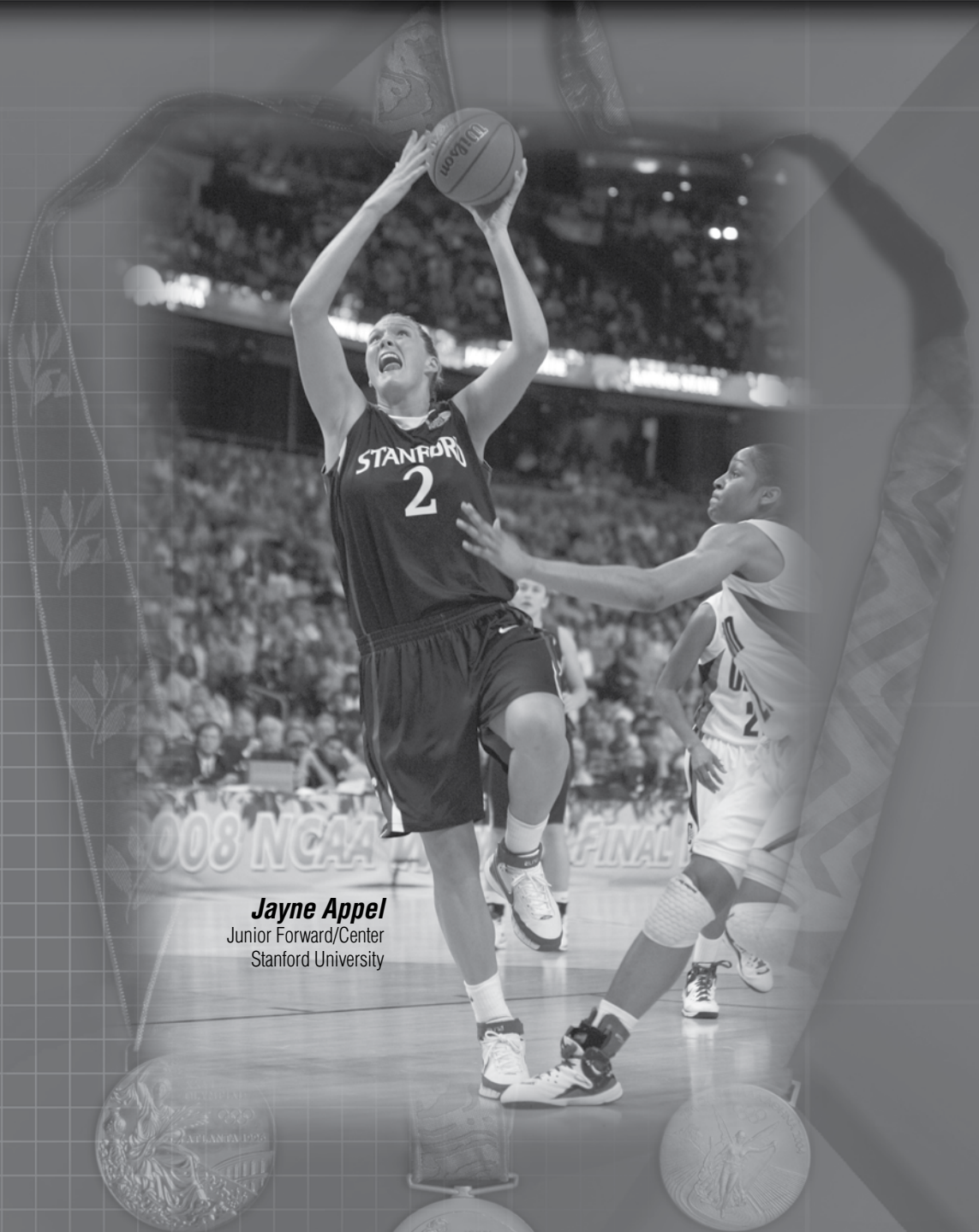

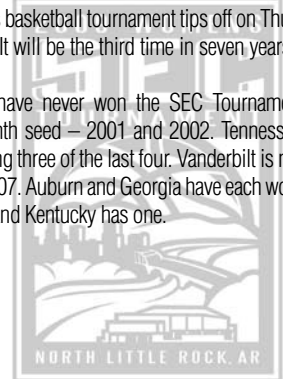

The 2009 SEC women's basketball tournament tips off on Thu., March 5, at ALLTEL Arena in North Little Rock, Ark. It will be the third time in seven years the SEC has battled for the title in North Little Rock.

The host Razorbacks have never won the SEC Tournament but have twice reached the semifinals as a seventh seed — 2001 and 2002. Tennessee leads the league with 13 tournament titles, including three of the last four. Vanderbilt is next in line with five titles, the most recent coming in 2007. Auburn and Georgia have each won the tournament four times, while LSU has two titles and Kentucky has one.

The NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament Selection Committee will announce the participants for the 2009 event on Tue., March 17.

The first two rounds of the tournament will be played March 21-24 at eight sites — Pit/ Bob King Court in Albuquerque, N.M.; Pete Maravich Assembly Center in Baton Rouge, La.; Comcast Center in College Park, Md.; Nationwide Arena in Columbus, Ohio; Arena at Gwinnett in Duluth, Ga.; United Spirit Center in Lubbock, Texas; Galen Center in Los Angeles, Calif.; and Brown Athletic Center in Piscataway, N.J.

Sites for the Regionals, which will be played March 28-31, are Haas Pavilion in Berkeley, Calif.; Ford Center in Oklahoma City, Okla.; RBC Center in Raleigh, N.C.; and Sovereign Bank Arena in Trenton, N.J.

The 2009 NCAA Final Four returns to Scottrade Center in St. Louis, Mo., on April 5 and 7. Notre Dame won the 2001 title the last time the Final Four was played there.

NIT

The Women's National Invitation Tournament includes 48 of the nation's top Division I women's basketball teams. The event features 16 first-round games, followed by 16 second-round games, eight third-round games, four quarterfinal games, two semifinal games and the championship, which is televised. The 48-team tournament is a single-elimination event with all games played at sites of host schools.

The WNIT offers 31 automatic berths, one to each conference, and 17 at-large berths. An automatic bid is offered to each conference to the team that finished the highest during the regular season and did not receive a bid to the NCAA Tournament. The 17 at-large berths are filled by the top remaining teams available, as decided by several factors. All Division I teams with overall records of .500 or better (including conference tournament player) are considered for an at-large berth. The field and bracket is announced late on the evening of the NCAA Tournament selections.
