GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- The Gamecocks have assisted on 56.3 percent of their made field goals in SEC action, logging a league-best 16.57 assists per game. Redshirt-freshman Raven Johnson leads the charge with 3.86 assists per SEC game, but she's been sure-handed all season, ranking fifth in the nation with a 2.86 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- The result of South Carolina's depth shows up best late in games. In three wins over ranked opponents this season, South Carolina outscored its foe by 8.3 points per fourth quarter, shooting 42.9 percent while allowing just 19.5 percent accuracy in the final period.
- The Gamecocks' 17.7 offensive rebounds per game (4th in NCAA) have delivered 19.2 second-chance points per outing. Their work on the defensive glass (32.2/gm) has held opponents to just 6.9 second-chance points per game.
- South Carolina's block party includes four of the SEC's top-10 shot blockers, but they are not alone. All but one Gamecock has recorded at least one block this season.
- In her last five outings, Aliyah Boston's numbers have exploded, averaging 16.4 points, 11.0 rebounds, 3.0 blocks and even 2.2 assists while shooting 68.8 percent (33-of-48) in that stretch. She has tied the program record with 72 career double-doubles (Sheila Foster, 1979-82).
- Boston continues to be among the most valuable players in the nation on both sides of the ball, according to Her Hoop Stats. Among players averaging at least 20 minutes, she leads the nation in player defensive rating (60.8) while coming in seventh in player offensive rating (135.6). Her win shares per 40 minutes comes in third (0.37).
- Zia Cooke's efficient shooting season includes nine games of 50.0 percent or better shooting, helping her to a career-best 41.7 percent mark for the season.

A Perennial Power

South Carolina women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful era, claiming at least 20 wins for the last 11 seasons, including five 30-win seasons in the last eight campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in the NCAA Final Four four times in the last seven NCAA Tournaments, including winning the 2017 and 2022 National Championships. They have been ranked in every AP Poll since Dec. 10, 2012, including a top-10 position every week since the start of the 2019-20 season. The Gamecocks have amassed 55 AP No. 1 rankings all-time, the fourth-most by a program in the history of that poll, with a current streak of 30 weeks, which is tied for the fourth-longest streak in the poll's history. In the 67 polls since the start of the 2019-20 season, South Carolina has been atop the poll 43 times.

Under head coach Dawn Staley's leadership, eight Gamecocks have earned All-America status, three have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 17 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once. Nine Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last seven years, including 2018 No. 1 overall pick Aja Wilson, who went on to become the Gamecocks' second-straight WNBA Rookie of the Year (2018) and the program's first WNBA MVP (2020, 2022).

The Arkansas Series

South Carolina leads the overall series 24-18 after winning the last six meetings with Arkansas. The Gamecocks are 12-5 against the Razorbacks in Columbia, including wins in the last six meetings in Colonial Life Arena.

The two teams met twice in 2021-22 with #1/1 South Carolina claiming both victories – 61-52 in Fayetteville (Jan. 16) and 76-54 in the SEC Tournament quarterfinals in Nashville (Mar. 4). Rebounding was the key in both with the Gamecocks holding a 20-board edge in Fayetteville and a 17-rebound margin in Nashville. Aliyah Boston was the top scorer and rebounder in both games, averaging 18.0 points and 13.5 boards in the set. In Nashville, she added a team-high five assists and led the way with five steals as well.

Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are 506-165 (.754) in home games (some records prior to 1976-77 did not include location of games). Current head coach Dawn Staley is 194-34 at

TEAM THEME: DNA

home with that .851 winning percentage ranking second in program history (Pam Parsons (41-7) .854).

Playing in its 20th season at Colonial Life Arena, South Carolina boasts a 257-67 (.793) record in the building, including four undefeated seasons since 2013-14. Staley's share of that record is 191-34 (.849).

In SEC action, South Carolina is 136-89 (.604) at home with Staley posting a 92-22 (.807) mark.

Opponent Files

The Gamecocks' schedule includes six games against teams currently ranked in at least one of the national polls – at #2/2 Stanford (W, 76-71), at #5/5UConn (Feb. 5), vs. #3/4 LSU (Feb. 12), vs. #15/17 UCLA (W, 73-64), at #17/18 Maryland (W, 81-56) and vs. #/22 Arkansas (Jan. 22).

One other opponent on the Gamecocks' schedule is receiving votes in at least one poll – Tennessee.

South Carolina's three wins over ranked opponents are tied for the second-most in the nation this season, and its two true road wins over ranked opponents ties for the best in the country (Maryland, Baylor). The average rank of the Gamecocks' ranked wins is 10.7, which is third among teams with more than one win over a ranked opponent – Notre Dame 4.5, North Carolina 8.3.

Ranked Readings

Against ranked teams, South Carolina is 102-66 (.607) in the Dawn Staley era (beginning 2008-09), and even that mark is skewed by the early seasons of her tenure.

Rebounding Roundup

South Carolina is routinely among the top rebounding teams in the country and has not dropped off this season.

The Gamecocks rank among the nation's top four in rebounding margin (2nd, +20.8), rebounding average (3rd, 49.89) and offensive rebounds (4th, 17.7). South Carolina is securing 49.0 percent of its own missed shots, which is second in the nation and has delivered 19.2 second-chance points per game.

Aliyah Boston (9.47, 2nd in SEC, 36th in NCAA) and Kamilla Cardoso (7.94, 8th in SEC) lead the rebounding effort and, are two of the top three offensive rebounders in the SEC as well – 3.26 and 3.61 per game, respectively.

South Carolina has been out-rebounded just once this season (41-47 at #2/2 Stanford, Nov. 20) and only four other games have had a single-digit rebounding margin for the Gamecocks.

Dial Up the Defense

Head coach Dawn Staley has always put a premium on defense, but the Gamecocks have taken it to another level over the last four seasons (2019-20 to present), during which opponents have scored just 53.3 points per game with 45 of those 120 games (37.5 percent) coming against ranked opponents.

This season, South Carolina leads the nation in scoring defense (45.7 ppg), field goal percentage defense (.288), 3-point percentage defense (.226) and blocks per game (9.9). Out-scoring opponents by 36.7 points per game, the Gamecocks also lead the nation in scoring margin.

No team has reached its scoring average against the Gamecocks this season with the closest being Kentucky (Jan. 12), which missed its average by 3.1 points. No other team has come within single digits of its average.

On the season, opposing teams have been held an average of 24.4 points below their usual points per game. In SEC action, that number is still strong at 19.8.

The Gamecocks held their three ranked opponents 21.4 points below their average, including #2/2 Stanford, which scored 20 fewer than its average despite the game going into overtime. The Cardinal are the only team to reach 70 points against South Carolina, needing overtime to eclipse the mark.

Paint Production

South Carolina's paint dominance predated the 2019 signing class, but the Gamecocks have certainly perfected

it since the group's arrival, scoring 53.6 percent of their points in the paint since the start of the 2019-20 season.

The 2019-20 team had the highest final paint points average (42.4 ppg) in this stretch, but the 2020-21 team posted the highest percentage of paint points (55.1%).

So far this season, the Gamecocks are beating both numbers, posting 46.5 points per game in the paint, which accounts for 56.4 percent of their offense.

Defensively, South Carolina controls the paint as well, allowing opponents to shoot just 34.6 percent in the lane to average 20.8 points in that area. The Gamecocks have been out-scored in the paint just twice this season – at #2/2 Stanford (40-36) and at Mississippi State (32-28).

"O" – That's Good!

While retaining its sterling reputation as a defensive stalwart, South Carolina's offense is clamoring for its share of the spotlight this season. The Gamecocks are top 10 in the nation in scoring offense (82.4 ppg, 9th) and field goal percentage (.481, 10th), and their efficiency has continued in SEC action with a league-leading 48.9 percent shooting.

South Carolina has shot over 50.0 percent in a game nine times this season, including three games over 60.0 percent, and has fallen below 40 percent just five times. Last season's National Championship team hit the 50.0 percent mark just seven times all season.

Five of the Gamecocks' six post players are shooting over 50.0 percent, including three over the 60.0 percent mark – Sania Feagin 65.5, Aliyah Boston 60.3 and Ashlyn Watkins 60.0. In SEC games, 12 Gamecocks are shooting 40.0 percent or better.

Block Party

South Carolina annually ranks among the best shot blocking teams in the country and leads the way again this season at 9.9 blocks per game (second place is 6.5).

This season, the Gamecocks have blocked 23.6 percent of their opponents' 2-point attempts, which also leads the country. They have posted double-digit blocks eight times, led by 16 against Coastal Carolina (Dec. 21).

Four Gamecocks are among the SEC's top 10 – Aliyah Boston (3rd, 2.00), Kamilla Cardoso (4th, 1.59), Laeticia Amihere (6th, 1.50) and Brea Beal (10th, 1.42). Boston's average includes an SEC-best 2.57 in league play.

Bench Mob

South Carolina's depth has been a hot topic this season, and it has not disappointed.

Averaging 97.2 minutes per game, the Gamecock bench has been especially productive offensively, averaging 40.1 points to account for 48.7 percent of the Gamecocks' total offense while shooting 49.3 percent. By comparison, last season's bench netted just 21.1 points per game for 29.8 percent of the offense.

Only two opponents' benches have out-scored South Carolina's this season – South Dakota State (Dec. 15, 19-15), at Georgia (Jan. 2, 21-19). The Gamecock bench has tied or out-scored an opponent's starters 12 times and has out-scored its own starters six times.

Four Gamecocks have come off the bench to score in double figures in at least five games so far this season – Kamilla Cardoso (8), Ashlyn Watkins (6), Laeticia Amihere (5), Sania Feagin (5).

The bench's offensive production has come in key games with this season's group averaging 31.7 points against ranked opponents (41.3 percent), including some timely buckets in tight games, and 35.6 points in SEC play.

On the boards, the bench has grabbed 52.2 percent of the total rebounds so far this season (23.9 per game). Kamilla Cardoso leads that group with her 7.94 boards per game, which rank her eighth in the SEC.

Quarter Breakdown

South Carolina's defense has held an opponent to single digits in a quarter 27 times this season. The Gamecocks have out-scored their opponent by 15 or more points in a quarter 20 times. The scoring differential is largest in the third and fourth quarters (+9.5).

The Long and Short of It

With 10 Gamecocks standing 6-feet or taller, South Carolina's roster is among the tallest in the country. The 14 Gamecocks range from 5-foot-8 (Raven Johnson, Olivia Thompson) to 6-foot-7 (Kamilla Cardoso).

South Carolina's 14 players stand an average of 72.9 inches tall, which is second only to Kansas State's 73.1-inch average. Stanford is next in line at 72.7 inches with Tennessee coming in at 72.1.

Beyond Basketball

South Carolina posted a 3.011 GPA in the Fall 2022 semester, the program's eighth-straight semester with a 3.00 or higher mark. In addition to Dean's List entries Brea Beal and Aliyah Boston (the 2022 CoSIDA Academic All-America Team Member of the Year), who exceeded a 3.5 GPA for the semester, eight other Gamecocks made the Athletics Director's Honor Roll (3.0 or higher) in the Fall.

Boston's Best

Reigning National Player of the Year Aliyah Boston continues to live up to that title thanks to the flattery of opposing coaches who create defensive schemes expressly designed to slow her down.

Despite the extra attention – double, triple and the occasional quadruple team – Boston is fifth in the nation with 12 double-doubles, including a current streak of four straight. She leads the Gamecocks in rebounding (9.47, 2nd in SEC, 36th in nation) and is second in scoring (12.7) – both numbers that go up dramatically against ranked opponents (16.0 ppg/12.0 rpg). Defensively, she remains locked in, ranking third in the SEC and 24th in the nation with 2.00 blocks per game, including 2.57 per conference game.

In her last five outings, Boston's numbers have exploded, averaging 16.4 points, 11.0 rebounds, 3.0 blocks and even 2.2 assists and shooting 68.8 percent (33-of-48) in that stretch. With four double-doubles in her last four games, she has tied the program record with 72 career double-doubles (Sheila Foster, 1979-82).

From her college debut triple-double in November 2019 to her sweep of the national player of the year awards – including Naismith Defensive Player of the Year – the 6-foot-5 St. Thomas, U.S.V.I., native has been among

the best in college women's basketball throughout her career.

Boston is a three-time All-American, three-time winner of the Lisa Leslie Award, three-time SEC Defensive Player of the Year and the 2022 SEC Player of the Year. She holds South Carolina career records for offensive rebounds (456), consecutive games started (120), rebounds in SEC games (638), offensive rebounds in SEC games (210) and double-doubles in SEC games (36). She is also among the program's top-10 all-time scorers with 1,701 points and is second in rebounds (1,309).

Averaging a double-double for her career (14.2 ppg/10.9 rpg), Boston leads all active NCAA players, all divisions, in career double-doubles and rebounds. Her 295 career blocked shots are third among all active players. She is the SEC's leading active scoring and rebounding leader and has scored in double figures 102 times in her 120 career games.

In 45 career games against ranked opponents, her averages rise to 15.2 ppg and 12.3 rpg.

All that said, Boston's impact on the Gamecocks goes beyond her own numbers. A three-time team captain, the senior is a constant communicator on the court and off it as well, keeping teammates organized on both sides of the ball and throughout the week.

Cooke-ing Time

South Carolina's four-year starting shooting guard Zia Cooke has been mentioned among the best players in the country throughout her career, but the senior has been working toward a year that sees her physical talents meet the mental side of the game, and it appears 2022-23 is that season.

Cooke is the Gamecocks' top scorer with 15.4 points per game (7th in SEC), has led the team in scoring nine times and scored in double figures in every game she has played more than 15 minutes. In SEC action, she has turned it up another notch, pouring in 17.7 points per game to rank sixth in the league and shooting 42.6 percent, which is 11th-best in the conference.

Efficiency has been the key for Cooke, who has shot at least 50.0 percent from the field nine times, including four SEC outings.

Even with her increased scoring, Cooke has been distributing the ball well, too, ranking third on the team in assists (2.1 per game). With her own 15.4 points per

game and teammates scoring 4.5 points per game off her assists, she has had her hands on 24.2 percent of the Gamecocks' offense this season. That number goes up to 25.9 percent (17.7 ppg / 3.3 ppg) in SEC games.

It's Time to BRea-

Often mentioned by head coach Dawn Staley as irreplaceable, senior guard Brea Beal is finally catching some of the spotlight usually reserved for her stat-performing teammates.

Beal is second on the team in assists (2.4), third in rebounding at 4.1 boards per game and fourth in blocks (1.42, 10th in the SEC). Offensively, her timely shooting has been critical to several victories and includes a career-high 40.9 percent accuracy from 3-point range (18-of-44), including 7-of-13 (.538) in SEC action.

Among active SEC players, Beal ranks fifth in career rebounds at 601, second among guards. She is eighth in blocked shots (98), the highest ranking guard on the list.

The powerful guard's trademark defense has not diminished this season. According to Synergy, Beal's matchup has scored just 3.6 points per game on 20.6 percent shooting this season. She has yielded double-digit points just twice this season (UCLA, Nov. 29; Miss. State, Jan. 8) and has posted seven shutout games, including two in SEC action.

Vamos Kamilla!

Junior Kamilla Cardoso has returned to the form and aggressive play that made her a star in the ACC as a freshman. After a summer during which she spent extended time with her family, the 6-foot-7 center returned to Columbia with a renewed energy and passion for the game that has been consistently on display this season.

Cardoso is second on the team and fifth in the SEC in rebounding at 7.94 per game, including 3.61 on the offensive end (2nd in SEC). Her 1.56 blocks per game are fourth in the SEC, and that average includes five games of three or more blocks. Offensively, she is third on the team with 9.4 points per game.

The Brazilian has scored on 40.8 percent of her own offensive rebounds, accounting for 2.9 of her 9.4 points per game this season. Against ranked teams, those numbers climb to scoring on 50.0 percent of her offensive boards, accounting for 3.3 of her 9.7 points per game in those three outings.

This year's Iron Gamecock winners were Zia Cooke and Ashlyn Watkins. The Iron Gamecock recipients exhibit exceptional performances in areas of speed, power, strength, and competitive challenges in the weight room.

That's So Raven

Redshirt-freshman point guard Raven Johnson looks to finally have both feet planted firmly under her midway through her first full season, and the Gamecocks are benefiting on both ends of the court.

Playing just 15.5 minutes per game, Johnson leads the team in steals (1.3) and assists (3.50, 11th in SEC). Her SEC-best 2.86 assist-to-turnover ratio is fifth in the nation. With 1.86 steals per conference outing, she ranks fifth in the SEC, and her 3.86 assists per league game are good for seventh.

While those numbers have been building all season, SEC play has seen Johnson's own scoring take root as well with 4.9 points per game on 48.4 percent shooting.

LA Live

Senior Laeticia Amihere has the size, strength, agility and basketball IQ to play every position on the floor. With a treasure trove of international experience – including playing in the 2020 Tokyo Olympics – the 6-foot-4 Canadian is a dynamic player with unwaivering confidence.

Averaging a career-best 7.2 points per game this season, Amihere's 50.6 percent shooting is also a career high. She is ninth in the SEC in blocks per game (1.50) while also handing out 1.6 assists per game. Amihere

has five double-figure scoring games this season off the bench, including 10 at #17/18 Maryland (Nov. 11) and 11 at Kentucky (Jan. 12) with nine of those coming in the decisive fourth quarter.

First Gamecock Takes Flight

Freshman Ashlyn Watkins became the first Gamecock in program history to dunk when she slammed one home following a steal with 3:30 to play in the fourth quarter at Clemson (Nov. 17). The Columbia, S.C., native was less hyped than her teammates after a high school career that frequently included that shot selection. Nevertheless, she entered the Gamecock history books fittingly against the program's in-state rival.

Great Gamecock Fans

South Carolina fans have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last eight seasons and that streak looks to continue for another year with a current 12,358 attendance average.

South Carolina holds four of the top-10 most attended games this season, including the top on-campus attendance of the season with 15,444 against Missouri (Jan. 15). Gamecock fans have logged 10 of the 20 games nationally with at least 11,000 fans.

The Gamecocks have had at least one sellout of their 18,000-seat Colonial Life Arena for six straight seasons (excluding COVID-limited 2020-21 season).

Excluding the COVID limited-attendance season of 2020-21, South Carolina has drawn at least 10,000 fans 102 consecutive regular-season games beginning on Jan. 2, 2015.

Everybody's All-American

On the Gamecocks' 14-woman roster, nine were McDonald's All-Americans in high school – Brea Beal, Aliyah Boston, Kamilla Cardoso, Zia Cooke, Talaysia Cooper, Sania Feagin, Bree Hall, Raven Johnson and Ashlyn Watkins.

At South Carolina, Staley has coached 20 McDonald's All-Americans, including 16 who joined the Gamecocks as freshmen. All three members of Staley's 2023 signing class have been nominated for the award.

Preseason Predictions

As the reigning national champion, the Gamecocks are atop both preseason polls by a near unanimous decision. South Carolina claimed all 30 No. 1 votes in the Associated Press Poll. In the USA Today Coaches Poll, 30 of the 32 votes went to the Gamecocks.

The Gamecocks were also selected to repeat as SEC Regular-Season Champions by both the media and league coaches in preseason voting.

The (Watch List) Watcher

The Gamecocks have been omnipresent on national award watch lists this preseason. Three are on the Naismith Trophy and Wooden Award preseason lists and four of the five positional award preseason watch lists include at least one Gamecock.

One of the three Naismith watch list entries, Zia Cooke is once again on the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award list. She was a finalist for the award that honors the nation's top shooting guard in 2021.

Brea Beal made her debut on the Naismith Watch List and was listed among those on the list for the best small

forward in the nation, the Cheryl Miller Award.

Power forwards Victoria Saxton and Sania Feagin were selected to the watch list for the Katrina McClain Award.

Reigning National Player of the Year Aliyah Boston is on the Naismith, Wade and Wooden watch lists and is looking for a sweep of the Lisa Leslie Award as the top center in the country after winning the award each of her previous three seasons.

2023 Signing Class

South Carolina's 2023 signing class was ranked second in the nation behind the addition of four top-40 players, including a pair of top-20 signings. Chloe Kitts, the #17 player in the class has already joined the team with her enrollment for the Spring 2023 semester.

In women's basketball, Colonial Life Arena has become one of the most feared places to play as enormous crowds fill the building with passion for the Gamecocks.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last seven seasons. The Gamecocks were one of a few programs to finish the 2019-20 season averaging over 10,000 fans and boast six sellouts (18,000) in the last six seasons of full capacity arenas.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest on-campus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300. The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of \$4.2 million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately 12' x 20' and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.

Colonial Life Arena first opened its doors on November 22, 2002, for the South Carolina women's basketball season opener against Clemson. Treasured memories have been made ever since.

15th Season at South Carolina

Catapulting South Carolina into the national spotlight, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. Under her leadership, the Gamecocks have reached many firsts – National Championships, NCAA Final Fours, No. 1 rankings, SEC regular-season and tournament titles, SEC Players of the Year, National Players of the Year, WNBA No. 1 Draft pick and No. 1 recruiting classes – to name the most notable.

In her 15th season at the helm of the Gamecocks, Staley's South Carolina highlights include:

- Two National Championships (2017, 2022)
- Four NCAA Final Fours in the last seven tournaments (2015, 2017, 2021, 2022)
- Ranking in the AP Top 25 every week since Dec. 10, 2012, including 125 weeks in the top five
- 55 weeks ranked No. 1 in the AP Poll, including two final No. 1 rankings (2019-20, 2021-22)
- 11 25-win seasons, including five 30-win campaigns led by a school-record 35 victories in 2021-22
- Six SEC regular-season championships (2014, 15, 16, 17, 20, 22) and Six SEC Tournament titles (2015, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21)
- Three top-two recruiting classes (#1 in 2021, #1 in 2019, #2 in 2014)
- Eight NCAA Attendance titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022)

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012.

In her 23rd season as a head coach, Staley has led her college teams to 12 25-win seasons, a total of 18 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 158 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 55 in the No. 1 spot – the fourth most times in the top spot of any program in the history of that poll. Her .751 winning percentage (557-185) ranks 11th in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 years of experience.

Also a force in USA Basketball, Staley was named the U.S. Women's National Team head coach for 2017-21, leading the U.S. to 2018 FIBA World Cup gold to earn USAB National Coach of the Year honors that year, adding gold medals at the 2019 and 2021 FIBA AmeriCups and stretching the U.S. Olympic gold medal streak to seven straight at the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games, for which she again earned Coach of the Year honors. Prior to that appointment, Staley led three other U.S. teams to gold medals and served two stints as an assistant on the Senior National Team, during which the U.S. claimed gold in the 2014 FIBA World Championship and the 2008 and 2016 Olympics.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last 14 seasons, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year three times (2014, 2020, 2022) with her 2020 unanimous selection making her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award. She is a five-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the Gamecocks' all-time winningest coach (385) with a program-record 11 postseason appearances and is the only black head coach in men's or women's basketball to win multiple national championships.

In the vaulted SEC, Staley's 174 league wins are the most among active league coaches and third all-time, trailing just Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Inductees Andy Landers (Georgia, 273) and Pat Summitt (Tennessee, 306). Her .760 SEC winning percentage (174-55) is second only to Summitt (.874) in league history. Her Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history, hitting that mark in 2015-16 and 2019-20.

In addition to coaching two National Players of the Year and a National Freshman of the Year, Staley has helped eight Gamecocks collect 19 All-America selections, three to pick up six SEC Player of the Year honors, three to earn SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognition a total of six times, one to SEC 6th Player of the Year honors and six to capture SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 17 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors a combined 34 times, including 18 first-team selections, and eight Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last five seasons, including 2018 No. 1 pick Aja Wilson, with two of those going on to win WNBA Rookie of the Year honors.
