GAMECOCKS IN THE SEC TOURNAMENT

- The Gamecocks are 24-24 all-time in SEC Tournament action, including a 21-7 mark under head coach Dawn Staley.
- The 2020 SEC Tournament champion, South Carolina has won five of the last six tournament titles and is the only team in league history to win four consecutive titles at the event (2015-18). Under Staley, the Gamecocks are 5-2 in SEC Tournament semifinal games.
- - South Carolina is 7-2 in SEC Tournament games played in Greenville and won two of their five titles in Bon Secours Wellness Arena (2017, 2020).
- The Gamecocks are 4-2 all-time when playing the tournament as the No. 2 seed, including three wins en route to the 2018 title. They were also seeded second in 2002 and 2019.
- South Carolina is 2-3 against Tennessee in the SEC Tournament, but the Gamecocks have won the last two meetings at the event - 2015 Championship Game (62-46), 2018 Quarterfinals (73-62).

GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- While the Lady Vols claimed the regular-season meeting between the two teams, South Carolina has won three of the last four outings against Tennessee and each of the last two SEC Tournament matchups.
- Friday night against Alabama, South Carolina turned nine offensive rebounds into 16 secondchance points. On the season, the Gamecocks, who rank fifth in the nation in offensive rebounds per game (16.7), average 1.03 points per offensive rebound while limiting opponents to just .83 points per offensive rebound.
- The Gamecocks' ball movement Friday night helped their field goal percentage skyrocket. South Carolina shot 48.4 percent from the field with 14 assists, their highest numbers in both areas since shooting 49.2 percent with 15 assists at Auburn on Feb. 4.
- Junior point guard Destanni Henderson continues to thrive in the SEC Tournament, following up her 2020 All-Tournament selection with 18 points and five assists Friday night. Over the last two tournament, Henderson is averaging 14.3 point and 4.8 assists, shooting 54.8 percent (23-40) from the field
- Alivah Boston's rebounding dominance in the SEC Tournament as she is pulling in 11.8 rebounds per career game at the event, in addition to shooting 52.9 percent from the field (18-34). Boston has two double-doubles in four career SEC Tournament games.
- Sophomore guard Zia Cooke has a team-high five 20-point games this season, including in two of her last four outings to average 18.9 points in that stretch. Her game-high 22 points against Alabama Friday night marked her first 20-point game in an SEC Tournament.
- In just her sophomore season, Aliyah Boston already ranks 10th on the SEC active career rebounding list (592) and fourth on the blocks list (154). Her block total ranks sixth in Gamecock history, and her 68 blocks this season are eight in the program's single-season record book. Boston's 26 career double-doubles are 10th in school history, and with 16 of them coming in SEC regular-season play, she is third in program history, trailing just Alaina Coates (27) and A'ja Wilson (21).
- Destanni Henderson's three 3-pointers Friday night against Alabama was her fifth such game this season and her second 3-of-3 outside shooting night of 2020-21. She is the team's most accurate 3-point shooter at 44.3 percent.

South Carolina has won three of the last four meeting against Tennessee.

The Gamecocks have 20 wins in a season for the 10th time in the 13 seasons of the Dawn Staley era.



Aliyah Boston has pulled down double-digit rebounds 17 times through 24 games this season.

South Carolina has scored 56.0 percent of its 77.6 points per game this season in the paint.

The Gamecocks' 71.4 field goal shooting in the first quarter against Alabama was their highest in a quarter since the season opener vs. College of Charleston.

Five-Second Count

South Carolina women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful era, claiming at least 20 wins for the last nine seasons, including four 30-win seasons in the last six campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in the NCAA Elite Eight three times in the last five NCAA Tournaments, including winning the 2017 National Championship, and have been ranked in the AP Top 25 for 166 consecutive weeks, including 35 straight weeks in the top 10. Staley has led the Gamecocks to their only No. 1 rankings in program history (12 weeks in 2014-15, 10 weeks in 2019-20, 3 weeks in 2020-21), five SEC regular-season titles and five SEC Tournament championships.

Under Staley's leadership, six Gamecocks have earned All-America status, two have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 20 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once. Eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five years, including 2018 No. 1 overall pick A'ja Wilson, who went on to become the Gamecocks' second-straight WNBA Rookie of the Year (2018) and the program's first WNBA MVP (2020).

Tennessee Series Notes

South Carolina has won six of the last 10 meetings, including three of the last four, leaving the series record 49-8 in favor of the Lady Vols.

In their regular-season meeting on Feb. 18, the Gamecocks dominated the second quarter to take a 37-25 lead into halftime. The Lady Vols rallied back in the third then tied the game at 62-62 with 5:36 to play, holding on for the 75-67 victory at Thompson-Boling Arena.

Neutral Stance

The Gamecocks are 138-93 (.597) all-time on a neutral court. South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley is 55-25 in games played at neutral sites, including a 32-14 mark in postseason action.

SEC Tournament Take

South Carolina is 24-24 all-time in the SEC Tournament since joining the league for the 1991-92 season. In her 13th trip to the event, head coach Dawn Staley is 21-7 with five championships, all coming in the last six years. South Carolina is 7-2 in SEC Tournament games in Greenville, home of the 2005, 2017, 2019, 2020 and 2021 events.

The Gamecocks have reached the tournament semifinals seven times in the last eight seasons and have won the tournament in each of their five trips to the

championship game. With titles in 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018, South Carolina is the only program in league history to win four consecutive SEC Tournament title, and the Gamecocks added another one in 2020.

Ranked Readings

South Carolina is 83-66 against nationally ranked opponents under head coach Dawn Staley, although that record is skewed by the early seasons of her tenure. The Gamecocks are 68-26 (.723) versus ranked foes since the start of the 2014-15 campaign, including a 24-19 mark against top-10 opponents during that time.

With a 7-4 record against ranked opponents season, the Gamecocks are second in the nation in wins over ranked opponents, trailing just Texas A&M's nine victories.

Schedule Strength

The Gamecocks lead the country in opponents' winning percentage (.671) and South Carolina's 11 games against nationally ranked opponents tied with Kentucky for the most in the country.

Ranking Review

The Gamecocks are No. 7 in both polls this week.

Ranked in the AP Top 25 for the last 166 consecutive weeks, South Carolina has the fourth-longest active streak in the nation. With 35 consecutive appearances in the top 10 of the AP Poll, the Gamecocks have the fifth-longest active streak of top-10 showings in the nation.

Staley's Stand

In her 21st season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .732 (497-182) winning percentage, which ranks 13th in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10

seasons of experience (sixth among Power 5 conference coaches). The unanimous 2020 National Coach of the Year, she became the first person to win both a Naismith Player of the Year Trophy and a Naismith Coach of the Year Trophy.

Leading the Gamecocks for the 13th season, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (325) with a program-record nine postseason appearances (8 NCAA/1 WNIT). She accounts for both of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances (2015, 2017) and the first national championship in program history.

After winning five SEC regular-season titles, Staley has won 152 SEC games to rank second among active league coaches (Gary Blair, Texas A&M, 154) and fourth all-time. Her 11.7 SEC wins average is the best in league history, and her .738 SEC winning percentage (152-54) is second only to Tennessee's Pat Summitt (.874) in league history.

Awards Season

South Carolina's awards season got off to a solid start this week with Aliyah Boston repeating as SEC Defensive Player of the Year, sharing the honor this season. Zia Cooke joined Boston on the All-SEC First Team, making it the second-straight season of multiple Gamecocks making that team and Boston's second first-team selection in as many seasons.

Boston has been named a semifinalist for the Naismith Trophy and the Naismith Defensive Player of the Year award, and she is on the Wooden Award National Ballot. She was named to the Lisa Leslie Award Top 5 as well.

Cooke is a finalist for the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award. She and Destanni Henderson are on The Dawn Staley Award Midseason Watch List.

For the Record

In closing out SEC regular-season play, the Gamecocks reset several program records for league games. Not surprisingly, the program record for rebounds per SEC game was raised to 47.2, and the record for rebounding margin in SEC games increased to 14.4.

Aliyah Boston now holds four program SEC-season records – rebounds (196), offensive rebounds (62), blocks (57) and blocks average (3.6). Her 93 career blocks in SEC games are already second and her 16 career doubledoubles vs. SEC teams are third.

Destanni Henderson's 89 assists in SEC games this season were fourth in program history, and her 551 minutes played vs. SEC teams is third. **Historic Boston**

With her 16 points, 11 rebounds and 10 blocks against #22/23 Georgia (Jan. 21), Unanimous AP Preseason All-American Aliyah Boston became the first Gamecock to record a triple-double against an SEC opponent and against a ranked opponent. Hers was just the seventh triple-double in an SEC regular-season game in league history; it was just the second that included blocked shots

Boston is also the first in Gamecock history to record multiple triple-doubles in her career, joining just two other SEC players in that category in league history. She is the first to do it with blocked shots.

Boston's 26 double-doubles in 57 career games are ninth in program history. Including nine this season, 16 of those 26 have come in SEC play, which is the third-most in program history, trailing only A'ja Wilson (2015-18) with 21 and Alaina Coates (2014-17) with 27. Thirteen of the 26 have been against ranked teams, including six this season.

In just her 47th career game, Boston reached the program's career top 10 in blocked shots (130), hitting the mark 11 games faster than record-holder A'ja Wilson, who finished her career with 363 blocks in 138 games. Boston is currently sixth with 154 career blocks, 10 away from Elem Ibiam (2012-15) in fifth place.

Boardroom

South Carolina opened the season with a Staley-era record 73 rebounds against Charleston (Nov. 25) and hasn't looked back. The Gamecocks are second in the nation in rebounds per game (48.2) and third in rebound margin at an SEC-best +15.3 advantage.

The Gamecocks have not been out-rebounded this season and have a +12.1 rebounding margin in their 11 games against ranked opponents. South Carolina is third in the nation in offensive rebounding (16.7) and averages 17.2 second-chance points. The Gamecocks are cleaning up an SEC-best 42.6 percent of their own missed shots, including 42.1 percent in SEC games.

Aliyah Boston leads the way on the glass (11.8 rpg), ranking 12th in the nation and second in the SEC overall and in league games (12.3). Her 3.9 offensive rebounds per game are 18th in the country, second in the SEC.

Junior Victaria Saxton is also among the SEC's top 10 in offensive rebounds per game, ranking seventh (2.8).

Block Party

South Carolina is annually among the best shot blocking teams in the country, and the 2020-21 Gamecocks are no different as they lead the nation with 7.0 blocks per game, including 7.6 in SEC play.

Ten different Gamecocks have at least one block, and, three rank among the league's top 15 in blocks per game.

Aliyah Boston averaged an SEC-best 3.6 blocks in league games to sit at 12th in the country at 2.8 blocks per game on the season. She has 11 games of three or more blocks, including four of five or more.

Victaria Saxton is next in line with 1.5 blocks per game to rank sixth in the SEC, and Laeticia Amihere's 1.0 are 11th.

Free for All

The Gamecocks continue to get to the free throw line at one of the highest rates in the country. South Carolina's 524 trips to the line are seventh in the nation. Its 347 made free throws rank 14th.

Zia Cooke leads the parade to the free throw line with 98 attempts this season, shooting 77.6 percent.

They Got Next

The Gamecocks signed the No. 1 recruiting class in the country in November as Staley and her staff added four from the Class of 2021. All four are ranked among the top 14 players in the class, including the Nos. 2, 3 and 4 entries.
