GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- For the second time in as many seasons, the Gamecocks come off the holiday break with a non-conference matchup. The previous five seasons all saw South Carolina go right into SEC action.
- South Carolina has already played five games against ranked opponents with four wins – both of which lead the nation. The Gamecocks' 30-game schedule includes a national-high 14 games against teams ranked in this week's polls or at the time of the game, including six non-conference outings.
- The Gamecocks are winning the turnover battle, forcing 18.8 per game that have led to 22.4 points per game off turnovers. On the other side, South Carolina's 11.9 turnovers per game are 13th-best in the NCAA and have yielded just 9.5 points per game for its opponents.
- The South Carolina defense has held seven opponents under 60 points, including three ranked teams.
- Four Gamecocks average double-figure points this season with just one of them playing over 20 minutes per game. Sophomore MiLaysia Fulwiley's 10.0 points per game have come in just 17.8 minutes per outing, making her per-40-minute average a team-high 22.5 points.
- South Carolina is 17th in the nation with 5.7 blocks per game, and all but one Gamecock has swatted away at least one shot this season. Junior Ashlyn Watkins leads the way and ranks fourth in the SEC with 1.82 blocks per game, including a 2.0 average over the last five games. Guards have accounted for nearly a third of the team's 68 blocks (22).
- Five Gamecocks are shooting at least 50.0 percent from the field this season, led by Sania Feagin's 58.3 percent.
- South Carolina's two true freshmen are already making names for themselves. Maddy McDaniel leads the nation with a 5.33 assist-to-turnover ratio, including a 12-to-1 mark in her four games against ranked opponents. Her 3.2 assists per game lead the team. Joyce Edwards is tied for the team lead with seven double-figure scoring games and three games leading the team. She has been especially dominant over the last six games, leading the team with 12.2 points per game on 60.9 percent shooting and 2.0 steals per game in that time.

Since the loss at UCLA, 10 Gamecocks are scoring at least 6.0 points per game.

A Perennial Power

South Carolina women's basketball has been a national power for more than a decade under head coach Dawn Staley, including seven 30-win seasons in the last 10 campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in six Final Fours in the last nine NCAA Tournaments, including the last four, with National Championships in 2017, 2022 and 2024. They have been ranked in every AP Poll since Dec. 10, 2012, including a top-10 spot every week since the start of the 2019-20 season. The Gamecocks have amassed 86 AP No. 1 rankings all-time, the third-most by a program in the history of that poll. South Carolina is one of two programs in NCAA history to put together multiple 40-game win streaks.

Under head coach Dawn Staley's leadership, 11 Gamecocks have earned All-America status, three have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 22 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once.

In the last nine seasons, 14 Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft, including 10 first-round picks, highlighted by two No. 1 overall picks in the last six years. In the 2024 season, 12 Gamecocks were on a WNBA roster, the second most of any program in the country. Three Gamecocks have been named WNBA Rookie of the Year and one is a three-time WNBA MVP and two-time WNBA Defensive Player of the Year.

The Wofford Series

The Gamecocks are 7-0 all-time against the Terriers, but only one of those games has been in the Dawn Staley era (beginning 2008-09) and just two of the five games played in Columbia have been in Colonial Life Arena.

Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are 535-166 (.763) in home games (some records prior to 1976-77 did not include location of games). Current head coach Dawn Staley is 223-34 at home for a program-best .868 winning percentage.

South Carolina currently has a program-record 64-game home winning streak, which ranks ninth in NCAA history, that began on Dec. 17, 2020.

Playing in its 23rd season at Colonial Life Arena, South Carolina boasts a 286-67 (.810) record in the building, including four undefeated seasons since 2013-14. Staley's share of that record is 220-34 (.866).

Ranking Review

South Carolina is ranked No. 2 in both the AP Poll and No. 4 the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Poll this week.

It marks the Gamecocks 104th consecutive entry in

In the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Poll, South Carolina has been in the top 10 since claiming the No. 10 spot in the 2019-20 preseason poll.

The Staley File

In her 25th season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .769 (623-187) winning percentage, which ranks ninth in the nation among active head coaches with at least 15 years of experience and 11th all-time.

Staley is one of just two women's basketball coaches to lead their teams to multiple 40-game win streaks in NCAA history with the Gamecocks' recent program-record 43-game streak ranking seventh longest in NCAA history. She is the first Black head coach to win multiple national championships in men's or women's basketball, the fifth women's coach to win at least three NCAA titles and one of just 11 men's or women's coaches to hit that mark.

Now in her 17th season with the Gamecocks, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (451) with a program-record 13 postseason appearances. She accounts for all six of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances (2015, 2017, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024) and the only NCAA National Championships in program history (2017, 2022, 2024).

Staley's eight SEC regular-season championships trail only Pat Summitt's 16 in league history, and her seven SEC Coach of the Year awards trails Summitt's league record by just one. Staley's 199 SEC regular-season wins are the most among active league coaches and third all-time – behind just Summitt (Tennessee, 306) and Andy Landers (Georgia, 273). Her 12.4 SEC wins per season is the best in league history among coaches with more than three years in the league, and her .783 SEC winning percentage (199-55) is second only to Summitt (.874).

Serious Scheduling

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has never been afraid to challenge her team to prepare it for the rigors of March and April. This season is no different.

The Gamecocks' 30-game regular-season schedule includes 14 games against teams in the national rankings this week or at the time of the game, including six against teams in the top 10. Six of the 14 games are against non-conference opponents.

Over the last 10 seasons, South Carolina has played an average of 9.6 regular-season games against ranked foes.

So far, South Carolina is 4-1 against ranked foes – vs #9/8 NC State (W, 71-57; 11/10), at #5/6 UCLA (L, 62-77; 11/24), vs. #15/15 Iowa State (W, 76-36; 11/28), vs #8/9 Duke (W, 81-70, 12/5), vs. #9/13 TCU (W, 85-52, 12/8).

All About Balance

Like last season, South Carolina's greatest asset is its depth with the 2024-25 roster featuring six Gamecocks who averaged at least 18.0 minutes and scored at least 8.1 points per game last season.

This season, 10 Gamecocks have played at least 15.0 minutes per game. Seven average at least 7.0 points, including four who average double figures. Four players have grabbed at least 4.0 rebounds per game. Eleven Gamecocks have scored in double figures at least once, including six who have done it at least four, and five players have led the team in scoring at least once.

Bench Mob

Head coach Dawn Staley's 13-player roster gives her the ability to make a full line change with little drop off.

This season, the Gamecock bench leads the nation with 40.6 points per game to account for 50.4 percent of the total offense. The South Carolina bench has out-scored its opponents' bench by 27.0 points per game and has outscored the opponent's starting lineup seven times, including a pair of ranked opponents.

On the glass, the bench averages 18.1 rebounds per game (46.5 percent of team total) compared to just 8.2 for their opponents' bench.

Glass Work

South Carolina continues to show a full team rebounding effort, keeping with program tradition. While the Gamecocks have been out-rebounded twice this season (at UCLA, 11/24, 41-34; Duke, 12/5, 33-28), they are rising to the program's standard, ranking 29th in the nation with 42.8 rebounds per game and 14th in rebounding margin (+11.1).

South Carolina's 16.33 offensive rebounds per game rank 13th in the nation, and its 43.7 offensive rebounding percent is ninth, according to Her Hoop Stats.

Four Gamecocks average at least four rebounds on the season with junior Chloe Kitts leading the way at 7.82 to rank 10th in the SEC. Junior Ashlyn Watkins is second with 5.8, and freshman Joyce Edwards is next at 5.2. Guard Raven Johnson rounds out the quartet with 4.6.

Block Party

South Carolina annually ranks among the best shot blocking teams in the country, and with 12 of 13 Gamecocks recording at least one block this season, they are continuing the tradition. Even without a dominant center, the Gamecocks are 17th in the nation with 5.7 blocks per game, including a combined 10 by the three shortest players on the team – Raven Johnson, Maddie McDaniel and Te-Hina Paopao.

Ashlyn Watkins is fourth in the SEC with 1.82 blocks per game, and Sania Feagin ranks 14th with a 1.17 average.

Paint Production

South Carolina has long controlled the paint, and this season's numbers have upheld that standard.

With 53.6 percent of their points coming in the paint, the Gamecocks are out-scoring opponents in that space 43.2 to 22.8 (+20.3) for the season, including by +12.4 points per game against ranked opponents (37.2-24.8). They are shooting 52.3 percent in the paint compared to opponents' 38.8 percent accuracy in the space. Over the

last six games (including three against ranked opponents), the Gamecocks' interior accuracy is up to 57.4 percent.

Last season, South Carolina averaged 45.6 points in the paint to account for 53.3 percent of its offense.

Quarter Breakdown

South Carolina's defense has held an opponent to single digits in a quarter eight times this season, including five against ranked teams. The Gamecocks have out-scored their opponent by 10 or more points in a quarter 17 times. The scoring differential is largest in the second quarter (+8.5).

Individually, three Gamecocks have scored double digits in a single quarter – Joyce Edwards (1), Tessa Johnson (1) and Chloe Kitts (1). The top single-quarter individual scoring this season is 11 points by Edwards in the fourth quarter against Charleston Southern (12/19).

First Watch

Seven Gamecocks have been named to national award watch lists to start the 2024-25 season.

Fifth-year senior Te-Hina Paopao and sophomore MiLaysia Fulwiley lead the way, appearing on both the Naismith Preseason Watch List and the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 in addition to their position award watch lists – Nancy Lieberman Award (point guard) and Ann Meyers Drysdale Award (shooting guard), respectively.

Junior Raven Johnson joined Paopao on the Naismith and Lieberman Award watch lists.

Senior Bree Hall joined Fulwiley on the preseason list of the Meyers Drysdale Award. Maryam Dauda was among the 20 on the Cheryl Miller Award (small forward), and Sania Feagin earned a spot on the Katrina McClain Award (power forward) list. Sakima Walker rounded out the positional honors with a spot on the Lisa Leslie Award (center) watch list, continuing a long line of Gamecocks on that award's watch lists.

Pao-erful Impact

Fifth-year senior guard Te-Hina Paopao is a four-time all-conference selection across two conferences, but she added two first-time accolades to her resume last season – All-American and NCAA Div. I 3-point percentage leader. This season she has leveled up again, appearing on both the Naismith and Wooden Award watch lists and posting her Gamecock career-high 23 points in a commanding win over #9/8 NC State (Nov. 10).

Paopao leads the team with 11.3 points per game this season, including 14.0 points per game against ranked opponents. She is shooting 49.1 percent from the field and 42.9 percent from 3-point range, averaging 1.75 made 3s. Those numbers rise against ranked opponents to 55.8 percent shooting and 60.0 from the arc with 2.4 made 3s.

Paopao also hands out 2.4 assists per game, which have led to 5.8 points per game and mean she has her hands on 23.5 percent of the Gamecocks' total offense.

After choosing to transfer to South Carolina because of her belief in head coach Dawn Staley's ability to develop the skills she needs to succeed at the next level, Paopao chose to return for her fifth season of college basketball because of the significant strides she made in her overall game in just a few months in Columbia. This season, Staley has challenged her again to raise her skills, and Paopao is delivering.

In addition to amping up her defensive skills, the veteran has diversified her offense as well. Paopao is

averaging 4.3 points from 3-point range, 4.3 from the paint and 2.4 from her midrange game. Against ranked teams, Paopao is even more level in her scoring – 5.0 ppg from 3, 4.4 from the paint, 4.6 from midrange.

CK Obsession

Forward Chloe Kitts spent the offseason focusing on building her strength as much as her skills. The result has allowed her to fully get to her skill set this season, and the confidence has her playing with authority.

Kitts is third on the team with 10.1 points per game and second with six double-figure scoring games, including a team-high three games as the team's high scorer. Her three double-doubles are a team high and halfway to her sophomore year total of six.

In just her fourth semester on campus, Kitts is 10th in the SEC with 7.82 rebounds per game. She is 12th in the SEC with 3.0 offensive rebounds per game that have added 2.0 points per game to her scoring.

The Full-wiley

The generational talent that is sophomore MiLaysia Fulwiley wow-ed fans last season with her creativity and

athleticism. This season, the extremely coach-able guard is learning the art of steadying her play between the "wow" moments.

Fulwiley earned SEC All-Freshman honors last season and was the SEC Tournament MVP after a phenomenal title game that saw her net a career-high 24 points against #8/5 LSU. She finished the season second on the team in scoring at 11.7 points per game on 43.8 percent shooting.

This season Fulwiley is fourth on the team in scoring at 10.0 points per game while shooting 41.0 percent from the field. She has two 20-point scoring games, including 20 against #9/13 TCU (Dec. 8).

That's So Raven

Junior Raven Johnson has turned her 2024 All-SEC effort into spots on the Naismith and Nancy Lieberman Point Guard of the Year Award watch lists after capping her 'Revenge Tour' with a lock-down defensive effort in the National Championship game.

The consummate point guard, Johnson showed off her balanced approach to the position last season with career-best scoring and assist averages – 8.1 ppg, 4.8 apg – meaning she had her hands on 22.3 percent of the Gamecocks' total offense. Her averages increased in her 11 games against ranked opponents to 9.2 points and 5.2 assists to account for 25.4 percent of the offense.

This season Johnson's scoring started off sluggish but is showing signs of returning to form. Over the last three games she averaged 7.7 points on 56.3 percent from the field, including 50.0 percent from 3-point range, while handing out 3.7 assists per game in that stretch.

It's T-Time

Sophomore guard Tessa Johnson saw her consistent effort and steady demeanor pay off in the biggest moments of her freshman campaign, and she has picked up right where she left off this season.

The soft-spoken guard earned NCAA Final Four All-Tournament honors after exploding for 14.0 points per game on the season's final weekend, including 19 points on 7-of-11 shooting in the National Championship game. The whole three weeks in the NCAA Tournament were solid for Johnson, who posted three of her 10 double-digit scoring games in the last five games of the season and averaged 10.2 points over the six-game event.

In the season opener against Michigan, Johnson was the steadiest guard offensively, pouring in 15 points on 6-of-12 shooting, including 3-of-6 from 3-point range, highlighted by netting seven points in an 11-5 run midway through the second half.

For the season, Johnson's 8.2 points per game have come on 48.4 percent shooting, including 46.4 percent from 3. She has posted double figures four times.

Ashlyn SWAT-kins

The first Gamecock to dunk in a game, Ashlyn Watkins' athleticism has never been in question and was solidified with her first dunk over a defender against #9/13 TCU (Dec. 8). The All-SEC Second-Team selection brought all aspects of her game together last season.

Watkins' 5.8 rebounds per game are second on the team and include 2.36 on the offensive end. She is scoring 7.6 points per game with three double-figure scoring outings. Over the last five games, which includes two against ranked opponents, her offense jumped to 8.6 points per game on 60.6 percent shooting.

Defensively, Watkins is fourth in the SEC with 1.82 blocks per game, including 2.0 over the last five games.

Let Us Re-Joyce

The No. 3 recruit in the 2024 signing class, according to ESPNW, forward Joyce Edwards has been as advertised with her athleticism and intellect allowing her to play multiple positions already.

In her college debut against Michigan (Nov. 4), the

National Gatorade Player of the Year delivered a clutch defensive rebound and a pair of free throws all in the final 13 seconds to close out the win.

For the season, Edwards is second on the team with 10.6 points per game and third with a 5.1 rebounding average. She is tied for the team lead with seven double-figure scoring games and three games leading the team in scoring. Half of her rebounds have come on the offensive end (2.58 per game), and she has a team-high 20 steals.

Edwards posted her first career double-double with a 13-point, 11 rebound effort against #15/15 Iowa State

(Nov. 28). After nearly repeating the effort in the next game, she earned a spot on the Fort Myers Tip-Off All-Island Division Team and SEC co-Freshman of the Week. She capped the pre-holiday schedule with back-to-back career-high scoring games, including her first 20-point outing (vs. Charleston Southern, 12/19).

M-M Good!

After missing much of the preseason and first two games recovering from an injury, freshman point guard Maddy McDaniel is beginning to show off the skill set that

has her head coach beaming and praising her reliability.

The two-time All-Washington Catholic Athletic Conference Player of the Year leads the nation with a 5.33 assist-to-turnover ratio with second place at a distant 3.92. McDaniels' number includes five turnover-free games (3 against ranked opponents) and five games of four or more assists – hitting both marks at #5/6 UCLA (Nov. 24) and #15/15 Iowa State (Nov. 28). Her 3.2 assists per game lead the team.

McDaniel is finding confidence in calling her own number as well, averaging 5.2 points for the season on 52.9 percent shooting, including a perfect 5-of-5, 10-point outing against Purdue (Nov. 30).

More New Faces

Two other new faces made their Gamecock debuts this season in redshirt freshman Adhel Tac and junior transfer Maryam Dauda.

Tac was part of the Gamecocks' No. 2 ranked 2024 signing class before enrolling early after her second season-ending injury in as many high school seasons. She has seen time in eight games so far this season.

Dauda joined the Gamecocks after two seasons at Arkansas, including a 2023-24 campaign that saw her average 10.1 points and 6.3 rebounds and lead the SEC in blocks per league game (2.8). In nine games this season, she averages 1.9 points and 1.9 rebounds.

Streaking

South Carolina's 43-game win streak that included the first five games of this season featured 12 games against ranked opponents. The run put the Gamecocks in elite company, joining UConn as the only teams to have multiple 40-game win streaks in program history – only six have hit the mark once. South Carolina's first such streak was a 42-game stretch from March 18, 2022, through March 27, 2023.

The Gamecocks' current 64-game home winning streak, dating back to Dec. 18, 2020, ranks ninth in NCAA history and includes 12 wins over ranked opponents. Their 33-game road win streak (Jan. 6, 2022 - Nov. 20, 2024) is the third longest in NCAA history with seven games versus ranked teams.

Nothing but NET

This season, the NET, used by the NCAA Tournament selection committee, is using the Quad system, similar to college men's basketball. The system weights the location of the game as well as the opponent.

Quad 1 includes games played at home against teams with NET rankings 1-25, neutral site games against teams

ranked 1-35 and away games against teams 1-45. Quad 2 is home games against 26-55, neutral games versus 36-65 and away against 46-80. Quad 3 is made up of home games 56-90, neutral 66-105 and away 81-130. Quad 4 is all remaining games.

South Carolina is second in the latest NET rankings and leads the nation with 15 Quad 1 games on the schedule.

Who's Got Next

On the first day of the early signing period, South Carolina landed No. 22 recruit Ayla McDowell (Cypress, TX). The 6-foot-2 wing poured in 19.6 points and 9.2 rebounds per game in leading Cypress Springs to a 30-3 record and a spot in the 6A regional semifinals in 2023-24. She is on the 2024-25 Naismith Trophy High School Player of the Year Preseason Watch List.

Everybody's All-American

The Gamecocks' 13-woman roster includes 10 McDonald's All-Americans – Maryam Dauda, Joyce Edwards, Sania Feagin, MiLaysia Fulwiley, Bree Hall, Raven Johnson, Tessa Johnson, Maddy McDaniel, Te-Hina Paopao and Ashlyn Watkins.

At South Carolina, Staley has coached 26 McDonald's All-Americans, including 20 who signed as freshmen.

WNBA Pipeline

With 12 alumnae playing in the WNBA in 2024, South Carolina had the second-most players in the league of any college program.

Since the first Staley-trained Gamecock was drafted in 2015 (Aleighsa Welch), a total of 15 South Carolina players have been taken in the WNBA Draft with 11 of those going in the first round, including two No. 1 overall picks.

In proof Staley sends players to the league ready, six Gamecocks have earned All-Rookie Team honors, including three WNBA Rookies of the Year – Allisha Gray (2017), Aja Wilson (2018), Aliyah Boston (2023).

Great Gamecock Fans

South Carolina fans have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last 10 seasons with an eye on tying Tennessee for the NCAA-record streak of 11 seasons after selling out of season tickets for the first time in program history – 13,152. They are currently leading the country in average attendance at 16,176, and the Gamecocks have played in front of the largest crowd in college women's basketball this season (and five of the top 10).

The Gamecocks have had at least one sellout of their 18,000-seat Colonial Life Arena for eight straight seasons (excluding COVID-limited 2020-21 season) dating back to the first ever sellout of 18,000 on Feb. 8, 2016. Last season's five sellouts were the most in a single season in program history, until five have already been declared for this season as well – vs. East Carolina (Nov. 17), vs. Oklahoma (Jan. 19), vs. LSU (Jan. 23), vs. Auburn (Feb. 2) and vs. UConn (Feb. 16).

DAWN STALEY Head Coach

17th Season at South Carolina • 25th Season in Career

Since thrusting South Carolina into the national spotlight when she was hired in May 2008, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame inductee as a player is angling for another induction as a coach with her standing as one of five head coaches with at least three women's basketball National Championships and the only Black basketball head coach with multiple national titles, one of five head coaches to lead an undefeated team to a National Championship, and the first Black head coach of the USA Basketball Senior National Team.

In her 17th season at the helm of the Gamecocks, Staley's highlights include:

- Three National Championships and six NCAA Final Fours in the last nine tournaments
- Ranking in every AP Top 25 since Dec. 10, 2012 (second-longest active streak and ninth-longest all-time (235)
- 38 straight weeks at No. 1 in the AP Poll, (2021-23) third program to go wire-to-wire in that poll in back-to-back seasons
- 86 total weeks at No. 1 in the AP Poll, the third-most in the history of that poll
- Eight SEC regular-season championships and eight SEC Tournament titles
- SEC-record 47 consecutive league regular-season victories (10th in NCAA history for conference win streaks)
- Four top-two recruiting classes (#2 in 2024, #1 in 2021, #1 in 2019, #2 in 2014)
- 10 NCAA Attendance titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024)

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012.

In her 25th season as a head coach, Staley has led her college teams to 14 25-win seasons, a total of 20 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 195 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 86 in the No. 1 spot – the third most times in the top spot in the history of that poll. Her .769 winning percentage (623-187) ranks ninth in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 years of experience and 11th all-time.

In her 17th season at the helm of the Gamecocks, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2020, 2022, 2023, 2024). Her 2020 unanimous selection made her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award, and she became the first men's or women's coach to claim the award in three straight seasons 2022-24. She is a seven-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the only Gamecock basketball coach – men's or women's – to amass 300 victories at South Carolina and became the fastest coach to 200 wins in program history, needing just 277 games at South Carolina to reach the plateau. She is the program's all-time winningest coach with 451 wins, an .808 (451-107) winning percentage and a program-record 13 postseason appearances.

In the vaunted SEC, Staley's 199 league wins are the most among active league coaches and third all-time, trailing just Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Inductees Andy Landers (Georgia, 273) and Pat Summitt (Tennessee, 306). Her .783 SEC winning percentage (199-55) is second only to Summitt (.874) in league history. Her Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history, hitting that mark four times (2015-16, 2019-20, 2022-23, 2023-24). Staley's back-to-back SEC undefeated seasons helped the Gamecocks to a current 47-game win streak in league play, which is an SEC record and ranks 10th in NCAA history for conference win streaks.

In addition to coaching two National Players of the Year, two National Defensive Players of the Year and a National Freshman of the Year, Staley has helped 11 Gamecocks collect 26 All-America selections, three to pick up seven SEC Player of the Year honors, four to earn eight SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognitions, two to SEC 6th Player of the Year honors and six to capture SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 21 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors 41 times, including 21 first-team selections. In the last 10 seasons, 15 Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft, including 11 first-round picks, highlighted by two No. 1 overall picks in the last seven years. Three Gamecocks have been named WNBA Rookie of the Year.

In women's basketball, Colonial Life Arena has become one of the most feared places to play as enormous crowds fill the building with passion for the Gamecocks.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last 10 seasons. The Gamecocks were one of a few programs to finish the 2019-20 season averaging over 10,000 fans and boast 15 sellouts (18,000) in the last 10 seasons of full capacity arenas.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest on-campus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300. The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of \$4.2 million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately 12' x 20' and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.
