## 2007 GAMECOCK SOFTBALL

### 2006 Season Review

Gamecock softball saw many ups and downs in its 2006 campaign. Dealing with numerous injuries throughout the season, the Garnet and Black suffered its first losing season since 1984, missed the SEC Tournament for the first time ever, and for the second year in a row, missed the NCAA Tournament.

The Gamecocks opened the season with a 3-2 record at the FAU Tournament where they finished as the runner-up, before going 2-2 at the Florida State Tournament. After winning five of their next six games, USC took a 12-5 record into the Tar Heel Invitational and recorded five more wins to capture the tournament title. Freshman Jacqueline Wetherbee was named tournament MVP and McKenna Hughes and Christie Hamilton were named to the all-tournament team. Wetherbee's efforts earned her SEC Freshman of the Week honors, the second of the year for South Carolina. Ashton Payne first brought home the honors just the week prior for her efforts at the Gamecock Invitational. The Gamecocks went a perfect 5-0 at the Tar Heel tournament to compile a nine-game win streak, the longest of the season.

The Gamecocks took a 17-5 record into SEC action. South Carolina opened conference play on the road at No. 6 Alabama, only to get swept by the Tide 3-0. USC picked up its first conference win in its next series when they won game one against Kentucky. Unfortunately, that would be the only win for USC in the series as the Wildcats took the next two to claim the series for the first time since 2001.

The challenge did not get any easier for South Carolina as four of its next five opponents would be ranked in the Top 25. In that stretch, the Gamecocks went 3-10, including an eight-game losing streak.

The streak was snapped when the Gamecocks swept Arkansas in a doubleheader and recorded their first conference series win of the season. After the Arkansas victories, the Gamecocks stumbled once again as they were swept 3-0 by No. 6/4 Tennessee, who eventually advanced to the finals of the World Series.

Despite the struggles, the Gamecocks continued to play with their heads up. USC bounced back by taking their next two series, defeating Ole Miss and No. 19 Auburn. The Tigers were the highest ranked team the Gamecocks defeated for the season. With the wins over Ole Miss and Auburn, USC's chances of advancing to the SEC Tournament were still alive. With just one series left to play, the Gamecocks entered their meeting against the Florida Gators one game above .500. They needed to claim at least two games against the Gators to make the hopes of the SEC Tournament a reality. USC traveled to Gainesville and fought hard but the Gators kept the Gamecocks at bay and denied them any chances of postseason play as they swept USC 3-0.

South Carolina completed the year 28-30 and 8-21 in SEC play. The Gamecocks look forward to turning the corner with high anticipation for the 2007 season. The 2006 season was a year of growing pains for the Gamecocks, but behind pain, there lies the potential for even greater success.

## 2007 GAMECOCK SOFTBALL

### The Southeastern Conference

In only its 10th year of existence, SEC softball has made a name for itself across the nation.

The Southeastern Conference qualified six teams for the 2006 NCAA Tournament - Alabama, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, LSU and Tennessee. Alabama and Tennessee both went on to represent the SEC at the Women's College World Series. It was Alabama's fourth WCWS appearance and Tennessee's second, making them two of three SEC teams with multiple WCWS appearances since softball became a conference sport. The Lady Vols would finish third in the WCWS.

The Crimson Tide claimed the regular season championship and the Western Division title, while Georgia claimed the Eastern Division crown. Tennessee won the SECTournament, defeating LSU 3-0 to capture their first SEC Tournament Championship.

Trailing only the Pac-10, the SEC tied a record number six teams for the 2000 NCAA Softball Tournament. LSU, Arkansas, Mississippi State, Alabama, Florida and SEC Tournament Champion South Carolina all made the field of 48.

The sport came under the auspices of the Southeastern Conference in the 1996-97 season. Since that time, nine different conference teams have made appearances in the NCAA Championship, including three Women's College World Series berths - one by South Carolina in the inaugural season, Alabama in 2000 and LSU in 2001. LSU reached the semifinals in 2001 and finished the season ranked third nationally. In 1999, four teams earned bids to postseason, the second most by any conference.

Eight teams (Alabama, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, LSU, Mississippi State, South Carolina and Tennessee) have made Top 25 appearances and four teams have climbed into the Top 10 (Alabama, Georgia, LSU and Tennessee) of the NFCA/USA Today Poll. At least one SEC team has been ranked in the poll each week since the inception of SEC Softball. In 1999 alone, SEC teams made 29 appearances in the poll.

South Carolina is the flagship team of the league with a rich history in softball dating back 28 seasons. The Gamecocks have made 11 NCAA Regional and three Women's College World Series appearances.

Mississippi State played softball for five seasons during the 1980's before resuming the sport when it was added to the SEC. Tennessee added softball in 1995-96, one year before its inception in the SEC. Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU and Ole Miss began softball programs in 1996-97 to give the league 11 representatives (Vanderbilt does not sponsor softball).

The 1999 season was the first in which the conference was eligible for an automatic berth to the NCAA Championships.

In its first six seasons, the SEC has watched its newest sport gain in competitiveness and popularity. Two different teams have won the SEC regular season title as well as the tournament title. South Carolina has won both once and LSU has won both three times.

#### 2006 SEC Tournament

The 2007 SEC Tournament will be hosted by Auburn University at Jane B. Moore Field in Auburn, Ala., May 10-12. The tournament moved to campus sites in 2004, so this marks the first time the Tigers have hosted the postseason event.

The tournament will consist of the top eight teams playing in a single-elimination format over a span of three days. The winner of the tournament will not only capture the tournament title, but will also receive an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

Seeding will be determined as follows: the conference regular season champion will be seeded No. 1 overall and the rest of the tournament will be seeded 2-8, regardless of division, based on conference winning percentage at the conclusion of regular season play.
