ABOUT TONIGHT'S GAME

- South Carolina is tipping off its 47th season of women's basketball today and its 13th under the tutelage of head coach Dawn Staley.
- The Gamecocks are 19-2 in season openers under Staley, including wins in the last nine. South Carolina is 6-1 in home season openers in the Staley era.
- South Carolina holds a 16-9 edge over College of Charleston in the all-time series, including wins in the last nine meetings.
- This is the fourth meeting between the Gamecocks and Cougars in the Staley era with the most recent a 69-43 South Carolina victory on Dec. 5, 2017.

GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- November 25 marks the latest the Gamecocks have started a women's basketball season since opening the 1994-95 season at the Dial Classic tournament in Minneapolis on Nov. 26 against Valparaiso. The latest known start for South Carolina was a Dec. 7, 1976, game at Claflin.
- South Carolina out-rebounded its opponent in 29 of 33 games last season, including 15 of 16 SEC regular-season contests. The Gamecocks finished the season with a school-record 46.5 rebounds per game and a program-best +12.4 rebounding margin. The 2020-21 roster includes Gamecocks that accounted for 80.6 percent of those rebounds.
- Senior guard LeLe Grissett is set for the final season opener of her career today. In her three seasons in the Garnet and Black, the Garnecocks have gone 84-18 overall and 41-7 in SEC play. The program has won one SEC regular-season title and two SEC Tournament championships and advanced to at least the Sweet 16 in her two career NCAA Tournaments.
- Sophomore Aliyah Boston is back for her second campaign after becoming the first Gamecock to win National Freshman of the Year honors. She is a unanimous AP Preseason All-America selection this season and is on the watch lists for the Naismith and Wade Trophies and the Lisa Leslie Award.
- Sophomore Zia Cooke joined Boston on the watch lists for the Naismith and Wade Trophies. She also earned a spot on the Ann Meyers Drysdale Shooting Guard of the Year Award watch list.
- Sophomore Laeticia Amihere has been all the talk of the preseason as her agility and aggressive mindset have stood out at practice as she no longer wears the knee brace she donned last season. She is poised to improve on her 4.7 points and 3.9 rebounds per game of last season.

The Gamecocks' three returning starters are all on the watch lists for their national positional awards.

South Carolina has been ranked No. 1 in the last 11 AP Top 25 Polls.

Under Staley, South Carolina has won its season openers by an average of 25.5 points per game.

The Gamecocks ended last season on a 26-game winning streak they are looking to extend tonight.

South Carolina returns 69.4 percent of its school-record 82.0 points per game from last season.

The Gamecocks return 80.6 percent of their school-record 46.5 rebounds per game from last season.

Five-Second Count

South Carolina women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful era, claiming at least 20 wins for the last nine seasons, including four 30-win season in the last six campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in the NCAA Elite Eight three times in the last five NCAA Tournaments, including winning the 2017 National Championship, and have been ranked in the AP Top 25 for 151 consecutive weeks, Staley led the Gamecocks to their on No. 1 rankings in program history (12 weeks in 2014-15, 10 weeks in 2019-20, 1 week in 2020-21), five SEC regular-season titles and five SEC Tournament championships.

Under Staley's leadership, six Gamecocks have earned All-America status, two have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 19 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once. Eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five years, including 2018 No. 1 overall pick A'ja Wilson, who went on to become the Gamecocks' second-straight WNBA Rookie of the Year (2018) and the program's first WNBA MVP (2020).

CofC Series Notes

South Carolina holds a 16-9 edge in the all-time series against College of Charleston, including wins in the last nine meetings.

Today marks the fourth time the teams have played in the Dawn Staley era with the Gamecocks winning the first three outings, all played at Colonial Life Arena, by an average of 24.0 points.

The last time these teams met, South Carolina claimed a 69-43 victory on Dec. 5, 2017. The Gamecock defense set the tone early, allowing the Cougars just 10 points in the opening half to take a 34-10 lead into the locker room. The second half saw South Carolina out-score CofC by just 35-33.

Each team has just one holdover from that last meeting. Gamecock senior LeLe Grissett posted 10 points, six rebounds, three assists and two steals in here 14 minutes on the court. Cougar senior Lexi Maddox grabbed a rebound in six minutes of court time.

Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are 470-164 (741) all-time in home games, including a 158-33 mark under head coach Dawn Staley. Her .827 winning percentage at home is second among the program's seven all-time head coaches (Pam Parsons (41-7) .854).

Playing in its 19th season at Colonial Life Arena, South Carolina boasts a 221-66 (.770) record in the building, including three undefeated seasons since 2013-14. Staley's share of that record is 155-33 (.824).

Ranking Review

The Gamecocks open the season at the top of both the AP Preseason Top 25 and USA Today Preseason Coaches' Poll for the first time in program history.

South Carolina has been ranked No. 1 in the last 11 AP Polls released, and their 23 weeks at No. 1 since the start of the 2013-14 season are third-most in the stretch.

Ranked in the AP Top 25 for the last 151 consecutive weeks, South Carolina has the fourth-longest active streak in the nation.

The Gamecocks' 24-game schedule includes nine games against teams ranked in both the AP Top 25 and USA Today Coaches' Poll in the preseason.

Four of those opponents are non-conference foes – No. 21 Gonzaga (Nov. 30), No. 9 NC State (Dec. 3), No. 15 lowa State (Dec. 6) and No. 3 UConn (Feb. 8).

Four SEC teams are ranked in the preseason – No. 11 Kentucky (Jan. 10, Feb. 21), No. 14 Arkansas (Jan. 18), No. 6 Mississippi State (Jan. 28) and No. 13 Texas A&M (Feb. 28).

Preseason Props

A trio of Gamecocks have collected preseason honors from league and national affiliations.

Sophomore Aliyah Boston leads the way as an AP Preseason All-American, Naismith and Wade Trophy Watch Lists member, All-SEC First-Team selection by both the coaches and media and recognition on the Lisa Leslie Award watch list

Sophomore Zia Cooke has received similar national recognition, earning spots on the watch lists for the Naismith and Wade Trophies and the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award. She was an All-SEC Preseason Second-Team selection by the league's coaches.

Sophomore Brea Beal broke through on the national scene as a member of the Cheryl Miller Small Forward of the Year Award watch list.

Oh Captain, My Captain

South Carolina named two team captains this season – Aliyah Boston and Victaria Saxton. It is the second season that Saxton has been a team captain.

Staley's Stand

In her 21st season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .728 (477-178) winning percentage, which ranks 13th in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 seasons of experience. The unanimous 2020 National Coach of the Year, she became the first person to win both a Naismith Player of the Year Trophy and a Naismith Coach of the Year Trophy.

Leading the Gamecocks for the 13th season, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (305) with a program-record nine postseason appearances (8 NCAA/1 WNIT). She accounts for both of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances (2015, 2017) and the first national championship in program history.

After winning five SEC regular-season titles, Staley has won 138 SEC games to rank second among active league coaches (Gary Blair, Texas A&M, 141) and sixth all-time. her 11.5 SEC wins average is the best all-time among coaches with at least 10 seasons in the league, and her .726 SEC winning percentage (138-52) is second only to Tennessee's Pat Summitt (.874) in league history.

Depth Squad

The power of the 2019-20 Gamecock team was its depth and the diversity of ways it could win games.

All nine returning Gamecocks this season scored in double figures at least once last season, including four who hit the mark at least four times.

Six returners played in every game in 2019-20, including three who started every game, and each averaged at least 5.4 points. Laeticia Amihere played in every game for which she was available as she missed four games while helping Team Canada qualify for the Tokyo Olympics.

U-S-A. U-S-A

Since the arrival of Staley in the 2008-09 season, South Carolina has solidified its relationship with USA Basketball. at least one Gamecock has donned the red, white and blue in each of the last six years of international competition (no events in 2020), and the group of nine Gamecocks, including three currently in the program, has helped 14 U.S. teams to gold medals, three more to silvers and another to bronze.

The participation streak is guaranteed to continue through 2021 as Staley was named Senior National Team Head Coach through the delayed Tokyo Olympics. The Gamecocks' head coach has led the U.S. to gold in the 2018 FIBA World Cup, earning her second USA Basketball National Coach of the Year award for her effort, and in the 2019 FIBA AmeriCup.

Sophomores Aliyah Boston and Zia Cooke were part of two gold-medal winning teams – 2018 FIBA U17 World Cup, 2017 FIBA U16 Americas Cup. Boston also picked up gold in the 2018 Youth Olympics 3x3 and the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup.

Great Gamecock Fans

South Carolina has led the nation in attendance for the last six seasons, averaging at least 11,000 fans in each of those campaigns.

While the 2020-21 season will see far fewer fans in the stands around the nation due to restrictions in place to mitigate the COVID-19 pandemic, the Gamecocks still expect to be among the nation's leaders in attendance based on the fact that Colonial Llfe Arena is among the largest arenas in women's college basketball.
