### ABOUT TODAY'S GAME

- Vanderbilt leads the all-time series 21-18, but the Gamecocks have a 13-2 edge in the Dawn Staley era, including the current 12-game win streak over Vanderbilt.
- The Gamecocks are looking to open SEC play 4-0 for the third-straight season. After last season's 16-0 SEC slate, South Carolina has won 19 straight regular-season league games. Their longest SEC win streak is 24 games – Jan. 3, 2016, through Jan. 26, 2017.
- A win today would be Dawn Staley's 142nd in SEC regular-season action, moving her into soul possession of fourth place all-time in most SEC regular-season victories. It would break her current tied with her former Olympic head coach Van Chancellor who amasses 141 wins in 20 seasons at Ole Miss and LSU combined. Third place is owned by Texas A&M head coach Gary

#### GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- Unanimous AP Preseason All-American Aliyah Boston continues to be a force in SEC action. She needed just 25 minutes at #10/8 Kentucky on Sunday to post a near triple-double with 20 points, 12 rebounds and seven blocked shots. The effort earned her SEC co-Player of the Week honors and catapulted her up the league standings. In SEC play, she is ninth in scoring (17.7), third in rebounds (12.7) and first in blocked shots (4.3). Her 2.7 steals per SEC game are good for sixth in the league, and she is pulling down 4.3 offensive rebounds per league game to rank second in the conference.
- Junior point guard Destanni Henderson is beginning to stamp her authority on the Gamecocks, and outside observers are beginning to recognize the quiet floor general. In SEC action, she is third on the team and 19th in the league with 14.7 ppg, leads the team and is second in the SEC with 5.7 apg, and her 7.7 rebounds per game are second on the team and 14th in the conference. She joins Kentucky's Rhyne Howard and Tennessee's Rennia Davis as the only three players in the SEC to rank among the league's top 15 in both assists and rebounds per game. She has scored 20 or more points three times this season, including the last two outings.
- Sophomore Zia Cooke has provided a bulk of the Gamecocks' offensive firepower this season, ranking ninth in the league with 17.4 points per game this season. Even in a tough shooting game at #10/8 Kentucky Sunday, in the final minute of a three-point game, she came up with a pair of defensive rebounds and game-sealing free throws.

Just two of the 12 wins in South Carolina's' current streak against Vanderbilt have been decided by single digits.

Four Gamecocks average double-figure points in SEC action, led by Aliyah Boston (17.7) and Zia Cooke (17.0), who rank 9th and 11th in the league, respectively.

South Carolina guards have out-scored their forward teammates in the paint seven times in nine games this season.

The Gamecocks have limited their opponents to just 21.9 percent from the 3-pont line to rank seventh in the country in 3-point percentage defense.

South Carolina is rebounding 48.1 percent of its own missed shots in SEC play and averages 20.0 second-chance points against league foes.

The Gamecocks scored 56 of their 75 points at Kentucky in the paint, their hightest number in SEC play this season.

#### **Five-Second Count**

South Carolina women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful era, claiming at least 20 wins for the last nine seasons, including four 30-win seasons in the last six campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in the NCAA Elite Eight three times in the last five NCAA Tournaments, including winning the 2017 National Championship, and have been ranked in the AP Top 25 for 159 consecutive weeks, Staley led the Gamecocks to their only No. 1 rankings in program history (12 weeks in 2014-15, 10 weeks in 2019-20, 2 weeks in 2020-21), five SEC regular-season titles and five SEC Tournament championships.

Under Staley's leadership, six Gamecocks have earned All-America status, two have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 19 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once. Eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five years, including 2018 No. 1 overall pick A'ja Wilson, who went on to become the Gamecocks' second-straight WNBA Rookie of the Year (2018) and the program's first WNBA MVP (2020).

#### **Vanderbilt Series Notes**

The Commodores lead the all-time series 21-18, but the Gamecocks have won the last 12, including a sweep of last season's series by an average of 43.5 points. Dawn Staley's Gamecocks are 13-2 against Vanderbilt in her tenure in Columbia.

The Jan. 12, 2020, meeting in Memorial Gymnasium saw the Gamecocks dominate the first quarter defensively, allowing Vanderbilt just nine points, and the third quarter offensively, scoring 36 points on 75.0 percent shooting in the period. Five Gamecocks finished in double figures, including three then-freshmen Zia Cooke (17), Laeticia Amihere (11) and Aliyah Boston (10).

### **Road Ready**

The Gamecocks are 273-256 all-time in road games, including a 98-42 mark under head coach Dawn Staley. Staley's .700 winning percentage on the road is the best of the Gamecocks' seven head coaches all-time.

In SEC road games, Gamecocks are 67-30 (.691) during Staley's tenure.

#### **Ranking Review**

The Gamecocks are ranked No. 5 in the AP Poll and No. 4 in the USA Today Coaches' Poll for the sixth-straight week.

### WHAT MATTERS

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley picked "What Matters" as this season's theme, reflecting the value of knowing what matters most to you – your why – and how focusing on that provides a navigational guide through challenging times.

Each Gamecock wrote her own personal statement of "What Matters" to her. Pieces of each statement were blended together as a script for the video that launched the team.

That video and each Gamecocks' personal "What Matters" statement can be found at GamecocksOnline. com/WhatMatters.

Ranked in the AP Top 25 for the last 159 consecutive weeks, South Carolina has the fourth-longest active streak in the nation. With 2243 consecutive appearances in the top five of the AP Poll, the Gamecocks have the longest active streak of top-five showings in the nation.

### Schedule Strength

The Gamecocks second in the nation in past opponents' winning percentage (.839), trailing just Lafayette whose previous two opponents are undefeated this season, and in all opponents' winning percentage (.787).

With a 3-1 record against ranked opponents, South Carolina is one of five AP Top-25 teams with at least three wins over ranked foes this season.

The Gamecocks' 23-game schedule includes nine games against teams ranked in the most recent AP Top 25 and USA Today Coaches' Poll.

#### Staley's Stand

In her 21st season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .730 (485-179) winning percentage, which ranks 13th in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 seasons of experience (sixth among Power 5 conference coaches). The unanimous 2020 National Coach of the Year, she became the first person to win both a Naismith Player of the Year Trophy and a Naismith Coach of the Year Trophy.

Leading the Gamecocks for the 13th season, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (313) with a program-record nine postseason appearances (8 NCAA/1 WNIT). She accounts for both of the Gamecocks' Final

Four appearances (2015, 2017) and the first national championship in program history.

After winning five SEC regular-season titles, Staley has won 141 SEC games to rank second among active league coaches (Gary Blair, Texas A&M, 144) and tied for fourth alltime. Entering this season, her 11.5 SEC wins average is the best all-time among coaches with at least 10 seasons in the league, and her .731 SEC winning percentage (141-52) is second only to Tennessee's Pat Summitt (.874) in league history.

#### **Preseason Props**

After ending the shortened 2019-20 season at No. 1. the Gamecocks opened 2020-21 in that spot on every preseason poll. It marked the first preseason No. 1 ranking for the program.

SEC coaches and media were unanimous in their pick of the Gamecocks to repeat as SEC regular-season champion this season.

Individually, trio of Gamecocks collected preseason honors from league and national affiliations.

Sophomore Aliyah Boston led the way as an AP Preseason All-American, Naismith Wade and Wooden Watch Lists member, All-SEC First-Team selection by both the coaches and media and recognition on the Lisa Leslie Award watch list.

Sophomore Zia Cooke received similar national recognition, earning spots on the watch lists for the Naismith, Wade and Wooden Awards and the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award. She was an All-SEC Preseason Second-Team selection by the league's coaches.

Sophomore Brea Beal broke through on the national scene as a member of the Cheryl Miller Small Forward of the Year Award watch list

#### Oh Captain, My Captain

South Carolina named two team captains this season – Aliyah Boston and Victaria Saxton. It is the second season that Saxton has been a team captain.

#### **Quarter Breakdown**

The Gamecocks have been most impressive in the third quarter, averaging 25.0 points on 51.1 percent shooting to out-score opponents by an average of 8.4 points. Four of their six 30-point quarters have come in the third period.

Their next most productive quarter is the first – 20.3 points per first quarter on 44.7 percent shooting and a 6.1 scoring average advantage.

#### Boardroom

Rebounding is one stat most coaches will say is defined by effort. For the Gamecocks, that effort comes from every position on the court.

South Carolina opened the season with a Staley-era record 73 rebounds against Charleston (Nov. 25) and boasts the third-best rebounding margin in the country at

The Gamecock have serious speed in the open court. Laeticia Amihere registered the fastest 3/4-court sprint time at 2.96 seconds. Brea Beal, Zia Cooke, and Destanni Henderson all registered times between 3.1 and 3.15 seconds

#### **Power**

7 of 11 Gamecocks have a standing, two-foot vertical jump over 25 inches with Victaria Saxton leading the way at 29 inches. She can also touch 10-foot-5.

Amihere has a 27.9-inch vertical jump (a 6-inch improvement from last season) and can touch 10-foot-9.

Henderson improved her vertical jump from 24 inches to 27 inches this season.

6 Gamecocks have broad jumps greater than eight feet with Saxton leading at 9-foot-1.

#### **Block Party**

South Carolina is annually among the best shot blocking teams in the country, and the 2020-21 edition is no different as the Gamecocks are third in the country with an SEC-best 7.2 blocks per game.

Nine different Gamecocks have blocked at least one shot with three ranking among the SEC's top 15.

With 16 blocks in the last four games, Aliyah Boston is second in the conference and 29th in the nation with 2.2 blocks per game on the season.

Victaria  $\bar{S}$ axton is just behind with 2.1 blocks per game to rank third in the SEC, and Laeticia Amihere's 1.1 blocks per game are 14th.

#### Free for All

The Gamecocks continue to get to the free throw line at one of the highest rates in the country. South Carolina's 24.8 free throw attempts per game are sixth the nation. In the SEC, the Gamecocks are behind only Arkansas, which goes to the line 25.1 times per game.

Zia Cooke leads the parade to the free throw line with 38 attempts this season, shooting 76.3 percent from the stripe, which ranks 12th in the SEC. Destanni Henderson's 77.1 percent free throw shooting leads the team and is ninth in the conference.

#### **Everybody's All-American**

Of the 11 Gamecocks on the 2020-21 roster, six were McDonald's All-Americans in high school – Brea Beal, Aliyah Boston, Zia Cooke, Destanni Henderson, Destiny Littleton and Eniya Russell.

At South Carolina, Staley has coached 13 McDonald's All-Americans, including 10 who joined the Gamecocks as freshmen.

#### **Great Gamecock Fans**

South Carolina has led the nation in attendance for the last six seasons, averaging at least 11,000 fans in each of those campaigns.

While the 2020-21 season will see far fewer fans in the stands around the nation due to restrictions in place to mitigate the COVID-19 pandemic, the Gamecocks still expect to be among the nation's leaders in attendance based on the fact that Colonial Life Arena, which has a maximum capacity of 3,500 under the restrictions, is among the largest arenas in women's college basketball.

With paid attendance of 3,500 at each of the first four home games, South Carolina holds the three highest attendance games of the season.

#### They Got Next

The Gamecocks signed the No. 1 recruiting class in the country in November as Staley and her staff added four signees from the Class of 2021. All four are ranked among the top 14 players in the class, including the Nos. 2, 3 and 4 entries.

In women's basketball, Colonial Life Arena has become one of the most feared places to play as enormous crowds fill the building with passion for the Gamecocks.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last six seasons. The Gamecocks were one of a few programs to finish the season averaging over 10,000 fans and boast five sellouts (18,000) in the last five seasons.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest on-campus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300. The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of \$4.2 million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately 12' x 20' and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.

# **Head Coach**

13th Season at South Carolina

Catapulting South Carolina into the national spotlight, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. In 2017-18, she capped her first decade in Garnet and Black by leading her team to its fourth-straight SEC Tournament title, the first four-peat champion in league history, and celebrating the program's first National Player of the Year and No. 1 WNBA Draft pick in A'ja Wilson. Staley's staff has signed two No. 1 recruiting classes in the last three seasons (2019, 2021) and finished the 2019-20 season as the unanimous No. 1 team in the country.

Staley's 12 seasons at the helm of the Gamecocks include:

- 2017 NCAA National Championship
- 159 consecutive weeks ranked in the AP Top 25, including 88 weeks in the top five
- Eight 25-win seasons, including four 30-win campaigns led by a school-record 34 victories in 2014-15
- Five SEC regular-season championships (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2020)
- Five SEC Tournament titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2020)
- Six NCAA Attendance titles, averaging over 10,000 fans each season (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020)

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012.

In her 21st season as a head coach, Staley has led her teams to  $10\,25$ -win seasons, a total of 16 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 113 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 24 in the No. 1 spot. Also a force in USA Basketball, she was named the U.S. Women's National Team head coach for 2017-21, already leading the U.S. to 2018 FIBA World Cup gold to earn USAB National Coach of the Year honors. Prior to that appointment, Staley led three other U.S. teams to gold medals – 2015 FIBA U19 World Championships, 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship, 2007 Pan Am Games – and served as an assistant on the Senior National Team 2006-08 and again 2014-16, during which the U.S. claimed gold in the 2014 FIBA World Championship and the 2008 and 2016 Olympics.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last 12 seasons, Staley has twice been named National Coach of the Year (2014, 2020) with her 2020 unanimous selection making her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award. She is a four-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the only Gamecock basketball coach – men's or women's – to amass 300 victories at South Carolina and became the fastest coach to 200 wins in program history, needing just 277 games at South Carolina to reach the plateau.

Staley has coached a National Player of the Year (A'ja Wilson, 2018) and a National Freshman of the Year (Aliyah Boston, 2020). Under her leadership, Six Gamecocks have collected 12 All-America selections, two have picked up five SEC Player of the Year honors, three have earned SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognition a total of four times, one has been the SEC 6th Player of the Year and six were named SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 17 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors a combined 32 times, including 14 first-team selections, and eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five seasons, including 2018 No. 1 pick A'ja Wilson who went on to earn WNBA Rookie of the Year honors a year after Allisha Gray became the first Gamecock to capture the honor in 2017. Two other Gamecock draftees earned WNBA All-Rookie Team honors as well.

On Staley's watch, the Gamecocks are enjoying the most sustained success in program history. After posting back-to-back 25-win seasons in 2011-12 and 2012-13 for the first time in more than 30 years, the 2014-15 team broke the school record with 34 wins. South Carolina won more SEC games than the season before in each of her first seven seasons, culminating in the 2015-16 team recording just the second 16-0 conference record in league history. Her Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history after they matched that mark in 2019-20. Staley's 138 SEC wins account for 68.3 percent of the program's total 202 wins over its 28 seasons in the league. She has delivered the only five SEC championships in program history, and she has helped the Gamecocks to nine of the program's 10 top-four finishes in the league.


