

# **SOUTH CAROLINA (4-3, 2-3) vs. OKLAHOMA (4-3, 1-3)**

## **>>> SOUTH CAROLINA NOTES**

- Attendance at Gaylord Family - Oklahoma Memorial Stadium was 83,331.
- South Carolina's captains for the game were Davis Beville, O'Donnell Fortune, Jalon Kilgore and LaNorris Sellers.
- This was the first meeting between Carolina and Oklahoma.
- South Carolina is now 638-616-44 all-time.
- Shane Beamer is now 24-21 as a head coach at South Carolina.
- South Carolina won the toss and deferred until the second half. South Carolina defended the North goal.
- The 21 points in the first quarter were the most by the Gamecocks since the 2022 Tennessee game.

## **>>> SOUTH CAROLINA OFFENSE NOTES**

- Rocket Sanders had his sixth rushing touchdown of the season, a 3-yard scamper with 12:33 left in the first quarter.
- LaNorris Sellers connected with Joshua Simon for a 33-yard touchdown pass with 1:54 left in the second quarter. Simon recorded his second touchdown of the season.
- Sellers was 16-for-24 for 175 yards and a touchdown in the win.
- Simon and Vandrevius Jacobs both had four receptions in the win. Simon had 43 yards and a touchdown while Jacobs had 40.

## **>>> SOUTH CAROLINA DEFENSE NOTES**

- Nick Emmanwori picked up his third interception of the year and fifth in his career on Oklahoma's first play from scrimmage. It led to a Carolina touchdown with 12:33 left in the first quarter.
- Demetrius Knight forced a fumble with a sack, which led to a Tonka Hemingway touchdown. It was Carolina's sixth forced fumble of the year and Knight's second sack in as many weeks.
- Tonka Hemingway recovered a fumble and returned it 36 yards for a touchdown. It was Carolina's first fumble return for a touchdown since Jabari Ellis returned a fumble 18 yards for a touchdown in a win over Florida on Nov. 6, 2021.
- Emmanwori's second interception of the first quarter was returned 65 yards for a touchdown. It was Carolina's and Emmanwori's second interception return for a touchdown this season.
- Carolina forced three turnovers in the first half for the first time since 2016 vs. Florida. They forced four turnovers in the game.
- South Carolina now has 28 sacks on the season after its nine in the Oklahoma win. Carolina also had 13 tackles for loss in the win.
- Kyle Kennard recorded his 8 1/2 sack of the season with a fourth quarter tackle on Jackson Arnold.
- Dylan Stewart picked up his 4 1/2 sack of the year with a fourth-quarter takedown.
- Knight, Emmanwori and Bam Martin-Scott led the Gamecocks with 11 tackles on the day.
- The Gamecocks have the most sacks against the Sooners in Oklahoma's school history with their nine in the win.

## **>>> SOUTH CAROLINA SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES**

- Alex Herrera connected on field goals of 39 and 33 yards in the win. He now has 10 field goals this season.
- Kai Kroeger had a 51.6-yard punt average in the win, including a long of 57 yards.
