#### GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- Prior to tonight's game, South Carolina will celebrate its 2021-22 accomplishments by distributing rings and unveiling banners to recognize the program's sixth SEC Tournament title and third trip to the NCAA Final Four.
- Tonight's game is the home opener for South Carolina, which is 25-7 all-time in home openers, including an 11-2 mark under head coach Dawn Staley. The Gamecocks have won their last 10 home openers and are 17-2 in home openers played in Colonial Life Arena.
- The home opener is a great time to remind everyone that South Carolina fans have led the nation in average attendance for each of last seven seasons, including the limited-attendance 2020-21 season. This season, the Gamecocks have sold over 10,100 season tickets, putting them on track to retain the title.
- South Carolina's depth has shown in bench production so far this season. Through two games, the bench is averaging 23.0 points per game to account for 33.3 percent of the offense. Last season, the bench averaged 17.3 points per game for 22.9 percent of the offense.
- Senior Destanni Henderson continues to be the engine that powers the Gamecock offense. She leads the team with 14.5 points per game and 5.0 assists per game. Those numbers rank 14th and fourth, respectively in the SEC. She has shot 56.3 percent from the field, including a sterling 66.7 percent from 3-point range (4-of-6).
- Junior Aliyah Boston continues to garner a lion's share of opponents' attention on defense, but teams have not been able to slow her down as much defensively as she leads the nation with 4.5 blocks per game.

## Five-Second Count

South Carolina women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful era, claiming at least 20 wins for the last 10 seasons, including four 30-win seasons in the last seven campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in the NCAA Final Four three times in the last six NCAA Tournaments, including winning the 2017 National Championship, and have been ranked in the AP Top 25 39 in the top 10. Staley has led the Gamecocks to their only No. 1 rankings in program history (12 weeks in 2014-15, 10 weeks in 2019-20, 3 weeks in 2020-21, 2 weeks in 2021-22), five SEC regular-season titles and six SEC Tournament championships.

Under Staley's leadership, seven Gamecocks have earned All-America status, two have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 16 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once. Eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last six years, including 2018 No. 1 overall pick A'ja Wilson, who went on to become the Gamecocks' second-straight WNBA Rookie of the Year (2018) and the program's first WNBA MVP (2020).

## The Clemson Series

South Carolina has won the last 10 meetings, but Clemson leads the overall series 33-32. The Gamecocks' 10 straight victories have all come by double digits.

The Gamecocks hold a 20-11 overall advantage in games played in Columbia, winning the last five meetings at Colonial Life Arena.

The most recent meetings between the rivals went to South Carolina, 84-48, at Littlejohn Coliseum on Nov. 24, 2019. Six Gamecocks scored in double figures as South Carolina opened with a 20-9 advantage after the first quarter and never looked back.

The last game at Colonial Life Arena was on Nov. 15, 2018, resulting in a 69-57 South Carolina victory. Four Gamecocks on the current roster played in that game – Lele Grissett, Destanni Henderson, Victoria Saxton, Elysa Wesolek.

## Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are 479-165 (.744) all-time in home games, including a 167-34 mark under head coach Dawn Staley. Her .831 winning percentage at home is second among the program's seven all-time head coaches (Pam Parsons (41-7) .854).

Playing in its 19th season at Colonial Life Arena, South Carolina boasts a 230-67 (.774) record in the building, including three undefeated seasons since 2013-14. Staley's share of that record is 164-34 (.828).

## TEAM THEME: NETWORTH

South Carolina's 2021-22 season theme "Net Worth" taps into the universal symbol of success in basketball – cutting down the nets. Each member of the team, the program and the fan base plays a role in the march toward achieving that level of success.

Every role is not the same, but every person has a "Net Worth" – an added value necessary for the team to achieve its goals.

Head coach Dawn Staley's program develops a different theme each season to amplify the team's goals and mindset for the season ahead.

## Schedule Strength

South Carolina's 10 games against teams in either the AP or USA Today/WBCA Poll are the third-most in the nation, trailing just Stanford (12) and Maryland (11). Michigan, Tennessee and Texas also have nine confirmed such games on their schedule. The Gamecocks have a chance to add two more games based on results in the Battle 4 Atlantis (Nov. 20-22).

## Ranking Review

The Gamecocks open the season atop both primary national polls for the second time in as many seasons.

In the AP Poll, the Gamecocks have appeared in each of the last 170 weeks, giving them the fourth-longest active streak in the nation, which dates back to Dec. 10, 2021. They have spent the last 39 of those weeks ranked in the top 10 and have been No. 1 in the poll 17 times.

In the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Poll, South Carolina has been in the top 10 since claiming the No. 10 spot in the 2019-20 preseason poll. It has been No. 1 in this poll 12 times in the last eight seasons.

## Staley's Stand

In October, the University of South Carolina awarded head coach Dawn Staley a seven-year contract totaling \$22.4 million. With a guaranteed \$2.9 million this season, the move made Staley the highest paid women's basketball coach at a public institution (matching Geno Auriemma at UConn) and the highest paid Black coach in her sport.

Ever the trailblazer, Staley emphasized that her negotiations were about more than her contract. They were founded in her desire to make a point about the inequality in salaries for women, and Black women in particular, throughout her sport and across all professions.

per game, and junior Brea Beal's 1.5 blocks per game are 11th in the conference. Last season's ACC blocks leader Kamilla Cardoso has two blocks so far in her Gamecock career.

### Awards (Pre)Season

Five Gamecocks got an early jump on awards season with three grabbing Preseason All-America honors from at least one organization.

Aliyah Boston led the charge with unanimous First-Team All-America honors and a spot on the Lisa Leslie Center Award watch list. She was named USA Today Preseason Player of the Year as well.

Junior Zia Cooke picked up Preseason All-America Third Team recognition from Lindy's as well as a spot on the Preseason All-SEC First Team and the Ann Meyers Drysdale Shooting Guard Award watch list.

Senior Destanni Henderson made her debut on the national stage with a Preseason Second-Team All-America nod from USA Today. She was a Preseason All-SEC Second Team selection and was named to the Nancy Lieberman Point Guard watch list.

Sophomore Kamilla Cardoso and freshman Sania Feagin got in on the positional award recognition. Cardoso joined Boston on the Lisa Leslie Award list, which Feagin made the Katrina McClain Power Forward Award watch list.

### Great Gamecock Fans

South Carolina fans have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last seven seasons. With over 10,100 season tickets sold this season – the most since 10,221 were out in 2016-17 – that streak looks to continue for another year.

Excluding the COVID limited-attendance season of 2019-20, South Carolina has drawn at least 10,000 fans in 47 consecutive games dating back to the Nov. 10, 2017, season opener. In regular-season action (excluding NCAA Tournament games), the streak stretches to 82 games beginning on Jan. 2, 2015.

### U-S-A, U-S-A

Since the arrival of Staley in the 2008-09 season, South Carolina has solidified its relationship with USA Basketball. At least one Gamecock has donned the red, white and blue in each of the last six years of international competition (no events in 2020), and the group of 11 Gamecocks, including three currently in the program, has helped 18 U.S. teams to gold medals, three more to silvers and another to bronze.

Staley along with three current and two former Gamecocks added four golds to that count this summer.

In Tokyo, Staley and alumna A'ja Wilson led the U.S. to its record-tying seventh-straight gold medal in 5x5 basketball, while Alisha Gray was part of the first ever Olympic 3x3 gold medal team.

In June, Staley led the U.S. team, which included senior Destanni Henderson and junior Aliyah Boston, to gold at the FIBA AmeriCup in June. Two months later, freshman Sania Feagin was part of the U.S. team to take gold in the FIBA U19 World Cup.

While this summer marked the first gold medals for Feagin and Henderson, Boston's was the fifth of her career. Junior Zia Cooke also has two gold medals with USA Basketball.

### Everybody's All-American

On the Gamecocks' 16-woman roster, 11 were McDonald's All-Americans in high school – Brea Beal, Aliyah Boston, Kamilla Cardoso, Zia Cooke, Sania Feagin, Bree Hall, Destanni Henderson, Raven Johnson, Destiny Littleton, Saniya Rivers and Eniya Russell.

At South Carolina, Staley has coached 18 McDonald's All-Americans, including 14 who joined the Gamecocks as freshmen.

In women's basketball, Colonial Life Arena has become one of the most feared places to play as enormous crowds fill the building with passion for the Gamecocks.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last six seasons. The Gamecocks were one of a few programs to finish the season averaging over 10,000 fans and boast five sellouts (18,000) in the last five seasons of full capacity arenas.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest on-campus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300. The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of \$4.2 million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately 12' x 20' and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.

# DAWN STALEY

## Head Coach

### 14th Season at South Carolina

Catapulting South Carolina into the national spotlight, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. Under her leadership, the Gamecocks have reached many firsts – National Championship, NCAA Final Fours, No. 1 rankings, SEC regular-season and tournament titles, SEC Player of the Year, National Player of the Year, WNBA No. 1 Draft pick and No. 1 recruiting classes – to name the most notable.

Staley's 13 seasons at the helm of the Gamecocks include:

- 2017 NCAA National Championship
- Three NCAA Final Fours in the last six tournaments (2015, 2017, 2021)
- Ranking in the AP Top 25 every week since Dec. 10, 2012, including 96 weeks in the top five
- 27 weeks ranked No. 1 in the AP Poll, including the first-ever final No. 1 ranking in program history (2019-20)
- Nine 25-win seasons, including four 30-win campaigns led by a school-record 34 victories in 2014-15
- Five SEC regular-season championships (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2020)
- Six SEC Tournament titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2020, 2021)
- Three top-two recruiting classes (#1 in 2021, #1 in 2019, #2 in 2014)
- Seven NCAA Attendance titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021)

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012 and was one of the final nominees for induction to the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame the same year. In the summer of 2011, the WNBA recognized her as one of the league's "Top 15," honoring the most influential players in the league's history. In 21 seasons as a head coach, Staley has led her college teams to 11 25-win seasons, a total of 17 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 128 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 25 in the No. 1 spot.

Also a force in USA Basketball, Staley was named the U.S. Women's National Team head coach for 2017-21, leading the U.S. to 2018 FIBA World Cup gold to earn USAB National Coach of the Year honors that year, adding gold medals at the 2019 and 2021 FIBA AmeriCups and stretching the U.S. Olympic gold medal streak to seven straight at the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games. Prior to that appointment, Staley led three other U.S. teams to gold medals – 2015 FIBA U19 World Championships, 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship, 2007 Pan Am Games – and served as an assistant on the Senior National Team 2006-08 and again 2014-16, during which the U.S. claimed gold in the 2014 FIBA World Championship and the 2008 and 2016 Olympics.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last 13 seasons, Staley has twice been named National Coach of the Year (2014, 2020) with her 2020 unanimous selection making her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award. She is a four-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the only Gamecock basketball coach – men's or women's – to amass 300 victories at South Carolina and became the fastest coach to 200 wins in program history, needing just 277 games at South Carolina to reach the plateau.

Staley has coached a National Player of the Year (A'ja Wilson, 2018) and a National Freshman of the Year (Aliyah Boston, 2020). Under her leadership, seven Gamecocks have collected 17 All-America selections, two have picked up five SEC Player of the Year honors, three have earned SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognition a total of five times, one has been the SEC 6th Player of the Year and six were named SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 16 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors a combined 31 times, including 16 first-team selections, and eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five seasons, including 2018 No. 1 pick A'ja Wilson who went on to earn WNBA Rookie of the Year honors a year after Allisha Gray became the first Gamecock to capture the honor in 2017. Two other Gamecock draftees have earned WNBA All-Rookie Team honors as well.
