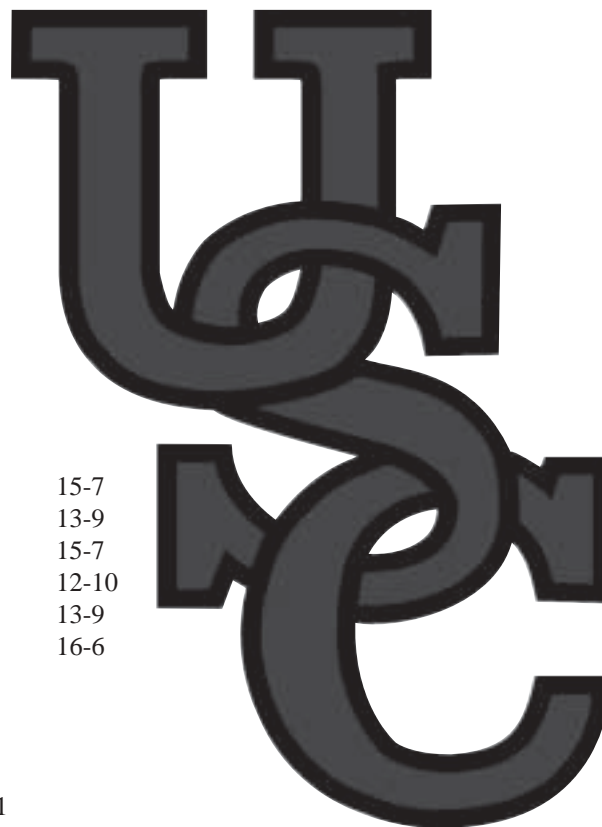

First Serve Carolina

Wiggins Selected to the NCAA Singles Championships: Danielle Wiggins becomes the first USC player selected to the NCAA Singles Championships since Katarina Markovski in 2002. Wiggins is 21-10 on the season and posted a 15-6 mark at the number one singles position in the spring. Against SEC opponents Wiggins went 9-2. She was named Second Team All-SEC by SEC Head Coaches. The 15 wins in the spring leads all Carolina players in singles and she has won seven of her last eight with the loss coming against Alexis Gordon of Florida who was ranked #1 in the country at the time of the match.

Freshman Trio: Three freshman have played in USC's lineup this season. Christyn Lucas, Miranda Gutierrez and Laura Ganzer have held down the two, three and four single positions this spring. Lucas leads the three with 14 wins in the spring while Ganzer has 12 and Gutierrez has nine. Lucas has played in all 22 matches this season for USC as she has played 20 of the 22 at the number two singles spot. Against SEC opponents, she held her own tallying an 8-4 mark on the season and winning five of her last six matches. Laura Ganzer is 12-9 on the season and posted an 11-7 mark at the number three singles position. Miranda Gutierrez has held down the number four spot for the majority of the year before being injured on March 18 in Tuscaloosa. Gutierrez was 9-4 on the spring and has posted a 17-7 mark before the injury. In doubles, Gutierrez was 11-2 on the spring and had totaled an 18-2 mark overall.

Welcome the Sunshine Girls: Three of Carolina's top four players are from the sunshine state. Danielle Wiggins at one, Christyn Lucas at two, and Miranda Gutierrez at four are all from the state of Florida. The three athletes have totaled a 38-18 mark in the spring.

How Important is the Doubles Point: This season when winning the doubles point, Carolina is 11-1.

Youth Movement: The 2004 Gamecock squad has consisted of mainly freshman and sophomores in the singles lineup. In 12 of the 22 matches this season, USC has had five combined freshman and sophomores in the lineup with the top four spots being played by sophomore, freshman, freshman, and freshman.

NCAA Tournament Appearances: The 2004 NCAA Tournament appearance is USC's 14th overall and 10th consecutive appearance. The 10 straight appearances is the 11th longest active streak in the country. Only four other programs at USC have more tournament appearances than the women's tennis team: Baseball with 19, Men's soccer 16, Men's tennis 16, Men's Golf 16 and only men's tennis (11) has been to more consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances than the women's tennis team.

First Round Wins in the NCAA Tournament: Carolina has posted 10 straight opening round wins in the NCAA Tournament. That is one of the longest streaks in the nation. Carolina's last loss in the first round of the tournament was in 1988 against BYU.

Coach Arlo Elkins: Coach Elkins is in his 21st season with the Gamecock women's tennis team. He has won 325 matches in his overall career at Carolina. Only 10 active coaches in the nation have more wins than Elkins. Since beginning his career in 1984, he has guided the Carolina tennis program to 12 NCAA Tournament appearances. That streak ranks 19th in the country.

500: With the 6-1 win on April 2, 2004 against Ole Miss in Oxford was the 500th win in the programs history. Entering the NCAA Tournament, Carolina has an overall record of 502-269. Only two SEC programs have more wins than the Gamecocks. (Florida and Georgia)

Clemson Regional Opponents: The Gamecocks hold an 21-17 record against the Tigers, a 9-7 mark versus the Demon Deacons. Carolina has never played Troy State. USC lost to Clemson 4-3 earlier this season in Columbia. The first round meeting against Wake will be the first meeting between the two programs since February 27, 2001 in Winston-Salem. The two played in the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 1999 in Columbia with Carolina winning 5-2.

Carolina's Lineup Geographically: The top six players in USC's lineup is consisted up of four players from the United States and two international athletes. Being compared to the top 16 teams in the 2004 NCAA Women's Tennis Tournament. Only three teams have more than four players from the United States in their lineup (North Carolina, Vanderbilt, Stanford) 12 of the 16 teams have at least three players while Tulane had one and Clemson have none.

2004 Opponents: After facing Wake Forest on Saturday, 18 of Carolina's 23 opponents this season have been nationally ranked with four of the 18 being ranked in the top 10.
