Open for Play in 2012

The South Carolina men's and women's tennis teams will share a brand new \$4.6 million facility that is being constructed just behind the Dodie Anderson Academic Enrichment Center in what will become the Athletics Village. Features of the new tennis facility include:

- 12 courts
- Lights and scoreboards
- Seating for 750
- Individual scoring for each court
- Covered media area
- 400 square feet of court-side storage
- 900 square feet of dedicated restroom facilities
