THE X FACTORS

- Xavier, 5-0, is coming off an 80-55 win over Siena on Nov. 20 at Cintas Center. This is Xavier's best start since going 8-0 to start the 2020-21 season. This is XU's second-best start in eight seasons under head coach Sean Miller, trailing only the 9-0 start in the 2008-09 season.
- Xavier graduate student Marcus Foster recorded his first double-figure scoring game as a Musketeer with 12 points, five rebounds and five assists against Siena. Nine Xavier players have at least one double-figure scoring game though five games this season.
- Xavier leads the BIG EAST in free-throw percentage (eighth in the nation at .827), 3-point percentage (10th in the nation at .434), assists per game (second in the nation at 21.8 apg.), assist-to-turnover ratio (fourth in the nation at 2.27) and fastbreak points (ninth in the nation in at 21.6 ppg.). XU is second in the BIG EAST in turnover margin at +4.4.
- Xavier junior newcomer **Ryan Conwell**, a preseason Third Team All-BIG EAST selection, leads the team in scoring at 18.2 ppg. (fourth in the BIG EAST), while leading the BIG EAST and ranking 10th in the nation at 4.0 3-point field goals made per game.
- Xavier has hit at least 10 3-pointers in four straight games, its longest such single-season streak since a six-game streak in the 1998-99 season. Junior Ryan Conwell has hit at least three 3-pointers in all five games and is one of only six XU players ever to have a streak of fivestraight games or more with at least three 3-pointers.
- Xavier graduate student Dayvion McKnight, a preseason Second Team All-BIG EAST selection, has averaged 12.6 ppg. and a team-high 5.2 apg. (sixth in the BIG EAST). McKnight leads the BIG EAST and ranks 18th in the nation with an 6.5 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Xavier graduate student Zach Freemantle, a preseason Second Team All-BIG EAST selection, is second on the team in scoring (12th in the BIG EAST at 15.6 ppg.) and leads the team in rebounding (sixth in BIG EAST at 7.2 rpg.). He is tied for the league lead in defensive rebound-
- Xavier is 25-11 in its last 36 games against 12 different current SEC members since 2008. South Carolina is one of only four current SEC teams that XU has not played since Jan. of 2008.

XAVIER LEADS THE SERIES 1-0

THE XAVIER-SOUTH CAROLINA SERIES:

Xavier leads the series 1-0 but the two teams have not met since the 1941-42 season at Xavier's Schmidt Fieldhouse with XU winning 63-43 (12-19-41).

FOR THE RECORD (SOUTH CAROLINA): The South Carolina Gamecocks, 3-2, are coming off an 84-72 win over Mercer on Thursday night. South Carolina made the 2024 NCAA Tournament field.

XAVIER VS. THE SEC: Xavier is 25-11 in its last 36 games against 12 different current SEC members dating back to 2008: Alabama (3-0), Auburn (3-2), Florida (3-2), Georgia (3-1), LSU (2-0), Missouri (5-1), Oklahoma (1-0), Ole Miss (1-0), Tennessee (1-2), Texas (0-2), Texas A&M (1-0) and Vanderbilt (2-1). Those records include road wins at Missouri, Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Vanderbilt, LSU and Auburn and NCAA Tournament wins over Ole Miss and Georgia and the 2022 NIT Championship Game win over Texas A&M. South Carolina (last game in 1941), Kentucky (last game in 1968), Arkansas (never played) and Mississippi State (last game in 2004) are the only current SEC teams that XU has not played since January of 2008.

SOME REGULAR SEASON TOURNAMENT SUCCESS RECENTLY IN FLORIDA: Xavier won tournaments in Orlando in back-to-back years in 2015 and 2016. Xavier won the 2015 Advocare Invitational with wins over Alabama, USC and Dayton. XU won the 2016 Tire Pros Invitational with wins over Missouri, Clemson and Northern Iowa.

SOME REGULAR SEASON TOURNAMENT SUCCESS UNDER MILLER: Xavier won the 2008 Puerto Rico-Tipoff with wins over Missouri, Virginia Tech and Memphis and the 2007 Chicago Challenge with wins over Southeast Missouri State, Coppin State, Kent State and Indiana. XU finished runner-up at the 2006 Paradise Jam in the U.S. Virgin Islands with wins over VCU and Villanova and a loss to Alabama in the championship game. These three holiday tournaments were during Sean Miller's first stint as XU head coach.

MUSKETEERS HIT THE ROAD: Xavier will play five of its next seven games away from Cintas Center. XU plays South Carolina and either Michigan or Virginia Tech in the Fort Myers Tip-Off Nov. 25 and 27, at TCU on Dec. 5, at Cincinnati on Dec. 14 and the BIG EAST opener at UConn on Dec. 18.

FOR THE RECORD (XAVIER): Xavier, 5-0, is coming off an 80-55 win over Siena on Nov. 20 at Cintas Center. Junior Ryan Conwell led four Xavier double figure scorers with 16 points on the strength of 4-5 3-point shooting. Xavier graduate student Marcus Foster recorded his first double-figure scoring game as a Musketeer with 12 points, five rebounds and five assists against Siena. Nine different Xavier players have at least one double-figure scoring game though five games this season.

XAVIER DEFEATED WAKE FOREST: Xavier recorded an impressive 75-60 win over Wake Forest in the Skip Prosser Classic on Nov. 16. Xavier's defense stepped up, helping XU forge a 34-24 halftime lead. Junior **Ryan Conwell** led all scorers with 21 points, including 16 in the second half, to go with four assists and three steals.

GREAT START: Xavier finished the season-opening five-game homestand with a 5-0 record. This is Xavier's best start since going 8-0 to start the 2020-21 season. This is XU's second-best start in eight seasons under head coach **Sean Miller**, trailing only the 9-0 start in the 2008-09 season.

3-POINTERS HAVE BEEN FALLING: Xavier has averaged 10.6 made 3-pointers per game this season (second in the BIG EAST), while leading the BIG EAST and ranking 13th in the nation in 3-point percentage at .434. Xavier has hit at least 10 3-pointers in four straight games, its longest such single-season streak since a six-game streak in the 1998-99 season. Xavier hit 16-31 from 3-point range vs. Jackson State on Nov. 12, which is tied for the second-most 3-pointers in XU history and the most since hitting a school record 19 in a win over Oklahoma in the 2020-21 season (12-9-20).

CONWELL ON TARGET FROM DEEP: Junior newcomer Ryan Conwell has hit at least three 3-pointers in all five games and is one of only six XU players ever to have a streak of five-straight games or more with at least three 3-pointers. This is the longest such streak of Conwell's collegiate career. Stanley Burrell (2005-06), Lionel Chalmers (2003-04) and Gary Lumpkin (first five games of 1996-97) posted five-game streaks with three or more and Lenny Brown (1998-99), Chalmers (2003-04) and Maurice McAfee (1999-2000) posted six-game streaks with at least three 3-pointers. Conwell, a preseason Third Team All-BIG EAST selection, leads the BIG EAST and ranks 10th in the nation at 4.0 3-point field goals made per game.

BALANCED ATTACK: Xavier has three players averaging in double figures in scoring and six others between 4.8 ppg. and 8.2 ppg. Junior **Ryan Conwell** leads Xavier at 18.2 ppg. (fourth in the BIG EAST) followed by

graduate student **Zach Freemantle** at 15.6 ppg. (12th in the BIG EAST) and graduate student **Dayvion McKnight** at 12.6 ppg. (22nd in the BIG EAST). Nine different players have at least one double-figure scoring game through five games. XU placed six players in double figures in scoring in the Jackson State win on Nov. 12, the first time XU has done that since its 2023 NCAA Second Round win over Pitt (3-19-23).

OFFENSIVE LEADERS: Xavier leads the BIG EAST in free-throw percentage (eighth in the nation at .827), 3-point percentage (10th in the nation at .434), assists per game (second in the nation at 21.8 apg.), assist-to-turnover ratio (fourth in the nation at 2.27) and fast-break points (ninth in the nation in at 21.6 ppg.).

OLDER TEAM THIS SEASON: Xavier had six freshmen and only one returning letterwinner on the active roster for the 2023-24 season. This season XU has zero scholarship freshmen. XU has seven graduate students on its active roster.

VETERAN STARTING LINEUP: Xavier has started three graduate students (Marcus Foster, Zach Freemantle and Dayvion McKnight), a junior (Ryan Conwell) and a sophomore (Dailyn Swain) for the first five games.

CONWELL ENJOYING IMPRESSIVE START TO XAVIER CAREER: Xavier junior newcomer Ryan Conwell, a preseason Third Team All-BIG EAST selection, leads the team in scoring at 18.2 ppg. (fourth in the BIG EAST), while hitting 52.6 percent (20-38) from 3-point range. Conwell's 4.0 made 3-pointers per game leads the BIG EAST and ranks 10th in the nation. Conwell led Xavier in scoring vs. Wake Forest on Nov. 16 with 21 points to go with four assists, three steals and zero turnovers.

CONWELL EARNED A BIG EAST HONOR; TWO STRAIGHT WEEKS FOR MUSKETEERS:

Xavier junior newcomer **Ryan Conwell** was named to the BIG EAST Honor Roll on Nov. 18 for his efforts in wins over Jackson State on Nov. 12 and Wake Forest on Nov. 16. Conwell averaged 17.5 points, 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals per game while committing just one turnover for the week. Conwell led all scorers in the Wake win with 21 points, including 16 in the second half, to go with four assists, three steals and zero turnovers. This was the second-straight week a Musketeer landed on the BIG EAST Honor Roll. Teammate **Dayvion McKnight** earned the honor on Nov. 11.

MCKNIGHT OFF TO A GREAT START: Xavier graduate student Dayvion McKnight, a preseason Second Team All-BIG EAST selection, has averaged 12.6 ppg. (22nd in the BIG EAST) and a team-high 5.2 apg. (sixth in the BIG EAST). McKnight leads the BIG EAST Conference and ranks 18th in the nation with





an 6.5 assist-to-turnover ratio. McKnight is XU's only returning double-figure scorer from last season.

MCKNIGHT EARNED A BIG EAST HONOR: Xavier graduate student Dayvion McKnight was named to the first BIG EAST Honor Roll of the season on Nov. 11 after averaging 18.0 points and 5.3 assists, while hitting 65.0 percent (13-20) from the field, including 75.0 percent (6-8) from 3-point range, for XU's first two games. McKnight contributed 19 points, five assists and two steals with zero turnovers vs. Texas Southern on Nov. 4 and followed that up with 17 points on 6-7 shooting, including 4-4 from 3-point range, in the win over IU Indy on Nov. 8.

FREEMANTLE ENJOYING HIS RETURN:

Graduate student **Zach Freemantle**, a preseason Second Team All-BIG EAST selection, is second on the team in scoring (12th in the BIG EAST at 15.6 ppg.) and leads the team in rebounding (sixth in BIG EAST at 7.2 rpg.). Freemantle is tied for the league lead in defensive rebounding at 6.0 drpg. Freemantle saw his first regular season game action since Jan. 28, 2023 on Nov. 4, recording his 21st career double-double with 19 points and 11 rebounds to go with a career-high tying four steals. Freemantle led XU with 21 points vs. Jackson State on Nov. 12.

FREEMANTLE IS CLIMBING THE XAVIER CAREER SCORING LIST: Graduate student Zach Freemantle has scored 1,305 career points, which is good for 26th place on Xavier's all-time scoring chart. The next target on the scoring list is Jamal Walker (25th place with 1,333 points from 1987-91).

SWAIN STARTING WELL: Sophomore Dailyn Swain has started the first five games and contributed 8.2 ppg. and 5.6 rpg. (second on the team and tied for 20th in the BIG EAST). Swain is tied for ninth in the BIG EAST in defensive rebounding at 5.2 drpg. Swain recorded his first career double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds to go with two blocks and two assists vs. Jackson State on Nov. 12.

RETURNING TALENT: Xavier returns three scholarship letterwinners from last season led by graduate student Dayvion McKnight, who was second in the BIG EAST Conference and 19th in the nation in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.06. Dailyn Swain and Trey Green both made last season's BIG EAST All-Freshman Team. Xavier also returns two starters from its 2023 team that reached the NCAA Sweet 16, Zach Freemantle and Jerome Hunter, who had to sit out last season for medical reasons.

NEW FACES: Xavier has five transfer newcomers on the active roster: Ryan Conwell, Cam Fletcher, Marcus Foster, John Hugley IV and Dante Maddox Jr. Conwell earned 2023-24 Missouri Valley Conference Second Team honors for an Indiana State team that won 32 games and reached the NIT Finals; his 109 3-pointers ranked 15th in the nation. Foster, 2023-24 Second Team All-SoCon selection, was a three-year starter at Furman who was a part of the team that upset Virginia in the 2023 NCAA Tournament. Hugley, who earned 2021-22 Honorable Mention All-ACC honors at Pitt as a redshirt freshman, played last season at Oklahoma before injury ended his season. Maddox was a 2023-24 Second Team All-Mid-American Conference selection at Toledo.

BIG EAST PRESEASON HONORS FOR THREE MUSKETEERS; TEAM PICKED THIRD: Graduate students Dayvion McKnight and Zach Freemantle were named to the preseason BIG EAST Second Team, while junior Ryan Conwell was voted to the Third Team. The coaches picked Xavier to finish third in the regular season conference race.

25TH SEASON AT CINTAS CENTER: The Xavier men's basketball team, in its 25th season at Cintas Center, has compiled a 328-62 (.841) record in its on-campus home, including 5-0 this season.

TOUGH TICKET: Xavier has sold out 235 games at full arena capacity (now listed at 10,212 capacity) at Cintas Center since it opened for the 2000-01 season, including three games this season. Xavier has averaged 10,062 fans for its 377 games in 24 seasons played at full capacity since it opened for the 2000-01 season (all but the attendance-restricted 13 games in the 2020-21 pandemic year).

XAVIER KEPT ITS STREAK ALIVE: Xavier won its 35th straight regular season opener with a 78-69 win over Texas Southern on Nov. 4. XU has won all 25 season openers at Cintas Center. Xavier graduate student **Zach Freemantle** saw his first regular season game action since Jan. 28, 2023, recording a double-double with 19 points and 11 rebounds with a career-high tying four steals.

GRADUATION STREAK: Xavier has a senior graduation streak of 125 that traces back to 1986, including current scholarship players Brad Colbert, Zach Freemantle, Jerome Hunter and Dayvion McKnight.

POSTSEASON REGULAR: Xavier made its 35th postseason appearance in the last 41 postseasons in 2024 (2020 cancelled by the pandemic), including 28 NCAA Tournament berths and seven NIT berths during that time. XU only made the NCAA Tournament field one time (1961) before the 1982-83 season.

SEAN MILLER RADIO SHOW: The next Coach Sean Miller Radio Show, which airs live from Dilly Bistro in Mariemont, will air on Tuesday, Dec. 3 from 7-8 p.m. 55KRC is the home of the radio show broadcasts again this season. The show also airs live on the Xavier Men's Basketball Facebook page with Behind the Mic, presented by Deer Park Roofing, LLC!

TWO TOP 100 SIGNEES JOIN THE XAVIER BASKETBALL FAMILY: Head coach Sean Miller announced the signing of decorated prep standouts Nyk Lewis (pronounced Nick), a 6-2 guard from Washington, D.C., and Gonzaga High School, and Jayden Forsythe, a 6-5 guard/forward from Norristown (Pa.) Westtown School, to Athletics Aid Agreements. Lewis is a top 60 recruit in the ESPN Top 100 (52), Rivals Top 100 (57) and the 247Sports Top 100 (59). Nyk Lewis was named to the Washington Post's All-Met First Team and the First Team All-State DC-SAA for the second straight year. Lewis' impressive resume goes well beyond Gonzaga. Lewis, a USA Basketball member, was an NBA Top 100 Camp invite. He is a two-time Peach Jam Champion in the 16/17u category, playing for Team Takeover. Jayden Forsythe is a Top 100 recruit in the On3 national recruit rankings at No. 94. Forsythe is ranked as the No. 1 overall recruit in Pennsylvania for the Class of 2025, according to the 247Sports' Composite Rankings, and the No. 110 recruit nationally. Forsythe was the only player on the circuit to shoot over 40 percent from 3-point range on 75+ 3-point attempts. He averaged 9.5 points for Team Final at the Peach Jam this past summer, while shooting 39 percent from 3-point range.

Sean Miller, the Sedler Family Men's Basketball Head Coach, returned to Xavier in 2022 after 12 seasons (2009-21) as the head coach at Arizona. His first season back he led Xavier to one of the top five winningest seasons in school history at 27-10, tied the school record for BIG EAST wins in a season at 15-5 and led the Musketeers back to the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16.

Miller, who earned a spot on the 2023 Werner Ladder Naismith Men's College Coach of the Year Late Season Watch List, owns a 470-184 (.719) on-court record and is in his 20th season as a head coach. In his first 19 years as a head coach, including seven at Xavier (2004-09 and the 2022-24 seasons), Miller has had eight Regular Season Conference Championships, four Conference Tournament Championships, 12 NCAA Tournament appearances and eight Sweet 16s, including four that ended in the Elite Eight.

Miller holds a 168-75 (.691) mark in his eighth season leading Xavier. His 168 wins at XU rank him third on Xavier's all-time wins list. He passed the late Skip Prosser (148 wins in seven seasons from 1994-01) last season. Pete Gillen (202 wins in nine seasons from 1985-94) is in second place.

Miller took Xavier to at least the Sweet 16 in three straight seasons as the Xavier head coach (2023 Sweet 16, 2009 Sweet 16 and 2008 Elite Eight). Miller has made the NCAA Tournament five times as the XU head coach.

In 2023, Miller coached in his 12th NCAA Tournament as a head coach, including his fifth at Xavier. He reached five Sweet 16s (three that advanced to Elite Eights) in 12 seasons at Arizona and has taken Xavier to three Sweet 16s (one that advanced to the Elite Eight). Miller has a 21-12 on-court record as a head coach in NCAA

Tournament play, including 13-7 at Arizona and 8-5 at XU.

SECOND STINT AS XAVIER HEAD COACH

Xavier, 27-10 overall for the 2022-23 season, tied the 2008-09 Sweet 16 team coached by Miller for the fifth-best win total in Xavier history. The school record of 30 wins was set by the 2007-08 Elite Eight team, also under Miller. Xavier finished 15-5 and in second place in the BIG EAST Conference, tying the school record for most BIG EAST wins.

Xavier, which reached the 2023 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, made the NCAA Tournament in five straight seasons with Miller at the helm (the final four years during his first stint in 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 and his first year back in 2023). Those last three appearances gave him three straight years making at least the Sweet 16 as the XU head coach (2008 Elite Eight, 2009 Sweet 16 and 2023 Sweet 16). Miller won four Atlantic 10 Championships, including three regular season titles and one tournament title, during his first stint at XU. Miller was named the 2007-08 Atlantic 10 Conference Coach of the Year after leading Xavier to a 14-2 record and a second straight A-10 Regular Season Title. The National Association of Basketball Coaches named Miller as its 2008 NABC District 10 Coach of the Year and he was a finalist for numerous National Coach of the Year awards.



WINNING AND POSTSEASON SUCCESS

Since Miller became a head coach at Xavier in the 2004-05 season, he has the 10th most on-court wins by any head coach with 465 (sixth among active head coaches) and the 10th highest winning percentage (.716). His 12 NCAA appearances since 2004-05 rank tied for 13th (10th among active coaches), NCAA win total of 21 ranks tied for 13th (seventh among active coaches), his four Elite Eights rank tied for 10th (sixth among active coaches) and his eight Sweet 16s rank tied for seventh (fifth among active coaches). SUCCESS IN THE CLASSROOM

Since becoming the Xavier head coach in 2004, every single player Sean Miller coached that has exhausted their eligibility has gone on to graduate. Standing at 56 straight graduates, this streak is comprised of 24 straight graduates from Xavier University and 32 straight graduates from the University of Arizona.

NATIONAL LEADER ON OFFENSE

Xavier led the nation in assists for the 2022-23 season at 19.1 apg., while ranking in the top 10 in scoring offense (10th at 80.9 ppg.), field goal percentage (seventh at .492) and 3-point percentage (fifth at 39.0). XU led the BIG EAST Conference in all four categories.

MILLER PLAYERS IN THE NRA

With the exception of John Calipari, no other active head coach can claim a deeper roster of NBA players than Sean Miller. Over the last 19 seasons as a head coach, Miller has seen 27 players that he has signed and/or coached move on to play professionally in the NBA, including Colby Jones, a 2023 NBA Draft second round selection (34th overall selection) and last season's leading scorer, Quincy Olivari. Of these 27, 12 were selected in the First Round of the NBA Draft, including six NBA Lottery picks. The Lottery selections include the first overall pick in 2018 (Deandre Ayton), the second overall pick in 2011 (Derrick Williams) and the fourth overall pick in 2014 (Aaron Gordon).

2024-25 active players in the NBA (11): Colby Jones (Sacramento Kings), Quincy Olivari (Los Angeles Lakers), Aaron Gordon (Denver Nuggets), Bennedict Mathurin (Indiana Pacers), Christian Koloko (Los Angeles Lakers), Dalen Terry (Chicago Bulls), Deandre Ayton (Portland Trailblazers), Josh Green (Charlotte Hornets), Lauri Markkanen (Utah Jazz), T.J. McConnell (Indiana Pacers) and Zeke Nnaji (Denver Nuggets). Gordon and Nnaji won the 2023 NBA World Championship with the Nuggets.

PLAYER DEVELOPMENT: STAFF LISTED AS THE BEST IN THE BIG EAST

Sean Miller and his staff received high honors in 2023-24 edition of *The Almanac*, the annual college basketball season preview produced by The Field of 68 staff. A panel of anonymous BIG EAST coaches named the XU staff as the best development staff in the league.

Individual player development has long been a staple of the Sean Miller program. The player-focused, 12-month emphasis on individual on-court development, strength and conditioning, nutrition and recovery has paid dividends for countless athletes over Miller's years as head coach.

USA BASKETBALL SUCCESS

Miller made his mark with USA Basketball as well. Miller was elevated from assistant coach to head coach of the U.S. Men's U19 National Team in 2015, leading the United States to the gold medal at the FIBA U19 World Championship in Crete, Greece, and was named the 2015 USA Basketball National Co-Coach of the Year. Miller's first gold medal with USA Basketball came as a player in 1991, when he helped propel the U.S. to gold in men's basketball at the World University Games in Sheffield, England.

BEFORE XAVIER

Miller came to Xavier for the first time in 2001 as Associate Head Coach under Thad Matta after coaching stops at North Carolina State, Pittsburgh, Miami (Ohio) and Wisconsin.

In 1992, the year after finishing his playing career at Pittsburgh, Miller served on Stu Jackson's Wisconsin staff as a graduate assistant. Jackson, who previously served as the BIG EAST Conference Executive Associate Commissioner, is now the Commissioner of the West Coast Conference.

BIG EAST SUCCESS AS A PLAYER

Miller, a 1992 graduate of the University of Pittsburgh, was the 1987-88 BIG EAST Freshman of the Year and helped lead Pitt to the 1988 BIG EAST regular-season title, as well as three NCAA Tournament appearances. A member of the Pitt All-Centennial Team that was convened in 2005, Miller ranks in the top 20 on the program's career scoring chart with 1,282 points. He also ranks in the top 30 on the NCAA Division I free throw shooting

list (.885), fourth in career free-throw percentage in BIG EAST games (.909) and stands fourth on the BIG EAST career assists chart for league play with 401.

A legend at Blackhawk High School in the Pittsburgh area, Miller was inducted into the Western Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic League Hall of Fame in 2012.

PERSONAL

Miller, 56, and his wife, Amy, have three boys, Austin (29), Cameron (26), Braden (23). Miller, a native of Beaver Falls, Pa., was born Nov. 17, 1968.
