The Southeastern Conference, with its storied 77year history of athletic achievements and academic excellence, has built perhaps the greatest tradition of intercollegiate competition of any league in the country since its inception in 1933.

The 2009-10 academic year was another season to remember for the SEC, as conference teams captured four national titles and four national runner-up finishes. The SEC has won consecutive national championships in baseball and football. Since 1990, the SEC has won 135 national team championships for an average of more than six per year.
Alabama won the SEC's first national title of the year with its win in the BCS National Championship Game in football. It is the SEC's fourth consecutive football national title. Florida captured its second women's swimming and diving national championship. Florida also won its first championship in men's indoor track and field. South Carolina won the national championship in the sport of baseball. Florida finished second overall in the final Director's Cup standings.
Overall, the SEC finished in the top two in nine of its 20 sponsored sports and in the top five in 14 of the 20 sports. Ten SEC teams participated in football postseason bowls, with Alabama, Florida, Mississippi, Arkansas, Auburn and Georgia winning the BCS National Title Game, Sugar, Cotton, Liberty, Outback, and Independence bowls, respectively. Four men's basketball teams and seven women's basketball teams were invited to their respective NCAA Tournaments. The SEC had eight teams advance to postseason play in baseball, hosting four regionals, with South Carolina and Florida advancing to the College World Series. With 145 teams

## SEC Softball

Southeastern Conference Softball will celebrate its 15th year of existence in 2011 and has established itself as one of the leading conferences in the sport.
The SEC qualified seven teams for the 2010 NCAA Tournament - Alabama, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU and Tennessee, as the conference made its 13 th overall, and eighth consecutive, Women's College World Series appearance. For the third straight year, an SEC team received the No. 1 national seed, as the Alabama Crimson Tide coveted the honor in 2010. Overall, five teams earned national seeds: No. 1 Alabama, No. 4 Florida, No. 6 Georgia, No. 12 LSU and No. 15. Tennessee.

The SEC advanced three teams to Oklahoma City: Florida, Georgia and Tennessee while Georgia and Tennessee advanced to the semifinals.

Alabama won the 2010 conference title as they posted a 23-4 SEC record, marking their second title in school history. It was quite the year for the Tide as they posted a 52-11 overall record and swept league honors. Pat Murphy was named Coach of the Year while Kelsi Dunne earned Pitcher of the Year honors and Charlotte Morgan defended her Player of the Year title. Kayla Braud was named Co-Freshman of the Year along with LSU's Rachele Fico and Tennessee's Kat Dotson. Arkansas' Jessica Bachkora was selected as Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

Softball came under the auspices of the Southeastern Conference in the 1996-97 academic year. Since that time, 10 different conference teams have made appearances in the NCAA Championship, including six teams earning Women's College World Series berths one by South Carolina in the inaugural season, Alabama
advancing to NCAA postseason competition, the SEC continued to solidify its place as the nation's premier conference.

In addition to the four team championships, 41 SEC student-athletes garnered individual national championships, while 440 individuals were awarded with FirstTeam All-America honors. Student-athletes around the league continued to excel in the classroom as well, with more than 2,300 earning recognition on the SEC Academic Honor Roll.

On the national all-sport level, 11 SEC schools placed in the top 60 of the NACDA Director's Cup rankings. Florida led the league with a second place finish. Tennessee placed 16th while LSU was 19th; Georgia finished 20th, Alabama 23rd, Auburn 26th, Kentucky 29th, South Carolina 41st, Arkansas 46th, Ole Miss 56th and Vanderbilt 59th to round out the league's top-60 finishes.

Already, the SEC has added to its national championship total in the 2010-11 academic year. Auburn captured the BCS National Championship Game in Glendale, Ariz., giving the league its fifth straight crown. Ten SEC teams made bowl appearances, as Alabama, Florida, Mississippi State and LSU joined the national champion Tigers as bowl winners in the Capital One, Outback, Gator and Cotton Bowls, respectively.

The league's volleyball got a boost, as Florida held a No. 1 ranking for eight straight weeks and earned the top seed in the NCAA Tournament. Six SEC teams earned NCAA bids in volleyball, while three teams made the 2010 women's soccer field, led by No. 2 overall seed Florida.
in 2000, 2003, 2005, 2006, 2008 and 2009, Florida in 2008, 2009 and 2010, Georgia in 2009 and 2010, LSU in 2001 and 2004 and Tennessee in 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2010.

Eight teams (Alabama, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, LSU, Mississippi State, South Carolina and Tennessee) have made Top 25 appearances and six teams have climbed into the Top 10 (Alabama, Florida, Georgia, LSU, South Carolina and Tennessee) of the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA)/USA Today Poll. At least one SEC team has been ranked in the poll each week since the inception of SEC Softball.

South Carolina is the longest standing program of the league with a rich history in softball dating back 36 seasons. The Gamecocks have made 15 NCAA Regional and three Women's College World Series appearances.

The Mississippi State Bulldogs played softball for five seasons during the 1980's before resuming the sport when it was added to the SEC. Tennessee added softball in 199596, one year before its inception in the SEC. Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU and Mississippi began softball programs in 1996-97 to give the league 11 representatives (Vanderbilt does not sponsor softball).

The 1999 season was the first in which the conference was eligible for an automatic berth to the NCAA Championships.

As the sport continues to grow in competitiveness and popularity, the SEC has had six different regular season champions and five different conference tournament champions.

## Postseason Tournaments

The 2011 Southeastern Conference Tournament will be held over May 12-14 at Ole Miss Softball Complex on the campus of the University of Mississippi. This will be the eighth year that the tournament has been staged at a campus site and marks the first time the Rebels have hosted the event.

The single-elimination tournament will be held over the span of three days and will consist of the top eight teams regardless of division in the league. The winner of the tournament will capture the SEC Tournament Championship and the league's automatic bid into the NCAA Tournament.

Seeding will be determined as follows: the conference reg-ular-season champion will be seeded No. 1 overall and the rest of the field will be seeded by conference winning percentage, regardless of division, at the conclusion of regular-season play.

Seeding for the tournament will be as follows: The tournament will be seeded 1-8, regardless of division, based on conference winning percentage. The bracket is subject to change based on the seed of the host school.

## 2011 NCAA Tournament \& Women's College World Series

The NCAA will select 64 teams out of the over 300 schools which sponsor Division I Softball to compete in the 2011 NCAA Tournament. Regionals will be held on 16 campus sites from May 20-22. The 16 Regional winners advance to Super Regionals, which are set for May 27-29 on campus sites. Those eight finalists move on to the Women's College World Series, scheduled for June 1-7 at the ASA Don E. Porter Hall of Fame Stadium in Oklahoma City, Okla. The WCWS format is a dou-ble-elimination tournament until six teams are eliminated. The final two squads face off in the best-of-three Championship Series on June 5-7.
The champions of 30 NCAA Division I conferences will automatically qualify for the 2011 championship. The remaining 34 teams will be selected at-large based on upon win-loss record and strength of schedule. In addition, the committee will utilized the Ratings Percentage Index (RPI) as a tool to evaluate teams. Representatives from the America East, Atlantic-10, Atlantic Coast, Atlantic Sun, Big 12, BIG EAST, Big South, Big Ten, Big West, Colonial Athletic Association, Conference USA, Horizon League, Ivy League, Metro Atlantic Athletic, Mid-American, Mid-Eastern Athletic, Missouri Valley, Mountain West, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Pacific-10, Pacific Coast Softball, Patriot League, Southeastern, Southern, Southland, Southwestern Athletic, Summit League, Sun Belt and Western Athletic Conferences each qualify by winning their leagues. This season will mark the 12th year that the SEC Tournament Champion will receive an automatic bid.
