2020 Season Highlights

- ◆ Shi Smith became the first player in South Carolina history to record back-to-back games with double figures in pass receptions after catching 10 passes against Tennessee and 12 at Florida. The 22 receptions over a two-game stretch is one shy of the school record of 23 receptions in consecutive games, set by Bryan Edwards last season, when he had 14 against Vanderbilt and followed that up with nine against Appalachian State.
- ◆ Carolina defeated #15 Auburn, 30-22, on Oct. 17, earned the Gamecocks' third nationally-ranked win in the last five years, and for the second year in a row. Cornerback Jaycee Horn was named the Walter Camp National Defensive Player of the Week and the Co-SEC Defensive Player of the Week with a pair of interceptions and a deflected pass leading to a third interception. He was credited with four total pass breakups and three tackles. Punter Kai Kroeger was named the SEC Special Teams Player of the Week, averaging 48.4 yards on five punts, with three downed inside the 20-yard line.
- ◆ Senior placekicker Parker White was one of 67 Division I (FBS) student-athletes nominated for the 2020 Burlsworth Trophy. The award is given to the most outstanding football player in America who began his career as a walk-on and has shown outstanding performance on the field.
- ◆ Junior linebacker Ernest Jones was named one of 16 semifinalists for the Butkus Award, honoring the nation's best linebacker.
- ◆ Senior linebacker Spencer Eason-Riddle was named one of 20 semifinalists for the Jason Witten Collegiate Man of the Year Award, given annually to a player based on leadership, both on and off the playing field. Eason-Riddle was also named to the SEC Football Community Service Team.
- ◆ Kevin Harris became the first Gamecock to lead the SEC in rushing yards per game, averaging 113.8 yards against a 10-game slate comprised of all SEC opponents. His 1,138 rushing yards ranked fifth in school history, despite playing just 10 games.
- ◆ Running back Kevin Harris was named first-team All-SEC by the Associated Press, while defensive lineman Kingsley Enagbare was a first-team selection according to the league's coaches. Harris (Coaches), Enagbare (AP) and cornerback Jaycee Horn (Coaches) earned spots on the All-SEC second team.
- ◆ Linebacker Mohamed Kaba and punter Kai Kroeger were named to the Coaches' SEC All-Freshmen squad.
- ◆ Shane Beamer, considered to be one of the rising stars among coaches in college football, was named USC's 36th head football coach on December 6, 2020. Beamer, 43, has been an assistant coach at seven FBS schools for 21 seasons. During his career, he has coached in 17 bowl games, including a CFP National Championship Game, and has posted 18 non-losing seasons, six of those with double-digit victories and his teams have won 62.5 percent of its games. He comes to Columbia from Oklahoma, where he has been the Sooners assistant head coach for offense since 2018, coaching tight ends and H-backs. He was an assistant at South Carolina from 2007-10.
- ◆ Five University of South Carolina football players were invited to the 2021 NFL Scouting Combine. The Gamecock quintet includes Jaycee Horn, Sadarius Hutcherson, Ernest Jones, Israel Mukuamu and Shi Smith. The 2021 NFL Combine took on a different format this year due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Among the alterations will be no in-person workouts at the combine as they will take place at colleges' pro days.

COLUMBIA, S.C. (AP) — Tennessee quarterback Jarrett Guarantano expected a difficult time at South Carolina. He also expected the 16th-ranked Vols to come out on top, no matter how hard things got.

The Vols squandered a two-touchdown lead in the second half and held on to defeat the Gamecocks 31-27 for their seventh straight victory.

The game wasn't decided until a Tennessee punt touched South Carolina's Cam Smith and the Vols' Jimmy Holiday recovered with 1:24 to go.

"When you go on the road in the SEC, nothing comes easy," Guarantano said. "You saw some of that today."

There was also plenty of Guarantano to see, as well. The fifth-year passer threw the tie-breaking touchdown to Josh Palmer with 9:35 left in the game, then stayed poised enough down the stretch to keep South Carolina at bay.

Tennessee looked to have the Southeastern Conference and season opener in hand when they went ahead 21-7 on Eric Gray's 12-yard scoring run on their opening drive of the third quarter.

But South Carolina rallied behind first-time starter quarterback Collin Hill with two touchdowns and a field goal to tie it at 24-all in the fourth quarter.

That's when Guarantano struck with back-to-back big plays for the deciding score.

Guarantano was heavily pressured when he got the ball to an all-alone Brandon Johnson for 33 yards inside South Carolina territory. The next play, Guarantano threw a picture perfect pass to Palmer for a 32-yard touchdown.

Palmer was grateful Guarantano trusted him with the play. "But it was just a traditional go route, beat the defender and caught it over the shoulder," he said.

South Carolina looked like it had a final chance when it forced a Tennessee punt with 90 seconds left. But the punt touched Cam Smith after it hit the ground, Holiday recovered and the Vols ran out the clock for the win.

Guarantano finished 19 of 31 for 259 yards. He also rushed for Tennessee's first touchdown.

South Carolina, with a new offensive coordinator in ex-Colorado State coach Mike Bobo and new quarterback in grad transfer Hill, showed some spark as it took the opening drive 75 yards for a touchdown on Kevin Harris' 3-yard run.

Linebacker Henry To'o To'o had a 32-yard interception return for a touchdown, catching the ball after it bounced off receiver Shi Smith's hands and tip-toeing down the sideline for the score.

Hill finished 25 of 39 passing for 290 yards and a touchdown. Smith had 10 catches for 140 yards for the Gamecocks.

Hill blamed himself for the interception, throwing the ball behind Smith where To'o To'o could make the defensive play.

"The play that sticks out to me is the pick six," Hill said. "You just can't turn the ball over."

GAME CHANGER

South Carolina was looking to get the ball back with a chance to win the game with a successful two-minute drill, but a fumble on a punt return gave the Volunteers the ball and clinched a 31-27 victory over the Gamecocks in both team's season opener.

KEY STAT

140 – Shi Smith had his second consecutive 100-yard game in a contest against Tennessee as he caught 10 passes for 140 yards and a touchdown in the 31-27 loss. Smith had 156 yards receiving against Tennessee last year, which is a career high.

GAINESVILLE, FLA. (AP) — Kyle Trask and Kyle Pitts hooked up for two more touchdowns, continuing their hot start and leading No. 3 Florida to a 38-24 victory over South Carolina on Saturday.

Trask completed 21 of 29 passes for 268 yards, with four touchdowns and an interception. His second-quarter fumble kept the Gamecocks (0-2) in the game early.

Pitts finished with four receptions for 57 yards, commanding extra attention and beating South Carolina's top defenders. He nearly made a one-handed catch in the third quarter, but the ball slipped off his left fingertips.

The K2K connection now has six touchdowns in two games, one more than it notched in 2019. The next performance comes at Kyle Field, where Texas A&M will try to become the first Southeastern Conference opponent to slow down Trask and Pitts in 2020.

Some thought former Florida coach Will Muschamp and his Gamecocks would find a way. But the Gators (2-0) had their way with South Carolina for three quarters in front of 15,120 socially distant fans in the Swamp. They finished with 347 yards and punted twice.

Kadarius Toney put an exclamation point on the victory with a 57-yard touchdown catch late in the third. He somehow broke through three defenders, turning a 7-yard catch into Florida's biggest gain.

He ended with six receptions for 86 yards and a touchdown to go along with 42 yards on two punt returns.

Kevin Harris was one of the few bright spots for South Carolina, which flubbed a chance to make it a one-score game in the final minute. The sophomore ran 22 times for 100 yards and a score.

Collin Hill completed 28 of 47 passes for 212 yards and two touchdowns. He was sacked four times. He threw behind Shi Smith in the end zone on Carolina's final play, which ended an 18-play, 7-plus minute drive without any points.

GAME CHANGER

Kyle Trask connected with Kedarius Toney for a 57-yard touchdown reception that gave Florida a 38-14 lead with 4:44 left in the third quarter. The Gamecocks scored the final 10 points and had an 18-play drive on their final possession but did not score to fall by a pair of touchdowns.

KEY STAT

100 – Kevin Harris had 100 yards on the ground on 22 carries for the Gamecocks, his second 100-yard rushing performance in his career. He had a touchdown on the ground and in the air as his nine-yard touchdown pass from Collin Hill in the fourth quarter made it 38-24.

NASHVILLE, TENN. (AP) — The South Carolina Gamecocks ran the ball so well on a rainy, sloppy day that quarterback Collin Hill would not have minded if he never threw the ball.

Hill ran for two touchdowns and Kevin Harris ran for two TDs and a career-high 171 yards as the South Carolina Gamecocks beat Vanderbilt 41-7 Saturday for their first victory of the season.

"I just like winning," Hill said.

The Gamecocks (1-2, 1-2 SEC) won their 12th straight in this series by dominating Vanderbilt 486-249 in total offense and three sacks on a rainy day. South Carolina had more yards rushing (290) than the Commodores had total yards.

Harris, the sophomore running back limited last season by an injured groin, had himself a day. He ran for a 25-yard TD early in the third, and he added a career-long 88-yarder early in the fourth. South Carolina coach Will Muschamp said Harris gets better as the game goes on.

"You get tired of hitting him, and there's nothing really soft on his body," Muschamp said. "He's got a short stature but he's a very muscular guy. He runs with high knees, he gets behind his pads and when you take him on there's nothing there that's soft to hit. He's a guy that wears on people as the game continues to go."

Vanderbilt (0-3, 0-3) remains winless after having 56 scholarship players available for this game, just three above the limit set by the Southeastern Conference for a team to play a game. The Commodores already had six players opt out of this season.

Vanderbilt coach Derek Mason said he learned Thursday that his numbers would be limited by injuries and contact tracing during a pandemic.

"These are challenging times, and I think in challenging times what you've got to do is just take it one day at a time ..." Mason said.

Parker White kicked a pair of field goals, including a 43-yarder that gave the Gamecocks the lead for good in the first quarter.

Vanderbilt had its chances early to either tie or take a lead. Pierson Cooke missed a 29-yard field goal wide right for Vanderbilt and is now 1 of 4 this season.

In the second quarter, the Commodores went for it on fourth-and-2 at the South Carolina 3. Freshman Ken Seals rolled right and wound up being tackled, missing the chance to throw to a receiver in the end zone when open or run himself.

"We had a chip on our shoulder because we were 0-2," Gamecocks linebacker Ernest Jones said.

Hill hit Nick Muse with a 32-yard pass, starting a 12-play, 96-yard drive that the South Carolina quarterback capped himself for a 14-point swing. Hill went over the top for a 1-yard touchdown and a 10-0 lead with 2:09 left in the first half.

South Carolina scored the final 24 points. Hill ran for a 10-yard TD in the third, and Harris broke loose for his 88-yarder and Dakereon Joyner had a 47-yard TD, both in the fourth.

GAME CHANGER

Carolina scored the final 24 points of the game, starting with a 10-yard Collin Hill touchdown run with 4:22 left in the third quarter. Kevin Harris sealed the win with an 88-yard touchdown run with 13:07 left in the fourth, the longest run by a Carolina back since 2006.

KEY STAT

COLUMBIA, S.C. (AP) — South Carolina's Jaycee Horn was tired of hearing he didn't have the ball skills to be a truly exceptional cornerback.

His play against No. 15 Auburn proved he did — and led the Gamecocks to a breakthrough win over the Tigers on Saturday.

Horn had the first two interceptions of his career and his pass break up led to a third — all which South Carolina turned into touchdowns — for a 30-22 victory that was its first win over Auburn in 87 years.

Horn is a junior who's been a lockdown corner most of his career. "If a team throws at him like that every game, he'll have a game like that every game," Gamecocks receiver Shi Smith said of Horn.

Horn was assigned to Auburn receiver Seth Williams, one of the best receivers in the Southeastern Conference, averaging 18 yards a catch. Williams finished with four catches for 74 yards, but no scores.

"I heard a lot of people saying I (don't) have any ball skills, which is crazy to me," Horn said. "I just knew the day would come when I'd have a lot of opportunities to make plays."

South Carolina made plenty of them throughout to beat Auburn for the first time in 87 years.

Kevin Harris ran for two touchdowns, Smith added a 10-yard TD catch and Horn and the defense did enough to stop Bo Nix and the Tigers' attack.

Auburn (2-2) had won eight straight in the series and jumped out to a 9-0 lead in the opening 10 minutes. But Nix, the sophomore quarterback, threw three picks and the Gamecocks (2-2) cashed in each time to win consecutive games for the first time in more than a year.

Smith had eight catches including his score midway through the third quarter that put South Carolina ahead for good, 20-19.

Auburn was driving on its following series when Nix threw his third interception — and second to c Horn who brought the ball down the left sidelines to the Tigers' 8. Harris was in the end zone a play later for a 27-19 lead and Auburn could not recover.

The Tigers closed to 30-22 on Anders Carlson's 22 yard field goal with 6:39 left. Auburn got the ball back once more with 2:15 left and drove to the South Carolina 13. Nix, though, was called for intentional grounding trying to avoid a sack and the Gamecocks held on to beat the Tigers for the first time since 1933.

Auburn coach Gus Malzahn said his team will have to get past this quickly. "We're just going to have to be big boys and we're going to have to man up and put it behind us and go into next week and find a way to win," he said.

South Carolina had not won back-to-back games since defeating Kentucky and then-No. 3 Georgia last season. That win over the Bulldogs was the last time the Gamecocks had beaten a ranked opponent.

Auburn's offense looked unstoppable the first half and doubled up South Carolina in yardage (243-119) the first 30 minutes — except when Nix put the ball in danger.

Nix had 272 yards passing and was sacked three times.

Bigby, the Auburn freshman, had 111 yards rushing and went past the century mark for a second straight game.

GAME CHANGER

Leading 30-22 with 2:15 left in the contest, Auburn took the ball and its own 32 and ran 11 plays to the 12-yard line with nine seconds left. Bo Nix tried to rush for the touchdown but Ernest Jones tackled him at the nine. Auburn had a hands to the face penalty on the play, ending the game.

BATON ROUGE, LA. (AP) — LSU freshman TJ Finley passed for 265 yards and two touchdowns in his college debut. Trey Palmer scored on a 95-yard, sideline-to-sideline kickoff return and the Tigers defeated South Carolina 52-24 on Saturday night.

Filling in for injured starter Myles Brennan, Finley completed his first three passes and capped his first series with a 1-yard keeper for a touchdown. It was an auspicious start to a game in which Finley — who was highly recruited out of Ponchatoula, Louisiana — delighted the Death Valley crowd of 21,855 by completing 17 of 21 passes, including touchdowns of 7 and 51 yards to Terrace Marshall Jr.

Marshall continued his torrid start to this season. He finished with receptions six for 88 yards and now has 27 catches for 532 yards and nine touchdowns through four games this season.

South Carolina was unable to maintain its form from a week earlier, when the Gamecocks beat Auburn for the first time since 1933. Collin Hill was 12 of 22 for 234 yards and one touchdown, but also was intercepted by Eli Ricks, who returned the ball 45 yards for the first of LSU's two non-offensive touchdowns during the game.

Running back Kevin Harris largely carried the Gamecocks' offensive with 126 yards and two TDs on 12 carries.

LSU's much maligned defense gave up several more big plays, but largely redeemed itself with numerous drive-stalling sacks and held South Carolina to a field goal after Finley's lone interception gave the Gamecocks the ball inside the LSU 40. South Carolina settled for field goal tries on four promising drives, and kicker Parker White missed three from 54, 34 and 40 yards.

Palmer's kickoff return for a touchdown was the first by LSU in Tiger Stadium since Eric Martin did it in 1981. The return hardly looked promising when Palmer mishandled the kickoff and had to stop and bend over to pick it up at his own 5 as South Carolina's kickoff unit converged. But Palmer was able to side-step a couple tacklers, made his way across the width of the field and outran remaining pursuers down the opposite sideline from which he started.

LSU also looked determined to show it could run the ball after struggling to do so in a 45-41 loss in Missouri on Oct. 10 in which the Tigers failed to take a final-minute lead despite having first-and-goal from the 1. LSU rushers combined for 276 yards against the Gamecocks, with running backs John Emery and Tyrion Davis-Price each scoring from inside the 5. Davis-Price led LSU with 135 yards rushing.

GAME CHANGER

LSU took a 31-10 lead with 2:43 before halftime as Eli Ricks returned an interception 45 yards for a touchdown to give the Tigers a three-score lead before halftime.

COLUMBIA, S.C. (AP) — Kellen Mond threw four touchdown passes to become the school's career leader, Isaiah Spiller ran for 131 yards and the Aggies routed South Carolina 48-3 on Saturday night.

"We're turning heads and doing a lot of things that people didn't think we were going to do," Aggies defensive tackle Bobby Brown III said. "We're going to keep turning heads, proving people wrong."

Just maybe all the way to a playoff berth. They certainly look the part against the Gamecocks.

"You always think you can be dominant," Texas A&M coach Jimbo Fisher said. "The experience has helped on each side of the ball. Learning to win each play and, in turn, the bigger picture is coming together."

Especially when Mond, Spiller and the Aggies defense play like this.

Mond set the school mark with the 68th touchdown pass of his career, a 52-yarder to Devon Achane in the third quarter with the game long decided.

Mond also ran for a score to help Texas A&M improve to 5-1 — all in the Southeastern Conference — for its best start since opening 6-0 in 2016. The Aggies are 7-0 against the Gamecocks.

Mond and Spiller helped the Aggies open a 21-0 halftime lead and cruise to their fourth consecutive victory since a loss at Alabama last month.

Spiller had two short pickups for first downs — one on a fourth-and-1 with Texas A&M in chip-shot field goal range — before Mond flipped a 4-yard TD pass to Ainius Smith.

Mond found tight end Jalen Wydermyer for two first-half scores. Wydermyer was left all alone and walked into the end zone on a 15-yard scoring grab. Right before half, Mond hit Wydermyer on a crossing route near the goal line to go up three scores.

South Carolina (2-4), coming off an off week, had no answer.

Quarterback Collin Hill was 8 of 21 for 66 yards and two interceptions before getting lifted in the fourth quarter for last year's starter and current backup, Ryan Hilinski.

Kevin Harris, the SEC's second-leading rusher coming in, was limited to 39 yards on 13 carries.

Mond had a 15-yard scoring run to start the third quarter before his long TD pass to Achane gave him his latest school record. Mond already holds career Aggies marks for completions, passing yards and total offense — probably with more on the way as his senior season continues.

He finished 16 of 26 for 224 yards.

Spiller also had two catches for 46 yards before limping off the field in the third quarter. The tailback went into the Aggies' medical tent and came out running on the sidelines. But with Texas A&M's big lead, he was not needed in the second half.

South Carolina has surrendered 1,071 yards and 100 points in losses to LSU and the Aggies its past two games.

The Gamecocks avoided their first shutout since 2018 on Parker White's 48-yard field goal with less than six minutes left.

GAME CHANGER

Texas A&M started the scoring with a 12-play, 52-yard drive, capped by a three-yard pass from Kellen Mond to Ainius Smith with 4:40 left in the first quarter. Jalen Wydermyer and Devon Achane each had a pair of touchdowns for the Aggies' offense.

OXFORD, MISS. (AP) — Matt Corral accounted for five touchdowns, including a go-ahead 91-yard touchdown strike to Elijah Moore in the fourth quarter, as Mississippi rallied to defeat South Carolina 59-42 on Saturday night.

Trailing 42-38, Corral found a wide-open Moore waiting in the middle of the field at the South Carolina 45-yard line. Moore then turned and raced into the end zone to put Ole Miss ahead to stay, 45-42 with 12:02 remaining.

During the play, Ole Miss coach Lane Kiffin tossed his clipboard 20 yards in the air at the catch and raced up the sidelines 30 yards before stopping to celebrate with a fist pump as Moore completed the game's decisive play.

Ole Miss (3-4, 3-4 Southeastern Conference) finished with 708 yards of offense, the most in school history in an SEC game. Corral finished 28 of 32 for 513 yards passing, a school record, including four touchdowns. Corral added a 3-yard touchdown run, while Jerrion Ealy rushed for 84 yards on 17 carries with touchdown runs of 12 and 5 yards.

Moore had 13 receptions for 225 yards, including touchdown catches of 91 and 25 yards, both during the fourth-quarter surge. Lakin Henry had 10 tackles and A.J. Finley had an interception as Ole Miss stopped the final three South Carolina offensive series.

Kevin Harris led South Carolina (2-5, 2-5) with 243 yards rushing on 25 carries, including a school-record five touchdown runs of 46, 1, 1, 44 and 12 yards. The Gamecocks rallied from a 31-21 deficit early in the third quarter to take a 42-38 lead early in the fourth.

Collin Hill was 17 of 28 for 230 yards passing with an 11-yard touchdown pass to Shi Smith, who finished with 10 receptions for 117 yards. South Carolina had 548 yards of total offense and linebacker Ernest Jones had a game-high 18 tackles.

GAME CHANGER

Ole Miss' defense forced Carolina to punt with 9:17 left in the game with a 45-42 lead. The Rebels took advantage with an eight-play, 80-yard drive that ended with a 5-yard touchdown run by Jerrion Ealy with 6:09 left to give the Rebels the two-score lead on their way to a victory.

COLUMBIA, S.C. (AP) — Missouri coach Eli Drinkwitz was proud his team wouldn't let the obstacles they've faced this season keep them from success.

And he happily congratulated them, COVID-19 worries and all, after the Tigers' 17-10 victory over South Carolina on Saturday night.

Coronavirus has severely impacted the Tigers this year: they had just 52 scholarship players available this week and defensive coordinator Ryan Walters remained at home because of contact tracing concerns.

Still, Missouri and quarterback Connor Bazelak opened a 17-0 lead in the first half and defense held on to defeat the Gamecocks 17-10 on Saturday night.

The Tigers hadn't played since Oct. 31 because of a bye week and a postponement of their game last week with Georgia. Drinkwitz wasn't sure he'd get this one either with his dwindling roster.

Instead, they played like a winning SEC team as Bazelak threw for 203 yards and a touchdown and the defense, under substitute coordinator David Gibbs, choked off the Gamecocks when it mattered most.

Larry Rountree III rushed for a score and became the Tigers all-time time rushing leader among running backs for the Tigers (3-3 Southeastern Conference).

It was the fourth straight loss for South Carolina (2-6), which fired coach Will Muschamp last Sunday and took a half to get itself going.

Bazelak and the Missouri offense weren't crisp. Then again, they didn't have to be as the Tigers opened up a 17-0 lead by halftime and kept the Gamecocks off balance much of the way.

South Carolina managed just 68 yards and five first downs in the opening half, punting five times and failing to convert a fourth down in six series before halftime.

The Tigers essentially put the game out of reach on Bazelak's pretty 20-yard TD throw to Tauskie Dove midway through the opening quarter.

Rountree's 1-yard burst made it 14-0 and Missouri ended the half with Harrison Mevis' 20-yard field goal to head to the locker room up 17-0.

Rountree finished with 58 yards, giving the senior 3,238 for his career and moving him past Zack Abrom who played from 2000-03. Only quarterback Brad Smith is ahead of Rountree's school career rushing total with 4,289 yards.

Carolina freshman quarterback Luke Doty provided a second-half spark in place of season-long starter Collin Hill, rallying the team to within a touchdown after Deshaun Fenwick's 1-yard TD run made it 17-10.

The Gamecocks had one last drive, but Doty was intercepted by Devin Nicholson and Missouri held on for the win.

Mike Bobo, the first-year offensive coordinator elevated to interim coach, talked this week of settling nerves and restoring effort for a fragile group of players. But during the week, several players opted out of the season including starting cornerbacks — and likely NFL draft picks — Jaycee Horn and Israel Mukuamu.

In addition, Bobo said two defensive line starters in Aaron Sterling and Brad Johnson were lost for the year with injuries.

That opened things up for the Tigers and Bazelak, who completed 13 of 21 passes for 140 yards the first 30 minutes.

GAME CHANGER

South Carolina scored 10 second half points and had the ball on its 1-yard line with 2:37 left. The offense drove to its 36 before an interception with 53 seconds left gave the Tigers the seven-point win.

COLUMBIA, S.C. (AP) — No. 13 Georgia's 45-16 win over South Carolina was the Bulldogs' biggest victory of this strange season on the scoreboard.

But Georgia coach Kirby Smart wasn't sure had its best game Saturday night, with the Gamecocks missing more than two dozen players and offering little resistance.

"It's hard to say that because of the quality of the competition," Smart said.

James Cook ran for 104 yards on just six carries and three other Georgia backs had at least 77 yards. It was barely a game from the start. Georgia (6-2) led 21-0 after three possessions and South Carolina (2-7) had yet to get a first down.

The Gamecocks can barely field a team. Nearly 20 players couldn't play because of injuries or COVID-19 issues. Another seven players have opted out, several since the school fired coach Will Muschamp two weeks ago.

Still, Smart said he was happy for the fast start and the 332 yards his team gained on the ground.

"They didn't play down to that level," Smart said. "They knocked people off the ball."

After throwing for 401 yards in his first start last week, Southern California transfer JT Daniels was 10 for 16 for 139 yards with two touchdowns and an interception.

Daniels overthrew a few open receivers and took two sacks, but Smart said he thought the sophomore did fine, making sure he only made a few mistakes.

"He took the things the defense gave to him," Smart said.

Zamir White ran 13 times for 84 yards, Kenny McIntosh had 79 yards on nine carries, and Daijun Edwards ran 14 times for 77 yards. The Bulldogs didn't attempt a pass after Daniels' 31-yard touchdown strike to Arian Smith on the first play of the fourth quarter gave them a 45-10 lead.

Georgia got the ball back with 9:27 left and ran 12 straight times, taking a knee at first-and-goal at the 1 to mercifully end it. The Bulldogs averaged 8 yards a run when Daniels sacks were removed from their total.

South Carolina interim coach Mike Bobo said he was proud that the players he had fought hard and didn't give up even as Georgia tried to score in the closing moments.

"Part of being a man is you don't make excuses and you don't let people make excuses for you," said Bobo, whose South Carolina team was without leading receiver Shi Smith and SEC sack leader Kingsley Enagbare.

South Carolina has lost five in a row, allowing at least 45 points in four of the defeats.

GAME CHANGER

South Carolina chipped away at the early Georgia lead, cutting the Bulldog advantage to 21-10 after a 1-yard Kevin Harris touchdown run and a Parker White 39-yard field goal with 8:23 left in the first half, but a 29-yard James Cook touchdown run with 4:31 left put UGA up, 28-10, going into the locker room.

LEXINGTON, KY. (AP) — Chris Rodriguez Jr. rushed for three touchdowns, Terry Wilson and A.J. Rose each rushed for one, and Kentucky rolled South Carolina 41-18 Saturday night in the regular season finale for both schools.

Looking to halt a two-game slide and remain in consideration for the postseason, the Wildcats (4-6, 4-6 Southeastern Conference) scored on five of their first seven possessions to lead 27-3 at halftime. Their highest first-half output this season was aided by 10 points off two of their three takeaways, including two fumble recoveries by Jordan Wright.

Rodriguez returned from a two-game absence to rush for first-half TDs of 1 and 2 yards around Rose's 8-yard score before sealing the rout with a 79-yard burst down the left side with 4:56 remaining. Wilson added a 1-yard TD run early in the third quarter as the Wildcats outgained the Gamecocks (2-8, 2-8) 492-404.

Wilson, the senior quarterback, finished 17 of 26 passing for 201 yards and rushed for 46 to break 1,000 career. Rodriguez had 139 yards on 14 carries and Rose 101 on 14 carries as Kentucky dealt South Carolina its sixth consecutive loss.

Kevin Harris rushed for 210 yards and a touchdown on 21 carries to become the 11th Gamecock with 1,000 in a season. Luke Doty's 30-yard TD pass to Dakereon Joyner and two-point conversion to Nick Muse with 5:12 left made it 34-18 before Rodriguez's big TD run.

GAME CHANGER

South Carolina looked to get on the board on its first possession, but a holding call negated the score and led to a missed field goal. Kentucky had a field goal on its first possession, scored 10 points in the first frame and had 27 in the first half on its way to victory.

KEY STAT

1,138 – Kevin Harris became the ninth Gamecock to reach 1,000 yards in a season as the Hinesville, Ga., native rushed for 210 yards on 21 carries in the Kentucky game.
