SEASON IN REVIEW



GAMECOCK WOMEN'S TENNIS

After an injury-plagued 2005-06 season that left the Gamecocks just above .500 at season's end, head coach Arlo Elkins' troops rebounded with a strong effort the following year. Even though the campaign did not end the way South Carolina had envisioned it, there were several positives to take away from 2006-07.

South Carolina's fall season was headlined by its lone newcomer Ana Marija Zubori, who finished with a 13-2 record. She began her career with seven straight wins, winning her flight at the Furman Fall Classic and then reaching the final of the top draw at the USTA National Tennis Center Invitational. She added another title when the Gamecocks hosted their annual Southern Intercollegiate Championships at the end of October.

A pair of seniors produced the best falls of their careers with Laura Ganzer's 9-4 singles record and Miranda Gutierrez's 12-4 mark. Ganzer won her singles flight at the Southern Intercollegiates, as did Gutierrez. Ganzer also reached the final of her flight at the Furman tournament and Gutierrez ended her fall with three straight victories at the SEC Fall Coaches Classic after losing in the first round.

Doubles play was a concern for the Gamecocks heading into the fall after dropping seven consecutive doubles points during the spring in dual matches. Elkins' decision to focus on doubles play throughout fall practice paid dividends, as Ganzer and junior Megan McGavock combined for an 8-1 record while Schofield and Zubori went 6-1. The Ganzer/McGavock combination ended on a seven-match unbeaten streak that included titles at the Southern Intercollegiates and the SEC Fall Coaches Classic. Schofield and Zubori won their first six contests together before suffering a loss in the title match at the SEC event to end the year.

To begin the spring season, the Gamecocks posted five straights wins with four of them coming in 7-0 sweeps. Between the five, South Carolina won a combined 42 singles and doubles matches while surrendering just three. A 6-1 triumph over East Tennessee State at home on the indoor courts began the streak that continued against the likes of Furman, Winthrop, Davidson and South Carolina State.

Carolina's first major test of the season came in late February with back-to-back road matches against N.C. State and intrastate-rival Clemson. Unfortunately for the Gamecocks, neither match ended in their favor. They were short-handed versus the Wolfpack since Zubori was still recovering from an ankle sprain she sustained earlier in the week during practice. Sophomore Natasa Vuckovic scored South Carolina's lone point of the match, a three-set victory over Catherine Grotz at the No. 2 singles position. She and senior Christyn Lucas also won their doubles match at the top slot against Alejandra Guerra and Daria Petrovic.

Zubori returned to the lineup for doubles in the Clemson match, but her absence in singles did not help the Gamecocks' chances against the 12th-ranked Tigers. South Carolina suffered a 5-2 loss, winning the second and fifth singles positions. Schofield nearly snagged a victory against Clemson's highly touted freshman Ani Mijacika at the top spot, losing in three sets 4-6, 6-3, 7-5.

With a disappointing weekend behind them, the Gamecocks rebounded with a 6-1 thrashing of Marshall on Feb. 28. It was a big day for Schofield, as she began the match with an 8-3 win over No. 27 Lynzee Kever and Kellie Schmitt in doubles and then upended Schmitt, ranked 27th at the time, by scores of 6-4, 6-2.

Mississippi State and Ole Miss represented South Carolina's first Southeastern Conference opponents of the season in Columbia, S.C., on March 2 and 4. State entered the match with just five healthy players, putting the Bulldogs in an immediate 1-0 hole. The Gamecocks cruised in doubles to make the score 2-0 and then lost no more than three games in any of the five singles matches on their way to an 18th consecutive victory over MSU. Ole Miss did not fare much better against South Carolina two days later, as the Gamecocks recorded their sixth sweep of the year.

Next on the agenda were visits to Eastern Division foes Georgia and Tennessee. Even though the No. 3 Bulldogs won 5-2, South Carolina hung in the match the entire way. The doubles matches were very competitive, with USC winning the No. 1 match, and Zubori nearly won her singles match at the third slot versus Yvette Hyndman, losing 7-5 in the third. Vuckovic managed one of the top victories of her career with a 7-5, 6-3 decision against Darya Ivanov, a player ranked in the top 50 in the nation.

The Gamecocks moved on from their loss to Georgia knowing they could compete with any team in the league. The Lady Volunteers, traditionally one of the SEC's top four teams, held a No. 16 national ranking when Carolina traveled to Knoxville, Tenn., a place in which the Gamecocks had only won once before. Ignoring history, South Carolina grinded out a 4-2 win that was clinched by Ganzer's 6-4, 0-6, 6-4 win at No. 6 singles versus Zsofia Zubor. It also marked the Gamecocks' first win over UT since 2002 and ended a four-match skid to the Lady Vols.

A couple of non-conference matches over spring break against College of Charleston and Troy added two more victories to USC's total and pushed its overall record to 11-3. The Gamecocks returned to SEC play the following weekend at LSU and Arkansas. After escaping from Baton Rouge, La., with a 4-3 win, South Carolina crushed the Lady Razorbacks 7-0 to move to 5-1 in the league and stay in the hunt for the SEC title.

In its next home match, Carolina had to face an Auburn team that came in having recently defeated Georgia, then the No. 1-ranked team in the land. Ganzer and McGavock clinched the doubles point for the Gamecocks at the third position after the two teams split at one and two. South Carolina closed out the match with three straight-set victories by Schofield, Vuckovic and Ganzer to go ahead 4-0, but the Tigers came back to win the final three matches left on court.

South Carolina entered the top 25 for the first time the next week following the Auburn win and a 7-0 sweep of Alabama, checking in at No. 22 with a 15-3 record and a 7-1 mark in the SEC. With one home match remaining against Kentucky, the Gamecocks had a chance to accomplish many things in their next match: a perfect 11-0 record at home, a first-round SEC Tournament bye and win at least eight league matches for just the second time since first playing in the conference in 1992.

The Wildcats owned a five-match winning streak over Carolina, last losing

to the Gamecocks in 2001. South Carolina fell behind the Wildcats early after a closely contested doubles point in which every match ended in an 8-6 score. Zubori countered for the Gamecocks with a 6-3, 6-3 win over Kim Coventry at the No. 2 position and a victory by Ganzer at the bottom of the lineup made the score 2-all. UK and USC split the next two matches to finish, setting up a 3-3 tie with the deciding match coming between McGavock and Jessica Giuggioli on court five. McGavock dropped the first set but stormed back to win 6-0 in the second and fought her way to a 6-4 win in the third, propelling USC to its eighth consecutive win.

In control of their own destiny, the Gamecocks had a chance to win their first SEC title if they closed out the regular season with wins at Vanderbilt and Florida. The season did not end that way, however, as South Carolina dropped a 5-2 decision to the Commodores and then suffered a 4-1 setback to the Gators. Still, the Gamecocks held the fourth seed for the SEC Tournament and more importantly would not have to play on the first day of the event.

Fifth-seeded Tennessee took care of business against No. 12 seed Alabama in the first round in Lexington, Ky., to set up a rematch against Carolina. The Gamecocks appeared to be in control of the doubles point despite losing at No. 3 doubles up 7-3 and 5-3 at the top two spots, but the Lady Vols clawed their way back into both contests. Blakeley Griffith and Samantha Orlin ended up defeating Lucas and Vuckovic at two to win the point while Caitlin Whoriskey and Zubor were actually leading 8-7 when their match with Schofield and Zubori was suspended. In singles, the match came down to Schofield and Griffith on court one after the score was tied 3-3, and Griffith came away with a 7-5 victory in the third.

A week and a half later, South Carolina learned it would head to Coral Gables, Fla., to face Wichita State in the first round of its 13th consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance. The news was met with much delight for Gutierrez, Lucas, McGavock and Schofield, as all four players hailed from the Sunshine State. It was especially good for Lucas, a native of Miami, and Schofield, a native of nearby Boca Raton. While a potential second-round match with host Miami provided a good storyline, the Gamecocks faced a real challenge in Wichita State, a team with a 26-2 record.

Losing the doubles point for the fifth straight match proved to be South Carolina's undoing again. Zubori, Vuckovic and Gutierrez responded quickly for the Gamecocks with easy victories in singles, but Lucas and Schofield were both trailing in their matches when USC went ahead 3-1. Following losses for both players, court four's contest between Ganzer and Stephanie Dalmacio became the deciding factor. Ganzer had won the first set but could not come away with a win in the second, a 12-10 tiebreak victory for Dalmacio. In the third, Ganzer led 3-2 before Dalmacio ran off three games in row before finally winning 6-4.

Although four straight losses were not the ending South Carolina had in mind, the Gamecocks' 16-7 record was still their most wins since posting 17 in 2002 and their 8-3 SEC slate was the second best in school history. Carolina also had three All-SEC honorees with Schofield, Vuckovic and Zubori, who would all return the following year along with fellow starter McGavock.
