AGGIES AT GAMECOCKS:

The Texas A&M men's basketball team seeks a 4-0 start in SEC play when the Aggies take on the South Carolina Gamecock in a 5 p.m. road matchup at Colonial Life Arena on Saturday.

- The Aggies have opened SEC play with a trio of keystone victories - the program's first-ever win over Florida in Gainesville, snapping a 10-game losing skid to LSU and knocking off the first ranked foe of the season against No. 20 Missouri.
- Saturday's matchup with the Gamecocks is another keystone opportunity as the Aggies look to snap a six-game losing streak to South Carolina with the last five being double-digit margins of defeat.

GETTING TO THE LINE:

The Aggies rank No. 1 nationally free throws made per game and No. 2 in FTs attempted. Texas A&M has shot 100+ more free throws than seven SEC teams.

- The Aggies average 19.3-26.4 FTM-FTA per game. Tyrece Radford and Wade Taylor IV are in the SEC top five in free throw makes with 74 and 69, respectively. Both are hitting over 80.0% of their FTAs -- 81.2% for Taylor and 80.4% for Radford.
- Texas A&M has been to the line 25 or more times in 13 of 16 games and has hit 20 or more FTs seven times.

TRENDS & STREAKS:

- In the three SEC wins, the Aggies have trailed for a combined 5 minutes and 25 seconds.
- Team is seeking a 4-0 SEC start for a second straight year (Program-best SEC start is 7-0 by 2015-16 team).
- Texas A&M's season-high 5-game winning streak came on the heels losing back-to-back games prior to the holiday break.
- Since the holiday break, Tyrece Radford has scored 14 or more points in every game (team-high 17.6 average in last five games).
- The Aggies have made an about-face on fouling. The team had 20+ in 7 of the first 8 games of the season, including 24 or more 6 times. Over the last 8 games, the Aggies have had 20 or less 7 times and fewer than than opponents 7 times.
- Since scuffling through a streak of five games with 6 or fewer points, Dexter Dennis has hit double figures in past two games - 17 vs. LSU, 13 vs. Mizzou. In the 5-game win streak, Dennis is averaging a team-best 6.8 rebounds.
- Hayden Hefner came off the bench to hit his first FG of 2023, scoring 12 points on 3-of-3 shooting from deep all in the first half vs. Missouri.

WHAT'S UNIQUE ABOUT AGGIE HOOPS?

- During gameday shoot-arounds, the Aggies traditionally vibe to **The Commodores** Pandora station on the team Turtlebox bluetooth speaker. This may have changed **Bruno Mars**.
- "Shooting with Buzz" is a staple of the Aggies' practice regimen. As described by the Bryan-College Station Eagle: *"Each player must move their way through 18 shooting spots – some straight catch and shoot and some off of movement – and make 7 of 10 shots. The clock starts after the player's first make and stops once the whole circuit is done. Managers rebound the shots and pass a ball to Williams, who stands near the player, handing the ball off for each shot. On the sideline, a manager stands in front of a giant white board, keeping tallies of the players score at each position. On the other side, a record book of times it took to complete the course are logged."*

Williams told the Eagle the impetus for "Shooting with Buzz" was, *"I wanted to try to figure out a way, coming off of COVID and all the protocols and having, in essence, a completely revamped roster – how could I find some time working, while at the same time not screaming, while, in an unspoken way, they know I'm trying to invest in their life and in their game."*

- Buzz Williams** is a voracious reader, generally completing 4-5 books every month. On Jan. 2, 2023, he tweeted from @TeamCoachBuzz his "2022 Reads" which listed the 53 books he consumed throughout the year. For the last 11 years, Williams has selected and gifted a book to every player, staff member and their family on the initial road trip of the season. Describing his commitment to reading, Williams said, *"Who you are today and who you will be five years from today are the people you meet and the books that you read. Regardless of the genre of book that you read, they say it's worth five years of experience."* (Source: @AggieMBK/Dec. 16)

- Last fall, Williams presented four lectures to Texas A&M students for **SOMS 380 (School of Military Science)**, in collaboration with the Corps of Cadets and the Hollingsworth Center for Ethical Leadership.
- Williams' coaching/support staff has been together for a combined **80 seasons of experience**.
- On the occasion of a player or staff member's birthday, Williams honors the occasion with an **emoji-filled tweet** that always includes a wrong number of birthdays for the celebrator.
- #getBETTER** is the long-time mantra for Buzz Williams and his teams. It refers to *"the continual improvement in all facets of life. Always finding something to work on, to make progress on. Never being satisfied. Always looking for ways to grow."*
- A staple of every road trip are the Aggies' **Thank You** letters. Each coach/player/staff member on the trip writes a Thank You letter to someone in their life at the first team meal of the roadie.
- "**Buzz's Bunch**" was implemented by Williams as a way to bring together children with special needs and allow them to fall in love with basketball through an annual free camp and free tickets to a game.
- Quote Shirts** have been a pillar in the culture of Buzz Williams' programs throughout his career as a head coach. So far in 2022-23, six Quote Shirts have made their debuts:
 - 'We Are Always Choosing'
 - 'Be Allergic to the Big Meal'
 - 'Never Let That Influence This'
 - 'Airtime Equals Our Time'
 - 'In Order To Climb the Ladder, You Must Go One Step At a Time'
 - 'HUNT'

OBASEKI SIDELINED:

- The Aggies' leading bench scorer **Manny Obaseki** suffered a fractured pinkie on his left shooting hand vs. Florida (Jan. 4) and is estimated be out for 4-6 weeks, according to head coach **Buzz Williams**.

DO-IT-ALL DYNAMO:

Sophomore guard **Wade Taylor IV**, the 6-foot do-it-all dynamo from Dallas, Texas, ranks in the top 10 in the SEC in a wide array of statistical categories:

RARE AIR FOR TAYLOR IV:

Sophomore guard **Wade Taylor IV** is on pace to join an elite group of Aggies that led the team in scoring, assists and steals in the same season.

- The last Aggie to achieve the rare trifecta for an entire season was **Acie Law IV**, who did it in consecutive years in 2005-06 and 2006-07.
- Since 1974-75 when Texas A&M began recording steals as a statistic, just seven players have finished as the team leader in points, assists and steals in the same season with three of them being Texas A&M Athletics Hall of Famers.

MARKED IMPROVEMENT:

Tyrece Radford is getting to the line and hitting the freebies at a significantly higher rate in his fourth season as a collegian.



- After averaging only 2.5 free throw attempts per game for the first three years of his career, Radford is making 5.8 trips to the charity stripe per game in 2022-23.
- Radford has already hit 74 free throws in just 16 games. His previous high season total was 56 from his freshman season at Virginia Tech (56-of-81) when he played 32 games.
- Radford's 80.4 FT% is markedly improved from last year when he hit 67.1% from the line. Radford's three-year FT% entering 2022-23 was 70.6%.

- The "Voice of the Aggies," Andrew Monaco is entering his fifth season as the play-by-play voice for the Texas A&M men's basketball, football and baseball teams, as well as the host of the coach's radio show for those teams. Prior to Texas A&M, Monaco spent 16 seasons with the San Antonio Spurs and was a part of the broadcast crew covering two NBA titles.
- A team captain on the Aggies' SWC Championship team in 1974-75, Dr. John Thornton has served as the color analyst for the men's basketball team for many years. Also the SEC Newcomer of the Year in 1973-74, Thornton was an assistant coach from 1981-90 and served as interim head coach in 1990 before embarking on a long career as an administrator for Texas A&M Athletics.

HCIII LEADING THE WAY:

Junior F Henry Coleman III, along with women's basketball player Jada Malone, represent Texas A&M as members of the SEC Basketball Leadership Council. The council serves as a conduit of communication from student-athletes to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience and wellness and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.



- Coleman is an avid fisher and hunter. "Fishing and hunting teach you to be calm under pressure," Coleman said. "When you set that hook on that fish, you can't just start reeling it in. You've got to be a little bit calm and kind of work it in. When you're hunting and you see a buck right in front of you, you have to wait a little bit. I know you want to pull the trigger as soon as you see it, but you have to wait for the right time. It teaches you to be calm in the moment and stay in the moment." (Source: 12thMan.com)
- Coleman's father, Hank, was a standout defensive end for Virginia Tech and started for the Hokies' 1995 Sugar Bowl Champion team. HCIII told the Bryan-College Station Eagle (Jan., 7, 2022), "Enter Sandman' is one of my favorite traditions. A&M football is fun, but Virginia Tech football is deep in my heart."
- Coleman transferred to Texas A&M from Duke prior to the 2021-22. Former Duke head coach Mike Krzyzewski said of HCIII: "I hope I'm around when he's stopped playing to see who he becomes, not just as a player. I just think he's going to be a very special guy in our country. He's that good." (Source: USA Today Network, Nov. 18, 2020)

RANDOM NOTABLES:

- This week's SEC Player of the Week Julius Marble is connecting on a team-high 58.7% of his FGA (min. of 10 FGA) and has made 50% or higher of his shots in 14-of-16 games.
- Easily the Aggies' most prolific shooter from deep, Wade Taylor IV has improved his 3-point % by nearly .10 from last year. Taylor is hitting 36.7% in 2022-23 after making 27.8% as a freshman.
- The Aggies' starting lineup has a definite Pelican State flavor with at least two Louisiana natives in it for every game so far this season - Tyrece Radford (Baton Rouge) and Dexter Dennis (Baker). Additionally, Solomon Washington (New Orleans) has joined them in the starting lineup four times.
- The Aggies have used the same starting lineup (Coleman III, Dennis, Marble, Radford and Taylor IV) for the last five games (all wins). For the season, the fivesome is 6-1 with the lone loss coming to Boise State on Dec. 3.
- The defensive-minded duo of Andersson Garcia and Andre Gordon have been the first players off the bench for the past four games.
- The Aggies' 2022-23 roster was bolstered by the addition of six newcomers in the offseason -- five transfers and one scholarship freshman. Headlining the group was Dexter Dennis, who was the American Athletic Conference Defensive Player of the Year at Wichita State in 2021-22, and Julius Marble, who helped Michigan State advance to the second round of the NCAA tournament. Both have earned spots in

- Associate Head Coach Devin Johnson said, "We are thrilled to add Bryce Lindsay to our program. His toughness, shot-making ability and high IQ are going to fit well here in Aggieland. Bryce will continue to help Coach Buzz (Williams) build something special here at Texas A&M!"
- The 6-foot-4 Lindsay, who is playing a post-graduate season at IMG Academy in Bradenton, Fla., averaged 19.6 points, 3.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists for St. Frances Academy (Md.) in 2021-22 while leading the Panthers to a 35-6 record. He was coached by Nick Myles at St. Frances. Rated a four-star prospect by Rivals.com, Lindsay chose Texas A&M over Villanova, West Virginia and South Carolina.

- Six Aggies have played over 1,000 minutes, led by Dexter Dennis and Tyrece Radford who have both surpassed the 3,000-minute plateau.
- A nugget in the Jan. 12, 2021 Associated Press recap of Virginia Tech's win over Duke included legendary head coach Mike Krzyzewski describing Radford's 18-point, 12-rebound, 6-assist effort in the victory: "The kid Radford was the best player on the court. Double-double, but his intensity, how hard he played really helps their team immensely."

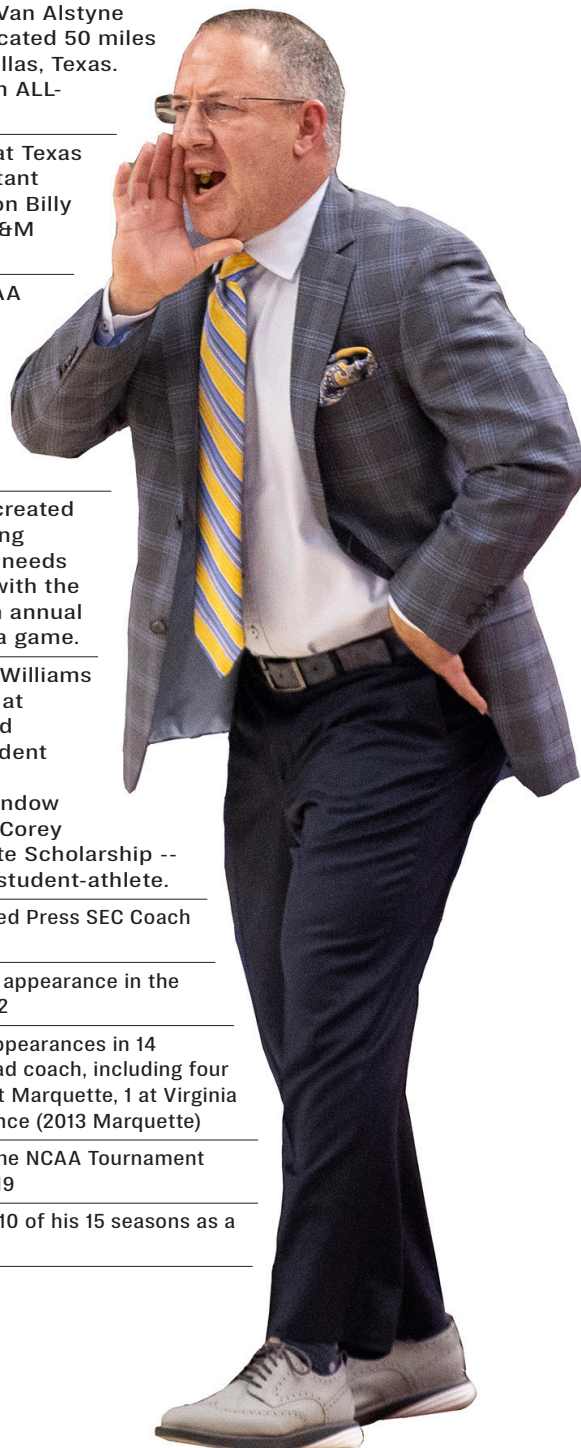

BUZZ WILLIAMS AT A GLANCE

- Buzz Williams is in his fourth season as the head coach at Texas A&M and his 16th year as a collegiate head coach.
- Prior to being named head coach of the Aggies on April 3, 2019, Williams served as head coach at Virginia Tech (5 years, 2014-19), Marquette (6 years, 2008-14) and New Orleans (1 year, 2006-07).
- He received the nickname "Buzz" while working as an energetic student assistant for longtime Navarro Junior College coach and mentor Lewis Orr. Brent Langdon Williams or "Buzz" was inducted into the Navarro College Bulldog Hall of Fame in 2021.
- Williams was born in Greenville, Texas and grew up in the small Texas town of Van Alstyne (population 4,369), which is located 50 miles north of the Cotton Bowl in Dallas, Texas. Van Alstyne is pronounced Van ALL-steen.
- This is Williams' second stint at Texas A&M - he also served as assistant coach/recruiting coordinator on Billy Gillispie's first staff at Texas A&M from 2004-06.
- Williams is one of the few NCAA Div. I head coaches that did not play college basketball. Instead, he was a student/graduate assistant at Navarro JC, Oklahoma City University and TAMU-Kingsville.
- While at Marquette, Williams created "Buzz's Bunch" as a way to bring together children with special needs and allow them to fall in love with the game of basketball through an annual free camp and free tickets to a game.
- As part of "Buzz's Bunch," the Williams family endowed a scholarship at Virginia Tech, which is awarded annually to a Virginia Tech student with a disability. Additionally, Williams' wife, Corey, helped endow a scholarship -- The Buzz and Corey Williams Family Student-Athlete Scholarship -- which is awarded to a female student-athlete.
- Williams was named the Associated Press SEC Coach of the Year in 2019-20
- He guided the Aggies to first-ever appearance in the NIT championship game in 2021-22
- He has eight NCAA Tournament appearances in 14 postseason opportunities as a head coach, including four career Sweet 16 appearances (3 at Marquette, 1 at Virginia Tech) and one Elite Eight appearance (2013 Marquette)
- Williams guided Virginia Tech to the NCAA Tournament three straight seasons from 2017-19
- He has won 20-or-more games in 10 of his 15 seasons as a head coach.





MOLDING YOUNG MINDS:

Buzz Williams presented a trio of lectures to the SOMS (School of Military Science) 380: Workshop in Leadership Education class this fall semester in a collaboration with Texas A&M's Corps of Cadets and the Hollingsworth Center for Ethical Leadership.

- Dr. Dave Keller, Director of the Hollingsworth Center, said, "The Hollingsworth Center works primarily with students who are not going into the military upon graduation, although we certainly have several that do. Our SOMS [School of Military Science] program of study begins during the spring semester of their sophomore year, where we focus on helping cadets find their strengths and lead from a perspective of authenticity.
- Keller added, "SOMS 380 is the second course for our students. It focuses heavily on finding their leadership constraints and blind spots, and then developing an action plan to intentionally improve in these critical areas. In later semesters, students learn more about the science of leadership, along with how to lead teams and organizations more effectively."
- Dr. Darin Paine, Associate Director for the Hollingsworth Center, said, "Whenever cadets can learn from a presenter such as Coach Buzz Williams, there are many opportunities for personal and professional gain. It could reinforce what they are already learning in SOMS, or present a new concept, or allow them to hear something that applies to their life right now. There are countless opportunities to benefit from an experience like this. Coach Williams is a high achiever, lifelong learner, and very enthusiastic about teaching. He has so much to offer and we are thrilled with this partnership."
- One of the class attendees, sophomore Luke White, told the Bryan-College Station Eagle: "I think it's really cool that he's doing this. He's going beyond being just a coach. He's really trying to connect with us as students."
