# **GAMECOCK NOTABLES**

- The FAMS never disappoint, and their turnout for the home opener Thursday night 15,550 made it the highest
  attended game in the NCAA so far this season. Today's game will top that as the first of five sellouts already announced
  for this season.
- With a win today, South Carolina would tie its program record for consecutive victories at 42, which is tied for seventhbest in NCAA Div. I history. The Gamecocks' first 42-game streak ran March 18, 2022, through March 27, 2023. The current 41-game streak began on Nov. 6, 2024.
- The Gamecocks have shaken off their uncharacteristic season opener to shoot 50.8 percent over the last two games, which includes a top-10 win over then #9/8 NC State (Nov. 10).
- South Carolina ranks 18th in the nation in rebounding average (47.7) and is in the top 30 in rebounding margin (27th, +14.3) and offensive rebounds per game (29th, 17.0).
- Junior Chloe Kitts is averaging a double-double this season with 19.0 points and 12.0 rebounds per game while shooting a team-high 62.5 percent from the field.
- Sophomore MiLaysia Fulwiley has been filling it up since the Gamecocks came back to the East Coast, averaging 15.5 points on 63.0 percent shooting over the last two games, including an 18-point outing against #9/8 NC State last Sunday.
- Senior Te-Hina Paopao continues to be a do-it-all guard for the Gamecocks, ranking among the SEC's top 10 in 3-point shooting – percentage (.438) and made 3s per game (2.33) – and assist-to-turnover ratio (3.0) while sitting 17th in scoring at 15.0 points per game. Those numbers go up dramatically when factoring out a tough-shooting season opener with her averaging 18.0 points on 60.0 percent (15-of-25) shooting, including 50.0 percent (6-lof-12) from 3-point range, over the last two games.

### A Perennial Power

South Carolina women's basketball had been a national power for more than a decade under head coach Dawn Staley, including seven 30-win seasons in the last 10 campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in six Final Fours in the last nine NCAA Tournaments, including the last four, with National Championships in 2017, 2022 and 2024. They have been ranked in every AP Poll since Dec. 10, 2012, including a top-10 spot every week since the start of the 2019-20 season. The Gamecocks have amassed 85 AP No. 1 rankings all-time, the third-most by a program in the history of that poll (2nd is Tenn., 112).

Under head coach Dawn Staley's leadership, 11 Gamecocks have earned All-America status, three have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 22 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once.

In the last nine seasons, 14 Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft, including 10 first-round picks, highlighted by two No. 1 overall picks in the last six years. In the 2024 season, 12 Gamecocks were on a WNBA roster, the second most of any program in the country. Three Gamecocks have been named WNBA Rookie of the Year and one is a three-time WNBA MVP and two-time WNBA Defensive Player of the Year.

### The East Carolina Series

The Gamecocks hold a 16-1 edge in the series against East Carolina with the lone loss coming in the inaugural game of the series in the 1974-75 season.

The two teams have met twice in South Carolina's Dawn Staley era, including last season's 73-36 Gamecock win in Greenville (Dec. 30, 2023). Columbia's own MiLaysia Fulwiley and Ashlyn Watkins led the way with 12 and 11 points, respectively, as South Carolina posted a 73-36 victory. The win was a dominant defensive performance as the Pirates shot just 19.4 percent from the field.

### **Home Sweet Home**

The Gamecocks are 531-165 (.763) in home games (some records prior to 1976-77 did not include location of games). Current head coach Dawn Staley is 219-34 at home for a program-best .866 winning percentage.

South Carolina currently has a program-record 60-game home winning streak that began on Dec. 17, 2020.

Playing in its 22nd season at Colonial Life Arena, South Carolina boasts a 282-67 (.808) record in the building, including four undefeated seasons since 2013-14. Staley's share of that record is 216-34 (.864).

### **Preseason Predictions**

As the reigning national champion, the Gamecocks are atop both preseason polls by a near unanimous decision, claiming 27 No. 1 votes in both the Associated Press Poll (30 voters) and the USA Today Coaches Poll (31 voters).

The Gamecocks were also selected to repeat as SEC Regular-Season Champions by both the media and league coaches in preseason voting. Both groups tapped senior guard Te-Hina Paopao with Preseason First-Team All-SEC honors and gave second-team recognition to guards Raven Johnson the MiLaysia Fulwiley.

### **Ranking Review**

South Carolina stayed atop both national polls after winning both its games in the opening week of the season. It marked the 85th time the Gamecocks were No. 1 in the AP Poll – the third-most of any program in that poll's history (2nd is Tennessee, 112).

The Gamecocks have the longest active streak of weeks in the AP Top 10 at 98, beginning with the 2019-20 preseason poll. Their 229 straight appearances in the AP Poll, dating back to Dec. 10, 2012, marks the second-longest active streak in the nation and the ninth longest all-time (8th place, Notre Dame, 234).

In the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Poll, South Carolina has been in the top 10 since claiming the No. 10 spot in the 2019-20 preseason poll.

In her 25th season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .767 (614-186) winning percentage, which ranks ninth in the nation among active head coaches with at least 15 years of experience and 11th all-time.

The unanimous 2020 National Coach of the Year, Staley became the first person to win both Naismith Player of the Year and a Naismith Coach of the Year. In 2024, she became the first men's or women's coach to earn Naismith Coach of the Year in three straight seasons. Staley is also the first Black head coach to win multiple national championships in men's or women's basketball. She has been named national coach of the year by at least one organization five times, including four of the last five years.

Now in her 17th season with the Gamecocks, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (443) with a program-record 13 postseason appearances. She accounts for all six of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances (2015, 2017, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024) and the only NCAA National Championships in program history (2017, 2022, 2024).

Staley's eight SEC regular-season championships trail only Pat Summitt's 16 in league history, and her seven SEC Coach of the Year awards trails Summitt's league record

by just one. Staley's 199 SEC regular-season wins are the most among active league coaches and third all-time – behind just Summitt (Tennessee, 306) and Andy Landers (Georgia, 273). Her 12.4 SEC wins per season is the best in league history among coaches with more than three years in the league, and her .783 SEC winning percentage (199-55) is second only to Summitt (.874).

### **Serious Scheduling**

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has never been afraid to challenge her team to prepare it for the rigors of March and April. This season is no different.

The Gamecocks' 30-game regular-season schedule includes 12 games against teams in the national rankings this week, including four against teams in the top five and three others against top-10 foes. Five of those 12 games are against non-conference opponents.

Over the last 10 seasons, South Carolina has played an average of 9.6 regular-season games against ranked foes.

Three teams matched this season for the high-water mark of 12 – 2019-20 (11-1), 2017-18 (6-6), 2015-16 (11-1). Each of those years four of the 12 games were non-conference matchups. The 2021-22 Gamecocks went a perfect 11-0 against their regular-season ranked opponents, including six such non-conference wins.

So far this season, South Carolina is 1-0 against ranked foes – vs #9/8 NC State (W, 71-57; 11/10).

### **All About Balance**

Like last season, South Carolina's greatest asset is its depth. Returning nine of 11 letterwinners from last season's undefeated National Championship team, the 2024-25 roster features six Gamecocks who averaged at least 18.0 minutes and scored at least 8.1 points per game last season

This season, 10 Gamecocks have played at least 16.0 minutes per game. Six average at least 6.0 points and three have grabbed at least 6.0 rebounds per game. Six Gamecocks have scored in double figures at least once this season, and each of the first three games have had a different top scorer.

### First Watch

Seven Gamecocks have been named to national award watch lists to start the 2024-25 season.

Fifth-year senior Te-Hina Paopao and sophomore MiLaysia Fulwiley lead the way, appearing on both the Naismith Preseason Watch List and the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 in addition to their position award watch lists — Nancy Lieberman Award (point guard) and Ann Meyers Drysdale Award (shooting guard), respectively.

Junior Raven Johnson joined Paopao on the Naismith and Lieberman Award watch lists.

Senior Bree Hall joined Fulwiley on the preseason list of the Meyers Drysdale Award. Maryam Dauda was among the 20 on the Cheryl Miller Award (small forward), and Sania Feagin earned a spot on the Katrina McClain Award (power forward) list. Sakima Walker rounded out the positional honors with a spot on the Lisa Leslie Award (center) watch list, continuing a long line of Gamecocks on that award's watch lists.

### **Pao-erful Impact**

Fifth-year senior guard Te-Hina Paopao is a four-time all-conference selection across two conferences, but added two first-time accolades to her resume last season

30th in the nation with a 2.23 assist-to-turnover ratio.

After choosing to transfer to South Carolina because of her belief in head coach Dawn Staley's ability to develop the skills she would need to succeed at the next level, Paopao chose to return for her fifth season of college basketball because of the significant strides she made in her overall game in just a few months in Columbia. This season, Staley has challenged her again to raise her defensive skills, and Paopao is delivering.

### **CK Obsession**

Forward Chloe Kitts showed flashes of her potential throughout her sophomore season, and, after an offseason of focusing on building her strength as much as her skills, she has exploded into her junior campaign.

She is the Gamecocks' top scorer and rebounder, averaging a double-double with 19.0 points and 12.0 rebounds per game. Her two double-doubles in as many outings rank her seventh in the nation. Her .625 field goal percentage leads the team as well.

After starting 31 games last season, Kitts held her position again this season, leading the Gamecocks with 19 points on 7-of-14 shooting against Michigan. Her career-high tying 14 rebounds included five offensive, and she scored immediately on three of those.

### The Full-wiley

The generational talent that is sophomore MiLaysia Fulwiley wow-ed fans last season with her creativity and athleticism. This season, the extremely coachable guard is learning the art of steadying her play in between her "wow" moments.

Fulwiley earned SEC All-Freshman honors last season and was the SEC Tournament MVP after a phenomenal title game that saw her net a career-high 24 points against #8/5 LSU. She finished the season second on the team in scoring at 11.7 points per game on 43.8 percent shooting.

In this season's first game against a ranked opponent, Fulwiley lit up #9/8 NC State (Nov. 10) for 18 points on

8-of-14 shooting. She is tied for second on the team with 15.0 points per game and is shooting 63.0 percent from the field over the last two games.

### That's So Raven

Junior Raven Johnson has turned her 2024 All-SEC effort into spots on the Naismith and Nancy Lieberman Point Guard of the Year Award watch lists after capping her 'Revenge Tour' with a lock-down defensive effort in the National Championship game.

The consummate point guard, Johnson showed off her balanced approach to the position last season with career-best scoring and assist averages – 8.1 ppg, 4.8 apg – meaning she had her hands on 22.3 percent of the Gamecocks' total offense. Her averages increased in her 11 games against ranked opponents to 9.2 points and 5.2 assists to account for 25.4 percent of the offense.

#### It's T-Time

Sophomore guard Tessa Johnson saw her consistent effort and steady demeanor pay off in the biggest moments of her freshman campaign, and she picked up right where she left off.

The quiet guard earned NCAA Final Four All-Tournament honors after exploding for 14.0 points per game on the season's final weekend, including 19 points on 7-of-11 shooting in the National Championship game. The whole three weeks in the NCAA Tournament were solid for Johnson, who posted three of her 10 double-digit scoring games in the last five games of the season and averaged 10.2 points over the six-game event.

In the season opener against Michigan, Johnson was the steadiest guard offensively, pouring in 15 points on 6-of-12 shooting, including 3-of-6 from 3-point range, highlighted by netting seven points in an 11-5 run midway through the second half.

### Let Us Re-Joyce

The No. 3 recruit in the 2024 signing class, according to espnW, forward Joyce Edwards has been as advertised with her athleticism and intellect allowing her to play multiple positions already.

The National Gatorade Player of the Year dominated the Gamecocks' exhibition games, leading the team with 19.5 points and 11.5 rebounds. In her official college debut, her 10 points and seven rebounds against Michigan included a clutch defensive rebound and a pair of free throws all in the final 13 seconds to help close out the victory.

Early in the season, Edwards has been aggressive on the glass, grabbing 6.0 rebounds per game to go along with her 9.3 points per game.

This year's Iron Gamecock winners were MiLaysia Fulwiley and Joyce Edwards. The Iron Gamecock recipients exhibit exceptional performances in areas of speed, power, strength, and competitive challenges in the weight room. This is MiLaysia's second consecutive Iron Gamecock award, and the first for Joyce.

### **Who's Got Next**

On the first day of the early signing period, South Carolina landed No. 22 recruit Ayla McDowell (Cypress, TX). The 6-foot-2 wing poured in 19.6 points and 9.2 rebounds per game in leading Cypress Springs to a 30-3 record and a spot in the 6A regional semifinals in 2023-24. She is on the 2024-25 Naismith Trophy High School Player of the Year Preseason Watch List.

### **Everybody's All-American**

The Gamecocks' 13-woman roster includes 10 McDonald's All-Americans – Maryam Dauda, Joyce Edwards, Sania Feagin, MiLaysia Fulwiley, Bree Hall, Raven Johnson, Tessa Johnson, Maddy McDaniel, Te-Hina Paopao and Ashlyn Watkins.

At South Carolina, Staley has coached 26 McDonald's All-Americans, including 20 who joined the Gamecocks as freshmen

### **WNBA Pipeline**

With 12 alumnae playing in the WNBA in 2024, South Carolina had the second-most players in the league of any college program.

Since the first Staley-trained Gamecock was drafted in 2015 (Aleighsa Welch), a total of 15 South Carolina players have been taken in the WNBA Draft with 11 of those going in the first round, including two No. 1 overall picks.

In proof Staley sends players to the league ready, six Gamecocks have earned All-Rookie Team honors,

including three WNBA Rookies of the Year – Allisha Gray (2017), A'ja Wilson (2018), Aliyah Boston (2023).\

### **Great Gamecock Fans**

South Carolina fans have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last 10 seasons with an eye on tying Tennessee for the NCAA-record streak of 11 seasons after selling out of season tickets for the first time in program history – 13,152.

The Gamecocks have had at least one sellout of their 18,000-seat Colonial Life Arena for eight straight seasons (excluding COVID-limited 2020-21 season) dating back to the first ever sellout of 18,000 on Feb. 8, 2016. Last season's five sellouts were the most in a single season in program history, until five have already been declared for this season as well – vs. East Carolina (Nov. 17), vs. Oklahoma (Jan. 19), vs. LSU (Jan. 23), vs. Auburn (Feb. 2) and vs. UConn (Feb. 16).

Excluding the COVID limited season of 2020-21, South Carolina has drawn at least 10,000 fans for 127 consecutive regular-season games beginning on Jan. 2, 2015.

# DAWN STALEY Head Coach

### 17th Season at South Carolina • 25th Season in Career

Since thrusting South Carolina into the national spotlight when she was hired in May 2008, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame inductee as a player is angling for another induction as a coach with her standing as one of five head coaches with at least three women's basketball National Championships and the only Black basketball head coach with multiple national titles, one of five head coaches to lead an undefeated team to a National Championship, and the first Black head coach of the USA Basketball Senior National Team.

In her 17th season at the helm of the Gamecocks, Staley's highlights include:

- Three National Championships and six NCAA Final Fours in the last nine tournaments
- Ranking in every AP Top 25 since Dec. 10, 2012 (second-longest active streak and ninth-longest all-time (229)
- 38 straight weeks at No. 1 in the AP Poll, third program to go wire-to-wire in that poll in back-to-back seasons
- 85 total weeks at No. 1 in the AP Poll, the third-most in the history of that poll
- Eight SEC regular-season championships and eight SEC Tournament titles
- SEC-record 47 consecutive league regular-season victories (10th in NCAA history for conference win streaks)
- Four top-two recruiting classes (#2 in 2024, #1 in 2021, #1 in 2019, #2 in 2014)
- 10 NCAA Attendance titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024)

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012.

In her 25th season as a head coach, Staley has led her college teams to 14 25-win seasons, a total of 20 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 218 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 83 in the No. 1 spot – the third most times in the top spot in the history of that poll. Her .768 winning percentage (614-186) ranks ninth in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 years of experience and 11th all-time.

In her 17th season at the helm of the Gamecocks, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2020, 2022, 2023, 2024). Her 2020 unanimous selection made her the first former Naismith Plaver of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award, and she became the first men's or women's coach to claim the award in three straight seasons 2022-24. She is a seven-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the only Gamecock basketball coach – men's or women's – to amass 300 victories at South Carolina and became the fastest coach to 200 wins in program history, needing just 277 games at South Carolina to reach the plateau. She is the program's all-time winningest coach with 443 wins, a .807 (443-106) winning percentage and a program-record 13 postseason appearances.

In the vaunted SEC, Staley's 199 league wins are the most among active league coaches and third all-time, trailing just Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Inductees Andy Landers (Georgia, 273) and Pat Summitt (Tennessee, 306). Her .783 SEC winning percentage (199-55) is second only to Summitt (.874) in league history. Her Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history, hitting that mark four times (2015-16, 2019-20, 2022-23, 2023-24). Staley's backto-back SEC undefeated seasons helped the Gamecocks to a current 47-game win streak in league play, which is an SEC record and ranks 10th in NCAA history for conference win streaks.

In addition to coaching two National Players of the Year, two National Defensive Players of the Year and a National Freshman of the Year, Staley has helped 11 Gamecocks collect 26 All-America selections, three to pick up seven SEC Player of the Year honors, four to earn eight SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognitions, two to SEC 6th Player of the Year honors and six to capture SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 21 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors 41 times, including 21 firstteam selections. In the last 10 seasons, 15 Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft, including 11 first-round picks, highlighted by two No. 1 overall picks in the last seven years. Three Gamecocks have been named WNBA Rookie of the Year.

In women's basketball, Colonial Life Arena has become one of the most feared places to play as enormous crowds fill the building with passion for the Gamecocks.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last 10 seasons. The Gamecocks were one of a few programs to finish the 2019-20 season averaging over 10,000 fans and boast 14 sellouts (18,000) in the last nine seasons of full capacity arenas.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest on-campus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300. The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of \$4.2 million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately  $12' \times 20'$  and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.
