1st Year at LSU · 8th Year as a Head Coach

When Matt McMahon stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach he listed the core values of his coaching career and his teams.

"Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy."

Those words are now the cornerstone of LSU Basketball as it moves into a new era as a very successful head coach begins to reshape the program in his image.

The image was on display during the past seven years at Murray State University where the Racers posted a record of 154-67, a .697 winning percentage. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022 (the 2020 appearance was canceled by the pandemic).

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

Two of those players, Williams and Hill, are now at LSU.

Williams, who ranked 12th nationally in 3-pointers made (94), became the third Murray State player to score 1,500 points and grab 800 rebounds. Hill took over point guard duties in a Racer program known for good guards, leading Murray State in assists in 19 games with a plus-101 margin in assists to turnovers.

McMahon's Racers, picked third in the OVC preseason poll, were just the sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games that season and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3). The Racers were ranked No. 20 in the final AP poll and No. 22 in the Ferris Mowers Coaches Poll.

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have

three seasons of 25 or more wins and was one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Although the 2019-20 season was called early because of the pandemic, it marked the third year in a three-year run when Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season championships (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

Coach McMahon's commitment to defense showed in those years as the Racers ranked as the league leader twice in defensive field goal percentage and each of the three seasons the team led the league in defending the 3-point shot.

The 2018-19 team won 28 games and made its mark in the NCAA Tournament when the 12th-seeded Racers won their fourth all-time tourney game by defeating No. 5 seed Marquette. That season is when Morant stepped to the forefront at Murray State.

He was named the OVC POY, leading Division I in assists and earning first-team all-America honors from the USBWA. In the NCAA Tournament win over Marquette, Morant posted a triple double of 17 points, 11 rebounds and 16 assists as he became the eighth player to record a triple double in the tournament.

He was drafted second overall in the 2019 NBA draft by the Memphis Grizzlies.

In 2017-18, McMahon's team won 26 games and the OVC regular season and tournament championship, sending the Racers to what was at that time the school's 16th NCAA Tournament.

Prior to being named head coach, he was a key part of Coach Steve Prohm's staff as assistant at Murray State as the Racers won a pair of Ohio Valley Conference championships, a CollegeInsider.com Tournament championship and an appearance in the NIT. He was part of a staff that won 104 games from 2011-15.

PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian

State. Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000. The Mountaineers won the SoCon Tournament in 2000 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

He played in 90 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 124 three-pointers, graduating in 2000.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as a student assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a student coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season. A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Like his time at Murray State, McMahon coached some outstanding talent in the early stages of his coaching career, including Southern Conference POY Donald Sims as well as all-league picks Jeremy Clayton and D.J. Thompson.

At UNCW, he recruited Adam Smith, a Parade All-America Second-Team selection.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

RECAP: The Tigers couldn't hit shots in the first 20 minutes, allowing Texas A&M to dominate the game early, jumping out to a 19-2 lead and to as much as 29 in the first half at 41-12 before settling in to a 41-14 advantage at halftime. It equaled LSU's lowest first half point total, equally the 14 scored in the first half against Arkansas. In the second half, it was the Tigers that cameout to play, hitting 53.3 percent of their shots (16-30) and 7-of-15 from the arc. Four times in the final 4:08 of the game, LSU was able to get the game to within eight points.

Adam Miller scored 18 points with four treys to lead LSU and freshman Tyrell Ward in his third start continued to show improved ability, scoring 15 points on 5-of-9 shooting with two treys and three free throws. LSU out rebounded Texas A&M, 30-27, and after giving up 42 points in the paint in the first meeting in January, had a 22-18 advantage in points in the paint in this game. Alabama was able to hit some key threes to get the lead back up as the two teams combined to go 1-of-20 over the final seven minutes of the game.

LSU's Derek Fountain played his best scoring game of his career, hitting 6-of-9 field goals, with two treys and 12-of-15 at the free throw line to score 26 points with seven rebounds, 2 assists, 4 blocks and no turnovers in 35 minutes. Cam Hayes came off the bench in this game and hit three treys to have 15 points with a co-high eight rebounds. KJ WILLIAMS JOINS 2,000-1,000 CLUB

With a three-pointer with 17:40 to go in the second half against Tennessee (1/21), super senior KJ Wilson passed the 2,000-point mark in his career at Murray State and LSU. Williams got his 1,000th rebound on Jan. 7 at Texas A&M and joins a small fraternity of college basketball players to have posted 2,000 and 1,000 in their college career. Williams' year-by-year point totals and rebounds:

2018-19 -- Murray State -- 243 points -- 151 rebounds
2019-20 -- Murray State -- 405 points -- 232 rebounds

A total of 123 players in college basketball, three this season including KJ, now have hit the 2,000-1,000 mark in their careers including some of the biggest names in the history of the game. Among those of interest in Louisiana would be of course Rudy Macklin of LSU (1976-81) who had 2,080 points and 1,276 rebounds. According to an NCAA list of 2,000-1,000 players in college basketball, these players spent time at present SEC schools:

KJ was presented a ceremonial ball honoring his accomplishment by the only LSU player on the list -- Rudy Macklin. His 1,276 rebounds is an all-time best at LSU and his 2,080 points is second only to Pete Maravich in LSU history.

MWANI WILKINSON

After battling through right shoulder pain for much of the season after hurting in the preseason, the situation became too much and earlier this week had season-ending surgery that will allow him to rehab and be ready for next season.

Wilkinson played in nine games this season, averaging 13.0 minutes a game, 2.6 points and 1.6 rebounds.

EQUAL NUMBERS AT UGA

Here's something that you really don't see to often that occurred 31 minutes into the LSU-UGA game at the 8:59 mark of the second half with the teams tied at 46:

In that final nine minutes, LSU made 5 field goals, 2 three-pointers and 5 free throws. UGA made 7 field goals, 1 three-pointer and four free throws. Thus, your difference of two points in the end for Georgia.

SATURDAY'S OPPONENT

South Carolina comes in off a Tuesday night loss at home to Vanderbilt, 75-64. Meechie Johnson led the way for South Carolina with 19 points. Chico Carter Jr had 15 and Hayden Brown 11 for the Gamecocks. Vanderbilt outrebounded South Carolina, 48-34, for the game and 19-10, on the offensive glass. The Commodores capitalized on 22 second chance points to 11 for Carolina. Vanderbilt was up 38-18 at halftime, and the Gamecocks scored 46 points in the second half.

Lamont Paris is in his first year as the head coach of the Gamecocks.

South Carolina leads the series, 20-18. Carolina won last year in Columbia stopping a three-game LSU win streak. LSU leads the series, 9-6, in games played in Baton Rouge.

POINTS IN THE PAINT

In the 13 conference games, opponents have a 394-316 advantage in points in the paint. Tennessee only actually had a 2-point advantage over LSU, 32-30, Mizzou just four points and Alabama two in recent games. Saturday, against A&M, after the Aggies had 42 points in the paint in the first meeting, LSU actually had a 22-18 advantage in points in the paint.

LSU had the advantage in the paint in the game the Tigers won over Arkansas (12/28), 40-36.

POINTS OFF TURNOVERS

Turnovers have been a problem for LSU for a lot of the season, but more importantly what has resulted in opponents points off turnovers have really been a factor for the Tigers.

In the eight SEC games listed below, LSU has given up 161 points off turnovers (the number being 161 for opponents to 53 for LSU):

With both teams having single digit turnovers in the Alabama game (2/4), the Tigers were able to get the 7-3 advantage in points off in that game. The lack of turnovers allowed LSU to play better defense allowing them to set their plan when Alabama came down court.

TYRELL WARD

The word "patience" has to mean a lot to Tyrell Ward as this freshman has sat on the bench in 10 games this year (DNP-Coach's Decision) and is now a starter for LSU.

Ward has started the last four games and against A&M (2/11), Ward played a season high 30 minutes, made 5-of-9 field goals with two treys and three field goals to record 15 points. It was his first game scoring in double figures in college.

Ward scored seven points in 22 minutes at Georgia with three rebounds and a steal.

The Dematha Catholic freshman started his first game of the season against Alabama (2/4), playing 20 minutes with two points and one assist and a steal.

Ward started again at Mississippi State (2/8) and played 24 minutes with two field goals including a three-pointer to score five points with two rebounds and four steals.

In the last five games, Ward has played 104 minutes (20.9 average) and is averaging 7.0 points, 1.8 rebounds and 1.4 steals. He has made 6-of-16 from beyond the arc in those game.

For the 16 games he has played, he is averaging 11.0 minutes a game and is averaging 3.0 points a game. In league play, he is averaging 4.8 points a game.

DEREK FOUNTAIN

Derek Fountain continues to play some of his basketball of his college career this season at LSU and he again showed out versus Alabama (2/4). Fountain played 35 minutes, hitting 6-of-9 three pointers, including his third and fourth three-pointers of the year. More importantly he hit 12-of-15 free throw attempts as he drew nine fouls. He finished with 26 points, seven rebounds, two assists, four blocks and no turnovers.

In two games against Alabama, he was 21-of-25 at the free throw line.

Against Mississippi State (2/8), Fountain posted his fourth straight double figure game with 10 points, making 3-of-3 field goals, including a three-pointer and 3-3 at the line.

Derek Fountain moved into the starting lineup before the Wake Forest game (12/10) and has posted very good numbers with double figures in eight contests since then, including his three collegiate double doubles:

In all he has nine double figure scoring games.

Fountain is averaging 8.0 points, 5.4 rebounds and 1.3 steals a game overall and 8.5 points and 5.4 rebounds in league games.

Since moving into the starting lineup, Fountain's average has gone from 5.1 to 8.0 and his rebound average from 3.8 to 5.4.

Fountain's best season of his two at Mississippi State was the 2020-21 campaign when as a freshman he started 10-of-19 games and averaged 5.4 points. Ironically, his previous career high came against LSU in Baton Rouge when he scored 20 points.

FOUNTAIN'S FOUL NUMBERS

Derek Fountain's nine fouls drawn versus Alabama (2/4) and his 21-of-25 at the free throw line for the two meetings against Alabama brought together a few memories of recent Tigers that drew a lot of free throw opportunities.

Cam Thomas in his season at LSU (2020-21) drew 10 fouls against UGA and 11 versus Missouri that year. He was a combined 20-of-24 on free throws versus Georgia in the two matchups.

Ben Simmons drew 13 fouls in an SEC game versus Florida in the 2015-16 season. He was a combined 24-of-28 on free throws in the two games against Florida that year.

THE STARTS, THE WINS, DOUBLE DOUBLES AND MORE FOR KJ

Two milestones in this five-year career of KJ Williams took place on against Wofford (11/27) as the Tigers won 78-75.

The game marked his 100th win of his college career in games he has played in. He came to LSU with 94 wins in games he participated in at Murray State, and now has 106.

KJ has 107 games in double figures for his career, 21 this season.
KJ now has 116 college starts between Murray State and LSU and he has started every game (83) over the 2020-21, 2021-22 and now 2022-23 seasons.

And, when he made his one three-pointer against NCCU (12/13) (with 1:09 to go in the first half), it was his 100th career three-point field goal made. He is now at 124 career made three-pointers.

Earlier in the year against Wake Forest (12/10), he made 7-of-9 three-pointers. He is 42-of-101 for the season from the arc (41.6 percent) and overall from the field 160-of-328 (48.8%).

Here are the Williams double doubles this season:

He had just missed double doubles in the previous two games before Missouri with nine points and 11 rebounds against Arkansas (1/24) and 14 points and nine rebounds against Texas Tech (1/28). Entering play on the weekend, Williams was third in career double doubles among active SEC players:

CAM HAYES EARNING PLAYING TIME

He's come a long way since the second game of the season when NC State transfer Cam Hayes didn't get off the bench (Coach's Decision). Since then there have been nine double figure games, including against Missouri (2/1) and Alabama. He has started a total of 11 games, including at Georgia (2/14).

In three of those games in December, Hayes had 13 points, 6 rebounds, no turnovers against Wake Forest (12/10); 14 points, 7 rebounds vs. NCCU (12/13) and 25 points, 4 treys against Winthrop (12/27).

Hayes against Kentucky (1/3) started 2023 off right with 11 points on 3-of-5 shooting, including a big three-pointer in the corner in the second half and then three free throws when fouled on a distance attempt in the final half minute. He followed with a 10-point game against A&M (1/7).

It was in the first half of the A&M game in January that he tweaked his right knee and he did not dress against Florida.

But he was back against Alabama (1/14), coming off the bench for 20 minutes and scoring 10 points.

Against Missouri, Hayes scored 10 points with two treys and three assists, while against Alabama (2/4), he made three treys and had 15 points, eight rebounds with an assist and a block in 28 minutes off the bench. He scored nine with three assists against A&M this past Saturday.

At NC State, Hayes averaged 7.8 points in 20-21 and 7.0 points in 21-22. He shot 38.6 percent as a freshman and 33.5 percent as a sophomore. So far at LSU, Hayes is averaging 7.9 points with 29 treys and 30-of-36 at the line. He is also averaging 2.1 assists a game.

ADAM MILLER

The Adam Miller shooting well from long distance returned against Texas Tech (1/28) as he hit 5-of-10 outside the arc. He finished with his fourth 20-point game of the season against the Red Raiders.

It was the first time he hit five since he hit five each in the Kentucky (1/3) and A&M games (1/7). For the season, Adams has made 58 three-pointers.

Miller earned all-tournament honors in the Cayman Islands Classic after averaging 15.7 points, 1.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists in the three games of the tournament. He had a best of 23 against Akron when he hit five three-pointers in the Tigers semifinal wins.

Against Wofford (11/27), he was important for the Tigers rallying win, hitting a late three-pointer that gave the Tigers the winning points in the game.

His season highs are 26 points against Arkansas State, 11/12 and Wofford, 11/27.

He has hit four or more treys in a game this season eight times, including the four games he scored 20 or more this season:

- 5 – at Texas A&M (1/7)**

Miller hadn't played in a counting regular season game since March of 2021 when Illinois played its final game of the 2020-21 season. He transferred to LSU but tore his ACL prior to the team's exhibition game and missed the entire 2021-22 season. He was medically cleared during the summer for a full go this season and Tiger fans couldn't be happier.

Miller has started all 57 games he has played in (31 at Illinois) and is averaging 11.7 points per game (second on the team) to go with 2.2 rebounds and 1.5 assists. Miller has 14 games in double figures.

TRAE HANNIBAL

Hannibal was in a walking boot a week ago after a Feb.7 practice injury to his right leg. He returned against Georgia (2/14) and played 18 minutes, scoring four points with two assists.

After a successful start to SEC play, the senior transfer from Murray State was named SEC Player of the Week (1/2) after his play in the win over Arkansas in which LSU rallied from six down in the second half to win by three.

Hannibal played 22 minutes off the bench, hitting 9-of-14 shots, including 6-of-7 in the second half, to finish with 19 points and six assists, along with a +/- team best number of +10.

Hannibal's game is coming off a screen and driving through traffic through the lane and scoring. He did that again at Kentucky (1/3) when his team needed it most.

Against the Wildcats he posted 12 points, playing 29 minutes off the bench, making 5-of-6 field goals to record 12 points and four assists. In his first start against Texas A&M (1/7), despite two early fouls, he was on the floor for 24 minutes, scoring nine points with five rebounds and four assists.

Against Auburn (1/18), Hannibal struggled to score inside but his constant driving to the rim allowed him to get fouled eight times. He made 10-of-12 free throws and finished with a game co-high of 16 points. He followed it with 10 in the Tennessee game (1/21).

Against Missouri (2/1), he was 3-of-5 from the field and 5-of-6 from the line for 11 points and his sixth double figure scoring game, fifth in league play.

Hannibal has averaged 20.8 minutes a game and is averaging 6.8 points, 4.2 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game. In the league in the 10 games he has played in, he is averaging 9.5 points, second best on the team.

Against Florida (1/10), he pulled down 12 rebounds, his career high in boards and his second double figure rebound game of his career.

JUSTICE HILL

With Hill's return for the Texas Tech game (1/28), the depth at the guard position is helped for the LSU Tigers.

In his last two road games (at Mizzou, 2/1) and at Mississippi State (2/13), Hill showed his presence helps LSU has he played 35:30 at Mizzou and 29 minutes at Mississippi State.

Against Missouri, Hill had three treys and four assists to score his co-second high of the season of 13 points. At Mississippi State, he hit three field goals and a trey for seven points with two assists.

The Missouri game was his first double figure scoring game since the finals of the Cayman Island Classic against Kansas State on Nov. 23.

He returned to the starting lineup for the 17th time against Texas A&M (2/11), hitting two treys for six points with two assists and two steals in 21 minutes for the Tigers.

Justice Hill is in his third year of playing for Coach McMahon as he helped guide the Racers for two seasons, including last year when the team was 31-3.

Hill has posted seven games of five assists or more this season.

Justice Hill's fake of the defender and drive through an open lane was a game-winner for the Tigers against Wake Forest (12/10) with 1.2 seconds to play at Holiday Hoopsgiving.

He averages 3.1 assists a game with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.9. He has 71 assists and 38 turnovers. He is averaging 6.9 points this season at LSU.

SHAWN PHILLIPS

The freshman, saw his first action since Nov. 21 against Arkansas (12/28) and his longest stint of the season at that point with close to five minutes with an offensive rebound.

Since then Phillips has been earning more and longer playing stints as this season goes on.

In the game against Alabama (1/14), he was on the court for some 13 minutes, scoring two points with four rebounds.

He did not dress against Arkansas (1/24) after an undisclosed injury but did dress against Texas Tech (1/28).

Phillips played over 10 minutes against Missouri (2/1) with two boards and a steal and played five minutes against Alabama (2/4), making both field goal attempts, including an alley oop dunk to finish with four points.

Against Mississippi State, he played 11 minutes with five rebounds, two blocks and a steal. He had a floater that was disallowed on a shot clock violation. He had eight minutes of action against A&M (2/11) with two points, two rebounds and a block.

Phillips played 11 minutes at Georgia (2/14) and while he didn't score, he did have seven rebounds to help LSU win the rebounding battle.

For the season, Phillips has played in 15 games, averaging 0.8 points and 1.6 rebounds. In the last five games, the freshman is averaging 1.2 points and 3.4 rebounds.

JALEN REED

The freshman from Jackson, Mississippi started the first eight games and returned to the starting lineup against Arkansas (1/24), where he played 28 minutes. He played 15 minutes off the bench against Texas Tech (1/28) with three points at the free throw line, three rebounds, and a block.

After playing just a combined eight minutes at Missouri and versus Alabama, he played 12 minutes at Mississippi State (2/8) and hit 3-of-4 field goals to score six points to go with three boards and an assist.

Against UNO (11/17) he scored eight points, hitting all three field goal attempts in 21 minutes. He added six rebounds and a steal in the game.

Against Tennessee, Reed played 22 minutes off the bench and had his season best of nine points, hitting 3-of-5 field goals and adding three free throws. He also had five rebounds in the game. He equaled that nine points at UGA (2/14), hitting 3-of-6 field goals, including a three-pointer and two free throws.

For the season, Reed is averaging 3.1 points and 3.1 rebounds. He was able to pull a season high of seven rebounds against Alabama in the first meeting (1/14).

Reed is the son of the late SEC star Justin Reed, who played at Ole Miss (2000-04).

JUSTICE WILLIAMS

After missing five games earlier in the season because of a sprained ankle, Justice Williams has earned his starts in this his sophomore season in the last seven games.

While not playing more than two minutes in games at Missouri and Alabama in starts, he did in between those two games played 28 minutes and had four points and four assists for LSU.

Williams played 31 minutes, had a career high six boards with seven points on 3-of-7 shooting with a three-pointer against Auburn (1/18) and then against Tennessee (1/21), he played a career-high 35 minutes, scoring five points with two rebounds and four assists. Against Arkansas (1/28), he had 7 points to go with two rebounds and two assists.

He returned after missing the five games on Dec. 10 against Wake Forest.

Both years, he has struggled with injury problems at LSU. Last season, he missed the entire non-conference schedule as a freshman before being thrust into action due to other injuries at the start of conference play.

For the season, Williams is averaging 3.4 points and 1.4 rebounds to go with 1.5 assists.

KENDAL COLEMAN

Coleman played 11 minutes against Wofford (11/27), making both field goal attempts and 3-of-3 at the line to finish with seven points, his second highest total of the season.

In the next game against UTA (12/2), Coleman played 13 minutes, making 3-of-4 field goals to again score seven points with six rebounds.

Against NCCU, he made the most of his six-plus minutes, making both field goal attempts with a rebound and a block. It has been the case when asked, Coleman has made the most of his minutes. In the Winthrop game (12/17),

Coleman made 2-of-4 from the field with five points and two blocks and for the second time this season grabbing seven rebounds.

Coleman had five points against Alabama (1/14) and has played 10 minutes in two-of-the-last-four games, while scoring nine points and going 3-of-8 from the field and 3-of-4 from the line.

The Northwestern State transfer is averaging 2.3 points and 2.1 rebounds

Coleman's season high at LSU was eight points versus Illinois St. in the Cayman Islands (11/21).

SHOT CLOCK VIOLATIONS

Last year, LSU was the Division I leader in shot clock violations drawn according to @CBBAnalytics with 38, four more than Richmond and Virginia in college basketball. The total so far this season is 17.

FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE

Last year, LSU was 16-1 when opponents shot under 40 percent and LSU is 4-1 this year in that category as Kansas City (32.8%), Arkansas State (38.6%), Akron (25.9%), UTA (37.5%) and Florida (39.6%) have shot under 40 percent overall.

The Tigers are 56-3 since the start of the 2017-18 season when opponents shoot under 40 percent.

However, LSU was 6-10 last year when opponents shoot 40 percent or better from the field. LSU is 7-13 this season when teams shoot over 40 percent.

Since the Jan. 3 game against Kentucky, LSU has only shot over 40 percent from the field in four of the last 12 games.

Against Alabama (1/14), Auburn (1/18) and at Arkansas (1/24), LSU shot no better than 29 percent in any of those games.

Offensively, the Tigers have won the last 17 games when shooting 50 percent or more in a game and LSU is 104-9 in the last 112 games when LSU shot 50 percent or better since the start of the 2007-08 season. The 50 percent games this season:

LSU vs. UNO (11/17) – 30-of-58, 51.7%

LSU vs. Wofford (11/27) – 28-of-53, 52.8%

LSU vs. Winthrop (12/17) – 35-of-64, 54.7%

FROM THE ARC

The Tigers last season shot just 31.6 percent from the arc and LSU has not shot over 35 percent from the arc since 2012-13 season.

And LSU is at 32.9 percent from the arc (189-of-574). LSU has made 52 threes the last six games.

Opponents are now almost even with LSU in percentage at 33.1 percent (198-of-599).

THE PETE MARAVICH ASSEMBLY CENTER

The Tigers are in their 52nd season of play in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center, originally known as the LSU Assembly Center until 1988 when the building was renamed by state government legislation following the untimely death of the star LSU player.

The Maravich Center is the fourth oldest continuous basketball arena in the league having hosted its first game in January 1972. Memorial Gym at Vanderbilt opened in 1952, Stegeman Coliseum at UGA in 1964 and Coleman Coliseum at Alabama opened in 1968.

LSU was 15-2 a year ago in the building and in 822 games the Tigers have an on-court record of 614-208 (74.7%) ... LSU is 283-164 in conference games (63.3%).

The loss to Florida on Jan. 10 ended a 13-game winning streak in the building by LSU.

ITS A FATHER AND SON THING

There are a couple of guys who knows something about the Southeastern Conference because their fathers played in the league with good success.

Director of Player Development Ronrico White's father, Tony, was an All-America at Tennessee. Tony White played from 1983 to 1987 at Tennessee.

Then there is freshman Jalen Reed from Jackson, Mississippi, whose late dad, Justin, was an All-America at Ole Miss and the SEC Freshman of the Year in 2001. Justin Reed was an All-SEC selection in each of his four years at Ole Miss, guiding the Rebels to a first ever "Sweet Sixteen" appearance for the program.

Corey Chest, New Orleans, La. Link Academy, Brandon, Mo.

The four-star recruit will play this season at Link Academy in Brandon, Missouri. Chest (6-8, 210) played the 2021-22 season at Eleanor McMMain High School in New Orleans. He is ranked No. 75 in the 247sports.com and 89 in their national composite rankings. He is listed No. 95 in the ESPN Top 100 for the class of 2023.

Chest was a Class 4A First Team All-State selection in Louisiana averaging 17 points, 10 rebounds, three assists and four blocks. McMMain was 28-8 last season and reached the Class 4A title game each of the last two years.

Williams made a midseason switch to Bishop Walsh this past season which will play in the National Interscholastic Basketball Conference against some of the top schools in the country. In the 60th Alhambra Catholic Invitational Tournament, billed as the most prestigious Catholic high school tournament in the country, Williams averaged 16.7 points per game, 3.9 rebounds, 1.3 assists and 2.0 steals.

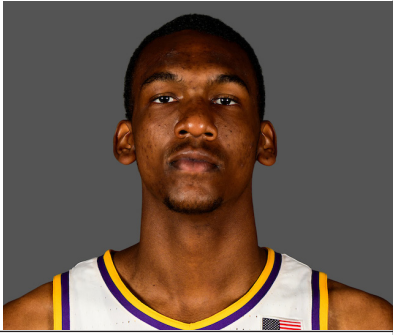

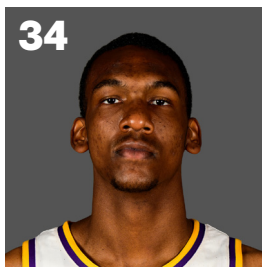
