QUICK HITTERS

• Sophomore forward **Mackenzie Mgbako** scored 49 points (24.5 points per game) in the first two contests of the season for the Hoosiers, the most since James Blackmon Jr. scored 49 in a two-game stretch at the beginning of the 2016-17 season. His career high of 31 points in the opener against SIUE (Nov. 6) marked the highest point total for a Hoosier season debut since **Eric Gordon** scored 33 points to open his collegiate career in 2007. • Fifth-year senior guard **Trey Galloway** has handed out 17 helpers in 35 minutes off the bench this season. He is the NCAA leader in assists per game in a reserve role with 8.5 assists. Dug McDaniel (Kansas State) is second with 6.0 per game and Kerr Kriisa (Kentucky) stands third at 5.7. (More on Pg. 3)

• Twenty-four members of scouting departments or front offices from 21 NBA teams are expected to be in attendance for the game on Saturday.

NOTABLES

OPENING TIP

- Indiana University continues its 125th season of competition in men's basketball against South Carolina at 3 p.m. ET on Saturday, Nov. 16, at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. The game will be streamed on Peacock with Paul Burmeister (pxp) and Robbie Hummel (analyst) on the call.
- The Gamecocks enter the contest with a record of 2-1 behind 21.0 points, 10.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists, and 1.3 blocks per game from sophomore forward Collin Murray-Boyles. Senior guard Jacobi Wright adds 16.0 points per game on 46.7% shooting from the 3-point line, while senior guard Jamarii Thomas averages 10.7 points and 3.3 assists.

SERIES HISTORY

- The Hoosiers have won the last two matchups with the Gamecocks and hold a 2-1 series advantage. The two sides last met in Bloomington on Dec. 22, 1973, with Indiana prevailing by a count of 84-71.
- That top-15 matchup featured 10 players selected in the NBA Draft, including 1977 first overall pick **Kent Benson** (Indiana) and eight-time All-Star Alex English (South Carolina). **Scott May** (2nd overall), **Quinn Buckner** (7th overall), **Bob Wilkerson** (11th overall), and Brian Winters (12th overall) all went on to be selected in the first round of their respective draft.

LAST TIME OUT

- No. 17/18 Indiana (2-0) used a dominate second half to defeat Eastern Illinois by a score of 90-55 on Sunday, Nov. 10, at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall.
- IU outpaced EIU 54-18 in the second half. The Panthers shot 5-of-30 (16.7%) from the floor, 2-of-10 (20.0%) from the 3-point line, and committed nine turnovers in the second half. The Hoosiers collected 32 points in the paint, 20 fastbreak points, and shot 22-of-34 (64.7%) from the floor over the final 20 minutes of the contest.

- Sophomore forward **Mackenzie Mgbako** (18 points, 7 rebounds) paced a balanced Hoosier attack. Sixth-year senior center **Oumar Ballo** (17, 9), junior forward **Malik Reneau** (17, 6), and freshman wing **Bryson Tucker** (12) all hit double figures in the scoring column.

SECOND-YEAR LEAP FOR MGBAKO

- Sophomore forward **Mackenzie Mgbako** scored a career-high 31 points on 13-of-17 shooting from the floor and 4-of-5 shots from behind the arc in Indiana's victory over SIUE on Nov. 6 at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall.
- Mgbako joined Marquette guard Kam Jones as the only high-major players to score 30 points on less than two free throw attempts in a game in the opening week of the season.
- The 31 points scored marked the most in a season debut for a Hoosier since 17-year NBA veteran **Eric Gordon** dropped 33 points in his collegiate debut against Chattanooga on Nov. 12, 2007. Former All-American **Jimmy Rayl** holds the program record for points in a season opener when he scored 35 against Virginia on Dec. 1, 1962.
- His two-game total of 49 points (24.5 points per game) are the most by an IU player in the first two games of a campaign since **James Blackmon Jr.** scored 49 (26 vs. Kansas, 23 vs. UMASS Lowell) at the beginning of the 2016-17 season.

BIG FELLA BALLO

- Sixth-year senior center **Oumar Ballo**, who has secured 34 career double-doubles, is second among active college basketball players with 114 career wins.
- Against Eastern Illinois (Nov. 10), Ballo recorded 17 points, nine rebounds, and three blocks in 27 minutes. He shot 8-of-10 from the field in the Indiana victory. He is one of three players (Ryan Kalkbrenner, Creighton; Danny Wolf, Michigan) this season to post a line of 17-9-3 or better while shooting at least 80.0% from the floor.

GALLO DROPPING DIMES

- Fifth-year senior guard **Trey Galloway** posted nine assists in 17 minutes off the bench in Indiana's 80-61 season-opening win over SIUE in Bloomington.
- In the last 25 seasons of major conference basketball, Gallo is the 10th player to have at least nine assists in 17 minutes or less. He is the first player to achieve the feat since Vanderbilt guard Carter Josephs on Feb. 22, 2014.
- Galloway finished the 2023-24 B1G season with 105 total assists, tied for the second most in program history in conference play. His also had multiple 12-assist games last season to become the first Hoosier to achieve that feat since Naismith Hall of Famer **Isiah Thomas** (1980-81).

- The Culver, Ind., native is averaging 19.2 assists per 40 minutes this season and leads the NCAA in assists per game (8.5) off the bench. He has handed out 17 helpers in 35 minutes.

RENEAU FOR TWO

- Junior forward **Malik Reneau** is averaging 16.0 points, 6.5 rebounds, and 1.5 blocks per game through the first week of the college basketball season.

- The Miami, Fla., native is shooting 61.9% (13-of-21) from the floor and 85.7% (6-of-7) from the free throw line in 26.5 minutes per game.

- Reneau has tallied 15-plus points 21 times in his career, including both games this season, and topped the 20-point threshold seven times.

MGBAKO DROPS 31 IN OPENING WIN OVER SIUE

- Indiana opened the season with an 80-61 victory over SIUE on Wednesday, Nov. 6, at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall.
- Sophomore forward **Mackenzie Mgbako** laced a career-high 31 points on 13-of-17 shooting from the field. The Gladstone, N.J., native became the fourth player under head coach Mike Woodson to top the 30-point threshold in a game at Indiana.

- The Hoosiers also received double-digit scoring performances from junior forward **Malik Reneau** (15 points), sixth-year senior center **Oumar Ballo** (15), and redshirt sophomore guard **Myles Rice** (11). The starting lineup for the Hoosiers outpaced the Cougars by a count of 72-35.

INDIANA TOPS MARIAN IN PAT KNIGHT'S RETURN

- Thirteen Hoosiers entered the scoring column in Indiana's 106-64 victory over Marian in the exhibition finale on Friday, Nov. 1, at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. IU shot 46-of-70 (65.7%) from the floor and scored 70 points in the paint.

- Junior forward **Malik Reneau** totaled 18 points, eight rebounds, and five assists in 18 minutes of action. Freshman wing **Bryson Tucker** scored a game-high 19 points in his collegiate debut.
- Marian head coach Pat Knight, son of legendary Indiana head coach **Bob Knight**, made his return to Bloomington in his debut season with the Knights. He was hired by athletic director **Steve Downing**, an All-American forward with the Hoosiers under Coach Knight.

RENEAU, RICE TOP DOGS IN KNOXVILLE

- Indiana went on the road to defeated No. 12/12 Tennessee in a charity exhibition by a score of 66-62 on Sunday, Oct. 27. The defense held the Volunteers to 18-of-59 (30.5%) shooting from the floor, 8-of-35 (22.9%) shooting from the 3-point line, and forced 15 turnovers.
- Junior forward **Malik Reneau** (21 points, 8 rebounds) and redshirt sophomore guard **Myles Rice** (20 points, 4 assists) combined for 41 points on 15-of-26 (57.7%) shooting.
- In the first half, Indiana scored 25 points on 11-of-33 (33.3%) shooting from the floor, 0-of-11 (0.0%) from behind the arc, and committed 10 turnovers. IU flipped the script in the second half to score 41 points on 14-of-27 (51.9%) shooting, 4-of-8 (50.0%) from the floor, and coughed just three turnovers.

IU TO PLAY KU AT ALLEGiant STADIUM IN 2027

The Indiana men’s basketball program will square off with the Kansas Jayhawks as part of the 2027 Hall of Fame Series in Las Vegas, the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame announced on Sunday. Arizona will play Duke as part of the doubleheader.

The game will be played on Friday, Nov. 12, 2027, at Allegiant Stadium, home of the Las Vegas Raiders. The state-of-the-art, multi-purpose stadium will play host to the 2028 NCAA Men’s Final Four later that season. Both games will be showcased on TNT Sports’ networks and platforms, with additional programming information to be announced at a later date.

“We are excited to play in such a prestigious event,” head coach Mike Woodson said. “I look forward to testing our ballclub that early in the season against a high-level opponent like Kansas. Our staff has always prioritized playing the best competition out there and getting this opportunity in Allegiant Stadium should be a lot of fun for both the program and the fan base.”

The two storied programs have met 16 times on the hardwood, and both teams have claimed eight victories. The Hoosiers topped the Jayhawks in each of the first six meetings, which included the 1940 and 1953 NCAA Championship bouts. IU (5 national titles) and KU (4) have combined to win nine national championships.

“I am excited to support the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame doubleheader to be played at Allegiant Stadium in Las Vegas in November 2027,” NCAA Senior Vice President of Men’s Basketball Dan Gavitt said. “Starting the college basketball season where it will end on the Road to the 2028 Final Four in Las Vegas is a rare opportunity to celebrate the game. Duke, Indiana, Kansas, and Arizona have combined to win 15 men’s basketball national championships. Congratulations to the Hall of Fame, the Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority, and the Las Vegas Raiders for arranging such an incredible tip-off to the 2027-28 college basketball season where a national champion will be crowned only 5 months later.”
