South Carolina has five players averaging double-figure including two off the bench.

Nine Gamecocks are playing at least 15 minutes per game with only four averaging more than 20 minutes.

GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- A win today would be the Gamecocks' 45th straight at home, matching the program record for consecutive home victories (2/24/13-2/4/16.
- South Carolina is among the nation's top five in blocked shots (1st, 11.8 bpg), assist-to-turnover ratio (2nd, 2.4), rebounding (2nd, 53.3 rpg), scoring (3rd, 100.3 ppg), scoring margin (3rd, +44.0), assists (3rd, 26.3) and offensive rebounding (5th, 20.2 rpg).
- The Gamecocks continue to build their success inside, averaging 60.5 points in the paint per game on 61.4 percent accuracy in that space. They own the space defensively as well, allowing just 25.0 points in the paint per game on 35.5 percent shooting.
- The nation's top shot blocking team, South Carolina blocks 11.8 shots per game and 23.7 percent of its opponents 2-point field goal attempts.
- A pair of Gamecocks are atop the national block rankings with sophomore Ashlyn Watkins pacing the country with 4.0 blocks per game and senior Kamilla Cardoso's 3.5 per game just behind in second place.
- National Player of the Year candidate Kamilla Cardoso shapes the game on both ends of the court. In addition to her blocking stats, she averages a double-double with 17.5 points per game (8th in SEC) and 11.2 rebounds per game (3rd in SEC). Her three doubledoubles on the season are seventh-best in the country and her .667 field goal percentage is 22nd.
- Sophomore Raven Johnson turned in a milestone week to grab SEC co-Player of the Week honors on Tuesday. Her 17 assists against Clemson (Nov. 16) were the most in the NCAA this season and the most in the SEC since 2005, and she poured in a career-best 18 points against South Dakota State (Nov. 20).
- Despite a shorter bench, South Carolina is sixth in the country with an SEC-best 41.5 bench points per game. Fulwiley leads the group at 14.5 ppg.

A Perennial Power

South Carolina women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful era, claiming at least 20 wins for the last 12 seasons, including six 30-win seasons in the last nine campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in the NCAA Final Four five times in the last eight NCAA Tournaments, including winning the 2017 and 2022 National Championships. They have been ranked in every AP Poll since Dec. 10, 2012, including a top-10 spot every week since the start of the 2019-20 season. The Gamecocks have amassed 65 AP No. 1 rankings all-time, the fourthmost by a program in the history of that poll.

Under head coach Dawn Staley's leadership, nine Gamecocks have earned All-America status, three have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 19 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once. In the last nine seasons, 14 Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft, including 10 first-round picks, highlighted by two No. 1 overall picks in the last six years. Three Gamecocks have been named WNBA Rookie of the Year and one is a two-time WNBA MVP and two-time WNBA Defensive Player of the Year.

The Mississippi Valley State Series

Today is the first meeting between the Gamecocks and Devilettes. South Carolina has played four other SWAC teams with a 7-0 record all-time against the league – Alabama A&M (2-0), Alabama State (3-0), Alcorn State (1-0), Jackson State (1-0).

HBCU History

Since 1974-75, the first official season of women's basketball as part of the Athletics Department, South Carolina has played 16 different HBCUs with a 73-12 record. The bulk of those games coming against South Carolina State (25-9).

Dawn Staley has scheduled at least one regular-season game against an HBCU every season since 2010-11 except for the COVID-shortened 2020-21 campaign. Staley's record against eight different HBCUs is 26-0, including three road games and three NCAA Tournament outings.

This season, the Gamecocks will play two HBCUs – Mississippi Valley State and Morgan State.

TEAM THEME: LOVE

As with most seasons, the LOVE theme has many meanings, all of which are rooted in loving the game of women's basketball. Staley often notes that "if you love the game, it will love you back" — and her career as a player and now a coach is evidence of that.

For her team, loving basketball is more than loving the wins and the trophies and the cheers from fans. That's just one side of the relationship. The pursuit of those means also loving the commitment and the sacrifice and the discipline required to get better every day, and it even means loving the doubt and criticism of others.

For the FAMS – the program's loyal fanbase – loving basketball means investing their time and money, it means saving their vacation days to come to games, and it means pouring their energy into the program's success. In return, Gamecock FAMS are part of a community that puts aside all other differences to share their love of the game and of being such an integral part of Staley's program.

Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are 516-165 (.758) in home games (some records prior to 1976-77 did not include location of games). Current head coach Dawn Staley is 204-34 at home with that .857 winning percentage is the best in program history.

Playing in its 20th season at Colonial Life Arena, South Carolina boasts a 267-67 (.799) record in the building, including four undefeated seasons since 2013-14. Staley's share of that record is 201-34 (.855).

Ranking Review

South Carolina sits atop both national polls. It marks the 65th time the Gamecocks have been No. 1 in the AP Poll – the fourth-most of any program in that poll's history.

The Gamecocks have been in the AP Top 10 every week since the 2019-20 preseason poll, (78) and their 209 straight appearances in the AP Poll, dating back to Dec. 10, 2012, marks the third-longest active streak in

the nation and the 12th longest all-time (trailing just Long Beach State 209 and La. Tech 214 to make it into the top 10)

In the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Poll, South Carolina has been in the top 10 since claiming the No. 10 spot in the 2019-20 preseason poll.

Ranked Readings

Against ranked teams, South Carolina is 108-67 (.617) in the Dawn Staley era (beginning 2008-09), and even that mark is skewed by the early seasons of her tenure. Since the start of the 2014-15 campaign, the Gamecocks are 93-28 (.769) against ranked teams.

The Staley File

In her 24th season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .757 (578-186) winning percentage, which ranks ninth in the nation among active head coaches with at least 15 seasons of experience and seventh among those with at least 20 years in the position. The unanimous 2020 National Coach of the Year, she became the first person to win both a Naismith Player of the Year and a Naismith Coach of the Year and the first Black head coach to win multiple national championships in men's or women's basketball. She has been named national coach of the year by at least one organization four times, including three times in the last four seasons.

In her 16th season leading the Gamecocks, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (406) with a program-record 12 postseason appearances (11 NCAA/1 WNIT). She accounts for all five of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances (2015, 2017, 2021, 2022, 2023) and the first NCAA National Championships in program history (2017, 2022).

After claiming seven SEC regular-season titles, Staley has won 183 SEC games, the most among active league coaches and third all-time – trailing just Women's Basketball Hall of Fame inductees Andy Landers (Georgia, 273) and Pat Summitt (Tennessee, 306). Her 12.2 SEC wins average per season is the best in league history

Senior center Kamilla Cardoso has gotten the lion's share of the preseason awards attention, but senior transfer Te-Hina Paopao and junior Sania Feagin have seen some accolades as well.

Cardoso earned spots on the preseason watch lists for the Naismith Trophy, Wade Trophy, Wooden Award and the Lisa Leslie Center of the Year Award. She was a Preseason All-SEC First-Team selection by both the media and coaches as well.

Paopao joined Cardoso on the Wooden Award Watch List and picked up her first SEC recognition when the coaches tabbed her for Preseason All-SEC Second-Team honors. She also was one of 20 named to the Nancy Lieberman Point Guard of the Year Award watch list.

For the third season in a row, Feagin was named to the Katrina McClain Power Forward of the Year Award watch list.

Opponent Files

South Carolina's regular-season schedule includes 10 games against teams ranked in at least one of the two national polls this week – the second most among ranked teams. Five of those games come in the first five weeks of the season, including the first two out of the gate against #10/10 Notre Dame (W, 100-71) and #14/11 Maryland (W, 114-76).

Five of the games against ranked teams are at home – #14/11 Maryland (W, 114-76), #25/rv Mississippi State (Jan. 7), #24/23 Ole Miss (Feb. 4), #6/7 UConn (Feb. 11), #19/21 Tennessee (Mar. 3).

Three others are true road games – at #18/17 North Carolina (Nov. 30), at #7/5 LSU (Jan. 25), at #19/21 Tennessee (Feb. 15). Another two are at neutral sites – #10/10 Notre Dame (W, 110-71) and #10/8 Utah (Dec. 10).

South Carolina's 10 games are the second-most of any ranked team this season (UCLA 11). The Gamecocks' five non-conference ranked contests are second behind UConn's seven and match Tennessee's five.

Serious Scheduling

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has never been afraid to challenge her team to prepare it for the rigors of March and April. Over the last 10 seasons, the Gamecocks have played an average of 9.7 regular-season games against ranked opponents.

Three teams hit the high-water mark of 12-2019-20 (11-1), 2017-18 (6-6), 2015-16 (11-1). Each of those years four of the 12 games were non-conference matchups. The 2021-22 edition of the Gamecocks went a perfect 11-0

against its regular-season ranked opponents, including six such non-conference wins.

Last season's team faced the fewest regular-season ranked games, playing just five games such games – three against top-five foes.. Just one of the five games was against an SEC rival.

Bench Mob

Any question about South Carolina's bench points falling off with last season's top bench scorers moving into the starting lineup were dispelled early. The Gamecocks' six-woman bench is sixth in the nation with 41.5 points per game.

Last season, the Gamecocks led the nation with 36.1 bench points per game. The second-place team (Georgia Southern) turned in 31.2.

Dime Droppers

There are few things head coach Dawn Staley likes more than the extra pass. Long preaching that the ball will find who should shoot it, she seen this year's team bring that philosophy to fruition. In the first three games, the Gamecocks twice broke the program's Staley-era record for assists in a game.

South Carolina has assisted on 64.0 percent of its made field goals this season. The Gamecocks are third in the country with an SEC-best 26.2 assists per game and are second in assist-to-turnover ratio at 2.39, also an SEC best

Raven Johnson leads the SEC and is third in the nation with 9.5 assists per game. Her 17 assists against Clemson (Nov. 16) were the second-most in program history and the most by an SEC player since 2005.

Behind Johnson, Te-Hina Paopao is fourth in the SEC with 5.0 assists per game.

Three For All

Long the Achilles Heel for the Gamecocks, this season's South Carolina team has thrived behind the arc so far, especially when all 11 players have been available. Prior to their top 3-point shooter, Te-Hina Paopao, missing the South Dakota State game, the Gamecocks were shooting 40.9 percent (20th in the nation) to pour in 9.0 made 3s per game (29th in the nation). At home, the average went up to 11.0 made 3s.

While the program record for made 3s per game is 9.2

set in 1993-94, the Staley era's high was 5.8 per game in 2018-19

Paopao's SEC-best 58.8 percent accuracy, which ranks 15th in the country. Her 3.33 made 3s per game are also best in the SEC while ranking 25th in the nation.

Paint Production

South Carolina has long dominated the paint, and this season's numbers have not fallen off from that tradition, despite all the attention to its 3-point shooting. The season kicked off with 70 of the team's 100 points against #10/10 Notre Dame (Nov. 6) coming in the paint.

The Gamecocks are out-scoring opponents in the paint 60.5 to 25.0. They are shooting 61.4 percent in the paint compared to opponents' 35.5 percent accuracy inside. So far this season, the Gamecocks have scored 60.3 percent of their points in the paint.

Last season, South Carolina averaged 43.8 points in the paint to account for 54.6 percent of its offense.

Quarter Breakdown

South Carolina's defense has held an opponent to single digits in a quarter six times this season. The Gamecocks have out-scored their opponent by 15 or more points in a quarter five times. The scoring differential is largest in the second quarter (+15.0).

digits in a single quarter – Kamilla Cardoso (1), Te-Hina Paopao (1). The top single-quarter individual scoring this season is 13 points by Cardoso in the third vs. #10/10 Notre Dame (Nov. 6).

Block Party

South Carolina annually ranks among the best shot blocking teams in the country and leads the way again this season at 11.8 blocks per game. The Gamecocks have blocked 23.7 percent of their opponents' 2-point attempts this season, which leads the nation.

The nation's two top shot blockers are Gamecocks with Ashlyn Watkins leading the country with 4.0 blocks per game and Kamilla Cardoso just behind at 3.75 blocks average.

Eight different Gamecocks have blocked at least one shot this season, including guards MiLaysia Fulwiley and Bree Hall.

Glass Cleaner

The Gamecocks continue to have a dominant rebounding effort, ranking second in the nation with and SEC-best 56.25 rebounds per game, Their offensive glass work is equally strong, ranking fifth in the country with

an SEC-best 20.2 offensive boards per outing. According to Her Hoop Stats, South Carolina is 11th in the nation in rebounding percentage, securing 72.0 percent of the rebound opportunities actually rebounded.

Four Gamecocks average at least 5.5 rebounds per game, led by Kamilla Cardoso's 11.3 average, which ranks 16th in the nation and third in the SEC. Ashlyn Watkins is next in line at 7.8 per game. Both are tied for the team lead on the offensive glass with 16 each. Sania Feagin and Chloe Kitts round out the quartet with 5.5 per game. Three guards are next on the list with 4.0 boards per game.

Vamos Kamilla!

From ACC Freshman of the Year in 2021 to SEC Sixth Woman of the Year in 2023. South Carolina senior Kamilla Cardoso can be a dominant player on both ends of the court and is standing firmly in that spotlight this season.

On the watch list for all three national player of the year awards and the Lisa Leslie Award, Cardoso is the Gamecocks' top scorer and rebounder, averaging a double-double with 17.5 points and 11.3 rebounds per game. She was the SEC and USBWA National Player of the Week in the opening week of the season after leading South Carolina to a pair of top-15 victories that propelled the Gamecocks back to the No. 1 ranking they possessed every week of the last two seasons.

Cardoso is eighth in the SEC in scoring, third in rebounding (16th in the nation) and second in blocks per game (3.75, 2nd in the nation). Her .667 field goal percentage is second in the league and 22nd in the nation. With three double-doubles through four games, she leads the SEC and is seventh in the nation.

TEAM SPECIALTY STATS

Pao-erful Impact

Senior transfer Te-Hina Paopao is often mentioned by her teammates as a leader, despite her summer arrival to the program. The three-time All-Pac-12 selection illustrated that leadership beautifully in the season opener against #10/10 Notre Dame (Nov. 6). As the starter with the most experience at the position, the steady guard led the way in the opening 10 minutes with seven points on 3-of-4 shooting, two assists and two steals to keep the Gamecocks within a point at the end of the period.

That steady hand has not wavered since. Paopao's 14.0 points per game are both her average and her game-bygame number as she scored 14 in each of the season's first three games. Third on the team in scoring, her SECbest 58.8 percent 3-point accuracy (10-of-17) ranks 15th in the nation. Her SEC-best 3.33 made 3s per game are 25th in the nation. She hit a sterling 4-of-5 (.800) from beyond the arc against Clemson (Nov. 16).

Not just an outside shooter, Paopao is second on the team in assists, ranking fourth in the SEC with 5.0 per game, including two games with five or more. The Gamecocks are scoring 12.0 points per game off Paopao's assists, putting her fingerprints on 26.0 points per game.

That's So Raven

SEC All-Freshman point guard Raven Johnson has the competitive fire, instincts and court vision that Staley loves, and her offensive efficiency has skyrocketed after offseason work. Johnson's court vision and speed have powered the Gamecocks' high-octane offense - Staley asserting that she couldn't slow Johnson down if she wanted to

an SEC-best 9.5 assists per game, and her 6.33 assist-toturnover ratio is eighth in the country (1st in the SEC). She has handed out six or more assists in every game so far this season

Johnson's 17 assists against Clemson (Nov. 16) were the most by an SEC player since 2005, the second-most in program history, missing the record by one, and the most in the NCAA so far this season.

Beyond her assists, Johnson has more than doubled her scoring from last season with 10.8 points per game this season on a career-best 51.3 percent shooting.

With her scoring and 21.0 points per game off her assists, Johnson has her hands on 31.7 percent of the Gamecocks' offense. Of her 9.5 assists per game, 42.1 percent (4.0) go to her long-time teammate and favorite target Kamilla Cardoso.

CK Obsession

Sophomore Chloe Kitts worked her way into the starting lineup this season, and proved immediately what Staley has seen in the young 6-foot-2 forward physicality, basketball IQ and tenacity.

Kitts has scored in double figures twice, including her first career double-double against #14/11 Maryland (Nov. 12). Those 13 points and 10 rebounds came in just 21 minutes on the court, and she powered home eight of her 13 points in just six minutes of the second quarter to guide the Gamecocks to a 12-point halftime lead.

On the season, Kitts averages 9.3 points and 5.5 rebounds. She is shooting 51.3 percent from the field and is second on the team with nine made free throws.

Ashlyn Swatkins

Sophomore Ashlyn Watkins' summer conditioning and court work have her thriving in her second season, averaging 10.0 points and 7.8 rebounds and leading the nation with 4.0 blocks per game.

With her athleticism never in question – she became the first Gamecock to dunk in a game last season at Clemson – Watkins is bringing all sides of her game together this season.

She has two double-doubles and at least three blocks in every game. She is tied for the team lead in offensive rebounds with 4.0 per game, which rank fourth in the SEC.

The Full-wiley

Freshman guard MiLaysia Fulwiley arrived on her hometown campus with fanfare befitting her high school highlight reel and her No. 13 ranking in the recruiting class. Often soft-spoken off the court, she wasted not time letting her game yell from the rooftops in support of Staley calling her a "generational player" who can do things with a basketball no one else can do.

On the biggest stage for her college debut in Paris, Fulwiley dazzled international fans and NBA legends alike with the style in her 17 points, six assists and six steals against #10/10 Notre Dame (Nov. 6). Columbia anxiously awaited her home debut, which was a 12-point, 2-assist, 2-block, 2-steal effort in just 15 minutes against #14/11 Maryland (Nov. 12). Four days later, she needed just 16 minutes to put on a highlight-reel near double-double, torching rival Clemson for 18 points, nine rebounds and three assists.

Fulwiley is second on the team with 14.7 points per game, which ranks 15th in the SEC, and third in assists with 3.5 per outing. She has also added nine steals and five blocks to the defensive effort.

Great Gamecock Fans

South Carolina fans have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last nine seasons and announced a 16-for-16 campaign to secure 16,000 season tickets to honor Staley's 16th season in Columbia.

While the season ticket number has not yet hit that mark, attendance at the first two homes games did with the rivalry game against Clemson (Nov. 16) coming in at 16,820 as the most attended regular-season game in the nation this season. Attendance at the home opener against #14/11 Maryland (Nov. 12) ranks second in the nation. Both of which have South Carolina top the average attendance rankings at 15,875 fans per game.

The Gamecocks have had at least one sellout of their 18,000-seat Colonial Life Arena for seven straight seasons (excluding COVID-limited 2020-21 season) dating back to the first ever sellout of 18,000 on Feb. 8, 2016...

Excluding the COVID limited-attendance season of 2020-21, South Carolina has drawn at least 10,000 fans 114 consecutive regular-season games beginning on Jan. 2, 2015.

Everybody's All-American

The Gamecocks' 11-woman roster includes eight McDonald's All-Americans – Kamilla Cardoso, Sania Feagin, MiLaysia Fulwiley, Bree Hall, Raven Johnson, Tessa Johnson, Te-Hina Paopao and Ashlyn Watkins.

At South Carolina, Staley has coached 23 McDonald's All-Americans, including 18 who joined the Gamecocks as freshmen.

Staffing Boost

For the first time since 2018, head coach Dawn Staley had changes to her staff this offseason, including a boost in numbers thanks to a change in the NCAA rules governing the number of assistant coaches.

Associate head coach Lisa Boyer and assistant coach Jolette Law remain the heart of the staff. Long-time assistant Fred Chmiel left the Gamecocks for his first NCAA Div. I head coaching position, making room for Winston Gandy who brought six hears of NCAA coaching experience and three seasons of NBA player development to Columbia.

The new NCAA legislation allowed Staley to elevate Mary Wooley into an assistant coach role. Wooley was previously the recruiting coordinator on Staley's staff for several season but also had 10 seasons of experience as an assistant coach with four different teams. Staley also brought former Gamecock Khadijah Sessions to her staff this summer after the 2016 grad spent the last few seasons coaching at the high school level.

WNBA Pipeline

With 10 alumnae playing in the WNBA in 2023, South Carolina had the third-most players in the league of any college program.

Since the first Staley-trained Gamecock was drafted in 2015 (Aleighsa Welch), a total of 14 South Carolina players have been taken in the WNBA Draft. Ten of those went in the first round, including two No. 1 overall picks.

With five players taken in the 2023 WNBA Draft, South Carolina joined Notre Dame (2019) and Tennessee (2008, 1999) as the only programs to have at least that many players taken in a single draft. Three of those five picks were in the first round, making South Carolina one of just seven programs to hit that benchmark.

In proof Staley sends players to the league ready, five Gamecocks have earned All-Rookie Team honors, including three WNBA Rookies of the Year – Allisha Gray (2017), A'ja Wilson (2018), Aliyah Boston (2023).

Gamecock alum A'ja Wilson has risen to become the face of the WNBA. The two-time league MVP (2020, 2022), two-time Defensive Player of the Year (2022, 2023) and five-time All-Star led her Las Vegas Aces to back-to-back WNBA Championships (2022, 2023). Wilson's former AAU and South Carolina teammate Alaina Coates joined her on the 2023 title team.

In women's basketball, Colonial Life Arena has become one of the most feared places to play as enormous crowds fill the building with passion for the Gamecocks.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last seven seasons. The Gamecocks were one of a few programs to finish the 2019-20 season averaging over 10,000 fans and boast nine sellouts (18,000) in the last eight seasons of full capacity arenas.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest oncampus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300. The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of \$4.2 million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately $12' \times 20'$ and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.

Catapulting South Carolina into the national spotlight when she was hired in May 2008, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. Under her leadership, the Gamecocks have reached many firsts – National Championships, NCAA Final Fours, No. 1 rankings, SEC regular-season and tournament titles, SEC Players of the Year, National Players of the Year, WNBA No. 1 Draft picks, an undefeated regular season, and No. 1 recruiting classes – to name the most notable.

In Staley's previous 15 seasons at the helm of the Gamecocks, highlights include:

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012.

In her 24th season as a head coach, Staley has led her college teams to 13 25-win seasons, a total of 19 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 198 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including the Gamecocks' 65 in the No. 1 spot – the fourth most times in the top spot in the history of that poll. Her .757 winning percentage (578-186) ranks ninth in the nation among active head coaches with at least 15 years of experience and 13th all-time.

Also a force in USA Basketball, Staley was named the U.S. Women's National Team head coach for 2017-21, leading the U.S. to gold in the 2018 FIBA World Cup and the 2019 and 2021 FIBA AmeriCups and stretching the U.S. Olympic gold medal streak to seven straight at the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games Prior to that appointment, Staley led three other U.S. teams to gold medals and served as an assistant on the Senior National Team 2006-08 and again 2014-16, during which the U.S. claimed gold in the 2014 FIBA World Championship and the 2008 and 2016 Olympics.

Now in her 16th season leading the Gamecocks, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year four times with her 2020 unanimous selection making her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award. She is also a six-time SEC Coach of the Year. Staley is the only Gamecock basketball coach – men's or women's – to amass 300 victories at South Carolina and was the fastest coach to 200 wins in program history, needing just 277 games at South Carolina to reach the plateau. She is the program's all-time winningest coach (403) with a program-record 12 postseason appearances and is the only black head coach in men's or women's basketball to win multiple national championships.

In the vaunted SEC, Staley's 183 league wins are the most among active league coaches and third all-time, trailing just Andy Landers (Georgia, 273) and Pat Summitt (Tennessee, 306). Her .769 SEC winning percentage (183-55) is second only to Summitt (.874) in league history. Her Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history, hitting that mark in 2015-16, 2019-20 and 2022-23.

In addition to coaching two National Players of the Year and a National Freshman of the Year, Staley has helped 10 Gamecocks collect 25 All-America selections, three to pick up seven SEC Player of the Year honors, three to earn SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognition a total of seven times, two to SEC 6th Player of the Year honors and six to capture SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 18 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors a combined 37 times, including 20 first-team selections. In the last nine years, 14 Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft, including 10 first-rounders, highlighted by two overall No. 1 picks. Three Gamecocks have been named WNBA Rookie of the Year.
