ABOUT TONIGHT'S GAME

- South Carolina and NC State have met four times in the Dawn Staley era with the Gamecocks winning the first three and the Wolfpack claiming the most recent matchup – 55-53 on Dec. 4,
- The Wolfpack leads the all-time series 19-11. Prior to tonight, four games of the series have seen both teams ranked in the top 10. The Gamecocks won the first three of those games, all played in the 1979-80 season
- Under Staley, the Gamecocks are 77-61 against ranked opponents, including a 61-14 mark when they are ranked higher than their opponent. In the last six seasons, they are 23-16 against top-10 opponents.

GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- South Carolina's 93.0 points per game ranks 20th in the nation and comes on the heels of last season's program-record 82.0 points per game. The Gamecocks have scored at least 79 points in each of their first three games this season.
- The Gamecocks have been most dominant in the third quarter this season, averaging 28.3 points and out-scoring their opponents by an average of 16.0 points in the period. Two of the team's four 30-point quarters have come in the third
- South Carolina is out-scoring opponents in the paint this season 53.3-32.7 (+20.6). Field goals in the paint account for 84.6 percent of the team's total, and 68.2 percent of those have been made by guards.
- Junior guard Destanni Henderson was named the SEC Player of the Week this week after capturing Bad Boy Mowers Crossover Classic MVP honors. She poured in 21.0 points per game on 58.3 percent shooting at the tournament. Against South Dakota, Henderson was one rebound shy of her first career double-double. She scored all of her career-high 23 points against #21/20 Gonzaga in the second half, including hitting four of the team's six free throw attempts in the final minute to seal the victory and the tournament title.
- Sophomores Aliyah Boston and Zia Cooke have been named to the preseason watch lists for all three National Player of the Year Awards.
- Boston has been getting the lion's share of the attention from opposing defenses this season but has still scored in double figures in every game, shooting 50.0 percent from the field.

The Gamecocks' three returning starters are all on the watch lists for their national positional awards.

South Carolina ranks 11th in the country with 7.3 blocked shots per game.

Eight Gamecocks are shooting at least 50.0 percent from the field this season, including four of five starters.

South Carolina's 23-game schedule features nine games against teams ranked in the preseason top 25.

The Gamecocks have been ranked No. 1 in each of the last 12 AP Polls to be released, dating back to Jan. 14, 2020. It matches the longest streak in program history.

South Carolina is averaging 53.3 points in the paint per game this season, including 44.0 against ranked opponents.

Five-Second Count

South Carolina women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful era, claiming at least 20 wins for the last nine seasons, including four 30-win season in the last six campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in the NCAA Elite Eight three times in the last five NCAA Tournaments, including winning the 2017 National Championship, and have been ranked in the AP Top 25 for 153 consecutive weeks, Staley led the Gamecocks to their only No. 1 rankings in program history (12 weeks in 2014-15, 10 weeks in 2019-20, 2 weeks in 2020-21), five SEC regularseason titles and five SEC Tournament championships.

Under Staley's leadership, six Gamecocks have earned All-America status, two have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 19 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once. Eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five years, including 2018 No. 1 overall pick A'ja Wilson, who went on to become the Gamecocks' second-straight WNBA Rookie of the Year (2018) and the program's first WNBA MVP (2020).

NC State Series Notes

The Wolfpack holds a 19-11 edge in the all-time series, which dates back to the 1977-78 season. The Gamecocks won the first three meetings in the Dawn Staley era, but NC State claims the most recent victory – 55-53 in Raleigh on Dec. 4, 2011.

In games played in Columbia, the series is tied 6-6 after the Gamecocks won the last two meetings in Colonial LIfe Arena - 77-63 on Dec. 12, 2019; 74-71 on Dec. 13, 2009.

Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are 470-164 (.741) all-time in home games, including a 158-33 mark under head coach Dawn Staley. Her .827 winning percentage at home is second among the program's seven all-time head coaches (Pam Parsons (41-7) .854).

Playing in its 19th season at Colonial Life Arena, South Carolina boasts a 221-66 (.770) record in the building, including three undefeated seasons since 2013-14. Staley's share of that record is 155-33 (.824).

Ranked Readings

South Carolina is 77-61 against nationally ranked opponents under head coach Dawn Staley, although that record is skewed by the early seasons of her tenure. The Gamecocks are 62-22 (.738) versus ranked foes since the

start of the 2014-15 campaign, including a 23-16 mark against top-10 opponents during that time.

This season, the Gamecocks are 1-0 against ranked opponents.

Ranking Review

The Gamecocks opened the season at the top of both the AP Preseason Top 25 and USA Today Preseason Coaches' Poll for the first time in program history.

South Carolina has been ranked No. 1 in the last 12 AP Polls released, and their 24 weeks at No. 1 since the start of the 2013-14 season are third-most in the stretch.

Ranked in the AP Top 25 for the last 153 consecutive weeks, South Carolina has the fourth-longest active streak in the nation.

Schedule Strength

The Gamecocks' 23-game schedule includes nine games against teams ranked in both the AP Top 25 and USA Today Coaches' Poll in the preseason.

Four of those opponents are non-conference foes -No. 21 Gonzaga (Nov. 30), No. 9 NC State (Dec. 3), No. 15 lowa State (Dec. 6) and No. 3 UConn (Feb. 8).

Four SEC teams are ranked in the preseason – No. 11 Kentucky (Jan. 10, Feb. 21), No. 14 Arkansas (Jan. 18), No. 6 Mississippi State (Jan. 28) and No. 13 Texas A&M (Feb. 28).

Staley's Stand

In her 21st season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .729 (480-178) winning percentage, which ranks 13th in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 seasons of experience. The unanimous 2020 National

Coach of the Year, she became the first person to win both a Naismith Player of the Year Trophy and a Naismith Coach of the Year Trophy.

Leading the Gamecocks for the 13th season, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (308) with a program-record nine postseason appearances (8 NCAA/1 WNIT). She accounts for both of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances (2015, 2017) and the first national championship in program history.

After winning five SEC regular-season titles, Staley has won 138 SEC games to rank second among active league coaches (Gary Blair, Texas A&M, 141) and sixth all-time. her 11.5 SEC wins average is the best all-time among coaches with at least 10 seasons in the league, and her .726 SEC winning percentage (138-52) is second only to Tennessee's Pat Summitt (.874) in league history.

Preseason Props

A trio of Gamecocks have collected preseason honors from league and national affiliations.

Sophomore Aliyah Boston leads the way as an AP Preseason All-American, Naismith Wade and Wooden Watch Lists member, All-SEC First-Team selection by both the coaches and media and recognition on the Lisa Leslie Award watch list.

Sophomore Zia Cooke has received similar national recognition, earning spots on the watch lists for the Naismith, Wade and Wooden Awards and the Ann

Meyers Drysdale Award. She was an All-SEC Preseason Second-Team selection by the league's coaches.

Sophomore Brea Beal broke through on the national scene as a member of the Cheryl Miller Small Forward of the Year Award watch list.

Oh Captain, My Captain

South Carolina named two team captains this season – Aliyah Boston and Victaria Saxton. It is the second season that Saxton has been a team captain.

7 of 11 Gamecocks have a standing, two-foot vertical jump over 25 inches with Victaria Saxton leading the way at 29 inches. She can also touch 10-foot-5.

Amihere has a 27.9-inch vertical jump (a 6-inch improvement from last season) and can touch 10-foot-9.

Henderson improved her vertical jump from 24 inches to 27 inches this season.

6 Gamecocks have broad jumps greater than eight feet with Saxton leading at 9-foot-1.

Sixth Woman

In 2019-20, South Carolina set a program record with seven games of six double-digit scorers. Prior to that season, there had only been six games total of six double-digit scorers in program history.

This season, the unselfish Gamecocks picked up right where they left off. In the season opener against College of Charleston (Nov. 25), a program-record seven Gamecocks finished in double-figure points.

Five or more Gamecocks scored in double figures 17 times last season, which nearly tripled the previous program record of six set by the 2017-18 and 2016-17 teams.

U-S-A, U-S-A

Since the arrival of Staley in the 2008-09 season, South Carolina has solidified its relationship with USA Basketball. at least one Gamecock has donned the red, white and blue in each of the last six years of international competition (no events in 2020), and the group of nine Gamecocks, including three currently in the program, has helped 14 U.S. teams to gold medals, three more to silvers and another to bronze.

The participation streak is guaranteed to continue through 2021 as Staley was named Senior National Team Head Coach through the delayed Tokyo Olympics. The Gamecocks' head coach has led the U.S. to gold in the 2018 FIBA World Cup, earning her second USA Basketball National Coach of the Year award for her effort, and in the 2019 FIBA AmeriCup.

Sophomores Aliyah Boston and Zia Cooke were part of two gold-medal winning teams – 2018 FIBA U17 World Cup, 2017 FIBA U16 Americas Cup. Boston also picked up gold in the 2018 Youth Olympics 3x3 and the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup.

Great Gamecock Fans

South Carolina has led the nation in attendance for the last six seasons, averaging at least 11,000 fans in each of those campaigns.

While the 2020-21 season will see far fewer fans in the stands around the nation due to restrictions in place to mitigate the COVID-19 pandemic, the Gamecocks still expect to be among the nation's leaders in attendance based on the fact that Colonial Llfe Arena is among the largest arenas in women's college basketball.

They Got Next

The Gamecocks signed the No. 1 recruiting class in the country in November as Staley and her staff added four signees from the Class of 2021. All four are ranked among the top 14 players in the class, including the Nos. 2, 3 and 4 entries.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last six seasons. The Gamecocks were one of a few programs to finish the season averaging over 10,000 fans and boast five sellouts (18,000) in the last five seasons.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest on-campus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300. The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of \$4.2 million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately 12' x 20' and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.

13th Season at South Carolina

Catapulting South Carolina into the national spotlight, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. In 2017-18, she capped her first decade in Garnet and Black by leading her team to its fourth-straight SEC Tournament title, the first four-peat champion in league history, and celebrating the program's first National Player of the Year and No. 1 WNBA Draft pick in A'ja Wilson. Staley's staff has signed two No. 1 recruiting classes in the last three seasons (2019, 2021) and finished the 2019-20 season as the unanimous No. 1 team in the country.

Staley's 12 seasons at the helm of the Gamecocks include:

- 2017 NCAA National Championship
- 153 consecutive weeks ranked in the AP Top 25, including 82 weeks in the top five
- Eight 25-win seasons, including four 30-win campaigns led by a school-record 34 victories in 2014-15
- Five SEC regular-season championships (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2020)
- Five SEC Tournament titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2020)
- Six NCAA Attendance titles, averaging over 10,000 fans each season (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020)

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012.

In her 21st season as a head coach, Staley has led her teams to $10\,25$ -win seasons, a total of 16 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 113 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 24 in the No. 1 spot. Also a force in USA Basketball, she was named the U.S. Women's National Team head coach for 2017-21, already leading the U.S. to 2018 FIBA World Cup gold to earn USAB National Coach of the Year honors. Prior to that appointment, Staley led three other U.S. teams to gold medals – 2015 FIBA U19 World Championships, 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship, 2007 Pan Am Games – and served as an assistant on the Senior National Team 2006-08 and again 2014-16, during which the U.S. claimed gold in the 2014 FIBA World Championship and the 2008 and 2016 Olympics.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last 12 seasons, Staley has twice been named National Coach of the Year (2014, 2020) with her 2020 unanimous selection making her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award. She is a four-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the only Gamecock basketball coach – men's or women's – to amass 300 victories at South Carolina and became the fastest coach to 200 wins in program history, needing just 277 games at South Carolina to reach the plateau.

Staley has coached a National Player of the Year (A'ja Wilson, 2018) and a National Freshman of the Year (Aliyah Boston, 2020). Under her leadership, Six Gamecocks have collected 12 All-America selections, two have picked up five SEC Player of the Year honors, three have earned SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognition a total of four times, one has been the SEC 6th Player of the Year and six were named SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 17 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors a combined 32 times, including 14 first-team selections, and eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five seasons, including 2018 No. 1 pick A'ja Wilson who went on to earn WNBA Rookie of the Year honors a year after Allisha Gray became the first Gamecock to capture the honor in 2017. Two other Gamecock draftees earned WNBA All-Rookie Team honors as well.

On Staley's watch, the Gamecocks are enjoying the most sustained success in program history. After posting back-to-back 25-win seasons in 2011-12 and 2012-13 for the first time in more than 30 years, the 2014-15 team broke the school record with 34 wins. South Carolina won more SEC games than the season before in each of her first seven seasons, culminating in the 2015-16 team recording just the second 16-0 conference record in league history. Her Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history after they matched that mark in 2019-20. Staley's 138 SEC wins account for 68.3 percent of the program's total 202 wins over its 28 seasons in the league. She has delivered the only five SEC championships in program history, and she has helped the Gamecocks to nine of the program's 10 top-four finishes in the league.
