## ABOUT TODAY'S GAME

- While LSU holds a 22-14 edge in the all-time series, the Gamecocks have won the last 10 meetings an are 11-5 against the Tigers in the Dawn Staley era including a 4-3 record at the Maravich Center.
- South Carolina is looking for its 23 rd straight SEC regular-season victory tonight. Its longest SEC win streak is 24 games - Jan. 3, 2016 through Jan. 26, 2017. Including three wins in the 2020 SEC Tournament, the Gamecocks have defeated an SEC opponent 25 straight games.
- Today's game pits the SEC's to longest-tenured Black female head coaches against each other with Staley in her 13th season at South Carolina and Nikki Fargas in her 10th at LSU. They are the second and third longest tenured active coaches in the league, trailing Gary Blair. in his 18th season at Texas A\&M.


## GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- The Gamecocks have been ranked in the top five of the last 24 AP Polls, marking the longest active such streak in the country.
- While the South Carolina offense gets a bulk of the headlines, opposing coaches know its the Gamecock defense that can take their team out of the game. South Carolina has allowed SEC opponents just 60.7 points per game this season to rank second in the league. On the season against a schedule that has the highest opponent winning percentage in the country, the Gamecocks are 30th in the country in field goal percentage defense (.352) and 17th in the nation in 3-point percentage defense (.240). South Carolina leads the nation in blocked shots per game (8.2) and averages 16.1 points off 14.6 opponent turnovers per game.
- Unanimous AP Preseason All-American Aliyah Boston's triple-double against Georgia was a performance that had been building since the start of league play. In the Gamecocks' three wins against ranked SEC opponents (at \#10/8 Kentucky, \#15/16 Arkansas, \#22/23 Georgia), the 6 -foot- 5 forward has averaged 20.7 points on 55.8 percent shooting, 13.0 rebounds and 7.7 blocks. On the season, Boston ranks sixth in the country in blocked shots per game (3.3) and 19th in rebounding average (11.1). She averages a double-double on the season (14.4 ppg, 11.1 rpg), in SEC play $(17.3,12.5)$ and against ranked opponents $(15.7,11.3)$
- While Boston gets much of the spotlight, junior Victaria Saxton has put her stamp on the Gamecocks' frontcourt as well. Known as a shot blocker and aggressive rebounder, Saxton's offense has blossomed this season to 10.6 points per game. She has been especially effective recently, ranking third on the team in scoring over the last five games at 12.2 points per game, including her first career 20-point game coming at Vanderbilt (Jan. 14).
- Junior Destanni Henderson is the primary driver of the Gamecocks' high pace this season, even as opponents focus on shutting her down. Her 12.3 points per game are third on the team and she leads the SEC with 5.8 assists per game, including 6.5 in league play. She recorded her first career double-double with 14 points and 10 assists against \#15/16 Arkansas (Jan. 18).
- The Gamecocks have taken full advantage of the versatility of senior LeLe Grissett with Staley playing her everywhere on the court, including honing her point guard skills. While she is learning to run the team from that spot, Grissett has been taking advantage of her size and ability to work down low to rank fifth in the SEC with 3.0 offensive rebounds per league game.

## Five-Second Count

South Carolina women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful era, claiming at least 20 wins for the last nine seasons, including four 30 -win seasons in the last six campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in the NCAA Elite Eight three times in the last five NCAA Tournaments, including winning the 2017 National Championship, and have been ranked in the AP Top 25 for 160 consecutive weeks, Staley led the Gamecocks to their only No. 1 rankings in program history (12 weeks in 2014-15, 10 weeks in 2019-20, 2 weeks in 2020-21), five SEC regularseason titles and five SEC Tournament championships.

Under Staley's leadership, six Gamecocks have earned All-America status, two have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 19 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once. Eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five years, including 2018 No. 1 overall pick A'ja Wilson, who went on to become the Gamecocks' second-straight WNBA Rookie of the Year (2018) and the program's first WNBA MVP (2020).

## LSU Series Notes

The Tigers hold a 22-14 edge in the overall series, but the Gamecocks have won the last 10 meetings and are 11-5 against LSU in the Dawn Staley era.

In last season's 63-48 win at Colonial Life Arena (Feb. 20), then-No. 1 South Carolina dominated the first and third quarters with 60.0 and 72.7 percent shooting, respectively, to tame the Tigers.

In their last visit to the Peter Maravich Center, the Gamecocks posted a 76-53 win (Jan. 13). Only three current Gamecocks played in that game - LeLe Grissett (5 pts, 9 rebs), Victaria Saxton (5 pts, 4 rebs) and Destanni Henderson (2 pts, 1 asst).

## Road Ready

The Gamecocks are 274-256 all-time in road games, including a 99-42 mark under head coach Dawn Staley. Staley's 702 winning percentage on the road is the best of the Gamecocks' seven head coaches all-time.

In SEC road games, Gamecocks are 68-30 (.694) during Staley's tenure.

## WHAT MATTERS

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley picked "What Matters" as this season's theme, reflecting the value of knowing what matters most to you your why - and how focusing on that provides a navigational guide through challenging times.

Each Gamecock wrote her own personal statement of "What Matters" to her. Pieces of each statement were blended together as a script for the video that launched the team.

## Ranked Readings

South Carolina is $81-62$ against nationally ranked opponents under head coach Dawn Staley, although that record is skewed by the early seasons of her tenure. The Gamecocks are 66-23 (.742) versus ranked foes since the start of the 2014-15 campaign, including a 24-17 mark against top-10 opponents during that time.

This season, the Gamecocks are 5-1 against ranked opponents.

## Schedule Strength

The Gamecocks leads nation in past opponents' winning percentage (.782) and in all opponents' winning percentage (.746).

With a 5-1 record against ranked opponents and 7-1 against NET top-30 teams. South Carolina and Texas A\&M are tied for the most wins over ranked opponents this season with five each.

The Gamecocks' 22-game schedule includes nine games against teams ranked in the most recent AP Top 25 and/or USA Today Coaches' Poll.

## Ranking Review

The Gamecocks are ranked No. 4 in the AP Poll and No. 3 in the USA Today Coaches' Poll, moving up a spot in each for the first time in six weeks.

Ranked in the AP Top 25 for the last 160 consecutive weeks, South Carolina has the fourth-longest active streak

in the nation. With 24 consecutive appearances in the top five of the AP Poll, the Gamecocks have the longest active streak of top-five showings in the nation.

## Staley's Stand

In her 21st season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .732 (488-179) winning percentage, which ranks 13th in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 seasons of experience (sixth among Power 5 conference coaches). The unanimous 2020 National Coach of the Year, she became the first person to win both a Naismith Player of the Year Trophy and a Naismith Coach of the Year Trophy.

Leading the Gamecocks for the 13th season, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (316) with a program-record nine postseason appearances (8 NCAA/1 WNIT). She accounts for both of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances $(2015,2017)$ and the first national championship in program history.

After winning five SEC regular-season titles, Staley has won 144 SEC games to rank second among active league coaches (Gary Blair, Texas A\&M, 145) and fourth all-time. Entering this season, her 11.5 SEC wins average is the best alltime among coaches with at least 10 seasons in the league, and her .735 SEC winning percentage (144-52) is second only to Tennessee's Pat Summitt (.874) in league history.

## Preseason Props

After ending the shortened 2019-20 season at No. 1, the Gamecocks opened 2020-21 in that spot on every
preseason poll. It marked the first preseason No. 1 ranking for the program.

SEC coaches and media were unanimous in their pick of the Gamecocks to repeat as SEC regular-season champion this season.

Individually, trio of Gamecocks collected preseason honors from league and national affiliations.

Sophomore Aliyah Boston led the way as an AP Preseason All-American, Naismith Wade and Wooden Watch Lists member, All-SEC First-Team selection by both the coaches and media and recognition on the Lisa Leslie Award watch list.

Sophomore Zia Cooke received similar national recognition, earning spots on the watch lists for the Naismith, Wade and Wooden Awards and the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award. She was an All-SEC Preseason SecondTeam selection by the league's coaches.

Sophomore Brea Beal broke through on the national scene as a member of the Cheryl Miller Small Forward of the Year Award watch list.

## Triple Threat

Not only has unanimous AP Preseason All-American Aliyah Boston added a 3-point shot to her arsenal (7-of-21 from beyond the arc), she is constantly a threat to post a triple-double.

With her 16 points, 11 rebounds and 10 blocks against \#22/23 Georgia, she became the first Gamecock to record a triple-double against an SEC opponent and against a

## Quarter Breakdown

The Gamecocks have been most impressive in the third quarter, averaging 25.6 points on 52.6 percent shooting to out-score opponents by 9.2 points. Five of their eight 30-point quarters have come in the third period.

Their next most productive quarter is the first - 21.1 points per first quarter on 46.1 percent shooting and a 7.1 scoring average advantage.

## Boardroom

Rebounding is one stat most coaches will say is defined by effort. For the Gamecocks, that effort comes from every position on the court.

South Carolina opened the season with a Staley-era record 73 rebounds against Charleston (Nov. 25) and leads the nation in rebounds per game (51.8) and is second in rebounding margin at an SEC-best +19.1 .

The Gamecocks have not been out-rebounded this season and have a +14.0 rebounding margin in their six games against ranked opponents. South Carolina is second in the nation in offensive rebounding (18.6) and averages 19.0 second-chance points. The Gamecocks are cleaning up an SEC-best 46.4 percent of their own missed shots, including 46.7 percent in SEC games.

Starting forwards Aliyah Boston (11.1) and Victaria Saxton (6.4) lead the way on the glass, ranking second and 18th in the SEC, respectively. In SEC play, Boston's rebounding average improves to an SEC-best 12.5.

## Block Party

South Carolina is annually among the best shot blocking teams in the country, and the 2020-21 edition is no different as the Gamecocks lead the country with 8.2 blocks per game, including 9.5 in SEC play.

Nine different Gamecocks have blocked at least one shot with three ranking among the SEC's top 10.

Aliyah Boston has been on a tear since the holiday break, averaging an SEC-best 5.5 blocks in league games
to move into sixth in the country with 3.3 blocks per game on the season.

Victaria Saxton is next in line with 1.9 blocks per game to rank third in the SEC, and Laeticia Amihere's 1.4 are eighth.

## Free for All

The Gamecocks continue to get to the free throw line at one of the highest rates in the country. South Carolina's 294 trips to the line are fifth in the nation and trail just Arkansas (392) among SEC teams.
Zia Cooke leads the parade to the free throw line with 46 attempts this season, shooting 78.3 percent from the stripe, which ranks 10th in the SEC. Destanni Henderson's 78.9 percent free throw shooting leads the team and is eighth in the conference.

## They Got Next

The Gamecocks signed the No. 1 recruiting class in the country in November as Staley and her staff added four from the Class of 2021. All four are ranked among the top 14 players in the class, including the Nos. 2, 3 and 4 entries.

In women's basketball, Colonial Life Arena has become one of the most feared places to play as enormous crowds fill the building with passion for the Gamecocks.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last six seasons. The Gamecocks were one of a few programs to finish the season averaging over 10,000 fans and boast five sellouts $(18,000)$ in the last five seasons.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest oncampus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300 . The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of $\$ 4.2$ million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately $12^{\prime} \times 20^{\prime}$ and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.

Catapulting South Carolina into the national spotlight, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. In 2017-18, she capped her first decade in Garnet and Black by leading her team to its fourth-straight SEC Tournament title, the first four-peat champion in league history, and celebrating the program's first National Player of the Year and No. 1 WNBA Draft pick in A'ja Wilson. Staley's staff has signed two No. 1 recruiting classes in the last three seasons $(2019,2021)$ and finished the 2019-20 season as the unanimous No. 1 team in the country.

Staley's 12 seasons at the helm of the Gamecocks include:

- 2017 NCAA National Championship
- 160 consecutive weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 , including 89 weeks in the top five
- Eight 25-win seasons, including four 30-win campaigns led by a school-record 34 victories in 2014-15
- Five SEC regular-season championships $(2014,2015,2016,2017,2020)$
- Five SEC Tournament titles $(2015,2016,2017,2018,2020)$
- Six NCAA Attendance titles, averaging over 10,000 fans each season (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020)

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012.

In her 21st season as a head coach, Staley has led her teams to 1025 -win seasons, a total of 16 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 113 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 24 in the No. 1 spot. Also a force in USA Basketball, she was named the U.S. Women's National Team head coach for 2017-21, already leading the U.S. to 2018 FIBA World Cup gold to earn USAB National Coach of the Year honors. Prior to that appointment, Staley led three other U.S. teams to gold medals - 2015 FIBA U19 World Championships, 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship, 2007 Pan Am Games - and served as an assistant on the Senior National Team 2006-08 and again 2014-16, during which the U.S. claimed gold in the 2014 FIBA World Championship and the 2008 and 2016 Olympics.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last 12 seasons, Staley has twice been named National Coach of the Year $(2014,2020)$ with her 2020 unanimous selection making her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award. She is a four-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the only Gamecock basketball coach - men's or women's - to amass 300 victories at South Carolina and became the fastest coach to 200 wins in program history, needing just 277 games at South Carolina to reach the plateau.

Staley has coached a National Player of the Year (A'ja Wilson, 2018) and a National Freshman of the Year (Aliyah Boston, 2020). Under her leadership, Six Gamecocks have collected 12 All-America selections, two have picked up five SEC Player of the Year honors, three have earned SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognition a total of four times, one has been the SEC 6th Player of the Year and six were named SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 17 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors a combined 32 times, including 14 first-team selections, and eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five seasons, including 2018 No. 1 pick A'ja Wilson who went on to earn WNBA Rookie of the Year honors a year after Allisha Gray became the first Gamecock to capture the honor in 2017. Two other Gamecock draftees earned WNBA All-Rookie Team honors as well.

On Staley's watch, the Gamecocks are enjoying the most sustained success in program history. After posting back-to-back 25-win seasons in 2011-12 and 2012-13 for the first time in more than 30 years, the 2014-15 team broke the school record with 34 wins. South Carolina won more SEC games than the season before in each of her first seven seasons, culminating in the 2015-16 team recording just the second 16-0 conference record in league history. Her Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history after they matched that mark in 2019-20. Staley's 138 SEC wins account for 68.3 percent of the program's total 202 wins over its 28 seasons in the league. She has delivered the only five SEC championships in program history, and she has helped the Gamecocks to nine of the program's 10 top-four finishes in the league.
