GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- South Carolina continues to be a dominant force on the glass, ranking second in the nation in rebounds per game (51.1) and rebounding margin (+20.9). The offensive glass work (17.9 per game) is eighth in the nation as the Gamecocks clean up 48.1 percent of their own missed shots. Kamilla Cardoso (3.43) and Aliyah Boston (3.38) lead the way on the offensive glass, ranking fourth and fifth, respectively in the SEC.
- The Gamecocks have stamped their authority in the paint for several seasons, and this season's dominance ranks among their best so far. With 503.1 paint points per game, 61.0 percent of the offense comes from that space with a 59.5 percent field goal percentage. Defensively, the NCAA-best 10.0 blocked shots per game have contributed to hold opponents to just 32.8 percent shooting in the paint for 19.0 points per game.
- Six different Gamecocks have led the team in scoring at least once this season and five have been the top rebounder at least once. Nine have scored in double-figures at least once with eight of those doing it multiple times. Five of those eight come off the bench.
- Reigning National Player of the Year Aliyah Boston continues to contribute to the Gamecocks' success in every aspect of the game, despite the relentless defensive schemes designed to stop her. The team's top scorer (12.9) and rebounder (9.6), she is tied for the team lead in blocks (13) and is handing out 1.8 assists per game as well.
- SEC Player of the Week Kamilla Cardoso has lifted her game this season, already matching last season's double-double number (2) and with five double-figure scoring games already, she is just one shy of her total last season. The junior center is second on the team in rebounding (7.6) and third in scoring (10.9) while shooting a team-best 70.8 percent.

A Perennial Power

South Carolina women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful era, claiming at least 20 wins for the last 11 seasons, including five 30-win seasons in the last eight campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in the NCAA Final Four four times in the last seven NCAA Tournaments, including winning the 2017 and 2022 National Championships. They have been ranked in every AP Poll since Dec. 10, 2012, including a top-10 position every week since the start of the 2019-20 season. The Gamecocks have amassed 49 AP No. 1 rankings all-time, the fourth-most by a program in the history of that poll. Since the start of the 2019-20 season, South Carolina has been atop the poll 37 times – over three times more than any other team in that time.

Under head coach Dawn Staley's leadership, eight Gamecocks have earned All-America status, three have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 17 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once. Nine Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last seven years, including 2018 No. 1 overall pick Aja Wilson, who went on to become the Gamecocks' second-straight WNBA Rookie of the Year (2018) and the program's first WNBA MVP (2020, 2022).

The Liberty Series

The Gamecocks and Lady Flames have met twice before, both times in a tournament setting and both South Carolina victories.

The first meeting between the two programs came in the 2022 NCAA Tournament with the host Gamecocks claiming a 69-61 victory to start the program's first ever run into the Elite Eight.

The most recent meeting was in a regular-season tournament at Minnesota in 2014-15. South Carolina topped Liberty 84-44 on Dec. 21, 2014.

Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are 506-165 (.752) in home games (some records prior to 1976-77 did not include location of games). Current head coach Dawn Staley is 188-34 at home with that .847 winning percentage ranking second among the program's all-time head coaches (Pam Parsons (41-7) .854).

Playing in its 20th season at Colonial Life Arena, South Carolina boasts a 251-67 (.789) record in the building, including four undefeated seasons since 2013-14. Staley's share of that record is 185-34 (.844).

TEAM THEME: DNA

South Carolina's 2022-23 season theme "DNA" stands for Dreams, Nets, Assets – the elements routed in the DNA of the program.

Head coach Dawn Staley has described herself as a dream merchant as much as a coach throughout her career. Nets are the symbol of basketball success. Assets is a reminder of each team member's ability to positively impact the team's success as well as nod to the student-athlete's value in the name, image, likeness space.

Staley's program develops a different theme each season to amplify the team's goals and mindset for the season ahead.

Opponent Files

The Gamecocks' schedule includes six games against teams ranked in the most recent version of both national polls – at #2/2 Stanford (W, 76-71), at #6/6 UConn (Feb. 5), vs. #11/11 LSU (Feb. 12), vs. #13/15 UCLA (W, 73-64) at #20/21 Maryland (W, 81-56) and vs. #21/22 Arkansas (Jan. 22).

This season also includes three games against teams that received votes in one or both polls this week – vs. South Dakota State (Dec. 15), vs. Missouri (Jan. 15), at Tennessee (Feb. 23).

South Carolina's non-conference strength of schedule is listed at 19th, according to the NET rankings.

Ranked Readings

Against ranked teams, South Carolina is 102-66 (.607) in the Dawn Staley era (beginning 2008-09), and even that mark is skewed by the early seasons of her tenure.

Since the start of the 2014-15 campaign, the Gamecocks are 87-27 (.763) against ranked teams, including a 39-6 mark since the start of the 2019-20 season.

Senior Aliyah Boston has thrived in her 45 career games against ranked opponents, averaging 15.2 points, 12.3 rebounds and 2.9 blocks while shooting 53.8 percent. Senior Zia Cooke's offense is not far behind with her 13.7 points per game in those 45 outings.

So far this season, South Carolina is 3-0 against ranked opponents, winning those games by an average of 13.0 points with a +7.7 rebounding margin.

Dial Up the Defense

Head coach Dawn Staley has always put a premium on defense, but the Gamecocks have taken it to another level over the last four seasons (2019-20 to present), during which opponents have scored just 56.7 points per game with 45 of those 109 games (41.3 percent) coming against ranked opponents.

This season, South Carolina leads the nation in scoring defense (47.6) and field goal percentage defense (.279). Out-scoring opponents by 34.8 points per game, the Gamecocks are fourth in the nation in scoring margin, and they lead the nation with 10.3 blocks per game.

No team has reached its scoring average against the Gamecocks this season with the closest being #15/17 UCLA (Nov. 29), which missed its average by 12.1 points. On average, opposing teams have been held 26.7 points below their average. Three ranked opponents have been held 21.4 points below their average, including #2/2 Stanford, which scored 20 fewer than its average despite the game going into overtime.

Paint Production

South Carolina has long dominated the paint with both guards and post players taking advantage of the high percentage shots. Since the start of the 2019-20 season, the Gamecocks have scored 53.7 percent of their points in the paint.

So far this season, the Gamecocks have netted 50.3 points per game in the paint, accounting for 61.0 percent of their offense. Post players have accounted for 70.1 percent of those paint points (35.2 ppg).

The 2019-20 team had the highest final paint points average (42.4 ppg), but the 2020-21 team posted the highest percentage of paint points (55.1%).

Defensively, South Carolina controls the paint as well, allowing opponents to shoot just 32.8 percent to average 19.0 points in that area.

Block Party

South Carolina annually ranks among the best shot blocking teams in the country and leads the way again this season at 10.0 blocks per game (the second-place team is Drake at 6.9 per game).

Early this season an unexpected shot blocker is tied for the team lead with guard Brea Beal matching Aliyah Boston's team-high 13 blocks through eight games.

On average, Kamilla Cardoso leads the way with 1.7 per game to rank fourth in the SEC. Beal and Boston come in seventh in the league (1.6), and Laeticia Amihere is ninth at 1.5.

This year's Iron Gamecock winners were Zia Cooke and Ashlyn Watkins. The Iron Gamecock recipients exhibit exceptional performances in areas of speed, power, strength, and competitive challenges in the weight room.

Bench Mob

South Carolina's depth has been a hot topic this season, and it has not disappointed.

The Gamecock bench has been especially productive offensively, averaging 42.9 points to account for 52.0 percent of the Gamecocks' total offense. By comparison, last season's bench netted just 21.1 points per game for 29.8 percent of the offense.

The bench offensive production has come in key games with this season's group averaging 31.7 points per game against ranked opponents (41.3 percent).

On the boards, the bench has grabbed 47.9 percent of the total rebounds so far this season (24.5 per game). Kamilla Cardoso leads that group with her 7.6 boards per game, which is second on the team overall.

Quarter Breakdown

South Carolina's defense has held an opponent to single digits in a quarter 11 times through eight games so far this season, including four fourth quarters and two second quarters as the Gamecocks' constant defensive pressure wears opponents down. The scoring differential is largest in the fourth quarter with South Carolina outscoring opponents by 10.4 points per final period.

Individually, four Gamecocks have scored double

digits in a single quarter – Kamilla Cardoso (2), Zia Cooke (1), Sania Feagin (1) and Ashlyn Watkins (1). Feagin's 11 points in the fourth quarter against ETSU (Nov. 7) is the best of the season.

Boston's Best

Forward Aliyah Boston opened her senior season with exactly what sealed her unanimous National Player of the Year junior campaign – double-doubles. With six this season, she is fifth in the nation in that category and is just six away from tying the program record for career double-doubles (72, Sheila Foster, 1979-82).

From her college debut triple-double in November 2019 to her sweep of the national Player of the Year awards – including Naismith Defensive Player of the Year – the 6-foot-5 St. Thomas, U.S.V.I., native has been among the best in college women's basketball throughout her career.

Boston is a three-time All-American, three-time winner of the Lisa Leslie Award and three-time SEC Defensive Player of the Year. She added SEC Player of the Year honors in 2022 as well.

Averaging a double-double for her career (14.3 ppg/11.1 rpg), Boston leads all active NCAA players, all divisions, with 66 career double-doubles and 1,206 career rebounds. Her 270 career blocked shots are third among all active players.

In 45 career games against ranked opponents, her averages rise to 15.2 ppg and 12.3 rpg.

Vamos Kamilla!

Junior Kamilla Cardoso has returned to the form and aggressive play that made her a star in the ACC as a freshman. After a summer during which she spent

extended time with her family, the 6-foot-7 center returned to Columbia with a renewed energy and passion for the game.

Cardoso showed glimpses of her impact early this season, but has proven to be a consistent dominant force over the last three games, averaging 15.0 points, 11.0 rebounds and 3.3 blocks while shooting 71.4 percent from the field in that stretch.

On the season, Cardoso is second on the team in rebounding at 7.6 per game and third in scoring with a 10.8 average. She is fourth in the SEC with 1.7 blocks per game and fourth in the league at 3.4 offensive rebounds per game.

Cardoso averages 3.4 points per game off her own offensive rebounds and scores either a field goal or free throw in 50.0 percent of her offensive boards.

First Gamecock Takes Flight

Freshman Ashlyn Watkins became the first Gamecock in program history to dunk when she slammed one home following a steal with 3:30 to play in the fourth quarter at Clemson (Nov. 17). The Columbia, S.C., native was less hyped than her teammates after a high school career that frequently included that shot selection. Nevertheless, she entered the Gamecock history books fittingly against the program's in-state rival.

The (Watch List) Watcher

The Gamecocks have been omnipresent on national award watch lists this preseason. Three are on the Naismith Trophy and Wooden Award preseason lists and four of the five positional award preseason watch lists include at least one Gamecock.

One of the three Naismith watch list entries, Zia Cooke is once again on the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award list. She was a finalist for the award that honors the nation's top shooting guard in 2021.

Brea Beal made her debut on the Naismith Watch List and was listed among those on the list for the best small forward in the nation, the Cheryl Miller Award.

Power forwards Victoria Saxton and Sania Feagin were selected to the watch list for the Katrina McClain Award.

Reigning National Player of the Year Aliyah Boston is on the Naismith, Wade and Wooden watch lists and is looking for a sweep of the Lisa Leslie Award as the top center in the country after winning the award each of her previous three seasons.

Preseason Predictions

As the reigning national champion, the Gamecocks are atop both preseason polls by a near unanimous decision. South Carolina claimed all 30 No. 1 votes in the Associated Press Poll. In the USA Today Coaches Poll, 30 of the 32 votes went to the Gamecocks.

South Carolina opened and closed the 2021-22 season atop both polls. The Gamecocks have been No. 1 in the AP poll 33 times since the start of the 2019-20 season, more than three times as many weeks as second place on the list, Stanford. South Carolina has been in the AP top five for a nation-leading 52 of the 57 polls in that same time period.

The Gamecocks were also selected to repeat as SEC Regular-Season Champions by both the media and league coaches in preseason voting.

Great Gamecock Fans

South Carolina fans have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last eight seasons. With over 10,000 season tickets sold this season that streak looks to continue for another year, currently leading the nation with 12,221 fans per game.

South Carolina holds two of the top-five most attended games so far this season with the home opener's 12,779 fans ranking third. Gamecock fans have logged four of the seven games nationally this season with at least 11,000 fans.

The Gamecocks have had at least one sellout of their 18,000-seat Colonial Life Arena for six straight seasons (excluding COVID-limited 2020-21 season).

Excluding the COVID limited-attendance season of 2020-21, South Carolina has drawn at least 10,000 fans 99 consecutive regular-season games beginning on Jan. 2, 2015.

Everybody's All-American

On the Gamecocks' 13-woman roster, nine were McDonald's All-Americans in high school – Brea Beal, Aliyah Boston, Kamilla Cardoso, Zia Cooke, Talaysia Cooper, Sania Feagin, Bree Hall, Raven Johnson and Ashlyn Watkins.

At South Carolina, Staley has coached 20 McDonald's All-Americans, including 16 who joined the Gamecocks as freshmen.

2023 Signing Class

South Carolina's 2023 signing class was ranked second in the nation behind the addition of four top-40 players, including a pair of top-20 signings. Chloe Kitts, the #17 player in the class, will get a jump on the rest as she plans to enroll at the University for the Spring 2023 semester.

The highest ranked member of the class is local product Milaysia Fulwiley (Columbia, S.C./W.J. Keenan) coming in at #13. A member of her high school varsity team since late in her seventh-grade season, the 5-foot-6 guard has been part of four state championship teams, including winning the last three 3A titles. A three-time state player of the year, she has averaged over 20 points in each of her last three seasons to amass over 2,000 career points ahead of her senior season.

Kitts (Oviedo, Fla./DME Academy) is a 6-foot-2 forward ranked 17th in the class. The Max Preps Junior All-American helped DME Academy to a bid in the GEICO Nationals in 2022 with her 18.7 points and 8.2 rebounds per game. She also helped USA Basketball to gold in the 2022 FIBA U18 Americas Championship with 7.7 points and 5.8 rebounds per game in just 16.2 minutes per game in the tournament.

Five-foot-10 guard Tessa Johnson clocks in at #25 in the 2023 class after her 23.4 points and 3.9 assists per game helped Saint Michael Albertville (Minn.) to a 2022 Class 4A state runner-up finish.

Sahnja Jah played three seasons at Bishop McNamara in Forestville, Md., to rise to #40 in the class. The 6-foot-1 wing is long and versatile with range and the ability to impact the game on both sides of the ball.

In women's basketball, Colonial Life Arena has become one of the most feared places to play as enormous crowds fill the building with passion for the Gamecocks.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last seven seasons. The Gamecocks were one of a few programs to finish the 2019-20 season averaging over 10,000 fans and boast six sellouts (18,000) in the last six seasons of full capacity arenas.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest on-campus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300. The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of \$4.2 million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately 12' x 20' and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.

Under her leadership, the Gamecocks have reached many firsts – National Championships, NCAA Final Fours, No. 1 rankings, SEC regular-season and tournament titles, SEC Players of the Year, National Players of the Year, WNBA No. 1 Draft pick and No. 1 recruiting classes – to name the most notable.

In her 15th season at the helm of the Gamecocks, Staley's South Carolina highlights include:

- Two National Championships (2017, 2022)
- Four NCAA Final Fours in the last seven tournaments (2015, 2017, 2021, 2022)
- Ranking in the AP Top 25 every week since Dec. 10, 2012, including 119 weeks in the top five
- 49 weeks ranked No. 1 in the AP Poll, including two final No. 1 rankings (2019-20, 2021-22)
- 11 25-win seasons, including five 30-win campaigns led by a school-record 35 victories in 2021-22
- Six SEC regular-season championships (2014, 15, 16, 17, 20, 22) and Six SEC Tournament titles (2015, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21)
- Three top-two recruiting classes (#1 in 2021, #1 in 2019, #2 in 2014)
- Eight NCAA Attendance titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022)

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012.

In her 23rd season as a head coach, Staley has led her college teams to 12 25-win seasons, a total of 18 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 152 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 49 in the No. 1 spot – the fourth most times in the top spot of any program in the history of that poll. Her .747 winning percentage (546-185) ranks 11th in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 years of experience.

Also a force in USA Basketball, Staley was named the U.S. Women's National Team head coach for 2017-21, leading the U.S. to 2018 FIBA World Cup gold to earn USAB National Coach of the Year honors that year, adding gold medals at the 2019 and 2021 FIBA AmeriCups and stretching the U.S. Olympic gold medal streak to seven straight at the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games, for which she again earned Coach of the Year honors. Prior to that appointment, Staley led three other U.S. teams to gold medals and served two stints as an assistant on the Senior National Team, during which the U.S. claimed gold in the 2014 FIBA World Championship and the 2008 and 2016 Olympics.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last 14 seasons, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year three times (2014, 2020, 2022) with her 2020 unanimous selection making her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award. She is a five-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the Gamecocks' all-time winningest coach (374) with a program-record 11 postseason appearances and is the only black head coach in men's or women's basketball to win multiple national championships.

In the vaulted SEC, Staley's 167 league wins are the most among active league coaches and third all-time, trailing just Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Inductees Andy Landers (Georgia, 273) and Pat Summitt (Tennessee, 306). Her .752 SEC winning percentage (167-55) is second only to Summitt (.874) in league history. Her Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history, hitting that mark in 2015-16 and 2019-20.

In addition to coaching two National Players of the Year and a National Freshman of the Year, Staley has helped eight Gamecocks collect 19 All-America selections, three to pick up six SEC Player of the Year honors, three to earn SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognition a total of six times, one to SEC 6th Player of the Year honors and six to capture SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 17 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors a combined 34 times, including 18 first-team selections, and eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five seasons, including 2018 No. 1 pick Aja Wilson, with two of those going on to win WNBA Rookie of the Year honors.
