000), Legat collected 115 career victories as a Gamecock. He was 11-0 in SEC dual matches while playing in the No. 1 position as a senior. A three-time SEC Academic Honor Roll member, Legat was also the NCAA Region II Senior Player of the Year in 2001.

## JOHAN SANDBERG ▶ 1994



Johan Sandberg became the first Gamecock to earn All-SEC honors and the eighth individual to earn All-American honors in 1994. He was also the first Gamecock to defeat an opponent ranked No. 1 in the nation (Laurent Orsini of Mississippi State, 7-5, 4-6, 6-3). Sandberg set a school record for SEC singles wins (13). He defeated 12 of the 20 nationally ranked opponents he faced in 1993-94 and participated in the 1994 NCAA Singles Championship. He also achieved the highest doubles ranking in school history (fifth, Fall 1993). Sandberg compiled a 54-46 career singles record and 42-30 career doubles mark. He was a three-time member of the SEC Academic Honor Roll while at South Carolina. He also earned 23 ATP points during the summer of 1994.

## SETH ROSE ▶ 2003



Seth Rose earned All-America honors in singles as a senior in 2003. Rose participated in the NCAA Tournament twice, advancing to the Round of 16 in 2003 after defeating sixth-ranked Janne Holmia of Florida. He was selected the 2000 Region II Rookie of the Year, making him a finalist for National Freshman of the Year 2000. Rose garnered All-SEC honors in 2002 and 2003. He was also a four-time SEC Academic Honor Roll recipient.
