ABOUT TODAY'S GAME

- Georgia leads the all-time series 33-19, but the Gamecocks are 15-6 against the Lady Bulldogs in the Dawn Staley era (2008-09 to present) including a current 12-game win streak
- Tonight is the 14th meeting between Georgia and South Carolina in which both teams are nationally ranked. The better-ranked team is 11-2 in the previous 13 outings; the Gamecocks are 5-1 when ranked better than the Lady Bulldogs.
- South Carolina is looking for its 22nd straight SEC regular-season victory tonight. Its longest SEC win streak is 24 games - Jan. 3, 2016 through Jan. 26, 2017.

GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- In its last two games, South Carolina scored at least 100 points in back-to-back games for the first time in program history, including its first 100-point game against a nationally ranked opponent. The 106 and 104 points at Vanderbilt and against Arkansas, respectively, are the most by any Gamecock team against an SEC opponent.
- The Gamecocks have dominated nearly every rebounding stat imaginable this season, including ranking second in the country in offensive rebounds per game (18.9) even as the team is shooting 46.6 percent from the field. South Carolina leads the nation with 52.2 rebounds per game and is second in rebounding margin (+19.9). There is little dropoff in those numbers in the Gamecocks' five games against ranked opponents, during which they average 47.2 rebounds, including 17.2 on the offensive end to produce 17.2 second-chance points per game.
- South Carolina is No. 3 in the NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool), which is the new quantitative measure the NCAA Tournament selection committee will use. The Gamecocks' five games against NET top-25 teams tie Nebraska for the most in the country with the 4-1 record in those games besting the Cornhuskers' 3-2 mark. South Carolina is one of two AP Top 25 teams with four or more wins over ranked opponents this season.
- Unanimous AP Preseason All-American Aliyah Boston has absolutely dominated SEC play, leading the league in rebounding (12.8), offensive rebounding (4.6) and blocks (4.6) per conference game. She is eight in scoring (17.6) and sixth in field goal percentage (.537). In five games against ranked opponents, Boston leads the team in scoring (15.6) and rebounding (11.4) and has three double-doubles in those outings.
- Forward Victaria Saxton has been known as a rebounder and shot blocker, and she is now establishing herself as a threat offensively. She's averaging 10.7 points and 6.0 rebounds in SEC action, including 15.0 points per game over the last two outings, during which she shot 77.8 percent (14-18). On the season, she is 19th in the SEC in rebounding (6.0) and third in blocks (1.9). She leads the league in field goal percentage in SEC play at .628.
- Junior Destanni Henderson launched into 2021 with a 20-point, five-assist game at Alabama and has not looked back. Over the last four games, the Gamecocks' lightning quick point guard has averaged 17.0 points and 6.8 assists, including her first career double-double with 14 points and 10 assists against #15/16 Arkansas.
- With a renewed focus on her trademark defense, Brea Beal has seen her offensive contribution explode in the last two games, posting career-high points in each to average at team-best 19.5 points in that stretch while shooting 70.0 percent (14-20), including 6-of-9 from 3-point range.

Multiple Gamecocks have scored at least 20 points in a game three times already this season, the most since the five games in the 2017-18 season.

With 24 consecutive appearances in the AP top five, the Gamecocks have the longest active streak of top-five showings in the nation.

South Carolina is shooting 37.5 percent from 3-point range this season to rank 23rd in the country.

The Gamecocks have scored 55.7 percent of their points this season in the paint. Of those 48.0 paint points per game, 25.3 of them have been scored by guards.

In five games against ranked opponents this season, the Gamecocks have scored 77.4 points per game on 44.4 percent shooting.

Five-Second Count

South Carolina women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful era, claiming at least 20 wins for the last nine seasons, including four 30-win seasons in the last six campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in the NCAA Elite Eight three times in the last five NCAA Tournaments, including winning the 2017 National Championship, and have been ranked in the AP Top 25 for 160 consecutive weeks, Staley led the Gamecocks to their only No. 1 rankings in program history (12 weeks in 2014-15, 10 weeks in 2019-20, 2 weeks in 2020-21), five SEC regularseason titles and five SEC Tournament championships.

Under Staley's leadership, six Gamecocks have earned All-America status, two have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 19 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once. Eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five years, including 2018 No. 1 overall pick A'ja Wilson, who went on to become the Gamecocks' second-straight WNBA Rookie of the Year (2018) and the program's first WNBA MVP (2020).

Georgia Series Notes

The Lady Bulldogs hold a commanding 33-19 lead in the all-time series, but the Gamecocks have a 15-6 advantage in the Dawn Staley era (2008-09 to present), including a current 12-game win streak.

In the Staley era, the series has been notoriously low scoring with just five games seeing a team score 70 points and four games with neither team reaching 60.

In both meetings last season, then-#1 South Carolina broke that trend and dominated offensively. In the regular-season meeting (Jan. 26), the Gamecocks posted an 88-53 win in Athens. In the SEC Tournament guarterfinals (Mar. 6), South Carolina cruised to an 89-56

Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are 473-165 (.741) all-time in home games, including a 161-34 mark under head coach Dawn Staley. Her .826 winning percentage at home is second among the program's seven all-time head coaches (Pam Parsons (41-7) .854).

Carolina boasts a 224-67 (.770) record in the building, including three undefeated seasons since 2013-14. Staley's share of that record is 158-34 (.822).

Ranked Readings

South Carolina is 80-62 against nationally ranked opponents under head coach Dawn Staley, although that record is skewed by the early seasons of her tenure. The Gamecocks are 65-23 (.739) versus ranked foes since the start of the 2014-15 campaign, including a 24-17 mark against top-10 opponents during that time.

This season, the Gamecocks are 4-1 against ranked

Schedule Strength

The Gamecocks leads nation in past opponents' winning percentage (.784) and in all opponents' winning percentage (.750).

With a 4-1 record against ranked opponents and 6-1 against NET top-30 teams. South Carolina and Texas A&M are the only top-25 teams with four or more wins over ranked opponents.

The Gamecocks' 22-game schedule includes nine games against teams ranked in the most recent AP Top 25 and/or USA Today Coaches' Poll.

Ranked in the AP Top 25 for the last 160 consecutive weeks, South Carolina has the fourth-longest active streak in the nation. With 24 consecutive appearances in the top five of the AP Poll, the Gamecocks have the longest active streak of top-five showings in the nation.

Staley's Stand

In her 21st season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .731 (487-179) winning percentage, which ranks 13th in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 seasons of experience (sixth among Power 5 conference coaches). The unanimous 2020 National Coach of the Year, she became the first person to win both a Naismith Player of the Year Trophy and a Naismith Coach of the Year Trophy.

Leading the Gamecocks for the 13th season, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (315) with a program-record nine postseason appearances (8 NCAA/1 WNIT). She accounts for both of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances (2015, 2017) and the first national championship in program history.

After winning five SEC regular-season titles, Staley has won 143 SEC games to rank second among active league coaches (Gary Blair, Texas A&M, 145) and fourth all-time. Entering this season, her 11.5 SEC wins average is the best all-time among coaches with at least 10 seasons in the

league, and her .733 SEC winning percentage (143-52) is second only to Tennessee's Pat Summitt (.874) in league history.

Preseason Props

After ending the shortened 2019-20 season at No. 1, the Gamecocks opened 2020-21 in that spot on every preseason poll. It marked the first preseason No. 1 ranking for the program.

SEC coaches and media were unanimous in their pick of the Gamecocks to repeat as SEC regular-season champion this season

Individually, trio of Gamecocks collected preseason honors from league and national affiliations.

Sophomore Aliyah Boston led the way as an AP Preseason All-American, Naismith Wade and Wooden Watch Lists member, All-SEC First-Team selection by both the coaches and media and recognition on the Lisa Leslie Award watch list

Sophomore Zia Cooke received similar national recognition, earning spots on the watch lists for the Naismith, Wade and Wooden Awards and the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award. She was an All-SEC Preseason Second-Team selection by the league's coaches.

Sophomore Brea Beal broke through on the national scene as a member of the Cheryl Miller Small Forward of the Year Award watch list.

7 of 11 Gamecocks have a standing, two-foot vertical jump over 25 inches with Victaria Saxton leading the way at 29 inches. She can also touch 10-foot-5.

Amihere has a 27.9-inch vertical jump (a 6-inch improvement from last season) and can touch 10-foot-9.

Henderson improved her vertical jump from 24 inches to 27 inches this season.

Their next most productive quarter is the first – 21.6 points per first quarter on 46.6 percent shooting and a 7.3 scoring average advantage.

Boardroom

Rebounding is one stat most coaches will say is defined by effort. For the Gamecocks, that effort comes from every position on the court.

South Carolina opened the season with a Staley-era record 73 rebounds against Charleston (Nov. 25) and leads the nation in rebounds per game (52.2) and is second in rebounding margin at an SEC-best +19.9.

The Gamecocks have not been out-rebounded this season and have a +14.8 rebounding margin in their five games against ranked opponents. South Carolina is second in the nation in offensive rebounding (18.9) and averages 19.0 second-chance points. The Gamecocks are cleaning up an SEC-best 47.2 percent of their own missed shots, including 48.5 percent in SEC games.

Starting forwards Aliyah Boston (11.1) and Victaria Saxton (6.0) lead the way on the glass, ranking second and 19th in the SEC, respectively. In SEC play, Boston's rebounding average improves to an SEC-best 12.8.

Block Party

South Carolina is annually among the best shot blocking teams in the country, and the 2020-21 edition is no different as the Gamecocks lead the country with 7.6 blocks per game, including 8.6 in SEC play.

Nine different Gamecocks have blocked at least one shot with three ranking among the SEC's top 10.

Aliyah Boston has been on a tear since the holiday break, averaging an SEC-best 4.6 blocks in league games to move into 11th in the country with 2.7 blocks per game on the season.

Victaria Saxton is just behind with 1.9 per game to rank third in the SEC, and Laeticia Amihere's 1.5 are seventh.

Free for All

The Gamecocks continue to get to the free throw line at one of the highest rates in the country. South Carolina's 24.55 free throw attempts per game are sixth the nation and best in the SEC.

Zia Cooke leads the parade to the free throw line with 44 attempts this season, shooting 77.3 percent from the stripe, which ranks 10th in the SEC. Destanni Henderson's 78.9 percent free throw shooting leads the team and is seventh in the conference.

They Got Next

The Gamecocks signed the No. 1 recruiting class in the country in November as Staley and her staff added four from the Class of 2021. All four are ranked among the top 14 players in the class, including the Nos. 2, 3 and 4 entries.

In women's basketball, Colonial Life Arena has become one of the most feared places to play as enormous crowds fill the building with passion for the Gamecocks.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last six seasons. The Gamecocks were one of a few programs to finish the season averaging over 10,000 fans and boast five sellouts (18,000) in the last five seasons.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest on-campus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300. The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of \$4.2 million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately 12' x 20' and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.

13th Season at South Carolina

Catapulting South Carolina into the national spotlight, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. In 2017-18, she capped her first decade in Garnet and Black by leading her team to its fourth-straight SEC Tournament title, the first four-peat champion in league history, and celebrating the program's first National Player of the Year and No. 1 WNBA Draft pick in A'ja Wilson. Staley's staff has signed two No. 1 recruiting classes in the last three seasons (2019, 2021) and finished the 2019-20 season as the unanimous No. 1 team in the country.

Staley's 12 seasons at the helm of the Gamecocks include:

- 2017 NCAA National Championship
- 160 consecutive weeks ranked in the AP Top 25, including 89 weeks in the top five
- Eight 25-win seasons, including four 30-win campaigns led by a school-record 34 victories in 2014-15
- Five SEC regular-season championships (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2020)
- Five SEC Tournament titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2020)
- Six NCAA Attendance titles, averaging over 10,000 fans each season (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020)

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012.

In her 21st season as a head coach, Staley has led her teams to $10\,25$ -win seasons, a total of 16 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 113 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 24 in the No. 1 spot. Also a force in USA Basketball, she was named the U.S. Women's National Team head coach for 2017-21, already leading the U.S. to 2018 FIBA World Cup gold to earn USAB National Coach of the Year honors. Prior to that appointment, Staley led three other U.S. teams to gold medals – 2015 FIBA U19 World Championships, 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship, 2007 Pan Am Games – and served as an assistant on the Senior National Team 2006-08 and again 2014-16, during which the U.S. claimed gold in the 2014 FIBA World Championship and the 2008 and 2016 Olympics.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last 12 seasons, Staley has twice been named National Coach of the Year (2014, 2020) with her 2020 unanimous selection making her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award. She is a four-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the only Gamecock basketball coach – men's or women's – to amass 300 victories at South Carolina and became the fastest coach to 200 wins in program history, needing just 277 games at South Carolina to reach the plateau.

Staley has coached a National Player of the Year (A'ja Wilson, 2018) and a National Freshman of the Year (Aliyah Boston, 2020). Under her leadership, Six Gamecocks have collected 12 All-America selections, two have picked up five SEC Player of the Year honors, three have earned SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognition a total of four times, one has been the SEC 6th Player of the Year and six were named SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 17 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors a combined 32 times, including 14 first-team selections, and eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five seasons, including 2018 No. 1 pick A'ja Wilson who went on to earn WNBA Rookie of the Year honors a year after Allisha Gray became the first Gamecock to capture the honor in 2017. Two other Gamecock draftees earned WNBA All-Rookie Team honors as well.

On Staley's watch, the Gamecocks are enjoying the most sustained success in program history. After posting back-to-back 25-win seasons in 2011-12 and 2012-13 for the first time in more than 30 years, the 2014-15 team broke the school record with 34 wins. South Carolina won more SEC games than the season before in each of her first seven seasons, culminating in the 2015-16 team recording just the second 16-0 conference record in league history. Her Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history after they matched that mark in 2019-20. Staley's 138 SEC wins account for 68.3 percent of the program's total 202 wins over its 28 seasons in the league. She has delivered the only five SEC championships in program history, and she has helped the Gamecocks to nine of the program's 10 top-four finishes in the league.
