ABOUT TODAY'S GAME

- The Gamecocks are 15-6 against Georgia in the Dawn Staley era, including wins in the last 12 meetings. At least one of the teams has been ranked in 18 of those 21 meetings
- South Carolina is looking to open the SEC season 3-0 for the third time in as many seasons and the seventh time in the last eight seasons.
- The Gamecocks are looking for their 19th straight SEC regular-season victory tonight. Their longest SEC win streak is 24 games - Jan. 3, 2016, through Jan. 26, 2017.

GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- South Carolina has been outstanding on the glass this season, especially on the offensive end. The Gamecocks are fourth in the nation in rebounds per game (52.2) and rebounding margin (+18.9) They have out-rebounded three of their last four opponents by at least 24 and have not been out-rebounded this season. South Carolina is also fourth in the country in offensive rebounds per game (19.1), reeling in an SEC-best 46.2 percent of its own missed shots to average 17.2 second-chance points.
- The Gamecocks' starting backcourt of Zia Cooke and Destanni Henderson is building a substantial resume this season. Both are explosive scorers and fierce competitors. Cooke is fourth in the SEC with a team-best 18.8 points per game, hitting 2.3 3-pointers per game to rank sixth in the SEC. She does that while adding 3.0 assists per game. Henderson is third on the team with 12.1 points per game, including a pair of 20-point outings. Her 5.5 assists per game are 24th in the country (2nd in the SEC), and her 3.1 assist-to-turnover ratio is 27th in the nation (5th in the SEC). The junior point guard adds 5.9 rebounds per game – she ranks 12th in the SEC with 7.5 rebounds per league game – and is shooting 40.0 percent from 3-point range.
- Sophomore forward Aliyah Boston continues to show off her expanding game this season with four double-figure rebound games, six double-figure scoring games and 1.6 blocks per game. She is one of four players in the SEC averaging a double-double on the season and one of two who also rank among the league's top 10 in blocked shots. She is shooting 35.7 percent from 3-point range (5-of-14) and, in league play, she ranks third in steals per game at 2.5.
- Junior forward Victaria Saxton has been especially strong in the last four games, averaging 12.3 points (3rd on the team), 8.5 rebounds and 2.8 blocks during the stretch. She has shot 55.3 percent from the field in those games.

Three Gamecocks rank among the SEC's top 15 in rebounds per league game - Boston (13.0, 2nd), Saxton (9.0, 6th) and Henderson (7.5. 12th).

Zia Cooke averages 3.6 assists per game in which she shoots at least 45.0 percent, compared to 2.0 assists per game when she is below that field goal percentage (3 gms).

Sophomore guard Brea Beal's six career double-figure rebound games are second most on the team.

In the last four games, Destanni Henderson has averaged 7.0 assists to go with her 10.5 points and 5.5 rebounds per game.

South Carolina goes to the free throw line 25.3 times per game, which is the fourth-highest number in the country.

Gamecocks' 31 made field goals (74.2%) came in the paint.

Five-Second Count

South Carolina women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful era, claiming at least 20 wins for the last nine seasons, including four 30-win seasons in the last six campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in the NCAA Elite Eight three times in the last five NCAA Tournaments, including winning the 2017 National Championship, and have been ranked in the AP Top 25 for 158 consecutive weeks, Staley led the Gamecocks to their only No. 1 rankings in program history (12 weeks in 2014-15, 10 weeks in 2019-20, 2 weeks in 2020-21), five SEC regularseason titles and five SEC Tournament championships.

Under Staley's leadership, six Gamecocks have earned All-America status, two have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 19 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once. Eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five years, including 2018 No. 1 overall pick A'ja Wilson, who went on to become the Gamecocks' second-straight WNBA Rookie of the Year (2018) and the program's first WNBA MVP (2020).

Georgia Series Notes

The Lady Bulldogs hold a commanding 33-19 lead in the all-time series, but the Gamecocks have a 15-6 advantage in the Dawn Staley era (2008-09 to present).

In the Stalev era, the series has been notoriously low scoring with just five games seeing a team score 70 points and four games with neither team reaching 60.

In both meetings last season, then-No. 1 South Carolina broke that trend and dominated offensively. In the regular-season meeting (Jan. 26), the Gamecocks posted an 88-53 win in Athens. In the SEC Tournament quarterfinals (Mar. 6), South Carolina cruised to an 89-56 victory.

Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are 472-165 (.741) all-time in home games, including a 160-34 mark under head coach Dawn Staley. Her .825 winning percentage at home is second among the program's seven all-time head coaches (Pam Parsons (41-7) .854).

Playing in its 19th season at Colonial Life Arena, South Carolina boasts a 223-67 (.769) record in the building, including three undefeated seasons since 2013-14. Staley's share of that record is 157-34 (.822).

WHAT MATTERS

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley picked "What Matters" as this season's theme, reflecting the value of knowing what matters most to you your why - and how focusing on that provides a navigational guide through challenging times.

Each Gamecock wrote her own personal statement of "What Matters" to her. Pieces of each statement were blended together as a script for the video that launched the team.

Ranking Review

The Gamecocks are ranked No. 5 in the AP Poll and No. 4 in the USA Today Coaches' Poll for the fifth-straight week.

Ranked in the AP Top 25 for the last 158 consecutive weeks, South Carolina has the fourth-longest active streak in the nation. With 23 consecutive appearances in the top five of the AP Poll, the Gamecocks have the longest active streak of top-five showings in the nation.

Schedule Strength

South Carolina's three games against ranked opponents are the second-most by a top-25 team at this point in the season, trailing only No. 10/8 Kentucky and No. 20/22 DePaul, which have each played four such games. No. 12/12 Maryland joins the Gamecocks with a 2-1 record in their three games against ranked foes.

The Gamecocks' 23-game schedule includes eight games against teams ranked in the most recent AP Top 25 and USA Today Coaches' Poll.

Staley's Stand

In her 21st season as a head coach. Dawn Stalev has a .730 (484-179) winning percentage, which ranks 13th in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 seasons of experience (seventh among Power 5 conference coaches). The unanimous 2020 National Coach of the Year, she became the first person to win both a Naismith Player of the Year Trophy and a Naismith Coach of the Year Trophy.

Leading the Gamecocks for the 13th season, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (312) with a program-record nine postseason appearances (8 NCAA/1

WNIT). She accounts for both of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances (2015, 2017) and the first national championship in program history.

After winning five SEC regular-season titles, Staley has won 140 SEC games to rank second among active league coaches (Gary Blair, Texas A&M, 142) and fifth all-time. Entering this season, her 11.5 SEC wins average is the best all-time among coaches with at least 10 seasons in the league, and her .729 SEC winning percentage (140-52) is second only to Tennessee's Pat Summitt (.874) in league history.

Preseason Props

After ending the shortened 2019-20 season at No. 1, the Gamecocks opened 2020-21 in that spot on every preseason poll. It marked the first preseason No. 1 ranking for the program.

SEC coaches and media were unanimous in their pick of the Gamecocks to repeat as SEC regular-season champion this season.

Individually, trio of Gamecocks collected preseason honors from league and national affiliations.

Sophomore Aliyah Boston led the way as an AP Preseason All-American, Naismith Wade and Wooden Watch Lists member, All-SEC First-Team selection by both the coaches and media and recognition on the Lisa Leslie Award watch list

Sophomore Zia Cooke received similar national

recognition, earning spots on the watch lists for the Naismith, Wade and Wooden Awards and the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award. She was an All-SEC Preseason Second-Team selection by the league's coaches.

Sophomore Brea Beal broke through on the national scene as a member of the Cheryl Miller Small Forward of the Year Award watch list.

Oh Captain, My Captain

South Carolina named two team captains this season – Aliyah Boston and Victaria Saxton. It is the second season that Saxton has been a team captain.

Quarter Breakdown

The Gamecocks have been most impressive in the third quarter, averaging 25.0 points on 51.3 percent shooting to out-score opponents by an average of 8.3 points. Four of their six 30-point quarters have come in the third period.

Their next most productive quarter is the first -21.0 points per first quarter on 44.5 percent shooting and a 7.4 scoring average advantage.

Boardroom

Rebounding is one stat most coaches will say is defined by effort. For the Gamecocks, that effort comes from every position on the court.

South Carolina opened the season with a Staley-era record 73 rebounds against Charleston (Nov. 25) and

boasts the fourth-best rebounding margin in the country at an SEC-best +18.9 on the season.

The Gamecocks have not been out-rebounded this season and have a +12.7 rebounding margin in their three games against ranked opponents. South Carolina is fourth in the nation in offensive rebounding (19.1) and averages 17.8 second-chance points.

Starting forwards Aliyah Boston (10.5) and Victaria Saxton (7.3) lead the way, ranking third and 15th in the SEC, respectively. In SEC play, those numbers improve to

The Gamecock have serious speed in the open court. Laeticia Amihere registered the fastest 3/4-court sprint time at 2.96 seconds. Brea Beal, Zia Cooke, and Destanni Henderson all registered times between 3.1 and 3.15 seconds

7 of 11 Gamecocks have a standing, two-foot vertical jump over 25 inches with Victaria Saxton leading the way at 29 inches. She can also touch 10-foot-5.

Amihere has a 27.9-inch vertical jump (a 6-inch improvement from last season) and can touch 10-foot-9.

Henderson improved her vertical jump from 24 inches to 27 inches this season.

6 Gamecocks have broad jumps greater than eight feet with Saxton leading at 9-foot-1.

TEAM STATEMENT ON NATIONAL ANTHEM DEMONSTRATION

During the national anthem this season, each of us has made an individual decision about how to use our platform to call attention to what matters most to us. Many of us stay seated or kneel to shine a light on the need for racial equality, social justice and ending systemic racism in our country. We know that not everyone will agree with the decisions we made, but we ask that everyone respect our right to make them.

Block Party

South Carolina is annually among the best shot blocking teams in the country, and the 2020-21 edition is not different as the Gamecocks are third in the country and with an SEC-best 6.9 blocks per game.

Eight different Gamecocks have blocked at least one shot with three ranking among the SEC's top 15.

Victaria Saxton's 2.3 blocks per game are third in the SEC and 24th in the nation. She got that number started with a career-high tying five against Charleston (Nov, 25) and has blocked multiple shots in a game four times in her first seven outings.

With nine blocks in the last three games, Boston has moved up to sixth in the SEC with 1.6 per game; and Laeticia Amihere's 1.3 blocks per game are 14th.

Free for All

The Gamecocks continue to get to the free throw line at one of the highest rates in the country. South Carolina's 25.3 free throw attempts per game are fourth the nation, trailing Howard (29.3), Arkansas (26.3) and Sam Houston State (26.1). The Gamecocks make 15.63 free throws per game, which is 12th in the country.

Laeticia Amihere leads the parade to the line with 34 attempts. After a slow start, she has shot 10-of-11 from the stripe over the last four games (.909). Zia Cooke's .813 free throw percentage (26-32) leads the team.

Everybody's All-American

Of the 11 Gamecocks on the 2020-21 roster, six were McDonald's All-Americans in high school – Brea Beal, Aliyah Boston, Zia Cooke, Destanni Henderson, Destiny Littleton and Eniya Russell.

At South Carolina, Staley has coached 13 McDonald's All-Americans, including 10 who joined the Gamecocks as freshmen

Great Gamecock Fans

South Carolina has led the nation in attendance for the last six seasons, averaging at least 11,000 fans in each of those campaigns.

While the 2020-21 season will see far fewer fans in the stands around the nation due to restrictions in place to mitigate the COVID-19 pandemic, the Gamecocks still expect to be among the nation's leaders in attendance based on the fact that Colonial Life Arena, which has a maximum capacity of 3,500 under the restrictions, is among the largest arenas in women's college basketball.

With paid attendance of 3,500 at each of the first four home games, South Carolina holds the three highest attendance games of the season.

They Got Next

The Gamecocks signed the No. 1 recruiting class in the country in November as Staley and her staff added four signees from the Class of 2021. All four are ranked among the top 14 players in the class, including the Nos. 2, 3 and 4 entries.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last six seasons. The Gamecocks were one of a few programs to finish the season averaging over 10,000 fans and boast five sellouts (18,000) in the last five seasons.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest on-campus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300. The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of \$4.2 million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately $12' \times 20'$ and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.

13th Season at South Carolina

Catapulting South Carolina into the national spotlight, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. In 2017-18, she capped her first decade in Garnet and Black by leading her team to its fourth-straight SEC Tournament title, the first four-peat champion in league history, and celebrating the program's first National Player of the Year and No. 1 WNBA Draft pick in A'ja Wilson. Staley's staff has signed two No. 1 recruiting classes in the last three seasons (2019, 2021) and finished the 2019-20 season as the unanimous No. 1 team in the country.

Staley's 12 seasons at the helm of the Gamecocks include:

- 2017 NCAA National Championship
- 158 consecutive weeks ranked in the AP Top 25, including 87 weeks in the top five
- Eight 25-win seasons, including four 30-win campaigns led by a school-record 34 victories in 2014-15
- Five SEC regular-season championships (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2020)
- Five SEC Tournament titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2020)
- Six NCAA Attendance titles, averaging over 10,000 fans each season (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020)

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012.

In her 21st season as a head coach, Staley has led her teams to $10\,25$ -win seasons, a total of 16 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 113 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 24 in the No. 1 spot. Also a force in USA Basketball, she was named the U.S. Women's National Team head coach for 2017-21, already leading the U.S. to 2018 FIBA World Cup gold to earn USAB National Coach of the Year honors. Prior to that appointment, Staley led three other U.S. teams to gold medals – 2015 FIBA U19 World Championships, 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship, 2007 Pan Am Games – and served as an assistant on the Senior National Team 2006-08 and again 2014-16, during which the U.S. claimed gold in the 2014 FIBA World Championship and the 2008 and 2016 Olympics.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last 12 seasons, Staley has twice been named National Coach of the Year (2014, 2020) with her 2020 unanimous selection making her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award. She is a four-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the only Gamecock basketball coach – men's or women's – to amass 300 victories at South Carolina and became the fastest coach to 200 wins in program history, needing just 277 games at South Carolina to reach the plateau.

Staley has coached a National Player of the Year (A'ja Wilson, 2018) and a National Freshman of the Year (Aliyah Boston, 2020). Under her leadership, Six Gamecocks have collected 12 All-America selections, two have picked up five SEC Player of the Year honors, three have earned SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognition a total of four times, one has been the SEC 6th Player of the Year and six were named SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 17 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors a combined 32 times, including 14 first-team selections, and eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five seasons, including 2018 No. 1 pick A'ja Wilson who went on to earn WNBA Rookie of the Year honors a year after Allisha Gray became the first Gamecock to capture the honor in 2017. Two other Gamecock draftees earned WNBA All-Rookie Team honors as well.

On Staley's watch, the Gamecocks are enjoying the most sustained success in program history. After posting back-to-back 25-win seasons in 2011-12 and 2012-13 for the first time in more than 30 years, the 2014-15 team broke the school record with 34 wins. South Carolina won more SEC games than the season before in each of her first seven seasons, culminating in the 2015-16 team recording just the second 16-0 conference record in league history. Her Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history after they matched that mark in 2019-20. Staley's 138 SEC wins account for 68.3 percent of the program's total 202 wins over its 28 seasons in the league. She has delivered the only five SEC championships in program history, and she has helped the Gamecocks to nine of the program's 10 top-four finishes in the league.
