PACK NOTES

NC State In The NCAA Tournament

The 2011 NCAA Columbia Regional will be NC State's 24th appearance in the NCAA Tournament. The Pack has played 82 NCAA Tournament games with a 35-47 record.

- » This year's regional appearance is NC State's 19th in the last 25 years, and Wolfpack's 11th in head coach Elliott Avent's 15 seasons.
- » NC State's last regional appearance was the 2010 Myrtle Beach Regional, which saw the Wolfpack fall to College of Charleston and Stony Brook.
- » NC State is 14-16 in Avent's previous 10 regional appearances, and 15-20 in NCAA play overall since Avent became head coach in 1997.

NC State vs. The Columbia Regional Field

This marks the third time in five years that NC State and South Carolina have been paired in the same regional. They also were bracketed together in the 2007 Columbia Regional and the 2008 Raleigh Regional.

NC State is 25-21 all-time vs. South Carolina, and defeated the Gamecocks twice 5-4 and 2-1 in the 2008 Raleigh Regional.

- » Clayton Shunick allowed USC two earned runs in 6 1/3 innings in a second-round matchup, and four relievers combined to pitch 2 2/3 shutout innings.
- » Dallas Pouk went 3-for-5 with a homer and two RBIs.
- » NC State won the regional the next night thanks to five shutout innings by the bullpen as Matt Payne singled home the winning run in the seventh inning.

NC State and South Carolina have played one another five times previously in the NCAA Tournament, with the Gamecocks holding a 3-2 advantage.

- » South Carolina defeated the Wolfpack 9-0 in the first round of the 1974 District 3 Tournament in Starkville, Miss.
- » The two teams met a year later in Columbia in the NCAA Atlantic Regional, with the Gamecocks eliminating NC State 4-3.
- » Ray Tanner's only ACC championship team at NC State, the 1992 Wolfpack, came face-to-face with his future in the Atlantic Regional in Coral Gables, Fla., with South Carolina defeating the Pack 9-6.

The Wolfpack is 2-1 in the all-time series vs. Stetson, including a pair of NCAA Tournament matchups.

- » NC State played defeated Stetson 11-6 during a four-game swing through Florida to begin the 1950 season.
- » The Hatters eliminated the Wolfpack from the 1988 East Regional in Tallahassee, Fla., by a 4-1 score.
- » NC State got revenge two years later by eliminating Stetson from the 1990 Atlantic Regional in Coral Gables, Fla., 13-2.

NC State is 0-2 all-time against Georgia Southern. The two teams first met in the 1974 NCAA District 3 Tournament, with the Eagles winning 8-1. The only other meeting between the two schools was an 8-6 win by GSU in 1998 in Charleston, S.C.

PACK NOTES

The Starting Pitchers

Junior righthander Cory Mazzoni (5-6, 3.61), sophomore righthander Josh Easley (0-2, 6.15) and senior righthander Rob Chamra (8-2, 4.13) are slated to start games for NC State in the NCAA Columbia Regional.

Mazzoni has received 76 runs of support in his 15 starts, 5.1 runs per game, but he received 45 of those runs, 59.2 percent, in just four starts. In Mazzoni's other 11 starts, the Wolfpack scored an average of 2.8 runs per game.

- » Entering play in the Columbia Regional, Mazzoni has not allowed a run in 16 consecutive innings, and only one earned run in his last 21 innings.
- » In his last two starts, May 25 vs. Florida State and May 20 vs. Boston College, both on four days' rest, he allowed no runs on seven hits in 15 innings, striking out 20 and walking one.
- » The Seminoles got a hit in each of the first two innings before Mazzoni retired 15 of 16 at one point, and 21 of the last 24 men he faced.
- » Mazzoni shut down Boston College on three hits through eight innings, retiring 16 of the first 17 batters he faced and 23 of 26 overall.
- » He struck out 11 BC hitters, the sixth time this season he has reached double figures in K's, tying a school record set in 1995 by Terry Harvey.
- » Mazzoni struck out 10 or more in consecutive games against Clemson, Wake Forest and Miami, and is the only NC State pitcher since at least 1977 to fan 10 or more in three consecutive games.
- » Mazzoni ranks fourth in NC State history for K's in a single season with 125, and seventh in career punchouts with 244.
- » In his last three starts — vs. Boston College, East Tennessee State and twice vs. Florida State — Mazzoni is 2-1 with a 0.91 ERA, 37 strikeouts and four walks in 29 2/3 innings.

Chamra moved into the starting rotation for good April 17 and has excelled as the Pack's No. 2 starter behind Mazzoni. He is 5-2 with a 3.40 ERA in eight starts this season, and is 4-2 with a 3.40 ERA since becoming a full-time starter.

- » On May 21 at Boston College, Chamra had a no-hitter through five innings and allowed just one run on two hits in 5 1/3 innings.
- » On April 30 vs. Maryland, he allowed three runs on six hits in eight innings.
- » In consecutive starts, both wins, vs. No. 5 North Carolina and No. 1 Virginia, Chamra allowed no earned runs on eight hits in 12 1/3 innings.
- » Chamra was 5-1 with a 3.92 ERA in nine regular-season appearances vs. ACC opponents, including six starts.
- » In four starts against teams in the top eight of the RPI — North Carolina, Virginia, Florida State and Georgia Tech — Chamra is 2-1 with a 2.57 ERA.
- » In six appearances, starts and in relief, against teams in the RPI top eight — the aforementioned four plus Clemson — he is 3-1 with a 2.79 ERA.

Easley began the season in NC State's weekend starting rotation, but pitched himself into the bullpen after posting an 8.86 ERA in six starts. He seems to have rediscovered himself over the last month, recording a save and a 2.87 ERA and 22 strikeouts in his last seven appearances, covering 15 2/3 innings.

- » Easley really started to turn it on May 6 vs. East Tennessee State, tossing two shutout innings and striking out two.
- » On May 11 at Campbell, he worked the final 3 2/3 innings and set down all 11 men he faced, seven of them on strikes, to earn his first college save.
- » The seven K's at Campbell marked a career high for Easley, eclipsing the six he fanned in a three-inning start March 9 vs. Radford.
- » In the games vs. ETSU and Campbell, he worked 5 2/3 innings and allowed no runs, one hit and one walk, and struck out nine.
- » He worked two perfect innings May 21 at Boston College, striking out three.
- » He worked three innings May 26 in NC State's 15-inning loss to Georgia Tech in the ACC Championship, allowing a run on three hits with six strikeouts and one walk.
- » In nine relief appearances in 2011, he has a 2.81 ERA in 16 innings.

Rob Chamra Vs. The Top 10

NC State took on top 10 opponents in back-to-back weekends in April — No. 5 North Carolina the weekend of April 15-17, and No. 1 Virginia a week later.

NC State won four of the six games, and of the four victories by the Wolfpack in the two series, the two most impressive pitching performances were turned in by redshirt-senior righthander Rob Chamra, who dominated the Tar Heels on April 17 at Doak Field at Dail Park, and did the same to the Cavaliers on April 23 in Charlottesville with a regional television audience watching.

- » Chamra shut out UNC on four hits for 5 1/3 innings.
- » He ran into trouble just once, in the top of the fourth, and was bailed out by center fielder Brett Williams, who made a circus catch and turned it into an inning-ending double play.
- » UVa scored a pair of unearned runs off Chamra in the first inning the following weekend, but that was all.
- » Chamra allowed no earned runs on four hits in seven innings against the nation's then-top-ranked team in Charlottesville.
- » Virginia came into the game with a 38-3 record and had All-American Danny Hultzen, who had not lost in more than a year, on the mound.
- » In the two games, Chamra pitched 12 1/3 innings and allowed two runs, both unearned, on eight hits and won both.

Counting his starts May 13 vs. No. 6 Florida State and May 26 vs. Georgia Tech — plus relief appearances March 20 at Georgia Tech and March 26 vs. Clemson — Chamra is 3-1 with a 2.79 ERA in six games, four of them starts, against teams ranked in the top 10 this season, and has held hitters to a .234 average in those six games.

- » On March 26 vs. Clemson at Doak Field at Dail Park, Chamra came out of the pen and allowed one hit in five shutout innings to pick up the win.
- » The one hit Chamra allowed was to the last man he faced, a one-out single in the eighth inning.
- » He allowed two walks and hit two batters among the first 17 men he faced, without allowing a hit.

Mazzoni In The Zone

How dominant can Wolfpack righthander Cory Mazzoni be? Once he settles into a groove, very dominant indeed. Mazz has dominated opposing batters for an extended stretch in almost every game he's pitched this season.

- » On Feb. 26 vs. No. 17 California, he retired 18 of 20 batters at one point.
- » On March 4 vs. Penn State, he set down 15 of the first 17 men he faced and 21 of the first 26.
- » On March 11 at Duke, he retired 16 of 20 Blue Devils in one stretch.
- » On March 25 vs. No. 15 Clemson, he retired 16 in a row at one point and 20 of 21.
- » On April 8 at Miami, Mazzoni retired 18 of 20 starting in the second inning.
- » On April 15 vs. No. 5 North Carolina, he mowed down 16 of 20 from the second through the seventh innings.
- » On April 23 at No. 1-ranked Virginia, he set down 15 of 16 from the third through the seventh.
- » On May 7 vs. East Tennessee State, he retired eight of the first nine men he faced, had three of four reach base, and then set down 16 of 17 before running into trouble in the ninth.
- » He retired 12 of 15 Florida State batters from the second inning through the fifth on May 15.
- » On May 20 at Boston College, he set down 16 of the first 17 BC batters, 20 of the first 22, and 23 of 26 through eight shutout innings.
- » He did it again May 25 vs. Florida State in the first round of the ACC Championship, retiring 10 straight at one point, 15 of 16, and 21 of the final 24 he faced.

PACK NOTES

Mazzoni Piling Up The K's

With nine strikeouts in seven innings May 25 vs. Florida State in the ACC Championship, Cory Mazzoni now has 125 strikeouts in 106 2/3 innings this season, 10.6 K's per nine innings, and ranks second in the ACC in strikeouts. His 125 K's rank fourth in NC State history for a single season.

- » Mazzoni has had as many or more strikeouts as innings pitched in 11 of his 15 appearances this season, including each of his last five.
- » He has whiffed 10 or more in a game six times this season, which ties the school record set by Terry Harvey in 1995.
- » Mazzoni now has 244 career strikeouts, which ranks seventh in school history.

Overman Dominates Out Of The Bullpen

NC State has had its share of dominant closers in recent years, from Jamie Walkosky and Clay Eason in the 1990s to Joey Devine, Sam Walls, Eryk McConnell and Jimmy Gillheeny the last decade. Current bullpen stopper Chris Overman appears to be the latest Wolfpack closer in that tradition.

- » Overman is 6-2 with six saves and a 2.54 ERA for the season.
- » He has appeared in 27 games and worked 46 innings, allowing 33 hits, striking out 40 and walking just seven.
- » Opponents are batting a paltry .209 against him.

Overman has been much better than those numbers suggest, however. In his first outing of the year, Feb. 19 at Elon, he got boxed around for four runs on two hits and two walks in 2 1/3 innings. Seventeen standout appearances later, on April 29 vs. Maryland, he gave up five runs on four hits in 1 2/3 innings. On May 13 vs. Florida State, he allowed two runs in one-third of an inning. Those are the only three times in 27 appearances that Overman has been knocked out of a game. Minus those three games, he has been nearly untouchable.

- » Overman is 6-1 with six saves and a 0.86 ERA in his other 24 appearances, holding opposing hitters to a .181 average.
- » He has worked 41 2/3 innings in those 24 games, allowing 25 hits, with 37 walks and four strikeouts.
- » He has not allowed a run in 20 of his other 24 appearances.

Overman emerged as the Wolfpack's main man out of the bullpen with 3 2/3 shutout innings March 22 vs. Northwestern, and was 3-1 with four saves and a 0.45 ERA in his next 10 appearances.

- » He allowed one run on 10 hits in 20 innings in those 10 games, striking out 19 and walking three.
- » Opponents batted .149 (10-for-67) against him in those 10 games.
- » He has allowed just three extra-base hits in his last 22 appearances covering 37 innings pitched.
- » In his last eight appearances, he has a 1.54 ERA with two saves

Typical for a college closer, Overman has not just been a one-inning pitcher. Several times when needed, he has worked an extended period and still dominated the opposition.

- » In 4 2/3 innings March 15 against Buffalo, he allowed a solo homer to the first man he faced, then retired the final 14 batters of the game in order, three on strikeouts, to record his third win of the season.
- » On March 22 vs. Northwestern, he allowed one hit in 3 2/3 shutout innings, retiring 10 of the 11 men he faced to pick up his fourth win.
- » He worked three innings April 2 vs. Wake Forest, allowing a hit and a walk, and retired nine of the 11 men he faced to record his second save.
- » On April 5 vs. East Carolina, he pitched 2 1/3 shutout innings, allowing a pair of hits and striking out four.
- » On May 17 vs. William & Mary, Overman worked 2 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing two hits and striking out two without allowing a walk.

Avent Now The All-Time Leader Of The Pack

NC State has had 16 head baseball coaches in a history that dates back to 1903, but current Wolfpack skipper Elliott Avent now stands atop the leaderboard for the Wolfpack.

- » Heading into this week's action in the NCAA Tournament, Avent has a 780-573 overall record in 22-plus years as a head coach, and 555-360 in 15 years at NC State.
- » Avent became the program's winningest head coach on May 9, 2010, when the Wolfpack pounded Towson 21-0.
- » Sam Esposito went 513-253 in 21 years as head coach (1967-87) and is second in school history in career victories.

PACK NOTES

NC State Comes Into The Postseason Hot

NC State began the season struggling — 10-10 after its first 20 games — but the Wolfpack is finishing the season on a roll. The Pack is 8-4 over its last 12 games, including six games against teams in the top 10 of the NCAA RPI rankings. The Wolfpack has batted a solid .288 over the last dozen games, but the name of the game for NC State in that time has been run prevention. NC State has a 2.92 ERA and a gaudy .985 fielding percentage in those 12 games.

- » The starting pitchers are 6-1 with a 2.37 ERA the last 12 games, striking out 52 and walking 16 in 64 2/3 innings while holding the opposition to a .224 average.
- » Junior righthander Cory Mazzoni has made three starts in that time and is 2-0 with a 0.43 ERA and 28 strikeouts and three walks in 21 innings, while holding opposing hitters to a .173 average.
- » Sophomore righthander Chris Overman has made seven appearances, all out of the pen, and has two saves while allowing just two runs on seven hits in 11 1/3 innings and fanning eight and walking none.
- » Freshman righthander D.J. Thomas has made six appearances, including one start, and is 1-0 with a 2.77 ERA.
- » Sophomore righthander Josh Easley has a 3.55 ERA with a save and 20 strikeouts in 12 2/3 innings.

Defensively, NC State has committed just seven errors in the 12 games — only one error in the last eight games — none by an outfielder or a catcher, and has made all the routine plays.

- » Third baseman Andrew Ciencin has two errors in the 12 games, but has handled his last 19 defensive chances without a miscue.
- » Second baseman Matt Bergquist, who started at shortstop as a freshman a year ago, has two errors in the 12 games, but also leads the infield with 35 assists and has handled his last 29 chances without an error.
- » Shortstop Chris Diaz has handled 43 defensive chances without an error over the last 12 games.
- » First baseman Harold Riggins has one error, a dropped pop-up, in 113 chances.

Offensively, NC State has scored 6.9 runs per game and is hitting .288 the last 12 games, which includes a .239 average against elite pitching by Florida State, Georgia Tech and Clemson in the ACC Championship.

- » Bergquist has hit safely in all 12 games, and his 12-game hitting streak is tied for the longest by a Wolfpack hitter this season.
- » Bergquist is hitting .348 (16-for-46) with four doubles, one homer and 11 RBIs, and he has driven in runs in seven of the 12 games.
- » Pratt Maynard is hitting .327 (16-for-49) with four doubles, two home runs, 12 runs scored and six RBIs.
- » All eight of NC State's regulars have between six and 11 RBIs during the 12 games, and seven of the eight are hitting .288 or better.

An All-ACC Season For Maynard

NC State's All-ACC catcher Pratt Maynard had a remarkably consistent 2011 campaign, batting .331 with 21 doubles, one triple, five home runs and 40 RBIs. Maynard began the season on a hot streak, going 7-for-13 with five RBIs to begin the season, and never letting his average dip below .330 the entire season.

- » Maynard has gone back-to-back games without a base hit just three times, and has never gone more than two games in a row without a hit.
- » Maynard had a team-best 12-game hitting streak from March 19 through April 5 and batted .386 (14-for-40) during the streak.
- » Maynard also has had hitting streaks of nine, seven and six games (current).
- » Maynard leads NC State with 21 doubles, five home runs (tied) a .490 slugging percentage and 45 runs scored.

Maynard Walking Up Career List

Being a selective hitter with a patient approach at the plate, Pratt Maynard draws a lot of bases on balls. He finished second in the nation a year ago with a school-record 64 walks, and while his walks are down in 2011, he still ranks second on the Wolfpack with 36 through 59 games.

- » Maynard enters play in the NCAA Columbia Regional with 131 career walks, which ranks fourth in school history.
- » Jake Weber (1995-98) and Robbie Bark are the NC State career record holders with 154 walks apiece.
- » Tom Sergio (1994-97) is third with 150 career bases on balls.

Postseason Experience

For a team that has been to the NCAA Tournament as often as NC State has, the Wolfpack does not have a roster filled with postseason veterans. Only one Wolfpack player, senior catcher Chris Schaeffer, has more than two games of postseason experience, all in 2008, and only two pitchers, righthander Vance Williams and lefthander Nick Rice, have more than two postseason innings under their belt.

- » Schaeffer, who missed the 2010 postseason with a concussion suffered in the ACC championship game, played six games in the 2008 postseason, three in the Raleigh Regional and three in the Athens Super Regional
- » Schaeffer, the only player on the current roster who played in the 2008 postseason, was 3-for-16 with a home run and two RBIs in the '08 Raleigh Regional and Athens Super Regional.
- » Of the seven current players who saw postseason action a year ago, sophomore outfielder John Gianis is the only one who batted higher than .200.
- » Gianis went 4-for-7 and scored three runs in the 2010 Myrtle Beach Regional.

Among the five pitchers on the current roster with postseason experience, Williams by far had the most success in an extended outing in relief vs. Stony Brook last season.

- » Williams pitched 5 2/3 shutout innings against the Seawolves and allowed just three hits while striking out five.
- » Ethan Ogburn followed Williams to the mound against Stony Brook and worked two scoreless innings, allowing four hits.
- » Rice worked 3 2/3 innings against College of Charleston at the Myrtle Beach Regional, and allowed two runs on four hits.
- » Grant Sasser has one inning of postseason experience, and Rob Chamra has one-third of an inning of work in the postseason.

The Defense Never Rests

Head coach Elliott Avent has called this the best defensive team he's ever coached, and NC State has played sound defense from the get-go this season. With a team fielding percentage of .976 entering the NCAA Tournament, the Wolfpack has supported its pitching with outstanding glove work. Looking just at the infield positions of catcher, first base, second base, third base and shortstop, NC State is fielding .977.

- » The Wolfpack's three catchers — Pratt Maynard, Chris Schaeffer and Danny Canela — are fielding .994 with nine passed balls.
- » The other infield positions are fielding .972, including a .969 mark from the second basemen and .978 from the shortstops.
- » NC State has not committed an error in its last five games, and has committed just one error in its last eight games, fielding .997 in those eight games.
- » The Wolfpack committed just four errors over an 11-game stretch from March 12 at Duke through March 26 vs. Clemson, and fielded .990 during those 11 games (292 putouts, 116 assists).

PACK NOTES

Run Support

In the old days, starting pitchers were judged by their won-lost record. Nowadays, with pitch counts and bullpens full of relief specialists, coaches simply ask their starting pitchers to go as deep into the game as possible and “give us a chance to win it.”

Old days or not, run support is a key component in whether a starting pitcher comes away with a “W” or an “L” and run support has not been evenly distributed for the eight Wolfpack hurlers who have made multiple starts in 2011.

- » Rob Chamra has been the biggest beneficiary, with NC State scoring 67 runs in his nine starts, an average of 7.4 runs per game.
- » In fairness to Chamra, 36 of those 67 runs, 53.7 percent, came in just three of his nine starts, meaning he got 5.2 runs per game his other six starts.
- » At the other end of the spectrum, Cory Mazzoni has gotten 76 runs of support in 15 starts, an average of 5.1 runs per game.
- » Mazzoni’s numbers are badly skewed, however, by the fact that the Pack scored 45 of those runs, 59.2 percent, in just four starts.
- » In Mazzoni’s other 11 starts, the Wolfpack scored an average of 2.8 runs per game,
- » Joining Mazzoni in the non-supported group are Danny Healey (3.6 rpg in 12 starts), D.J. Thomas (4.0 rpg in 2 starts) and Grant Sasser (5.3 rpg in 4 starts).

Mazz Forms The 3x10K Club

When Wolfpack righthander Cory Mazzoni struck out 11 Miami batters April 8 in Coral Gables, he not only set a new career high for strikeouts in an ACC game, he also reached double figures in strikeouts for the third game in a row.

- » Mazzoni struck out 10 on March 25 in a four-hit shutout of Clemson.
- » He whiffed 10 Wake Forest hitters a week later, on April 1.
- » He also fanned a career-best 13 on March 4 vs. Penn State, and struck out 12 vs. Maryland on April 29.
- » In his last nine games, Mazzoni has struck out 81 in 65 innings, an average of 11.2 K’s per nine innings.
- » Mazzoni has fanned 10 or more six times this season.

The media relations office’s records date back only to 1978, but Mazzoni is the only pitcher in that time to strike out 10 or more in three consecutive appearances. The closest anyone came during that time was Kurt Blackmon in 1998. Blackmon struck out 11, 14 and 15 in a span of three consecutive starts that year, but a relief appearance after the second of those starts snapped the 10K streak.

- » Blackmon began the streak by striking out 11 in seven innings on Feb. 25 vs. Virginia Commonwealth.
- » He followed that by fanning 14 in six innings on March 3 vs. Old Dominion.
- » Blackmon’s next appearance was in relief on March 11 vs. Appalachian State, a two-inning, two-strikeout outing.
- » Four days later, Blackmon set a career high with 15 strikeouts in a complete-game victory over Maryland.

All-Tournament Team For Mazzoni

NC State wasn’t around for the championship game of the ACC tournament last weekend, but Cory Mazzoni’s dominating start over Florida State in the tournament’s opening round made some lasting impressions. Mazzoni was the lone Wolfpack player voted to the all-tournament team.

- » Mazzoni allowed the Seminoles just four hits in seven shutout innings.
- » He struck out nine and walked just one.
- » At one point, Mazzoni retired 10 Seminoles in a row and 15 of 16.
- » He set down 21 of the final 24 Florida State batters he faced.

Hitting Streaks

NC State enters play in the 2011 NCAA Tournament with two players on significant hitting streaks. Sophomore second baseman Matt Bergquist is on a 12-game streak, which ties for the longest by the Wolfpack this season, and junior catcher Pratt Maynard has a nine-game streak.

- » Bergquist is hitting .348 (16-for-46) with four doubles, a home run, six runs scored and 11 RBIs during his streak.
- » Bergquist also had a six-game streak in late April and has hit safely in 18 of his last 21 games, batting .357.
- » Maynard is batting .314 (11-for-35) with three doubles, a homer and four RBIs in his nine-game hitting streak.

Maynard had a 12-game hitting streak snapped April 8 in the first game of the Miami series. He batted .386 (17-for-44) with two doubles, a home run, 10 walks, seven runs scored and eight RBIs during the streak.

The Wolfpack had a 10-game hitting streak earlier this season from Chris Diaz, and had other noteworthy hitting streaks from Andrew Ciencin (8 games), and Brett Williams and John Gianis (7 games each).

Strong Relief For The Wolfpack

Pitching has been NC State’s strongest and longest suit in 2011, and the bullpen has been the backbone of the pitching staff. Through 228 innings, the bullpen has an 18-7 record with a 3.71 ERA and 10 saves, holding opposing hitters to a .256 batting average.

- » Four NC State relievers have ERAs of 3.00 or lower — Grant Sasser (1.83), Josh Easley (2.81), Brandon Price (1.93) and Chris Overman (2.54).
- » Four Wolfpack relievers are holding opposing hitters to batting averages of less than .240 — Easley (.182), Overman (.209), Price (.235) and D.J. Thomas (.202).
- » Overman is 6-2 with a 2.54 ERA and six saves, and has been knocked out of a game just three times in 27 appearances.
- » In the 24 games that Overman was not knocked out of, he is 6-1 with six saves and a 0.86 ERA, holding opposing hitters to a .181 average.
- » Three times in four appearances in mid-March, Price inherited bases-loaded jams and did not allow an inherited runner to score.
- » Wolfpack relievers have inherited 140 baserunners from previous pitchers and stranded 93 of them, 66.4 percent.
- » Thomas has stranded 17 of 19 inherited runners, and Nick Rice has stranded 15 of 19.
- » Overman and fellow sophomore righthander Ethan Ogburn are a combined 10-4 in 39 appearances and 74 1/3 innings.

Extra-Inning Marathons

NC State coach Elliott Avent was asked following NC State’s 6-5, 15-inning loss to Georgia Tech during the ACC Championship if he had ever been that kind of extra-inning marathon before. The answer is yes. Compared to March 4, 2009, at Lake Worth, Fla., the game vs. Georgia Tech was brief and to the point.

- » NC State began that day with a 15-0 rout of Villanova, bashing out 14 hits, four of them home runs.
- » After a 40-minute break, the Wolfpack took on Akron, beginning shortly after 5 p.m.
- » The game with the Zips lasted 18 innings, with NC State winning 5-4 on a throwing error by Akron in the top of the 18th.
- » Eleven Wolfpack pitchers combined to set an NCAA record by striking out 31 batters.
- » The game vs. Akron lasted 5 hours and 12 minutes, and the two games combined, including the 40-minute break between contests, took 8 hours and 32 minutes.
