>>> SOUTH CAROLINA NOTES

- South Carolina opened SEC play with a 44-30 loss to #16 Arkansas Saturday morning (Sept. 10) in Fayetteville, Ark.
- Attendance at DW Reynolds Razorback Stadium was 72,437
- South Carolina's captains for the game were Jalen Brooks, Brad Johnson, Mo Kaba and Spencer Rattler.
- Arkansas leads the overall series 14-10 and snapped a three-game losing streak to the Gamecocks.
- South Carolina is now 622-602-44 all-time.
- South Carolina is now 12-19 all-time in SEC openers.
- Arkansas won the coin toss and deferred to the second half.
- Nick Emmanwori made his first start in the Arkansas game
- Sherrod Greene made his first appearance of the season in the Arkansas game.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA OFFENSE NOTES

- MarShawn Lloyd hauled in a 43-yard reception from Spencer Rattler in the first quarter. It was a career high for receiving yards on a play and in a game (65) for Lloyd
- Lloyd had his second rushing touchdown of the season with 2:56 left in the second quarter on a seven-yard run.
- Antwane Wells Jr., scored his first touchdown as a Gamecock, a 62-yard reception from Spencer Rattler. It was the longest play from scrimmage on the season for Carolina until Wells' 64-yard reception from Rattler in the fourth quarter.
- Wells ended the game with eight receptions for 185 yards and a touchdown.
- Wells tied for the 11th highest receiving yards in a game in Carolina history (185) and the most since Deebo Samuel had 210 receiving yards at Clemson on Nov. 24, 2018.
- Spencer Rattler was 23-for-38 for 371 yards, a touchdown and an interception in his first SEC game.
- Juju McDowell was Carolina's leading rusher with 35 yards on five carries and a touchdown.
- Jaheim Bell ran in for a 1-yard touchdown with 3:21 left in the fourth quarter.
- Austin Stogner had six receptions for 68 yards, including a 38-yard reception from Rattler.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA DEFENSE NOTES

- Zacch Pickens led the Carolina defense with 12 tackles on the day. He had four solo tackles and a half tackle for loss.
- Freshman Nick Emmanwori had 11 tackles, seven solos, on the day in his first career start.
- Jordan Burch and Jordan Strachan each recorded sacks on Arkansas QB K.J. Jefferson.
- Burch also had a pair of tackles for loss in his 10 stops.
- Darius Rush had a pair of passes defended in the Arkansas game.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Mitch Jeter connected on a 28-yard field goal in the first quarter. Jeter is now 3-for-3 on the season in field goals.
- Kai Kroeger punted three times for a 34.7-yard average.
- The Gamecocks recovered an onside kick in the fourth quarter with 1:32 remaining in the game.
