GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- South Carolina's bench is outscoring its starters this season, averaging 41.6 points per game to account for 50.2 percent of the team's total offense. Against ranked opponents, the starting lineup edges in front, but the bench still averages 31.7 points (41.3%) in those games. The bench is also out-pacing the starters in rebounding on the season – 24.2 to 22.1 per game.
- The Gamecock defense continues to dominate, despite playing three of their seven games against ranked opponents. South Carolina is second in the nation in scoring defense (46.7), trailing only Virgina Tech (46.1), which has not faced a ranked foe and only played two Power 5 opponents in its first seven games of the season. Only one Gamecock opponent has reached 70 points this season and needed overtime to get there (Stanford, 71, Nov. 20).
- Reigning National Player of the Year Aliyah Boston is fifth in the nation with five double-doubles this season, three coming in the Gamecocks' three games against ranked opponents.
- Senior guard Zia Cooke has netted double-figure points in six of seven games this season, missing only Hampton against which she played just 14 minutes. She is averaging a career-best 2.3 assists (3rd on team) with four games of three or more assists already (her career high is 10 such games in a season). Combining her 13.6 points per game with the 5.3 points per game scored on her assists, Cooke has her hands on 22.8 percent of the team's offense.
 - Junior Kamilla Cardoso has scored in double figures four times this season, but no performance was as dominant as her 16-point, nine-rebound effort against #15/17 UCLA (Nov. 29). From chasing down a guard to block a clear fast break layup in the opening quarter to pouring in 10 points and four rebounds in the fourth quarter, Cardoso was locked in.

A Perennial Power

South Carolina women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful era, claiming at least 20 wins for the last 11 seasons, including five 30-win seasons in the last eight campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in the NCAA Final Four four times in the last seven NCAA Tournaments, including winning the 2017 and 2022 National Championships. They have been ranked in every AP Poll since Dec. 10, 2012, including a top-10 position every week since the start of the 2019-20 season. The Gamecocks have amassed 48 AP No. 1 rankings all-time, the fourth-most by a program in the history of that poll. Since the start of the 2019-20 season, South Carolina has been atop the poll 36 times – over three times more than any other team in that time.

Under head coach Dawn Staley's leadership, eight Gamecocks have earned All-America status, three have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 17 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once. Nine Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last seven years, including 2018 No. 1 overall pick A'ja Wilson, who went on to become the Gamecocks' second-straight WNBA Rookie of the Year (2018) and the program's first WNBA MVP (2020, 2022).

The Memphis Series

The Gamecocks have a 16-5 lead in the overall series, which dates back to AIAW days and the teams' shared time in the Metro Conference through the early 1990s. That decade was the last time the two teams met with South Carolina punctuating the end of the regular series with a 73-68 win in Memphis on Jan. 25, 1993.

Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are 499-165 (.751) in home games (some records prior to 1976-77 did not include location of games). Current head coach Dawn Staley is 187-34 at home with that .846 winning percentage ranking second among the program's all-time head coaches (Pam Parsons (41-7) .854).

Playing in its 20th season at Colonial Life Arena, South Carolina boasts a 250-67 (.789) record in the building, including four undefeated seasons since 2013-14. Staley's share of that record is 184-34 (.8434).

Opponent Files

The Gamecocks' schedule includes five games against teams ranked in the most recent version of both national polls – at #2/2 Stanford (W, 76-71), at #3/3 UConn (Feb.

TEAM THEME: DNA

South Carolina's 2022-23 season theme "DNA" stands for Dreams, Nets, Assets – the elements routed in the DNA of the program.

Head coach Dawn Staley has described herself as a dream merchant as much as a coach throughout her career. Nets are the symbol of basketball success. Assets is a reminder of each team member's ability to positively impact the team's success as well as nod to the student-athlete's value in the name, image, likeness space.

Staley's program develops a different theme each season to amplify the team's goals and mindset for the season ahead.

5), vs. #11/12 LSU (Feb. 12), vs. #15/17 UCLA (Nov. 29) and at #20/21 Maryland (W, 81-56).

This season also includes three games against teams that received votes in one or both polls this week – South Dakota State, Arkansas, Tennessee.

Ranked Readings

Against ranked teams, South Carolina is 102-66 (.607) in the Dawn Staley era (beginning 2008-09), and even that mark is skewed by the early seasons of her tenure.

Since the start of the 2014-15 campaign, the Gamecocks are 87-27 (.763) against ranked teams, including a 39-6 mark since the start of the 2019-20 season.

Senior Aliyah Boston has thrived in her 45 career games against ranked opponents, averaging 15.2 points, 12.3 rebounds and 2.9 blocks while shooting 53.8 percent. Senior Zia Cooke's offense is not far behind with her 13.7 points per game in those 45 outings.

So far this season, South Carolina is 3-0 against ranked opponents, winning those games by an average of 13.0 points with a +7.7 rebounding margin.

Ranking Review

The Gamecocks opened this season atop both the AP and the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Polls for the third time in as many seasons and remained there this week.

In the AP Poll, the Gamecocks' 48 total weeks at No. 1 are the fourth most of any program in that poll's history. South Carolina has appeared in each of the last 191 AP Polls, giving it the fourth-longest active streak in the

nation, which dates back to Dec. 10, 2012.

In the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Poll, South Carolina has been in the top 10 since claiming the No. 10 spot in the 2019-20 preseason poll. It has been No. 1 in that poll 33 times in the last nine seasons.

The Staley File

In her 22nd season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .747 (545-185) winning percentage, which ranks 11th in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 seasons of experience. The unanimous 2020 National Coach of the Year, she became the first person to win both a Naismith Player of the Year Trophy and a Naismith Coach of the Year Trophy and the first Black head coach to win multiple national championships in men's or women's basketball

In her 15th season leading the Gamecocks, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (373) with a program-record 11 postseason appearances (10 NCAA/1 WNIT). She accounts for all four of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances (2015, 2017, 2021, 2022) and the first NCAA National Championship in program history (2017).

After claiming six SEC regular-season titles, Staley has won 167 SEC games, the most among active league coaches and third all-time – trailing just Women's Basketball Hall of Fame inductees Andy Landers (Georgia, 273) and Pat Summitt (Tennessee, 306). Her 11.9 SEC wins average is the best in league history among coaches with more than one year in the league, and her .752 SEC winning percentage (167-55) is second only to Summitt (.874) in league history.

Oh Captain, My Captain

For the third time in as many seasons, senior Victaria Saxton and junior Aliyah Boston will serve as team captains. It is Saxton's fourth season in that position

Zia Cooke, Olivia Thompson – has shaped the program from the moment those five freshmen gathered on campus.

In careers affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, the group has reached the Final Four in both their NCAA Tournament appearances, including winning the 2022 National Championship, and has never been ranked outside the top 10. With a combined 100-8 record, they have won 92.6 percent of their games, including a 40-5 mark against nationally ranked opponents.

In SEC action, the class has lost a total of just three league games en route to two regular-season titles (2020, 2022). They have played in three SEC Tournament championship games, claiming the title in two of those (2020, 2021).

Rebounding Roundup

South Carolina was among the top rebounding teams in the country in 2021-22 and has not dropped off this season

South Carolina's current +20.7 rebounding margin is second in the nation as is its 51.0 rebounding average. The Gamecocks' 17.7 offensive boards per game have yielded 17.7 second-chance points per game.

Four Gamecocks average at least 4.0 rebounds, including a pair of reserves in Kamilla Cardoso (7.2) and Ashlyn Watkins (4.9) to rank second and third on the team, respectively. Two Gamecocks are among the top five offensive rebounders in the SEC with Aliyah Boston coming in fourth with 3.6 per game and Cardoso at fifth with 2.9.

Last season, the Gamecocks' +17.7 rebounding margin led the nation, and they were third in rebounding average with a school-record 47.9 per game. They brought back 84.1 percent of that rebounding, including 88.7 percent of offensive boards.

Dial Up the Defense

Head coach Dawn Staley has always put a premium on defense, but the Gamecocks have taken it to another level over the last four seasons (2019-20 to present), during which opponents have scored just 54.2 points per game with 45 of those 108 games (41.7 percent) coming against ranked opponents.

This season, South Carolina is second in the nation in scoring defense (46.7) and third in scoring margin (+36.1). Opponents have shot just 27.3 percent (best in

the nation), and the Gamecocks lead the nation with 10.3 blocks per game.

Last season's program-record low 50.7 points per game ranked third in the nation and helped the Gamecocks lead the nation in scoring margin (+20.2). South Carolina was second in the nation in field goal percentage defense (.332) and first in blocked shots per game (7.4).

No team reached its scoring average against the Gamecocks last season, including some of the SEC and the nation's most prolific offenses, and only three came within single digits of it – Missouri (Dec. 30), Mississippi State (Jan. 2), vs. Kentucky (Mar. 6).

Paint Production

South Carolina has long dominated the paint with both guards and post players taking advantage of the high percentage shots. Since the start of the 2019-20 season, the Gamecocks have scored 53.5 percent of their points in the paint.

So far this season, the Gamecocks have netted 48.9 points per game in the paint, accounting for 59.0 percent of their offense. Post players have scored for 69.0 percent of those paint points (33.8 ppg).

The 2019-20 team had the highest final paint points average (42.4 ppg), but the 2020-21 team posted the highest percentage of paint points (55.1%).

Last season, South Carolina's 37.4 paint points per game accounted for 52.6 percent of its offense.

Block Party

South Carolina annually ranks among the best shot blocking teams in the country and leads the way again this season at 10.3 blocks per game after finishing the 2021-22 season with an NCAA-best 7.4.

Early this season an unexpected shot blocker leads the way with guard Brea Beal ranking fifth in the SEC and 44th in the nation with 1.9 blocks per game. Aliyah Boston is next in line at 1.7 (sixth in SEC) with freshman Ashlyn Watkins and junior Kamilla Cardoso each swatting 1.4 per game to also rank among the SEC's top 10.

Bench Mob

South Carolina's depth has been a hot topic this season, and it has not disappointed.

The Gamecock bench has been especially productive offensively, averaging 41.6 points to account for 50.2 percent of the Gamecocks' total offense. By comparison, last season's bench netted just 21.1 points per game for 29.8 percent of the offense.

The bench offensive production has come in key games with this season's group averaging 31.7 points per game against ranked opponents (41.3 percent).

On the boards, two of the top three rebounders this season come off the bench in Kamilla Cardoso (7.2) and Ashlyn Watkins (4.9). The bench has grabbed 52.5 percent of the total rebounds so far this season.

This year's Iron Gamecock winners were Zia Cooke and Ashlyn Watkins. The Iron Gamecock recipients exhibit exceptional performances in areas of speed, power, strength, and competitive challenges in the weight room.

Quarter Breakdown

South Carolina's defense has held an opponent to single digits in a quarter 11 times through seven games so far this season, including four fourth quarters and two second quarters as the Gamecocks' constant defensive pressure wears opponents down. The scoring differential is largest in the fourth quarter with South Carolina outscoring opponents by 11.1 points per final period.

Individually, four Gamecocks have scored double digits in a single quarter – Kamilla Cardoso (1), Zia Cooke (1), Sania Feagin (1) and Ashlyn Watkins (1). Feagin's 11 points in the fourth quarter against ETSU (Nov. 7) is the best of the season.

Boston's Best

Forward Aliyah Boston opened her senior season with exactly what sealed her unanimous National Player of the Year junior campaign – double-doubles. With five this season, she is fifth in the nation in that category while also ranking 13th in field goal percentage (.648).

From her college debut triple-double in November 2019 to her sweep of the national player of the year awards – including Naismith Defensive Player of the Year – the 6-foot-5 St. Thomas, U.S.V.I., native has been among the best in college women's basketball throughout her career.

Boston is a three-time All-American, three-time winner of the Lisa Leslie Award and three-time SEC Defensive Player of the Year. She added SEC Player of the Year honors in 2022 as well.

Averaging a double-double for her career (14.3 ppg/11.1 rpg), Boston leads all active NCAA players, all divisions, with 65 career double-doubles and 1,196 career rebounds. Her 269 career blocked shots are third among all active players.

In 45 career games against ranked opponents, her averages rise to 15.2 ppg and 12.3 rpg.

Cooke-ing Time

South Carolina's four-year starting shooting guard Zia Cooke has been mentioned among the best players in the country throughout her career, but the senior has been working toward a year that sees her physical talents meet the mental side of the game, and it appears 2022-23 is that season.

Cooke was the Gamecocks' top scorer in their first three games. She has shot at least 50.0 percent from the field three times. Her 13.6 points per game are 14th in the

Even with her increased scoring, Cooke has been distributing the ball well, too, ranking third on the team in assists (2.3 per game). With her own 13.6 points per game and teammates scoring 5.3 points per game off her assists, she has had her hands on 22.8 percent of the Gamecocks' offense this season.

It's Time to BRea-I

Often mentioned by head coach Dawn Staley as irreplaceable, senior guard Brea Beal is finally catching

some of the spotlight usually reserved for her statperforming teammates. In her fourth season, Staley sees Beal's trust in the process paying off with a stat-stuffing start to the season.

Beal leads the team in blocks (1.9 – 5th in the SEC, 44th in NCAA), is second in assists (2.4) and is third in rebounding at 4.9 boards per game.

The powerful big guard's trademark defense has not diminished this season as Beal has held her primary guard to an average of 2.4 points per game fewer than her season average (20.5 percent below).

First Gamecock Takes Flight

Freshman Ashlyn Watkins became the first Gamecock in program history to dunk when she slammed one home following a steal with 3:30 to play in the fourth quarter at Clemson (Nov. 17). The Columbia, S.C., native was less hyped than her teammates after a high school career that frequently included that shot selection. Nevertheless, she entered the Gamecock history books fittingly against the program's in-state rival.

The (Watch List) Watcher

The Gamecocks have been omnipresent on national award watch lists this preseason. Three are on the Naismith Trophy and Wooden Award preseason lists and four of the five positional award preseason watch lists include at least one Gamecock.

One of the three Naismith watch list entries, Zia Cooke is once again on the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award list. She was a finalist for the award that honors the nation's top shooting guard in 2021.

Brea Beal made her debut on the Naismith Watch List

and was listed among those on the list for the best small forward in the nation, the Cheryl Miller Award.

Power forwards Victaria Saxton and Sania Feagin were selected to the watch list for the Katrina McClain Award.

Reigning National Player of the Year Aliyah Boston is on the Naismith, Wade and Wooden watch lists and is looking for a sweep of the Lisa Leslie Award as the top center in the country after winning the award each of her previous three seasons.

Preseason Predictions

As the reigning national champion, the Gamecocks are atop both preseason polls by a near unanimous decision. South Carolina claimed all 30 No. 1 votes in the Associated Press Poll. In the USA Today Coaches Poll, 30 of the 32 votes went to the Gamecocks.

South Carolina opened and closed the 2021-22 season atop both polls. The Gamecocks have been No. 1 in the AP poll 33 times since the start of the 2019-20 season, more than three times as many weeks as second place on the list, Stanford. South Carolina has been in the AP top five for a nation-leading 52 of the 57 polls in that same time period.

The Gamecocks were also selected to repeat as SEC Regular-Season Champions by both the media and league coaches in preseason voting.

Great Gamecock Fans

South Carolina fans have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last eight seasons. With nearly 10,000 season tickets sold this season that streak looks to continue for another year, currently leading the nation with 12,313 fans per game.

South Carolina's home opener of 12,779 fans is the top attendance game of the season so far, and Gamecock fans have logged three of the seven games nationally this season with at least 10,000 fans.

The Gamecocks have had at least one sellout of their 18,000-seat Colonial Life Arena for six straight seasons (excluding COVID-limited 2020-21 season).

Excluding the COVID limited-attendance season of 2020-21, South Carolina has drawn at least 10,000 fans 99 consecutive regular-season games beginning on Jan. 2.2015.

Everybody's All-American

On the Gamecocks' 13-woman roster, nine were McDonald's All-Americans in high school – Brea Beal, Aliyah Boston, Kamilla Cardoso, Zia Cooke, Talaysia ooper, Sania Feagin, Bree Hall, Raven Johnson and Ashlyn Watkins

At South Carolina, Staley has coached 20 McDonald's All-Americans, including $16\ \text{who}$ joined the Gamecocks as freshmen.

2023 Signing Class

South Carolina's 2023 signing class was ranked second in the nation behind the addition of four top-40 players, including a pair of top-20 signings. Chloe Kitts, the #17 player in the class, will get a jump on the rest as she plans to enroll at the University for the Spring 2023 semester.

The highest ranked member of the class is local product Milaysia Fulwiley (Columbia, S.C./W.J. Keenan) coming in at #13. A member of her high school varsity team since late in her seventh-grade season, the 5-foot-6 guard has been part of four state championship teams, including winning the last three 3A titles. A three-time state player of the year, she has averaged over 20 points in each of her last three seasons to amass over 2,000 career points ahead of her senior season.

Kitts (Oviedo, Fla./DME Academy) is a 6-foot-2 forward ranked 17th in the class. The Max Preps Junior All-American helped DME Academy to a bid in the GEICO Nationals in 2022 with her 18.7 points and 8.2 rebounds per game. She also helped USA Basketball to gold in the 2022 FIBA U18 Americas Championship with 7.7 points and 5.8 rebounds per game in just 16.2 minutes per game in the tournament.

Five-foot-10 guard Tessa Johnson clocks in at #25 in the 2023 class after her 23.4 points and 3.9 assists per game helped Saint Michael Albertville (Minn.) to a 2022 Class 4A state runner-up finish.

Sahnya Jah played three seasons at Bishop McNamara in Forestville, Md., to rise to #40 in the class. The 6-foot-1 wing is long and versatile with range and the ability to impact the game on both sides of the ball.

In women's basketball, Colonial Life Arena has become one of the most feared places to play as enormous crowds fill the building with passion for the Gamecocks.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last seven seasons. The Gamecocks were one of a few programs to finish the 2019-20 season averaging over 10,000 fans and boast six sellouts (18,000) in the last six seasons of full capacity arenas.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest on-campus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300. The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of 4.2 million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately $12' \times 20'$ and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.

DAWN STALEY Head Coach 15th Season at South Carolina

Catapulting South Carolina into the national spotlight, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. Under her leadership, the Gamecocks have reached many firsts – National Championships, NCAA Final Fours, No. 1 rankings, SEC regular-season and tournament titles, SEC Players of the Year, National Players of the Year, WNBA No. 1 Draft pick and No. 1 recruiting classes – to name the most notable.

In her 15th season at the helm of the Gamecocks, Staley's South Carolina highlights include:

- Two National Championships (2017, 2022)
- Four NCAA Final Fours in the last seven tournaments (2015, 2017, 2021, 2022)
- Ranking in the AP Top 25 every week since Dec. 10, 2012, including 118 weeks in the top five
- 49 weeks ranked No. 1 in the AP Poll, including two final No. 1 rankings (2019-20, 2021-22)
- 11 25-win seasons, including five 30-win campaigns led by a school-record 35 victories in 2021-22
- Six SEC regular-season championships (2014, 15, 16, 17, 20, 22) and Six SEC Tournament titles (2015, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21)
- Three top-two recruiting classes (#1 in 2021, #1 in 2019, #2 in 2014)
- Eight NCAA Attendance titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022)

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012.

In her 23rd season as a head coach, Staley has led her college teams to 12 25-win seasons, a total of 18 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 152 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 49 in the No. 1 spot – the fourth most times in the top spot of any program in the history of that poll. Her .747 winning percentage (545-185) ranks 11th in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 years of experience.

Also a force in USA Basketball, Staley was named the U.S. Women's National Team head coach for 2017-21, leading the U.S. to 2018 FIBA World Cup gold to earn USAB National Coach of the Year honors that year, adding gold medals at the 2019 and 2021 FIBA AmeriCups and stretching the U.S. Olympic gold medal streak to seven straight at the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games, for which she again earned Coach of the Year honors. Prior to that appointment, Staley led three other U.S. teams to gold medals and served two stints as an assistant on the Senior National Team, during which the U.S. claimed gold in the 2014 FIBA World Championship and the 2008 and 2016 Olympics.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last 14 seasons, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year three times (2014, 2020, 2022) with her 2020 unanimous selection making her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award. She is a five-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the Gamecocks' all-time winningest coach (373) with a program-record 11 postseason appearances and is the only black head coach in men's or women's basketball to win multiple national championships.

In the vaunted SEC, Staley's 167 league wins are the most among active league coaches and third all-time, trailing just Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Inductees Andy Landers (Georgia, 273) and Pat Summitt (Tennessee, 306). Her .752 SEC winning percentage (167-55) is second only to Summitt (.874) in league history. Her Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history, hitting that mark in 2015-16 and 2019-20.

In addition to coaching two National Players of the Year and a National Freshman of the Year, Staley has helped eight Gamecocks collect 19 All-America selections, three to pick up six SEC Player of the Year honors, three to earn SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognition a total of six times, one to SEC 6th Player of the Year honors and six to capture SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 17 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors a combined 34 times, including 18 first-team selections, and eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five seasons, including 2018 No. 1 pick A'ja Wilson, with two of those going on to win WNBA Rookie of the Year honors.
