>>> SOUTH CAROLINA NOTES

- Georgia tallied 491 yards of total offense and scored five touchdowns in the first three quarters in a 40-13 win over South Carolina Saturday night (Sept. 18) in Athens.
- Attendance at Sanford Stadium was 92,746, which is a sellout.
- South Carolina's captains for the game were: Kingsley Enagabare, Aaron Sterling, Josh Vann and Dylan Wonnum
- Georgia leads the all-time series with the Gamecocks, 53-19-2, and is 30-9 against Carolina in Athens.
- Kevin Harris, Jakai Moore, Cam Smith and Damani Staley made their first starts of the season in the Georgia game.
- Luke Doty, Keveon Mullins and Rico Powers made their first appearances of the season in the Georgia game.
- Carolina allowed a safety for the first time since Oct. 15, 2011 at Mississippi State.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA OFFENSE NOTES

- Josh Vann recorded a career-high 61-yard reception from Zeb Noland in the first quarter. His previous career high was set last week (45 yards) in the win over East Carolina.
- Vann had back-to-back 100-yard receiving games, going for 128 yards on three receptions. Vann had 127 yards last week in a win over East Carolina.
- The last Gamecock with back-to-back 100-yard receiving games was Deebo Samuel vs. Chattanooga (112) and Clemson (210) in 2018.
- Luke Doty connected with Vann for a 36-yard touchdown reception in the fourth quarter. It was Vann's fourth career receiving touchdown and second of the season.
- Luke Doty came into the game in the first quarter and was 13-for-26 for 153 yards, a touchdown and an interception.
- Jalen Brooks had three catches for 54 yards, which is a Carolina career high. Brooks had an acrobatic 36-yard catch in the fourth quarter.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA DEFENSE NOTES

- Jaylan Foster recorded his second and third interceptions of the season in the Georgia game. Carolina now has six interceptions on the season, including a pair that were run back for a touchdown.
- The last Gamecock with two interceptions in a game was Jaycee Horn vs. Auburn in 2020.
- Jabari Ellis recorded his first sack of the season in the second quarter of the Georgia game. Ellis now has 2.5 career sacks.
- Ellis had a pair of tackles for loss in the Georgia game.
- R.J. Roderick led the Gamecocks with eight tackles on the night, which included a forced fumble.
- O'Donnell Fortune recorved his first career fumble in the fourth quarter.
