ABOUT TODAY'S GAME

- This is South Carolina's third-straight game against a nationally ranked opponent.
- South Carolina is making its third appearance in the SEC/Big 12 Challenge and playing on the road for the second time in those three games. The Gamecocks are 1-1 in the event.
- The Gamecocks and Cyclones have never met in women's basketball, making lowa State the second opponent South Carolina is facing for the first time in 2020-21. Gonzaga is the other.
- Under Staley, the Gamecocks are 77-62 against ranked opponents, including a 61-15 mark when they are ranked higher than their opponent. South Carolina is 23-21 against ranked opponents on the road under Staley.
- Today is the Gamecocks' first true road game of the season.

GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- Sophomore guard Zia Cooke leads the Gamecock offense with 16.0 points per game and has scored in double figures in every game.. Named to the watch list for all three national player of the year awards, she is also on the watch list for the Ann Meyers Drysdale Shooting Guard Award.
- Unanimous preseason All-America Aliyah Boston has become the focal point of every opponent's defense and this season, and the sophomore forward is watching film and working on ways to improve her efficiency as the season continues. Despite the attention, she has scored in double figures three times in four games and is second on the team in rebounding (8.5 rpg)
- The Gamecocks 2019 recruiting class was ranked No. 1 in the country, and three of those five signees began burnishing their reputations last season. Laeticia Amihere needed more time to recover from injuries that robbed her of her last two high school season, but has exploded into her sophomore season with her ability to affect the game on both sides of the ball and in the half-court as well as transition. She has two double-doubles and leads the team on the glass (9.8 rpg) and in blocked shots (2.0).
- Junior Destanni Henderson is adjusting to being the Gamecocks' primary point guard, balancing her dynamic scoring ability with the need to organize and facilitate the offense. She is ninth in the SEC with 4.0 assists per game and second on the team in scoring with 13.8 points per game. shooting 43.2 percent from the field. She was outstanding at the Bad Boy Mowers Crossover Classic with 21.0 points per game, including a career-high 23 to power a win over No. 21/20 Gonzaga (Nov. 29) en route to tournament MVP honors.

Five-Second Count

South Carolina women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful era, claiming at least 20 wins for the last nine seasons, including four 30-win season in the last six campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in the NCAA Elite Eight three times in the last five NCAA Tournaments, including winning the 2017 National Championship, and have been ranked in the AP Top 25 for 153 consecutive weeks, Staley led the Gamecocks to their only No. 1 rankings in program history (12 weeks in 2014-15, 10 weeks in 2019-20, 2 weeks in 2020-21), five SEC regularseason titles and five SEC Tournament championships.

Under Staley's leadership, six Gamecocks have earned All-America status, two have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 19 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once. Eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five years, including 2018 No. 1 overall pick A'ja Wilson, who went on to become the Gamecocks' second-straight WNBA Rookie of the Year (2018) and the program's first WNBA MVP (2020).

Carolina in the SEC/Big 12 Challenge

The Gamecocks are playing in their third SEC/Big 12 Challenge, and each game has been a matchup between top-25 teams.

In its debut in the series in 2016-17, then-No. 3 South Carolina traveled to then-No. 14 Texas for a 76-67 victory. Two seasons later, then-No. 4 Baylor came to then-No. 18 South Carolina and posted a 94-69 victory.

Road Ready

The Gamecocks are 270-256 all-time in road games, including a 95-42 mark under head coach Dawn Staley. Staley's .693 winning percentage on the road is the best of the Gamecocks' seven head coaches all-time.

Ranked Readings

South Carolina is 77-62 against nationally ranked opponents under head coach Dawn Staley, although that record is skewed by the early seasons of her tenure. The Gamecocks are 62-23 (.729) versus ranked foes since the start of the 2014-15 campaign, including a 23-17 mark against top-10 opponents during that time.

This season, the Gamecocks are 1-1 against ranked opponents.

Ranking Review

The Gamecocks opened the season at the top of both the AP Preseason Top 25 and USA Today Preseason Coaches' Poll for the first time in program history.

WHAT MATTERS

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley picked "What Matters" as this season's theme, reflecting the value of knowing what matters most to you your why - and how focusing on that provides a navigational guide through challenging times.

Each Gamecock wrote her own personal statement of "What Matters" to her. Pieces of each statement were blended together as a script for the video that launched the team.

That video and each Gamecocks' personal "What Matters" statement can be found at GamecocksOnline. com/WhatMatters.

South Carolina has been ranked No. 1 in the last 12 AP Polls released, and their 24 weeks at No. 1 since the start of the 2013-14 season are third-most in the stretch.

Ranked in the AP Top 25 for the last 153 consecutive weeks, South Carolina has the fourth-longest active streak in the nation

Schedule Strength

The Gamecocks' 23-game schedule includes nine games against teams ranked in the most recent AP Top 25 and USA Today Coaches' Poll.

Four of those opponents are non-conference foes -No. 21/20 Gonzaga (Nov. 30), No. 8/6 NC State (Dec. 3), No. 23/18 Iowa State (Dec. 6) and No. 3/3 UConn (Feb. 8).

Four SEC teams are currently ranked - No. 11/12 Kentucky (Jan. 10, Feb. 21), No. 16/14 Arkansas (Jan. 18), No. 6/7 Mississippi State (Jan. 28) and No. 12/13 Texas A&M (Feb. 28).

Staley's Stand

In her 21st season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .728 (480-179) winning percentage, which ranks 13th in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 seasons of experience. The unanimous 2020 National Coach of the Year, she became the first person to win both a Naismith Player of the Year Trophy and a Naismith Coach of the Year Trophy.

Leading the Gamecocks for the 13th season, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (308) with a program-record nine postseason appearances (8 NCAA/1 WNIT). She accounts for both of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances (2015, 2017) and the first national championship in program history.

After winning five SEC regular-season titles, Staley has won 138 SEC games to rank second among active league

coaches (Gary Blair, Texas A&M, 141) and sixth all-time. her 11.5 SEC wins average is the best all-time among coaches with at least 10 seasons in the league, and her .726 SEC winning percentage (138-52) is second only to Tennessee's Pat Summitt (.874) in league history.

Preseason Props

A trio of Gamecocks have collected preseason honors from league and national affiliations.

Sophomore Aliyah Boston leads the way as an AP Preseason All-American, Naismith Wade and Wooden Watch Lists member, All-SEC First-Team selection by both the coaches and media and recognition on the Lisa Leslie Award watch list.

Sophomore Zia Cooke has received similar national recognition, earning spots on the watch lists for the Naismith, Wade and Wooden Awards and the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award. She was an All-SEC Preseason Second-Team selection by the league's coaches.

Sophomore Brea Beal broke through on the national scene as a member of the Cheryl Miller Small Forward of the Year Award watch list.

Oh Captain, My Captain

South Carolina named two team captains this season – Aliyah Boston and Victaria Saxton. It is the second season that Saxton has been a team captain.

South Carolina opened the season with a Staley-era record 73 rebounds against Charleston (Nov. 25) and boasts the 15th-best rebounding margin in the country at +16.3 for the season.

The Gamecocks were out-rebounded just three times last season by just a combined seven boards.

Block Party

South Carolina is annually among the best shot blocking teams in the country, and the 2020-21 edition is not different as the Gamecocks are eighth in the country with an SEC-best 7.0 blocks per game.

Seven different Gamecocks have blocked at least one shot with forwards Laeticia Amihere and Victaria Saxton leading the way.

Amihere's 2.0 blocks per game are sixth in the SEC. She has blocked at least one shot in every game, including a season-best three against South Dakota.

Saxton is seventh in the SEC with 1.8 blocks per game behind a career-high tying five in the season opener against Charleston (Nov. 25).

Reigning SEC Defensive Player of the Year Aliyah Boston has just three blocks so far this season as opponents have focused on limiting her involvement on both sides of the ball, but she is tied for the team high with five steals to her credit this season.

Free for All

The Gamecocks continue to get to the free throw line at one of the highest rates in the country. South Carolina is second in the nation with 128 free throw attempts and third in free throws made at 76. The Gamecocks have made more free throws (76) than their opponents have attempted (69) through four games.

Three Gamecocks have worn a path to the line this season. Laeticia Amihere is 13th in the country with 23 free throw attempts. Guards Zia Cooke and Destanni Henderson are 26th in the nation with 15 made free throws so far this season.

U-S-A, U-S-A

Since the arrival of Staley in the 2008-09 season, South Carolina has solidified its relationship with USA Basketball. at least one Gamecock has donned the red, white and blue in each of the last six years of international competition (no events in 2020), and the group of nine

Gamecocks, including three currently in the program, has helped 14 U.S. teams to gold medals, three more to silvers and another to bronze.

The participation streak is guaranteed to continue through 2021 as Staley was named Senior National Team Head Coach through the delayed Tokyo Olympics. The Gamecocks' head coach has led the U.S. to gold in the 2018 FIBA World Cup, earning her second USA Basketball National Coach of the Year award for her effort, and in the 2019 FIBA AmeriCup.

Sophomores Aliyah Boston and Zia Cooke were part of two gold-medal winning teams – 2018 FIBA U17 World Cup, 2017 FIBA U16 Americas Cup. Boston also picked up gold in the 2018 Youth Olympics 3x3 and the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup.

Great Gamecock Fans

South Carolina has led the nation in attendance for the last six seasons, averaging at least 11,000 fans in each of those campaigns.

While the 2020-21 season will see far fewer fans in the stands around the nation due to restrictions in place to mitigate the COVID-19 pandemic, the Gamecocks still expect to be among the nation's leaders in attendance based on the fact that Colonial Life Arena, which has a maximum capacity of 3,500 under the restrictions, is among the largest arenas in women's college basketball

They Got Next

The Gamecocks signed the No. 1 recruiting class in the country in November as Staley and her staff added four signees from the Class of 2021. All four are ranked among the top 14 players in the class, including the Nos. 2, 3 and 4 entries.

In women's basketball, Colonial Life Arena has become one of the most feared places to play as enormous crowds fill the building with passion for the Gamecocks.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last six seasons. The Gamecocks were one of a few programs to finish the season averaging over 10,000 fans and boast five sellouts (18,000) in the last five seasons.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest on-campus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300. The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of \$4.2 million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately 12' x 20' and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.

13th Season at South Carolina

Catapulting South Carolina into the national spotlight, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. In 2017-18, she capped her first decade in Garnet and Black by leading her team to its fourth-straight SEC Tournament title, the first four-peat champion in league history, and celebrating the program's first National Player of the Year and No. 1 WNBA Draft pick in A'ja Wilson. Staley's staff has signed two No. 1 recruiting classes in the last three seasons (2019, 2021) and finished the 2019-20 season as the unanimous No. 1 team in the country.

Staley's 12 seasons at the helm of the Gamecocks include:

- 2017 NCAA National Championship
- 153 consecutive weeks ranked in the AP Top 25, including 82 weeks in the top five
- Eight 25-win seasons, including four 30-win campaigns led by a school-record 34 victories in 2014-15
- Five SEC regular-season championships (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2020)
- Five SEC Tournament titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2020)
- Six NCAA Attendance titles, averaging over 10,000 fans each season (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020)

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012.

In her 21st season as a head coach, Staley has led her teams to $10\,25$ -win seasons, a total of 16 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 113 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 24 in the No. 1 spot. Also a force in USA Basketball, she was named the U.S. Women's National Team head coach for 2017-21, already leading the U.S. to 2018 FIBA World Cup gold to earn USAB National Coach of the Year honors. Prior to that appointment, Staley led three other U.S. teams to gold medals – 2015 FIBA U19 World Championships, 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship, 2007 Pan Am Games – and served as an assistant on the Senior National Team 2006-08 and again 2014-16, during which the U.S. claimed gold in the 2014 FIBA World Championship and the 2008 and 2016 Olympics.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last 12 seasons, Staley has twice been named National Coach of the Year (2014, 2020) with her 2020 unanimous selection making her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award. She is a four-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the only Gamecock basketball coach – men's or women's – to amass 300 victories at South Carolina and became the fastest coach to 200 wins in program history, needing just 277 games at South Carolina to reach the plateau.

Staley has coached a National Player of the Year (A'ja Wilson, 2018) and a National Freshman of the Year (Aliyah Boston, 2020). Under her leadership, Six Gamecocks have collected 12 All-America selections, two have picked up five SEC Player of the Year honors, three have earned SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognition a total of four times, one has been the SEC 6th Player of the Year and six were named SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 17 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors a combined 32 times, including 14 first-team selections, and eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five seasons, including 2018 No. 1 pick A'ja Wilson who went on to earn WNBA Rookie of the Year honors a year after Allisha Gray became the first Gamecock to capture the honor in 2017. Two other Gamecock draftees earned WNBA All-Rookie Team honors as well.

On Staley's watch, the Gamecocks are enjoying the most sustained success in program history. After posting back-to-back 25-win seasons in 2011-12 and 2012-13 for the first time in more than 30 years, the 2014-15 team broke the school record with 34 wins. South Carolina won more SEC games than the season before in each of her first seven seasons, culminating in the 2015-16 team recording just the second 16-0 conference record in league history. Her Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history after they matched that mark in 2019-20. Staley's 138 SEC wins account for 68.3 percent of the program's total 202 wins over its 28 seasons in the league. She has delivered the only five SEC championships in program history, and she has helped the Gamecocks to nine of the program's 10 top-four finishes in the league.
