>>> SOUTH CAROLINA NOTES

- Attendance at Memorial Stadium was 81,500.
- South Carolina's captains for the game were Alex Huntley, Demetrius Knight, LaNorris Sellers, Toricelli Simpkins and Debo Williams.
- Clemson leads the all-time series, 73-44-4, with Carolina winning the last meeting between the two teams in Clemson.
- South Carolina is now 643-616-44 all-time.
- Shane Beamer is now 29-21 as a head coach at South Carolina.
- Clemson won the toss and deferred until the second half.
- The meeting was the seventh in school history when both Carolina and Clemson were ranked in the AP poll.
- Carolina won its ninth game of the season for the first time since 2017.
- Carolina extended its winning streak to six games, last accomplished in 2013.
- Carolina picked up its fourth road win of the season for the first time since 2006.
- Carolina has now defeated a ranked team for the fourth time this season, which is a school record.
- Carolina has now won two straight games in Memorial Stadium.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA OFFENSE NOTES

- LaNorris Sellers scrambled for a 25-yard touchdown with 9:20 remaining in the second quarter to tie the game at seven. It was Sellers' sixth rushing touchdown of the season.
- Sellers then scored on a 20-yard scramble with 1:08 left in the fourth quarter to give Carolina a 17-14 lead. It was his second multiple-rushing touchdown game of the season (2 vs. LSU).
- •Sellers ran for a career-high 166 yards in the win over the Tigers. His previous high was 106 vs. Texas A&M in 2024.
- Sellers ran for over 100 (166) and threw for over 100 (164) for the second time this season, also vs. Texas A&M.
- Nyck Harbor was Carolina's leading receiver with three catches for 51 yards.
- Rocket Sanders had 18 carries for 60 yards and three receptions for 48 yards in the win.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA DEFENSE NOTES

- Tonka Hemingway recovered his second fumble of the season in the third quarter.
- Bam Martin-Scott recorded his 2.5 sack of the year in the third quarter.
- Demetrius Knight picked off Cade Klubnik with 12 seconds remaining in the game to seal the 17-14 win.
- Knight led Carolina with 10 tackles, eight of them solos, to go along with the interception.
- Martin-Scott had two tackles for loss.
- Carolina now has 40 sacks on the season after Martin-Scott's.
- Knight has three forced turnovers this season, two forced fumbles and an interception.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Alex Herrera connected on a 42-yard field goal with 6:48 left in the fourth quarter. It was his 14th made field goal of the season.
- Kai Kroeger averaged 46.6 yards per punt in the win with three inside the 20.
